THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY

JULY 22

1986 - The Astros allow just one hit in a 1-0 walkoff win vs. the Expos in the Astrodome...this marks the only one-hit, extra-inning shutout in franchise history...a solo homer in the bottom of the 10th by **1B Glenn Davis** is the difference...**RHP Nolan Ryan** throws 9.1 innings in the start, tallying 14 strikeouts, while allowing that one hit...**RHP Dave Smith** earns the win for the Astros in relief.

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Astros will go for a sweep of the Marlins tonight in the finale of their three-game series at Daikin Park in Houston, TX...**RHP Peter Lambert** (8-5), who's posted a 1.02 ERA (2ER/17.2IP) in his three starts this month, will get the start for the Astros tonight opposite **RHP Sandy Alcantara** (10-5) and the Marlins.

RIDING THE LAMBO: Tonight's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** leads the Astros in wins and among AL pitchers he ranks second in opponent average (.197) and sixth in ERA (3.03) (min. 90IP)...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 starts.

MOVING UP THE LIST: Manager **Joe Espada** has 224 managerial wins as the Astros skipper, which ties him with **Terry Collins** (224 wins) for 10th all-time in managerial wins in club history...the two immediately trail **Hal Lanier** (254 wins) for ninth on that all-time list.

GET 'EM EARLY: The Astros rank first in the AL and second in the Majors in 1st-inning runs (68)...overall, the Astros rank 11th in the Majors in runs (468), two spots ahead of the Marlins (455), who rank 13th.

ON THE DEFENSIVE: The Astros rank second in the AL in fielding percentage (.988) and their 43 errors are the second-fewest in the AL...**1B Christian Walker** has led the way, as he has not committed an error in his 98 games played at 1B... dating back to last season, Walker has not made an error in his last 126 games at 1B (last error was Aug. 23, 2025 at BAL).

LOS ASTROS: Space City Home Network will televise tonight's game in English and Spanish with the Spanish broadcast being televised on SCHN2... **Enrique Vasquez** and **Danny Gonzales** will be on the call on the Spanish telecast tonight.

NARUTO NIGHT: The Astros will celebrate **NARUTO Night** at Daikin Park tonight...fans who unlock the exclusive add on ticket will receive a limited edition Jeremy Peña NARUTO inspired Bobble-head...the night promises to be fun for seasoned and newcomer anime fans alike.

AYA IN ACTION: The Astros Youth Academy hosted the 2026 MLB Nike RBI Southwest Regional Tournament earlier this week in Houston which produced two Astros teams advancing to the Nike RBI World Series, which will be played in Vero Beach, FL, from Aug. 2-7, 2026...the Junior Baseball Team will be seeking its first Nike RBI World Series Championship, while the Softball Team will be seeking its sixth Nike RBI World Series Championship.

LAST NIGHT'S WIN: The Astros played a clean game last night, downing the Marlins by a score of 5-3...**RHP Tatsuya Imai** (1ER/6IP) had a strong start, fanning eight, while allowing just four hits en route to the win...**SS Jeremy Peña** (1x4, HR, RBI) hit his seventh career leadoff homer, but the big damage came from **3B Isaac Paredes** (2x4, HR, 3RBI), who hit a three-run shot in the 5th inning.

TODAY'S TRADE: Earlier today, the Astros acquired **RHP Max Martin** from the Royals in exchange for the recently DFA'd **RHP Nate Pearson**...Martin, 22, owns a 6-2 record with a 2.01 ERA (9ER/40.1IP) in 26 relief appearances across two levels of Class A ball in the Royals organization this season.

MVP-CALIBER: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is a strong AL MVP candidate as he enters tonight as the AL's Triple Crown leader, ranking first in batting average (.326), HR (33), and RBI (75)...he currently leads all of baseball in OPS (1.081), OBP (.432), SLG (.649), and total bases (239), and in the AL, he ranks first in hits (120), first in XBH (53), tied for second in runs (68), and fourth in walks (66)...AL leaders below:

LEVELED UP: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is playing on another level, as he's riding an eight-game hitting streak in which six of those eight games have been multi-hit games...he's batting .517 (15x29) with six runs scored, four doubles, four homers, eight RBI, seven walks and a 1.680 OPS during the streak.

HIT PAREDES: Since June 3, **3B Isaac Paredes** is batting .297 (44x148) with 20 runs scored, eight doubles, one triple, seven homers, 29 RBI, 18 walks and an .893 OPS in 40 games...he enters tonight with an active 15-game on-base streak and an active seven-game hitting streak.

TAP FOR SUCCESS: Astros hitters have won an MLB-best 72 ABS challenges and lead the Majors in challenge success rate (60%)...**2B Jose Altuve** has been successful on 15-of-23 challenges (65%), ranking third in the Majors in challenges won...**3B Isaac Paredes** (11-for-12) has been the most efficient regular challenger for the team and was successful in his first 11 challenges this year.

WHAT A RELIEF: **LHP Josh Hader** is 3-1 with 11 saves (in 11 chances), has a 1.47 ERA (3ER/18.1IP), 29 strikeouts in 18.1 innings, a .154 (10x65) opponent average, and a 0.98 WHIP in 20 appearances...he has not allowed a hit in 14 of his 20 appearances.

HADER'S HEART: Astros **LHP Josh Hader** will host a group from Covenant House at tonight's game as a part of his **Hader's Heart** program...the group will also get to experience BP and talk with Hader on the field prior to the game.

DOWN ON THE FARM: The Triple A Sugar Land Space Cowboys picked up a 3-2 win in 10 innings lat night on a walkoff single by **1B Cavan Biggio**, who's hitting .300 (12x40) with a 1.107 OPS in 13 games this month...down at Class A Fayetteville, the Woodpeckers earned a rain-shortened 7-0 win thanks in part to top prospect **CF Kevin Alvarez**, who hit his eighth homer of the season.

ASTROS SIGN TOP TWO PICKS: The Astros have officially signed both of their first-round picks from the 2026 MLB Draft: **OF Logan Hughes** (17th overall) from Texas Tech and **RHP Jack Radel** (28th overall) from Notre Dame.

LAST START, JULY 17 vs. BAL: Got the Astros' first start coming out of the All-Star Break and struck out a career-high 10 batters while notching his 2nd consecutive quality start, allowing 1 run on 3 hits with 3 walks...did not factor into the decision of the Astros' 3-2 loss to the Orioles...marked the 4th instance an Astros pitcher struck out 10+ batters in a game, with **RHP Tatsuya Imai** the last to do so on June 25 at DET...prior to his last start, Lambert's single-game career high was a 9-strikeout effort on June 6, 2019 at CHC, while with the Rockies.

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has established himself as one of the top pitchers in the AL this season since being promoted from Triple A on April 17...among AL pitchers with at least 90.0 innings this season, he ranks 2nd in opponent batting average (.197), 2nd in H/9 (6.46), 6th in ERA (3.03), 7th in opponent OPS (.613) and 10th in WHIP (1.11)...the only pitcher he trails in both opponent batting average and H/9 is **TOR RHP Dylan Cease** (.196 OAVG; 6.38 H/9), who was the starter for the AL in this year's All-Star Game...also ranks T-8th among all AL pitchers this season with 8 wins.

THE STABILIZER: Leads Astros pitchers with 7 quality starts this season and has been scoreless in 3 of his starts (July 5 vs. TB; May 5 vs. LAD; April 22 at CLE)...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 8 of his 16 starts and 5.0+ innings in 14 of his 16 starts this season...since having his contract selected on April 17, he leads Astros pitchers with 92.0 innings, with **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (81.0) the next-closest.

JULY PITCHER OF THE MONTH?: Has the chance to put the finishing touches on a strong candidacy for the AL's July Pitcher of the Month...headed into tonight's start, he ranks 2nd in opponent batting average (.145), 2nd in opponent OPS (.425), 2nd in H/9 (4.58), 4th in ERA (1.02), 4th in WHIP (0.79), T-4th in wins (2) and T-10th in strikeouts (23) among AL pitchers (min. 15 IP)...would become the second Astros pitcher to win the award this season, joining **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (May).

STREAK SNAPPED: Had his career-long 4-game winning streak snapped on June 29 vs. MIN, spanning 6 starts from May 24-June 23...within the streak, he's posted a 2.97 ERA (11ER/33.1IP)...the streak ties as the longest by an Astro this season, also reached by **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** (April 15-May 2).

SLIDER COMBO: Is having his greatest MLB success with his slider, holding opponents to a .170 average on the pitch (8x47)...opponents had combined to hit .313 (50x160) vs. his slider through his first 4 MLB seasons...in 2024, his last season in the Majors prior to this year, opponents batted .340 (18x53) vs. his slider.

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Logged one of the best starts of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

TURNING THE PAGE: Has gone 2-1 with 4 saves and a 2.66 ERA (7ER/23.2IP) with 26 strikeouts, a 1.18 WHIP and a .200 opponent batting average in his last 25 apps., dating back to May 3...within these apps., he logged 9 consecutive scoreless outings (8.2 IP) from May 3-28...his 9-game scoreless streak is the 2nd-longest by an Astro this season, behind **LHP Steven Okert** (14-game streak).

VS. MIA: In 7 career appearances vs. the Marlins, he's posted a 1.13 ERA (1ER/8IP) with 10 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average...has recorded 5 consecutive scoreless outings vs. MIA (5.0 IP), dating back to July 11, 2024, at Daikin Park.
