SNAKEBITES

THE NL CHAMPS: Last season, the D-backs captured their second NL pennant and made their second trip to the World Series, first since winning it all in 2001, in their seventh Postseason berth ('99, '01, '02, '07, '11, '17, '23).

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-3 @ Reds last night.

- ◆ Eugenio Suárez had a 2-hit performance, including a homer (third of 2024) and his first stolen base.
- ◆ Ketel Marte hit safely in his ninth straight game.
- ◆ Jordan Montgomery earned his second win of the season (W; 2 ER in 7.0 IP).
- ♦ Joe Mantiply shut down the Reds' ninth-inning threat with a strikeout and fly out with 2 runners on.

VS. REDS: Over their last 22 matchups vs. Reds, the D-backs are 13-9 overall...in their last 12 on the road, they are 7-5.

FOR THE SWWWEEP: The D-backs are going for their first sweep of the season and first on the road since June 9-11, 2023 @ Tigers.

- ◆The D-backs last swept the Reds @ Great American Ball Park from April 20-22, 2021...Arizona has swept Cincinnati on the road 5 times overall, including the first ever series between the 2 teams from June 16-18, 1998 (also: Aug. 20-23, 2015; Aug. 13-15, 2002; May 15-17, 2001).
- ♦ In 2023, the D-backs collected 7 series sweeps and 2 total on the road (@ Nationals and @ Tigers).

THREE STRAIGHT W'S: The D-backs have won a season high 3 consecutive games.

♦ Last season, the D-backs won a season-high 6 straight games (3x - May 28-June 2, June 6-12 and Aug. 19-25), marking the first time to reach the 6-win feat since 2020.

SERIES SECURED: With last night's victory, the D-backs notched their fourth series win of the season.

SUAREZ'S FIRST HOMER VS. CINCY: Eugenio Suárez collected his first career home run last night against the Reds (solo in 8th inning off Lucas Sims)...it marked his first home run back in The Queen City since Sept. 27, 2021 vs. Pirates.

♦ Suárez has now homered against 29 of the 30 teams...the only remaining team is Baltimore, where the D-backs travel to for a 3-game series after today's game.

MANTIPLY'S MOMENT: Joe Mantiply collected his third career save last night (second on the road) and first since May 3, 2022 @ Marlins (0 ER in 1.0 IP)...his first career save was on April 23, 2022 vs. Mets (0 ER in 1.0 IP).

CLEAN FIELDING: Since April 22, the D-backs have made 3 errors (1 being Catcher's Interference), which are second fewest in the Majors, behind the Orioles (2).

2+ OUTFIELD ASSISTS IN A GAME: Last night, the D-backs' collected 2+ outfield assists (**Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** and **Pavin Smith**) in a game for the first time this season... it was the first occurrence since Sept. 11, 2023 @ Mets (Tommy Pham, 2).

RARE OUTFIELD OCCURRENCE: Last night, **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** became the 10th outfielder (also 10th occurrence) in franchise history to record both an error and assist in the same inning (Bot 2) [h/t Reds PR].

SERIES OPENING W: The D-backs collected their second series-opening victory of the season on Tuesday and first since Opening Night on March 28 vs. Rockies (W, 16-1).

bWAR(e) OF KETEL: Ketel Marte's 2.4 bWAR is fifth among all players (pitcher or position), behind Mookie Betts/LAD (3.3), Bobby Witt Jr./KC (3.0), Shohei Ohtani/LAD (2.5) and Marcus Semien/TEX (2.5).

ON DECK - BALTIMORE ORIOLES: Following today's game, the D-backs head to Baltimore for a 3-game weekend series vs. Orioles.

- ♦ It marks Arizona's first series @ Baltimore since Sept. 23-25, 2016.
- ♦ Last season, the D-backs hosted the Orioles @ Chase Field for 3 games, the first time since 2019.
- ♦ The D-backs are 5-4 all-time @ Orioles...their last win @ Oriole Park at Camden Yards came on June 17, 2007 (W, 6-4).

D-BACKS MINOR LEAGUE APRIL MONTHLY HONORS: The D-backs named Double-A Amarillo INF **Deyvison De Los Santos** and High-A Hillsboro RHP **Billy Corcoran** the organization's Minor League Player- and Pitcher-of-the-Month for April.

- ◆ De Los Santos hit .376 (32-for-85)/1.112 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 7 home runs, 18 RBI, 7 walks, 1 stolen base and 18 runs scored while reaching safely in 20 of 21 games with the Sod Poodles.
- ♦ Corcoran went 2-0 with a 2.53 ERA (7 R-6 ER in 21.1 IP), .259 opponents average (21-for-81), 5 walks and 28 strikeouts in 4 starts (2 quality) with the Hops.
