TONIGHT'S TILT...the Mariners continue the 6-game homestand with the second of 3 games against the New York Mets (1-0)...Seattle is coming off a 3-game sweep of the Arizona Diamondbacks on the homestand...following Thursday's off day, Seattle will embark on its first 3-city road trip of the season at Detroit (3 G, June 5-7), at Baltimore (4 G, June 8-11) and at Washington (3 G, June 12-14)...tonight's game against the Mets will be televised and streamed live on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryon Healy** on the call and **Angie Mentink** serving as field reporter...the game will be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

ODDS AND ENDS...the Mariners defeated the Mets in last night's series opener by a 3-2 score in 10 innings, recording their third walk-off win over their last 4 contests...Seattle has recorded walk-off wins in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 10-11 last season.

- **First Feels Great** - The Mariners are in first place in the American League West Division.
- **Dominate The Zone** - Seattle's pitching staff combined for 12 strikeouts and no walks in last night's win: **Emerson Hancock** (6.0 IP), **José A. Ferrer** (1.0), **Matt Brash** (1.0), **Andrés Muñoz** (1.0) and **Gabe Speier** (1.0).
- **You're So 'Extra'** - The Mariners have played 8 extra inning games this season, tied for 6th-most in MLB, while the Mets lead the Majors with 12 extra inning affairs.
- **Rauuuuul** - Former Mariner **Raul Ibañez** celebrates his 54th birthday today...he appeared in 11 seasons with Seattle, tallying 1,077 hits, 156 home runs and 612 RBI in a Mariners uniform.

SEVEN IS HEAVEN, EIGHT WOULD BE GREAT...the Mariners have won a season-best 7 consecutive games (5/25-c), the longest active winning streak in the big leagues...with a win tonight, Seattle would have its first 8+ game winning streak since rattling off 10 consecutive victories from Sept. 6-16 last season.

PITCHING DURING THE STREAK...over the last 7 games, the Mariners pitching staff has a 1.77 ERA (13 ER, 66.0 IP), allowing a total of 15 runs which comes out to just over 2 runs allowed per game...Seattle hurlers have recorded 60 strikeouts and 15 walks, holding opponents to a .172 batting average while posting a 0.83 WHIP, 2.05 walks-per-9 innings and 8.18 strikeouts-per-9 innings.

HITTING DURING THE STREAK...over the last 7 games, the Mariners offense is batting .290 (73x252) with 40 runs (5.7 runs per game) with 8 doubles, 1 triple, 18 home runs and 12 walks, posting a .331 on-base percentage, .544 slugging percentage and .875 OPS with 137 total bases across 274 plate appearances...Seattle has recorded 10+ hits in 5 of those 7 contests.

JULIO RODRÍGUEZ: AL PLAYER OF THE MONTH?...Mariners center fielder **Julio Rodríguez** finished May with having one of the best months in the big leagues...in 28 May games, Julio batted .274 (32x117) with 18 runs, 7 doubles, 10 home runs, 18 RBI and 6 walks, getting on base at a .309 clip, slugging .590 with an .899 OPS...Julio leads the AL during the month in home runs (10), the most homers he's hit in a calendar month...in the month among AL leaders, Julio also ranks 1st in total bases (69), 1st in extra-base hits (17), 2nd in slugging percentage (min. 100 PA), T-5th in hits, T-6th in runs scored and T-10th in RBI...MLB's monthly awards will be announced tomorrow, Wednesday, June 3 at 8:00 a.m. PT.

SOMEBODY'S CLOSERRR...the Mariners lead the Majors with 22 games decided by one run this year...Seattle is 10-12 in one-run games but have won 4 consecutive dating back to May 20 vs. the White Sox...three of Seattle's last 4 wins have been one-run, walk-off wins in the 10th inning: May 29, 31, and June 1.

COLT GOES YARD...**Colt Emerson** hit his third big league homer last night, with all of them coming at T-Mobile Park...in 14 career games, Emerson is batting .250 (11x44) with 7 runs, 3 doubles, 1 triple, 3 homers, 8 RBI and 5 walks, getting on base at a .340 clip, slugging .568 with a .908 OPS in 50 plate appearances...the 20-year-old Emerson has a 152 OPS+...the Mariners are 10-4 (.714) when Emerson appears in a game this season.

RALEY GOOD HITTER...**Luke Raley** has been one of the best hitters in the American League this season, batting .276 (42x152), 22 runs, 5 doubles, 1 triple, 13 home runs, 31 RBI, a .341 OBP and slugging .579 for a .920 OPS in 55 games...among AL hitters with at least 150 PA in 2026, Raley ranks 3rd in slugging, 7th in OPS and 3rd in OPS+ (161), trailing only Ben Rice-NYY (191) and Yordan Alvarez (191) in OPS+.

LIFE'S A PITCH...the Mariners pitching staff has posted a combined 3.43 ERA (208 ER, 545.1 IP) with an MLB-fewest 155 walks, along with 522 strikeouts...among Major League pitching staffs they rank 2nd in strikeout-to-walk ratio (3.37), 1st in fewest walks-per-9 innings (2.56), 5th in ERA, T-4th in WHIP (1.18) and 10th in strikeouts...Mariners starting pitching leads MLB with 347.2 innings pitched and ranks 2nd in strikeouts (331) and T-3rd in quality starts (27)...the Seattle bullpen ranks 2nd in the Majors in ERA (3.05), trailing only the Braves bullpen (3.02).

AS YOU MAY KNOW...three of the Mariners last 4 wins and each of their last 2 wins during their active 7-game winning streak have been walk-off wins in the 10th inning, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Seattle has recorded walk-off victories in back-to-back games for the first time since Sept. 10-11 last season, which also bookended a 3-game series sweep (vs. STL) and then opened a series (vs. LAA)...in each of the 3 recent walk-off wins for the Mariners, their pitching staff has stranded the extra inning ghost runner, and...**DID YOU ALSO KNOW?**...if Seattle walks it off tonight, it would mark the first time the team has recorded 3 consecutive walk-off victories since Sept. 16-18, 2002, when they walked off the Rangers in 3 consecutive games that went 11, 10, and 10 innings, respectively.

ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - JUNE 2

- **1987 - Ken Griffey Jr.** is selected first overall in the 1987 June Draft out of Cincinnati's Archbishop Moeller High School.
- **1990 - Randy Johnson** throws the first no-hitter in Mariners history, registering 8 strike outs while also walking 6 in a 2-0 win vs. Detroit.
- **2010 - Ken Griffey Jr.** announces retirement from Major League Baseball.
- **2014 - Kyle Seager** went 4-for-5, falling a single short of hitting for the cycle in the Mariners 10-2 romp over the Yankees in a makeup game at Yankee Stadium. Seager hit 2 triples, doubled and then hit a 3-run home run in the 9th inning.
- **2016** - The Mariners secured the largest comeback win in club history against the Padres, after trailing by 10 runs after 5 innings to earn the 16-13 victory. The Mariners hit 7 consecutive 2-out, RBI singles in the 7th inning, becoming the only Major League team to accomplish that feat since 1974, as far back as records are available.
- **2025 - Cal Raleigh** was selected as the American League Co-Player of the Week for May 26-June 1, along with Tampa Bay Rays infielder Junior Caminero, the first weekly award of Raleigh's career...Raleigh hit .348 (8x23) with 6 runs, 6 home runs, 10 RBI and 1 stolen base, getting on base at a .444 clip and slugging 1.130 (1.575 OPS).

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 13th start of the season and the 159th start of his career...also marks his first start against the Mets this season and the 3rd of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.

LAST TIME OUT...W#3 on May 27 at the Athletics, tossed 6.0 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts while allowing 5 hits and 2 walks...he threw 91 pitches and 54 strikes in his 12th start of the season...reached the 6th inning in all 5 of his starts in May.

#50...earned his 50th career win in his last start on May 27 at the Athletics, becoming the 13th pitcher in Mariners history with 50+ career wins with the club...joins teammate **George Kirby** who also surpassed 50 career wins on May 11 at Houston.

MAY FLOWERS...was 2-1 with a 3.26 ERA (11 ER, 30.1 IP), 30 strikeouts and 8 walks allowed across 5 starts in May...marked his lowest ERA across any month of May in his career...finished the month with a 0.890 WHIP which is the 7th-lowest mark in any month of his career and his lowest of any month since a 0.791 WHIP in April/March of 2025.

WELCOME JUNE...is 11-5 and owns a 3.28 ERA (49 ER, 134.1 IP) with 129 strikeouts to 24 walks allowed across 23 career starts in June...among pitchers with 20+ career starts in June since 2021, his 1.027 career WHIP in June ranks 2nd in MLB trailing only Max Fried (1.022)...his 5.38 WHIP in June is 3rd-best, trailing only **George Kirby** (7.57) and Aaron Nola (5.56).

NEW YORK STATE OF MIND...is making his first start against the Mets since Aug. 10, 2024 when he tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with 6 strikeouts while allowing 3 hits and 1 walk at T-Mobile Park...previously threw 6.2 innings while allowing 1 run (1 ER) on 7 hits (1 HR) with 1 walk and 9 strikeouts in his only career start at Citi Field (9/1/2023).

SHUTTING IT DOWN...has thrown 6.0+ IP without an earned run allowed in 2 starts this season (last: 5/27 at ATH) and in 18 career starts...including his last start against the Mets (8/10/24), he has thrown 7.0+ IP without an earned run allowed in 9 career starts, including 5 times in 2024...his 5 such starts in 2024 were tied for the most in MLB that season.

AMONG THE LEAGUE...his 953 strikeouts since 2021 lead the American League...among AL leaders since 2021, he ranks 2nd in total starts (157 GS), 3rd in innings pitched (903.2 IP), 4th in quality starts (74 QS), and T-9th in wins (50) alongside **George Kirby**.

HOME SWEET HOME...is making his 8th home start this season, including his first start at home since May 16 vs. San Diego...among qualified pitchers since 2021, his 6.06 K/BB is 2nd (trails **George Kirby**, 6.24), his 1.00 WHIP is T-4th (also: **Sandy Alcantara**-MIA), his 27.7% strikeout rate is 7th, and his 9.89 K/9 is 10th best in MLB.

IN COMMAND...made his 48th career start with 7+ strikeouts and 1-or-fewer walks at Chicago-AL on May 10...his 48 such starts are tied for 3rd most in MLB since 2021...also in his May 10 start, he allowed only 1 base runner for his 7th career start with 2-or-fewer base runners allowed over 6.0+ innings...his 7 such games are most in MLB since 2021.

QUALITY CONTROL...has thrown a quality start with 1-or-fewer walks issued in 58 career games (last: 5/10 at CWS), the 5th-most such games in MLB since 2021, just trailing behind rotation-mate **George Kirby** (59)...his 27 quality starts without a walk are T-5th-most in MLB since 2021.

HEY BATTER BATTER SWING...his 28.0 whiff rate in 2026 is the 10th-best in the AL (min. 750 pitches) while his 2,059 career swing and misses rank 5th-most in MLB since 2021...owns a 43.4 career whiff rate on his splitter, ranking 3rd among pitchers with 1000 splitters thrown since 2021.

HEATING UP...his four-seam fastball in his last start on May 27 at ATH, increased by 1.1 mph from his 95.3 mph average across the season to 96.4 mph...the 96.4 mph average in that start was tied for his highest velocity on his four-seamer in a single start this season (also: 4/12 vs. HOU)...in that May 27 start, he threw 10 pitches above 97 mph, the most pitches he has thrown above 97 mph in a single start since Sept. 29, 2024 vs. ATH (18 pitches of 97+ mph)...h/t **Daniel Kramer** (MLB.com).

PLAYING THE LONG GAME...his 84 career starts with 6.0+ innings thrown are tied for 3rd-most in AL since 2021 while his 26 games with 7.0+ innings are 8th-most among AL pitchers.

AMONG THE GREATS...his 3.59 career ERA (360 ER, 903.2 IP) is 5th-best among pitchers in Mariners history (min. 500 IP), trailing **Randy Johnson**, **Félix Hernández**, **Hisashi Iwakuma**, and **James Paxton** who each hold a 3.42 career ERA, and ranks ahead of **George Kirby** (3.60)...his 953 career strikeouts are 5th-most in Mariners history...he also ranks 1st in WHIP (1.062), T-2nd in K/9 (9.5, also **James Paxton**), and 2nd in K/BB (4.84) only behind **George Kirby's** 6.18 (min. 500 IP).

150 FOR THE M'S...made his 150th career start with the Mariners on April 12 vs. Houston Astros...he is the 7th pitcher to make 150 starts in a Mariners uniform...his 909 strikeouts rank 2nd among Mariners pitchers' first 150 career starts, only behind **Mark Langston** (916 K)...ranks 9th in wins with 48 over a players' first 150 games pitched with the Mariners.
