AROUND THE HORN

LOU GEHRIG DAY: Tonight, the D-backs will raise awareness and support for those affected by ALS during Lou Gehrig Day presented by Dignity Health. Doug Clough, who has lived with ALS for 12 years, and Phoenix native Ernie Ruiz, a 24-year U.S. Air Force veteran and ALS advocate who was diagnosed in 2023, will throw out the ceremonial first pitches. Longtime D-backs Advantage Member Henry "Chip" Stoecker, following his recent ALS diagnosis, will serve as reader for Lou Gehrig's iconic "Luckiest Man Alive" speech. Bill Olivier, who has surpassed the typical ALS prognosis, will serve as honorary captain.

JAPANESE HERITAGE NIGHT: Japanese Heritage Night tomorrow will feature an exclusive jersey, a parade, recognitions and performances.

MEXICAN HERITAGE NIGHT: On Thursday, fans can enjoy a night of culture, music and dance with Mexican Heritage Night presented by Coors Light. Fans who purchase the Special Event Ticket Pack will receive both a game ticket and a Mexican-inspired D-backs jersey.

HERE'S THE STORY: Since May 9, the D-backs are 9-1 in their last 10 home games...9 wins are tied for third in MLB, behind the White Sox (13) and Orioles (10).

- Since May 9, the D-backs' 15 wins (15-7) are tied for second most in MLB (also: White Sox), behind the Brewers (16).
- The D-backs are 12-2 in their last 14 games against NL West opponents since May 15 (6-0 vs. Giants, 5-2 vs. Rockies, 1-0 vs. Dodgers).
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 17 straight home starts, hitting .375 (21-for-56)/1.148 OPS with 5 doubles, 4 homers, 11 RBI, 7 walks and 3 hit-by-pitches.

LAST GAME: The D-backs won 4-1 vs. Dodgers last night with 4 unanswered runs powered by 3 homers, their 12th multi-homer game.

- **Eduardo Rodriguez** went decisionless after recording his third straight quality start and exiting the game tied 1-1 (1 ER in 6.0 IP, 5 H, BB, 3 K).
- **Tommy Troy's** first career home run tied the game at 1-1 in the sixth inning.
- **Nolan Arenado** hit a go-ahead and eventual game-winning solo homer in the seventh inning.
- **Ketel Marte** capped off the comeback with a 2-run homer in the eighth inning.
- **Taylor Clarke, Brandyn Garcia** and **Paul Sewald** combined for 3.0 scoreless frames with 1 hit, 0 walks and 2 strikeouts.
- **Paul Sewald** recorded his 15th save.

UPCOMING MILESTONES: The D-backs are 1 win shy (2,199) of 2,200 regular-season wins as a franchise.

- **Corbin Carroll** is 1 triple shy of tying Stephen Drew's 52 (773 G) for the club record.
- **Torey Lovullo** is 4 wins shy of 700 in his D-backs' managerial tenure.

COMEBACK WINS: The D-backs have won after trailing in 4 of their last 6 games...their 20 comeback wins are tied for second in the Majors (also: Braves).

SERIES WINS: The D-backs have won 5 of their last 7 series, including 2 sweeps (W 2-1 vs. Mets, L 1-2 @ Rangers, W 2-1 @ Rockies, W 3-0 vs. Giants, W 3-1 vs. Rockies, W 3-0 @ Giants, L 0-3 @ Mariners).

IT'S HOT AT HOME: **Ketel Martel** owns a 10-game home hitting streak, batting .462 (18-for-39)/1.449 OPS with 5 doubles, 1 triple, 4 homers, 16 RBI and 4 walks, including 6 games reaching base 2+ times.

- **Corbin Carroll** has a 7-game hitting streak, batting .414 (12-for-29)/1.192 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 triples, 4 RBI and 1 walk, including 3 multi-hit efforts.

WITH THE LEATHER TOO: **Ketel Marte** is 1 of 2 middle infielders (also: 2B Matt McLain/CIN) and 1 of 6 infielders overall in MLB without an error [min. 350.0 inn.].

VS. NL WEST FOES: Since April 26, the D-backs' 13 wins and .867 win percentage vs. NL West opponents are tops in the division.

- The D-backs' .294 AVG vs. NL West rivals also leads the division since April 26 (Dodgers .259, Rockies .250, Giants .250 and Padres .213).
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 13 games, is hitting .358 (19-for-53)/1.103 OPS with 3 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 6 walks, including 9 games reaching base safely 2+ times.
- **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 14 straight games, hitting .311 (14-for-45)/1.002 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 8 RBI, 8 walks and 3 hit-by-pitch.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base in 9 of his last 11 games, hitting .325 (13-for-40)/.891 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks, including 7 games reaching base safely 2+ times.

BULLPEN FOCUS: **Taylor Clarke** is scoreless in his last 14 games (11.1 IP) with an opponent .108 AVG (4-for-37)/.258 OPS, 0.53 WHIP, 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- **Jonathan Loaisiga** has not allowed an earned run in his last 9 games (7.1 IP), going 1-1 with a 0.68 WHIP, 1 walk and 1 strikeout.
- **Ryan Thompson**, in his last 11 games, is 1-1 with a 0.90 ERA (1 ER in 10.0 IP), 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.
- **Brandyn Garcia** is scoreless in his last 8 games (6.1 IP) with a 0.95 WHIP, 1 walk, 5 strikeouts and 0 XBH.

STARTING STRONG: Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 18 quality starts in their last 26 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 17 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 165.1), IP/G (1st, 6.1), Wins (T-2nd, 16), ERA (2nd, 2.83), BB/9.0 IP (3rd, 1.96), OBP (4th, .272) and WHIP (5th, 1.05).

VS. DODGERS: The D-backs are 4-4 in their last 8 meetings at Chase Field and split the last 4-game series from May 8-11, 2025.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base in 24 of his last 26 games, hitting .310 (31-for-100)/.970 OPS with 5 doubles, 7 homers, 12 RBI and 14 walks...has homered in 2 of his last 3 games.
- **Corbin Carroll**, in his last 11 games, is hitting .300 (12-for-40)/.906 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers, 6 RBI and 4 walks.
- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely 24 times in his last 19 games, hitting .294 (20-for-68)/.780 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 homers, 9 RBI and 4 walks.
