TONIGHT'S STARTER: #51 - RHP FREDDY PERALTA (7gs, 3-1, 3.49)

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: Freddy Peralta, 27, is making his eighth start of the season and second against the Cardinals....Peralta last started last Sunday at Chicago-NL in a 5-O loss (5ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 6bb, 5k, 1hbp, 1wp, 97 pitches)....his 6 walks tied a career high (5/19/18 at MIN)....following that start, he served a 5-game suspension for allegedly hitting Jose Siri intentionally with a pitch on 4/30 vs. Tampa Bay....the team is 6-1 in his starts....he has 3 quality starts....opponents are batting .174 (23-for-132, 4hr).....he is the third pitcher in franchise history born in the Dominican Republic to start on Opening Day, joining **Rafael Roque** (1999) and **Wily Peralta** (2016), who is of no relation..... Peralta was acquired from Seattle, along with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki, in exchange for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

LAST SEASON: Peralta went 12-10 with a 3.86 ERA in a career-high 30 starts last season.....the team went 17-13 in his starts.....he made 16 quality starts.....opponents batted .212 (131-for-617, 26hr).....Peralta ranked among the 2023 National League leaders in K/9IP (3rd, 11.41), WHIP (5th, 1.12), H/9IP (5th, 7.12), strikeouts (T5th, 210) and K/BB (7th, 3.89).....he became the eighth pitcher (14x) in franchise history to produce 200+ strikeouts in a season.

CAREER: Is 45-28 with a 3.81 ERA and 1 save in 153 games/104 starts (619.1ip, 262er)....is in his seventh Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-24).....has gone 37-26 with a 3.80 ERA as a starter (535.1ip, 226er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: IS 26-14 with a 3.39 ERA in 80 games/52 starts (323.2ip, 122er)....is 1-0 with a 4.09 ERA in 2 starts this season (11ip, 5er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 19-14 with a 4.26 ERA in 73 games/52 starts (295.2ip, 140er)....is 2-1 with a 3.25 ERA in 5 starts this season (27.2ip, 10er).

CAREER vs. CARDINALS: Is 3-6 with a 5.32 ERA in 16 games/12 starts (64.1ip, 62h, 39r, 38er, 26bb, 72k, 9hr), including a no-decision this season on 4/19 at Busch Stadium, coming in a 2-1, 10-inning win for the Brewers (6ip, 4h, 0r, 2bb, 7k).
