## So Close

Ozzie Albies came to bat with Atlanta down three runs and runners on second and third in Monday night's eighth inning, and drove the first pitch he saw 398 feet to the wall in center field.

In Monday's seventh inning, Marcell Ozuna clubbed a 366 -foot flyout to the wall in left

Ozuna's ball would have been a home run in 18 of the 30 major league parks, while Albies' effort would have been gone in 16 stadiums, including Truist Park in Atlanta.
The Braves have 84 outs this season on balls that traveled at least 360 feet, the third-
highest total in baseball. Only the Rockies
(88) and Royals (87) have more.


TODAY'S GAMES: The Braves and Cardinals today conclude a three-game set with the second and third of six scheduled meetings between the two teams this season...The teams will next meet from July 19-21 at Truist Park in Atlanta.

A Atlanta and St. Louis saw yesterday's game postponed and will play a split doubleheader today...The Cardinals won the series opener, 4-3, on Monday night.
A The Braves went 4-2 in six games with the Cardinals last season, including a three-game sweep here at Busch Stadium...St. Louis won two-of-three in Atlanta from September 5-7...Atlanta has won five consecutive season series against the Cardinals dating to 2018...The Braves went 4-2 last season, 4-3 against the Cardinals in 2022, 6-1 in 2021, 4-2 in 2019 and 4-2 in 2018.

A Despite Monday's loss, Atlanta has won eight of 11 and 13 of its last 17 regular-season games in St. Louis...The Braves enter play today with a $28-26$ (.519) record here since the facility opened in 2006, and are the only opposing National League team with a winning record in this building.

A Overall, the Braves have won 19 of their last 28 games against the Cardinals dating to September 19, 2018...In those 28 games, Atlanta has pitched to just a 3.52 ERA and allowed 97 earned runs over 248.1 total innings.

A RH Kyle Gibson is set to make the sixth start of his career versus Atlanta in Game 1, and is 2-1 with a 4.91 ERA (16 ER/29.1 IP) and one complete game over his first five starts...The 6-foot-6, 200pound native of Greenfield, IN, last faced the Braves in 2022 while with the Phillies, and went $1-0$ with a 5.06 ERA ( $9 \mathrm{ER} / 16.0 \mathrm{IP}$ ) over three starts that season.

LOSS: Atlanta dropped the opening game of this three-game set Friday night, falling to St. Louis, 4-3... The Braves moved to 17-9 in the first game of a series, including an 8-6 mark in such games on the road.

A Atlanta was outhit by the Cardinals, 11-6, but collected a higher expected batting average (.299 to .274 ) for the game...The Braves batted just .238 on their balls in play, while the Cardinals hit . 478 .
A The Braves went just 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position, with their only such hit coming in their two-run ninth.

A Atlanta has not lost back-to-back since suffering a season-worst five-game losing streak from June 7 to June 12.

A Austin Riley clubbed a fifth-inning homer, and has now gone deep in three straight games versus St. Louis and five of his last six such contests...He is a career $.337 / .390 / .653$ batter with eight homers in 25 career games against the Cardinals.

A Jarred Kelenic went 0 -for-4 from the top of the lineup, snapping his career high-tying 10-game hitting streak.

DOUBLEHEADER: Atlanta has played one doubleheader this season, splitting a pair of games with San Diego on May 20... Atlanta went 7-3 (.700) in 10 doubleheader games last year.

A Atlanta's seven wins in doubleheaders last year were most in the majors, and its .700 winning percentage was best among teams to play at least five such games.

REYNALDO LÓPEZ: Atlanta's Game 1 starter has never started against St. Louis, and has faced the Cardinals just once in his major league career...The 5-foot-11, 200-pound native of the Dominican Republic pitched 1.0 scoreless inning of relief against St. Louis on July 8 of last season while with the White Sox.

A López has posted a 1.57 ERA (13 ER/74.1 IP), lowest in the major leagues among pitchers with at least 70.0 innings this season...With at least 3.0 innings today in Atlanta's 77th game of the season, he will once again qualify for the ERA title.

A Since the club moved to Atlanta in 1966, no pitcher has allowed fewer earned runs through 13 starts than López's 13 ...His 1.57 ERA is the best by a Brave through 13 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine also pitched to a 1.57 ERA and a $9-2$ record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are only other starters in the Atlanta era with lower ERAs through 13 starts.

A López's 1.57 ERA is also the lowest in the Atlanta era by any pitcher in their first 13 games, all starts, for the franchise...Michael Soroka held the previous mark, pitching to a 1.89 ERA over his first 13 starts between 2018 and 2019.
A He pitched 5.0 scoreless innings in his last turn, June 19 vs. Detroit, and has 11.0 consecutive scoreless frames over his last two starts...It is the sixth-longest active scoreless streak by a starter in baseball.

A Opponents are batting just . 074 against him with runners in scoring position, the lowest mark in baseball among pitchers to face at least 50 such batters...Hitters are just 4 -for- 54 with a double, seven RBI and 20 strikeouts against him with runners in scoring position.

RILEY IN JUNE: Austin Riley opened the scoring for Atlanta Friday night, driving a solo home run out to center in the fifth inning...He ended the night 2-for-4, the only Braves batter with a multi-hit effort.
A Over 21 games in June, Riley has hit .303/.376/.579 with six doubles, five homers and $12 \mathrm{RBI} . . . \mathrm{He}$ entered the month hitting just .228/.295/.353.
A He has raised his batting average for the season by 23 points (.228 to .251 ) and his OPS by 97 points (. 648 to .745 ) this month.

A All five of his homers have come in his last 10 games dating to June 14, and he has hit .441/.513/1.000 in this stretch...His 1.513 OPS since that date is second highest in baseball behind just Shohei Ohtani (1.519)

## Today's Game

A Set to make his 14th start of the season and first of his career against St. Louis.
A Made his first career appearance against the Cardinals last season out of the bullpen.
A Has not allowed more than two earned runs since April 30 at Seattle.
A Has now held opponents to two earned runs or less in eight consecutive games; it is the second longest active streak by a starter in baseball.
A His 12 starts of two earned runs or less allowed are tied for the fifth most in the majors this season.
A López has posted a $1.57 \mathrm{ERA}(13 \mathrm{ER} / 74.1$ IP), the lowest ERA in the majors by a starter (min. 5 starts) and best by a Brave through 13 starts since Hall-of-Famer Tom Glavine pitched to a 1.57 ERA and an 9-2 record in 2002...Glavine and fellow Hall-of-Famer Greg Maddux (1.41) are only other starters in the Atlanta era (since 1966) with lower ERAs through 13 starts.

A His combined 13 earned runs allowed are the fewest by any starter in Atlanta franchise history through 13 games.
A His 1.57 ERA is the lowest through a player's firrst 13 career games as an Atlanta Brave in franchise history.

A His 1.11 ERA at home is also the lowest in MLB among qualifiers.
A Has made seven starts with at least six days rest between games; the most in the majors among starters.
A López has garnered the second-highest slider Whiff Rate (45.8\%) in the majors (min. 300 sliders thrown)...Miami's Jesús Luzardo leads the league (48.0\%).
A Pitching to a .074 opp. BA (4-for-49) with RISP this year; the lowest rate in the majors among starters with at least 10 outings.
A Owns a $25.0 \%$ LOB rate with RISP; the highest in MLB (min. 10 starts).
A Stranded $87.4 \%$ of all baserunnes this season; the highest rate in the NL.
A Throwing his fastball for an average of 95.4 MPH .
A Has thrown eight pitches over 98 MPH this season.
A Throwing his four-seam fastball on $57.0 \%$ of pitches; seventh higest rate in the majors (min. eight starts).

A His 1.73 ERA through his first 10 games with the Braves is the second lowest in Atlanta franchise history among starters' first 10 outings that have joined from another club.
A Shelby Miller owns the lowest ERA, sporting a 1.48 ERA in his fist 10 starts with the team in 2015.
A Struck out a season most eight hitters on May 31 against Oakland.
( Opened the season with four consecutive quality starts.
A Became the first Braves pitcher to pitch at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts since LHP Sean Newcomb, spanning May 2-19, 2018
A Is the second hurler in franchise history to match the criteria in their first four starts with the club, joining RHP Aaron Harang, who did so in five straight starts to begin his Braves tenure in April 2014
A Joined Ben Sheets (2012) as the only pitchers in Atlanta franchise history to only allow one earned run over 18.0 innings pitched in their first three starts after joining the club.
A Since 2000, there have been seven pitchers, league-wide, to log at least 6.0 innings, while allowing one run-or-fewer in four consecutive starts to begin their tenure with a club: Cliff Lee (Philadelphia, July-August, 2009), Harang (Atlanta, April 2015), Cody Anderson (Cleveland, June-July 2015), Kenta Maeda (Los AngelesNL, April 2016), Mat Latos (Chicago-AL, April 2016), Justin Verlander (Houston, September 2017) and López (Atlanta, April 2024).
A Made his first start since June 10, 2022 against Texas on April 2 earlier this season.
A Signed by the Atlanta Braves to a three-year contract with a club option for 2027 on November 20, 2023.

A Has played for four teams over an eight-year career...Started his career in the rotation, before transitioning to the bullpen in 2021.
A Made his major league debut on July 19, 2016 with Washington...Suffered a 8-4 loss to Los Angeles after starting the game and going 4.2 innings.
A Acquired by the White Sox on December 7, 2016 in a four-player trade that sent Adam Eaton to Washington...López, RHP Dane Dunning and RHP Lucas Giolito went to Chicago.
A This season marks the first time he will not be in the same organization as RHP Lucas Giolito.
A Both pitchers started their careers in 2012 with Washington...Giolito was the organization's first-round pick that season, while the team signed López as an
