<b>RAYS REPORT</b> —The Rays wrap up a brief four-game road trip against the Astros (2-1, one

The Rays claimed their first season series over the Astros since 2019 with yesterday's 16-3 win, erupting for a club-record-tying 12 XBH (also: June 16, 2009 at COL)... their 5 HR were their most since April 29, 2023 at CWS (5HR), and their 7 2B were thir most since April 1, 2023 vs. DET (7 2B). It marked their fourth win this season by 10 runs or more, tied with the Yankees for second most in the majors behind the Cubs (5G)... they are one of four teams to score 13 runs or more in four games this season (5G - LAD: 4G - BOS, LAD, TB). Of the 44 runs the Rays have scored vs. the Astros in 2025, 29 have come against the bullpen... Houston relievers have a 13.27 ERA (19.2IP, 29ER) against the Rays and a 2.52 ERA (178.2IP, 50ER) against all other opponents. Through three games of the current series, the Rays have 19 XBH...the team record for a single series is 24 XBH, set from Aug. 10-13, 2020 at BOS. The Rays have outscored opponents, 72-22 (+52), during their 9-2 stretch, pitching to a 1.92 ERA (98.2IP, 21ER) while averaging 6.7 runs per game...it marks their best run differential over any 11-game stretch since April 2-13, 2023 (+57). Tampa Bay leads the majors in stolen bases (82) and defensive runs saved (40). The Rays have not trailed in six of their last nine games.. they have faced a deficit at the end of only 12 of their last 92 innings since the 8th frame on May 20 vs. HOU. Tampa Bay went 16-12 in May, tied for the fourth-best record in the AL and marking its most wins in a calendar month since September 2023 (16-11). With a win today, the Rays would claim their fourth straight series win, their longest streak since June 18-July 4, 2024 (6), and sixth in their last seven tries.

I CAN GO THE DISTANCE—Yesterday, Zack Littell threw his first career complete game, the 10th in the majors this season and first by a Rays pitcher since Ryan Yarbrough on June 3, 2021 at NYY... before Yarbrough, the clubs last CG belonged to Matt Andriese on May 14, 2016 vs. OAK...Littell ended the Rays run of 647 consecutive games without a CG, the second-longest streak in major league history, eclipsed only by Tampa Bay's own 731-game streak from May 15, 2016–June 2, 2021...of the 106 CG in team history, only three have come over the last 10 seasons since 2016 (103CG from 1998–2015)..Littell threw a career-high 117 pitches, most by a Ray since Jake Odorizzi (118) on May 27, 2017 at MIN and most by a Ray in a CG since David Price (118) on Sept. 30, 2013 at TEX...it marked the most pitches thrown by any MLB hurler since TOR Bowden Francis (117) on Aug. 24, 2024 vs. LAA.

\*\*Paired with HOU Framber Valdez's start on Friday night, the Rays have been involved in back-to-back CGs for the first time since Trevor Bauer and Corey Kluber threw consecutive CGs against them from June 21-22, 2016 at CLE...they were last involved in three straight from Aug. 20-22, 2014 (Smyly/Price/Porcello).

LA MÁXIMA—Junior Caminero went 4-for-4 with 2 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI and 4 R in yesterday's win, recording his first career multi-homer game and first four-hit game... he became the first player with 4 XBH and 5 RBI in a game in franchise history and the fourth in the majors this season (last: HOU Jake Meyers on May 3 at CWS)...he is the fifth-youngest player in the majors since 1901 to reach those figures (see table to the right)...Caminero tied franchise records in extra-base hits (4, 7x, last: Ben Zobrist on June 11, 2011 at BAL) and total bases (12, 10x, last: Taylor Walls on April 18, 2023 at CIN)...he is 7-for-14 (500) with 3 2B, 3 HR and 11 RBI this series...it ties the Rays record for most extra-base hits in any series, regardless of length (6, five players, 9x, last: Evan Longoria from June 9-11, 2008 at LAA)...the 11 RBI are the second most by a Ray in a single series, trailing only Ben Zobrist's 13 RBI from April 27-29, 2011 at MIN.

\* Caminero has homered in three of his last four games and has an extra-base hit in eight of his last nine games, batting, 332 (16-for-37) with 7 2B, 5 HR and 17 RBI...he leads the majors in slugging (1.027), XBH, total bases (38) and hits (T1st, 16) in that span (since May 23) while ranking second in OPS (1.474) behind NYY Aaron Judge (1.514)...

He leads AL third basemen in home runs (13) and RBI (37) while ranking third in slugging pct. (512) behind BOS Alex Bregman (.553) and CLE José Ramirez (.541).

Caminero is currently on pace for 36 2B and 36 HR...the only player in Rays history to reach those marks is Evan Longoria (41 2B/36HR) in 2016, and only three hitters in the majors since 1901 have reached them in an age-21 or younger season: SEA Alex Rodriguez (54 2B/36HR in 1996, age 20). STL Albert Pujols (47 2B/37HR in 2001, age 21) and NYG Mel Ott (37 2B/42HR in 1929, age 20).

YOU GET A HIT. YOU GET A HIT...—All nine Rays starters recorded a hit yesterday for the fourth time this season, all of which have come in the last seven games (also: May 25 vs. TOR, May 26 vs. MIN, May 29 at HOU)...it marks the first time they have turned the trick four times over a seven-game span in franchise history...the last major league club to accomplish the feat was the Tigers (four times in five games) from May 2-6, 2014, per Stats Perform...the four games march their total from the entire 2024 season and are tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors all season.

\*\*Jonathan Aranda is 10-for-22 (.455) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 7 RBI in his last seven games.

\*\*The Rays are 11-5 since Josh Lowe returned from the injured list on May 15...Lowe has a hit in seven of his last nine games, going 12-for-35 (.343) with 4 XBH and 5 BB.

\*\*José Caballero has hit safely in in 12 of his last 15 games, batting .291 (16-for-55) with 8 XBH, 8 RBI and an .833 OPS.

\*\*Curtis Mead is 10-for-33 (.333) with 1 2B, 3 HR and 4 RBI over his last 10 games.

\*\*Yandy Diaz is 5-for-14 (.357) with 2 2B, 1 HR and 5 RBI this series...his homer yesterday was the 82nd of his career, tying Kevin Kiermaier for the 10th in team history.

DAWG POUND—Brandon Lowe is 17-for-49 (.347) with 4 2B, 4 HR and 7 RBI during his career-best 13-game hitting streak, the longest active streak in the majors...he has recorded a hit in 16 of his last 17 games overall, slashing .364/.417/.712 (24-for-66) with 11 XBH and 13 RBI...over that stretch (since May 13), he leads the AL in runs scored (17), and his 47 total bases are tied with LAA Taylor Ward for second most in the AL behind SEA Cal Raleigh (50).

\*\* Lowe has scored a run in nine straight games, the longest streak in the majors since LAD Shohei Ohtani (9G) from Sept. 19-28, 2024...OAK Lawrence Butler (10G - Aug. 21-31, 2024) has the last longer streak...it marks the second-longest streak of Lowe's career behind Aug. 11-21, 2020 (10G) and is two games shy of the franchise record (11G) held by Austin Meadows (Sept. 8-21, 2019).

MOUND MAESTROS—The Rays have allowed four runs or fewer in 12 straight games, their longest single-season streak since a 16-game run to conclude the 2021 season (Sept. 16-Oct. 3, 2021) and tied for the fifth-longest streak of any type in franchise history...the staff has also allowed 3 ER or fewer in nine straight games, their longest run since May 22-30, 2019 and tied for the third longest in team history, trailing streaks of 12 games (Aug. 4-16, 2014) and 10 games (July 24-Aug. 4, 2016).

The rotation has turned in a 1.52 ERA (59, IIP, 10ER) and 0.83 WHIP across their last nine starts, yielding one or zero runs in six of those outings.

The bullpen has a 1.98 ERA (36.1IP, 8ER) in the last 13 games since May 17, fourth in the majors behind the Cubs (0.88), Giants (1.61) and Blue Jays (1.94).

LESS IS MORE—Tampa Bay has the most efficient pitching staff in the majors, averaging the fewest pitches per inning at 15.4, which would surpass 2022 (15.8) for the fewest in team history and mark the lowest figure in MLB since the 2015 Mets (15.4)...the Rays have thrown 130 pitches or fewer in eight straight games (127, 123, 103, 126, 124, 130, 123, 117), tying the 2007 Rockies (July 20-28) and 2002 Mariners (June 12-21) for the longest single-season streak in the majors since pitch counts were first tracked in 1988.

TODAY'S START—Taj Bradley takes the mound today for his 12th start of the campaign second against the Astros...marks his 58th career start (60G) and fifth against Houston...is looking for his third consecutive quality start...was selected by the Rays in the fifth round (150th overall) of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft.

LAST TIME OUT—Bradley suffered the loss after a matching a career high with 7.0 innings pitched in a 4-2 defeat to Minnesota on May 27 (L, 7.0IP, 5H, 3R, 2ER, BB, 6SO, HR)...he was tagged for a run in the 1st inning after a double-strikeout-single-sacrifice fly sequence...Kody Clemens followed it up with a home run to start the 2nd inning but settled in and retired the next 10 batters to come to the plate and 12 of 13...allowed an unearned run in the 6th after a throwing error allowed Ryan Jeffers to score...he set down five of the final six batters he faced...was his ninth straight start throwing 80 or more pitches with at least 50 strikes.

\* His 7.0 innings were his most since he tossed 7.0 IP on April 29 vs. KC...he has reached that total eight times in his career.

\* He has six strikeouts or more in three straight starts for the second time this season and the sixth time in his career...he has reached four straight starts twice in his career (last: Sept. 27, 2024–April 11, 2025).

TAKING A SPACE WALK—In four career starts against Houston, he is 2-2 with a 7.71 ERA (18.2IP, 16ER) and a 11.09 strikeouts per nine rate...started against the Astros on May 21 at Steinbrenner Field and earned his fourth win of the season...he allowed two runs over 6.0 innings and allowed four hits (1HR) and two walks with seven strikeouts...

\* In 14 career starts against AL West opponents, he is 2-5 with a 5.64 (68.2IP, 43ER) and a .242 (64-for-264) opp. average...he has allowed three runs or fewer in five of his last seven starts against the division for a 4.30 ERA (37.2IP, 18ER) compared to a 7.26 ERA (31.0IP, 25ER) in his first six outings.

FREQUENT FLYER MILES—Is making his fifth road start of the campaign with a 1-1 record in his four previous outings...he holds a 6.20 ERA (20.1IP, 14ER) despite a .237 (18-for-76) opp. average in those starts...seven of the 14 runs he has allowed this year on the road have come on home runs and two have been the first batter faced in the game (April 5 at TEX, Marcus Semien & April 23 at AZ, Corbin Carroll).

**TWO NICE**—The right-hander has allowed two earned runs or fewer in seven of 11 starts this season with the Rays holding a 5-2 record in those games and a 1-3 record when he allows three earned runs or more... across his 57 career starts, he has given up two earned runs or fewer in 31 with the team going 22-9 compared to a 6-20 record with three earned runs or more. runs or more.

60 FEET, 6 INCHES—Is making his 60th career appearance today (58GS)... through 59 outings, he has allowed 283 hits, fourth fewest by a Ray through his first 59 career appearances (min. 300.0 IP)...across that span, only Shane McClanahan (259H, April 29, 2021-April 27, 2023), Blake Snell (270H, April 23, 2016–June 19, 2018) and Matt Moore (277H, Sept. 14, 2011–Sept. 19, 2013) have fewer hits allowed.

**HEART-STOPPING**—Opposing 3-4-5 hitters have batted .163 (13-for-80) with 1 HR against Bradley, the third-lowest mark among qualified AL pitchers behind TOR **Kevin Gausman** (.159) and NYY Carlos **Rodón** (.160)...all other batters have gone a combined 42-for-152 (.276) with 8 HR against him.

**STRETCH\_TIME**—Bradley has held opponents to a .200 (21-for-105) average with runners on base, including .176 (12-for-68) in his last seven starts…his .188 (9-for-48) opp. average with runners in scoring position is eighth lowest among AL pitchers (min. 50BF)…with the bases empty, opponents are batting .268 (34-for-127) with six of his nine home runs allowed.

FALTERED IN THE FIRST—12 of the 32 runs (37.5%) and 16 of the 55 hits (29.1%) Bradley has allowed have come in the opening frame, both of which are his most in any inning...he has permitted 1st-inning baserunners in 10 of 11 starts this season—the lone exception was May 10 vs. MIL...Bradley has yielded a run in the opening frame in eight of his last 10 starts, but has held opponents scoreless in two of his last five...on the season he has recorded a 9.82 ERA (11.0IP, 12ER) and a 348 (16-for-46) opp. average in the 1st frame compared to a 3.25 ERA (52.2IP, 19ER) and 209 (39-for-186) opp. average from the 2nd inning on.

He has limited opponents to a 189 (17-for-90) opp. AVG in his second time through the lineup...min. 90BF, that is tied for tenth among AL pitchers.

JUNE GLOOM—In 11 career starts during June, Bradley has held opposing batters to a .244/.320/.455 (52-for-213) slash line...he has four wins in June, tied for his most in any single month in his career (also: April)...he has worked to a 4.72 ERA (55.1IP, 29ER) with 74 strikeouts and has surrendered 2 ER or fewer in eight of the 11 starts.

HOMEGROWN—Bradley is one of 15 pitchers drafted by Tampa Bay to make at least 50 starts for the club, including one of four drafted since the team became the Rays in 2008 along with Shane McClanahan (2018), Ryne Stanek (2013) and Blake Snell (2011)...the fifth-round selection is one of six Rays draftees to make at least 50 starts with the club after being selected in the fifth round or later, joining Matt Moore (8th rd., 2007), Andy Sonnanstine (13th rd., 2004), James Shields (16th rd., 2000), Joe Kennedy (8th rd., 1998) and Ryan Rupe (6th rd., 1998).

HIGHS AND LOWS—Bradley's 2024 season, his second in the majors, was defined by several distinct stretches throughout the campaign:

\* May 8-June 1: After being reinstated from the 15-day IL (right pectoral strain), he tossed a quality start in his season debut on May 10 vs. NYY, but went 1-3 with a 5.81 ERA (26.1IP, 17ER) in five starts...this period culminated in a career-high 9 ER and a career-high-tying 4 HR on June 1 at BAL.

\* June 8-July 25: Bradley spun one of the most prolific stretches in franchise history, going 5-1 with a 0.82 ERA (55.0IP, 5ER), 65 strikeouts, 18 walks and a 0.89 WHIP over his next nine starts...it marked the lowest ERA over any nine-start span in Rays history (excl. openers)...he led the majors in ERA and opp. average (162) while also ranking highly in strikeouts (2nd), wins (T4th), innings (T4th) and WHIP (6th).

\* July 31-Sept. 10: He went 0-6 with an 8.27 ERA (41.1IP, 38ER), 40 strikeouts, 14 walks and a 1.62 WHIP over eight starts—the ERA and WHIP were the highest in MLB...he yielded 12 HR (2.61 HR/9.0IP) on the heels of a career-best five-start homerless streak (June 30-July 25).

\* Sept. 15-season's end: Bradley bounced back to the tune of a 2-1 mark and 1.76 ERA (15.1IP, 3ER) over his final three starts, allowing only one run across his final two outings (11.0IP).
