Contributed Atlanta's lone multi-hit effort in Wednesday's loss, 2-1, to the Chicago White Sox. In 24 road games, the shortstop has batted .333 (21-63) with four doubles, 10 RBI and a .960 OPS.

Mateo has posted 1.0 bWAR to this point of the season, already the second-best mark in his career.

He logged 3.7 bWAR for Baltimore in 2022, when he led the American League with 35 stolen bases.

TODAY'S GAME: The Atlanta Braves and New York Mets today open a three-game series with the first of 13 scheduled games between the clubs this season...This is the first of four series between the teams this season... They will next meet for a four-game wraparound series from July 3-6.

- A* The Chicago White Sox beat the Braves twice, on Tuesday and Wednesday, before a rainout yesterday...The game was postponed to August 20, which was previously an open date between two three-game road series at Minnesota and Milwaukee.
- A* The Braves and Mets are slated to play all of their regular season games during the summer months for the second consecutive season...Each of the contests between these two clubs will take place from today until August 12...In that span, 25% of Atlanta's games will be against New York.
- A* Atlanta played to an 8-5 record against New York last season, including a 4-3 mark here at Citi Field...Overall, the 2025 Braves went 30-22 against the NL East, but 46-64 against all other opponents.
- A* The Braves have taken the season series from the Mets for nine consecutive seasons, dating to 2018... The team is 83-61 (.576) against New York in that span.
- A* RH Nolan McLean is set to face the Braves for the second time in his major-league career...In his first turn, he pitched 7.0 innings and allowed just two runs...He struck out seven in a Mets win, 12-7, at Truist Park...The right-handed native of Willow Spring, NC, has surrendered 18 runs (15 earned) in his last four turns, pitching to a 1-2 record and a 6.75 ERA (15 ER/20.0 IP) in that time...Overall, McLean is 3-4 with a 3.98 ERA (32 ER/72.1 IP) this season.

SPENCER STRIDER: Will make his 12th appearance against the Mets (10th start), his most against any single opponent...In those games, the right-hander from Columbus, OH, is 6-2 with a 6.11 ERA (31 ER/45.2 IP) and a 11.23 K/9.

- A* Strider made his MLB debut in relief against the Mets on October 1, 2021 in Atlanta... Since then, the Braves are 8-3 as a team when he appears against them.
- A* The Braves are 6-1 when Strider takes the hill this year, good for a .732 winning percentage...Only five players in MLB (1 in NL) have ushered their team to victory at a higher clip (min. 7 starts): Davis Martin (CWS, .846), Will Warren (NYY, .846), Kyle Harrison (MIL, .833), Nick Martinez (TB, .769) and Steven Matz (TB, .750).
- A* Strider has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his seven outings this season, and in 13 straight turns dating to August 25, 2025...That streak is the fifth-longest active in MLB behind Carlos Rodón (NYY, 16), Shohei Ohtani (LAD, 15), Jacob Misiorowski (MIL, 14) and Cade Horton (CHC, 14).

PITCHING: Through 68 games, Atlanta's pitching staff has posted the best earned run average in Major League Baseball (3.20)...It's seven points better than the next-closest team, the New York Yankees (3.27), and eight points better than the next-closest NL team, the Los Angeles Dodgers (3.28).

- A* Since 2003, the Braves' pitching staff has posted a better 68-game start just once, when the 2013 club had a 3.18 ERA at this point.
- A* With 2.1 scoreless innings from Didier Fuentes, Dylan Lee and James Karinchak on Wednesday night, Atlanta's bullpen lowered its ERA to 2.93 – also the best in Major League Baseball...The Braves are the only team in MLB with a sub-3.00 bullpen ERA.
- A* In the last 13 seasons, Braves relievers have only once pitched to a better mark through 68 games...The 2022 bullpen posted a 2.89 ERA through this point.
- A* Braves starting pitchers own a 3.38 ERA this season, good for fourth in MLB behind the Dodgers (2.98), Yankees (3.17) and Rays (3.36).
- A* MLB-wide, four of the top 10 pitcher ERAs belong to Braves (min. 10 games): Robert Suarez (4th, 0.61), Dylan Lee (7th, 1.16), Raisel Iglesias (8th, 1.21) and Dylan Dodd (T9th, 1.26).

ON LOSING: The Braves have lost back-to-back games for just the fifth time this season, and for the first time since dropping two straight to Washington from May 23-24.

- A* Atlanta is one of two teams in MLB that hasn't been swept this season, joining the Los Angeles Dodgers...The Braves were last swept at the hands of the Milwaukee Brewers from August 4-6, 2025, at Truist Park.
- A* The Braves have lost three straight games just once this season, doing so on the road against the Arizona Diamondbacks (2) and the Los Angeles Angels from April 4-6.
- A* The only two teams in Major League Baseball that have yet to suffer a four-game losing streak played in the previous series – the Atlanta Braves and Chicago White Sox...Each team's longest skid stands at three games.

SCORING POSITION: The Braves left 10 runners on-base on Wednesday and batted just 1-for-6 with runners in scoring position...Atlanta left 10 men on-base both of the games in that series.

- A* The Braves hit .118 (2-for-17) with runners in scoring position during the previous series...Their only two knocks were both singles, coming off the bats of Mauricio Dubón (Tuesday) and Mike Yastrzemski (Wednesday).
- A* Despite the lull, Atlanta maintains the best batting average with RISP in Major League Baseball (.285), ahead of the Milwaukee Brewers (.283).

Today's Game

- Makes his eighth start of the 2026 season and the 85th of his career in the opener of a road series against New York (NL) at Citi Field.
- Strider is 6-2 with a 6.11 ERA (31 ER/45.2 IP) and 57 strikeouts over 11 career appearances (nine starts) against the Mets...He last faced New York on August 12, 2025, taking the loss after allowing eight runs over 4.0 innings at Citi Field.
- His most recent win against the Mets came on June 24, 2025, when he allowed three runs over 5.0 innings with eight strikeouts in a 7-4 decision.
- Enters play 4-1 with a 4.00 ERA (16 ER/36.0 IP) and 43 strikeouts over his first seven turns of the season...Atlanta is 6-1 in his starts.
- The Braves has scored at least six runs in five of its six wins in his starts this season...The lone exception came in a 3-2 victory in 10 innings on May 15 against Boston.
- Has allowed three earned runs or fewer in each of his seven outings this season, and in 13 straight turns dating to August 25, 2025.
- Earned the win in his most recent outing, June 6 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings with two walks and three strikeouts on 84 pitches in the 6-3 victory at Truist Park.
- Was placed on the 15-day injured list on March 25 with a left oblique strain, missing Atlanta's first 34 games of the season before being activated on May 3.
- Made three minor league rehabilitation starts in April, going 0-1 with a 1.42 ERA (2 ER/12.2 IP) and 18 strikeouts between High-A Rome and Triple-A Gwinnett... Posted a 2-0 record and a 3.24 ERA (3 ER/8.1 IP) over three Grapefruit League outings this spring with 11 strikeouts.
- The Braves are 54-30 in Strider's career starts.
- Enters play with a .632 winning percentage (43-25) in his career with Atlanta, the third-best mark among pitchers in the Atlanta era (since 1966) to make at least 80 starts for the club...He trails only Hall of Famer Greg Maddux (.688) and Max Fried (.670), and ranks just ahead of Hall of Famer Tom Glavine (.624).

2026

- Earned his fourth victory of the season on June 6 against Pittsburgh, allowing three runs on five hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and three strikeouts on 84 pitches in the 6-3 win at Truist Park...It marked his fourth career start against the Pirates.
- Took the loss in his start on May 31 at Cincinnati, allowing four runs (three earned) on seven hits over 5.0 innings with two walks and eight strikeouts on 90 pitches in the 6-4 defeat at Great American Ball Park...Atlanta took the series two games to one.
- Earned his third victory on May 26 at Boston, allowing three runs over 5.0 innings with three walks and five strikeouts on 87 pitches in the 7-6 win at Fenway Park... Duran and Rafaela hit back-to-back solo home runs in the bottom of the first.
- Earned his second win on May 21 at Miami, allowing three runs over 6.1 innings with two walks and nine strikeouts on 100 pitches in the 9-3 victory at loanDepot park...The nine strikeouts are his most in a start this season and the most since he fanned 11 on July 10, 2025 vs. the Athletics.
- Received a no-decision on May 15 against Boston, allowing one run over 5.1 innings with three walks and four strikeouts on 84 pitches in Atlanta's 3-2 win in 10 innings at Truist Park.
- Earned his first victory of the season on May 9 at Dodger Stadium, allowing one hit over 6.0 scoreless innings with two walks and eight strikeouts on 91 pitches in the 7-2 win at Los Angeles (NL)...It was his first decision since September 27, 2025.
- Received a no-decision in his season debut on May 3 at Coors Field, allowing three runs and four hits over 3.1 innings with five walks, six strikeouts and one home run on 87 pitches in the Braves' 11-6 victory at Colorado...Was activated from the 15-day injured list earlier that day.

2025

- Went 7-14 with a 4.45 ERA (62 ER/125.1 IP) in 23 starts, his first season back from internal brace surgery on his right elbow.
- Made his 2025 season debut on April 16 at Toronto, allowing two runs and five hits over 5.0 innings...It was his first start in 376 days, dating to April 5, 2024.
- Was placed on the 15-day IL on April 21 (backdated to April 18) with a strained right hamstring and was activated on May 19.
- Reached the 500th strikeout of his career on July 18 by punching out Toronto's Addison Barger.
- Became the ninth pitcher in the Modern Era to reach 500 strikeouts in 68 appearances or fewer, and the first to do so since Cleveland's Shane Bieber in 2021.
- The other pitchers on that list: José Fernández, Yu Darvish, Mark Prior, Kerry Wood, Hideo Nomo, Dwight Gooden and Herb Score.
- Strider was the only pitcher in that group with more than three relief appearances in his first 68 games (13).

Career Recap

- Drafted by Atlanta in the fourth round of the 2020 MLB June Amateur Draft out of Clemson University...Cleveland had previously selected him in the 35th round of the 2017 draft out of Christian Academy of Knoxville (Tenn.), but he did not sign.
- Underwent Tommy John surgery in February 2019 and missed the entire collegiate season.
- Made his MLB debut in 2021, appearing in two relief games for the Braves at age 22.
- Was named to the 2023 National League All-Star team in his first full season as a starter.
- Finished fourth in the 2022 NL Rookie of the Year voting after going 11-5 with a 2.67 ERA, 202 strikeouts and 10 quality starts in 31 appearances (20 starts).
- Led the National League in strikeouts in 2023 with 281, going 20-5 with a 3.86 ERA in 32 starts.
- Made two starts in 2024 before being placed on the 15-day IL on April 7 with a right elbow sprain...Dr. Keith Meister performed surgery to repair the ulnar collateral ligament with an internal brace on April 12, 2024 in Arlington, Texas.

- Since April 28th, he has allowed only two earned runs, two fewer than any other rookie and leads the pack in the span with a 0.90 ERA (min. 15.0 IP).
- Earned his first career save June 7 versus Pittsburgh, At 20 years and 355 days old, he's the youngest Brave to register a save since Mike McQueen on August 11, 1971, at St. Louis (20 years, 346 days)...The last major league pitcher as young to do so was Andrés Muñoz on August 29, 2019, at San Francisco, while with San Diego.

- Registers a chase rate of 40.1%, which ranks second in Major League Baseball and a 71.6% strike rate, third-highest in baseball (min. 20.0 IP).
- Has limited batters to a .194 OBP and .401 OPS using his four-seam, both ranking sixth-lowest among NL pitchers (min. 100 four-seams fastballs thrown).
- His 31.7% career changeup rate is the highest among Braves relievers in the Modern era (min. 100 games) and ranks first among such pitchers with 113 strikeouts on the pitch, 27 more than the next highest strikeout count.
