RAYS REPORT—The Rays continue a 12-game, 14-day road trip against the Angels (2-1), Mariners (0-3), Athletics (3G) and Giants (3G) tonight in West Sacramento...are a season-high-tying five games under .500 for the fourth time (last: 21-26 entering play on May 20)...need to win tonight to avoid falling six games under .500 for the first time since entering play on June 22, 2018 (34-40)...have lost five of six and 10 of their last 12 series, including seven of their last eight on the road...have lost three straight, five of seven, nine of 12, 13 of 17, 19 of 26 and 27 of their last 38 games...are 4-12 so far on a stretch of 19 road games in a 22-game span (July 25–Aug. 17)...started the season 21-26, went an MLB-best 25-9 from May 20–June 26 and are an MLB-worst 11-27 since June 27...are fourth in the AL East for the 31st consecutive day, a season-high 12.0 GB the division-leading Blue Jays and 5.5 GB the Astros for the AL's third and final Wild Card spot...including off days and the All-Star break, they have spent two days in first, 37 in second, 32 in third, 61 in fourth and four in fifth.

- ★ The Rays yielded a season-high-tying four runs in the opening frame (also: April 5 at TEX) and were unable to recover in yesterday's 6-3 loss in Seattle.
- ★ They were swept for the sixth time this season, tied with the Guardians for fourth most in the AL behind the White Sox (10), Angels (7) and Athletics (7)...they have been swept in three of their last five road series.
- ★ Six of the Rays nine hits went for extra bases (4 2B, 3B, HR), their most since July 18 vs. BAL (6)...it was their second loss this season with 6 XBH (also: 8XBH, June 7 vs. MIA)—from 2022-24, they went 44-1 in games with 6 XBH or more.
- ★ The Rays have scored one run from the 7th inning on over their last 10 games, batting 10-for-97 (103) with 42 SO in those frames...they have not scored from the 8th inning on in any of those 10 contests, their longest streak since going a club-record 11 straight games from Sept. 11-21, 2011 (Stats Perform).
- ★ Tampa Bay is 3-14 in its last 17 road games and 5-19 in its last 24 since June 29, the worst mark in the majors over that span.
- ★ Since the All-Star break, Rays pitchers lead the AL in strikeouts per 9.0 IP (9.71), and their 205 strikeouts rank second in the majors behind the Mariners (219SO).

RECENT TRANSACTIONS—Earlier today, the Rays recalled **OF Everson Pereira** (peh-RAH-ruh) from Triple-A Durham and optioned **OF Tristan Peters** to Durham...Pereira was acquired from the Yankees at the trade deadline on July 31 for **INF/OF José Caballero**...his first appearance with the Rays will mark his first in the majors since Oct. 1, 2023 at KC with the Yankees...he hit .276 (8-for-29) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 5 RBI and an .899 OPS over eight games with Durham.

OLD FRIENDS, NEW FOES—If both pitchers make their scheduled starts, this series would mark the second time this season the Rays will be opposed by **Jeffrey Springs** and **Jacob Lopez** in consecutive games, joining July 1-2 at Steinbrenner Field...both pitchers were traded to the Athletics in exchange for **RHP Joe Boyle**, **INF Will Simpson**, **RHP Jacob Watters** and a Competitive Balance Round A selection in the 2025 First-Year Player Draft on Dec. 14, 2024...it would also mark the fifth series in franchise history the Rays have been opposed by multiple starting pitchers who appeared for them last season...the other four instances were the previously referenced July 1-3 series in Tampa against the A's and three sets in 2022 when **BOS Rich Hill** and **BOS Michael Wacha** started opposite Tampa Bay in three separate series (April 22-24, Aug. 26-28, Sept. 5-7) after pitching for the Rays in 2021.

★ This marks the fifth time in 10 games and seventh time in 16 games the Rays will be opposed by a left-handed starter...they have won two of their last three games vs. southpaw starters on the heels of a six-game losing streak (June 30–Aug. 1).

RISP BUT NO REWARD—The Rays went 1-for-11 with runners in scoring position in yesterday's loss and are batting .199 (32-for-161) in scoring situations since the All-Star break, 29th in the majors, ahead of only the Mariners (.173)...they hit an AL-best .284 (224-for-788) with RISP before the break, third highest prior to the Midsummer Classic in team history behind 2023 (.289) and 2013 (.288)...the 85-point drop-off is the largest in the majors.

BULLISH ON THE PEN—Over the last 13 games since July 27, the Rays bullpen leads the majors in WHIP (0.89), opp. on-base pct. (.236), opp. OPS (.524) and strikeout rate (31.3%) and ranks third in opp. average (.179/33-for-184) and opp. slugging pct. (.288)...their 2.22 ERA (52.2IP, 13ER) in that stretch trails only the Guardians (1.77), White Sox (2.08) and Mariners (2.14)...the bullpen's 25.1 pct. strikeout rate on the season is third in MLB behind the Astros (27.8%) and Blue Jays (25.7%) and would be its best since a club-record 25.6 pct. in 2021.

LIVE BY THE LONG BALL—The Rays have hit 10 HR in their last five games after going homerless in four of their previous five games (July 31–Aug. 4)...they have gone deep in a season-high-tying five straight road games (3x, last: July 26-30) and 10 of their last 12 games away from home...their last longer streak was six consecutive road games from Aug. 23-28, 2024...12 of their last 14 runs have been scored via 9 HR...however, 19 of their 28 runs allowed on the current road trip have come on 9 HR by opponents.

★ Rays infielders lead the AL with 73 HR, tied with the Mets for second most in the majors behind the Diamondbacks (85HR).

LA MÁXIMA—**Junior Caminero** has homered four times in his last four games, five times in last eight games and nine times in his last 22 games since the All-Star break, tied for third most in the majors...his 32 HR on the season are third in the AL behind **SEA Cal Raleigh** (45HR) and **NY Yankees Aaron Judge** (37HR) and are fourth most in Rays history before the end of August...with 43 games remaining on the Rays schedule, it already ties the 15th most homers by any player in an age-21-or-younger season since 1901 (age as of June 30)...among primary third basemen (min. 50% of games at 3B) in an age-21-or-younger campaign, only **ATL Bob Horner** (33HR, 1979) and the Milwaukee Braves **Eddie Mathews** (47HR, 1953) have more homers.

★ He is on pace for 43 HR, which would be the second-highest total in Rays history behind **Carlos Peña** (46HR) in 2007...he needs 8 HR in the next 43 games to join **ATL Ronald Acuña Jr.** (41HR, 2019), **Mathews** (47HR, 1953) and **NY Yankees Mel Ott** (42HR, 1929) as the only players in MLB history to record 40 HR in an age-21-or-younger season.

RAYS AND A'S—The Rays and Athletics close a six-game season series this week in West Sacramento after Tampa Bay dropped two of three games from July 1-3 at Steinbrenner Field...the Rays need to sweep this series to claim a fourth straight season series win, which would extend the longest streak in franchise history...Tampa Bay is 2-1-2 over the last five individual series dating back to the start of 2020...the clubs have split the last 14 meetings, but the Rays are 13-7 in the last 20 (May 2, 2022–pres)...their .431 (93-123) all-time winning pct. against the A's is their second lowest vs. any AL opponent, better than only their .430 (204-270) mark vs. the Yankees.

★ The Rays went 9-19-5 in series play at Oakland Coliseum, including 3-1-3 from 2017-24...they have not dropped a road series to the Athletics since May 7-9, 2021 (1-2).

DÉJÀ VU—Seven members of the Rays active roster have previously appeared at Sutter Health Park...**Griffin Jax** (June 4) and **Bryan Baker** (June 8) both pitched in this venue earlier this season as members of the Twins and Orioles, respectively...**Edwin Uceta** made four appearances here with Triple-A Reno (AZ) in 2022...**Adrian Houser** started in West Sacramento on June 11, 2018 while in the Brewers system...**Ryan Pepiot** started here twice in the Dodgers organization: April 22, 2022 and July 14, 2023...**Hunter Feduccia** has appeared in 17 games in this ballpark over the last three seasons as a Dodgers farmhand (2023-25), tallying 3 HR and 11 RBI...**Tristan Gray** went 5-for-13 (.385) with 3 XBH and 3 RBI over three games at Sutter Health with Triple-A Las Vegas (ATL) from Aug. 28-30, 2024.

DOWN ON THE FARM—**INF Carson Williams**, the Rays No. 1 prospect (MLB.com), hit his 20th home run for Triple-A Durham yesterday to secure his third consecutive 20-HR, 20-SB season...he joined **Kyle Tucker** (2017-19) as the only minor leaguers since at least 1995 to record three consecutive 20-20 seasons (Stats Perform)...he became the fourth Durham hitter to record a 20-20 season since the Bulls became the Rays Triple-A affiliate in 1998, joining **Kameron Misner** (2023), **Josh Lowe** (2021) and **Justin Ruggiano** (2007).

★ Two Rays farmhands received league Player of the Week honors for Aug. 4-10: Double-A Montgomery's **OF Homer Bush Jr.** (.522/12-for-23, 6RBI, 6R, 10SB) in the Southern League and DSL Tampa Bay's **INF Andreimi Antunez** in the Dominican Summer League (.524/11-for-21, 2B, HR, 6RBI, 2BB, 4R, 2SB).

★ Rays prospects have claimed 23 weekly league awards, tied with the Dodgers and Tigers for second most by any organization behind the Giants (24).

TONIGHT'S START—**Ryan Pepiot** (PEP-ee-oh) will make his 25th start of the season and 12th on the road...marks the 61st start (68G) of his career and 28th away from home (32G)...is his fourth career start against the Athletics and second this season...is 5.2 innings short of reaching 350.0 for his career...leads the Rays in starts (24), quality starts (14), innings pitched (136.0) and strikeouts (134)...is looking to earn the win in back-to-back starts for the first time since June 16-21 after snapping a career-high-tying three-game losing streak in his last outing...acquired from the Dodgers along with **OF Jonny DeLuca** for **RHP Tyler Glasnow**, **OF Manuel Margot** and cash considerations, Dec. 16, 2023.

LAST TIME OUT—Pepiot tossed 5.2 innings of two-run ball, coming one out shy of his 15th quality start of the season in a 7-3 win on Aug. 5 at Los Angeles-AL (W, 5.2IP, 5H, 3R, 2ER, 2BB, 6SO, HR)...did not allow a baserunner until a fielding error to lead off the 5th inning...the following hitter, **Jo Adell**, then put the Angels on the board with a two-run homer...Pepiot allowed three more baserunners in the frame on a walk-double-single sequence before getting out of the inning with a double-play ball...he retired the first two batters in the 6th before allowing a single, a walk and an RBI-single from Adell that prompted a pitching change.

- ✦ He received seven runs of support, his most since receiving seven in back-to-back starts from June 16 vs. BAL and June 21 vs. DET...he is 6-0 in the six career starts that he has been backed by seven runs of support or more.
- ✦ The Rays are 2-5 in Pepiot's last seven starts dating back to July 2 despite Pepiot throwing 5.0 IP or more with 3 ER or fewer in five of those seven outings...four of those starts were quality.

WILD, WILD WEST—Pepiot will be making his first major league start at Sutter Health Park, the 23rd ballpark he has started in in his career and 14th AL venue...he has made one previous road start against the Athletics, earning the win after tossing 6.0 innings of two-run ball in a 4-2 win in Oakland on Aug. 21, 2024 (W, 6.0IP, 3H, 2ER, HR, BB, HBP, 5SO)...overall, in three career starts opposite the Athletics, he has gone 2-0 with a 3.06 ERA (17.2IP, 6ER) with two quality starts, 21 SO and a .164 (10-for-61) opp. average...his lone outing against them in 2025 came on July 2 at Steinbrenner Field, where he logged a quality start and struck out nine batters in a 6-5 victory (W, 6.0IP, 4H, 2ER, 2HR, 3BB, 9SO).

- ✦ He is 5-2 with a 3.34 ERA (70.0IP, 26ER) in 12 career starts against AL West opponents, seven of which were quality...since being tagged for six runs in his debut vs. the division on April 1, 2024 vs. TEX, he has a 2.80 ERA (64.1IP, 20ER) in his last 11.

TURNING THINGS AROUND—In his last outing, Pepiot earned his first win since July 2 vs. the Athletics...in his six starts since then, he has gone 1-3 with a 5.08 ERA (33.2IP, 19ER) but has allowed 3 ER or fewer in four of six outings...he has received two runs of support or fewer in five of six starts...the Rays have also been defeated in nine of his last 10 road starts dating back to May 2 at NYY, a stretch in which he has gone 1-5 with five quality starts, a 4.50 ERA (52.0IP, 26ER) and a .234 (46-for-197) opp. average.

GOTTA BE QUICKER THAN THAT—Pepiot's four pickoffs are tied with STL **Sonny Gray**, CWS/TB **Adrian Houser**, AZ/TEX **Merrill Kelly**, CHC **Colin Rea** and CLE **Gavin Williams** for the most by any right-handed pitcher in the majors...including southpaws, only CHC **Matthew Boyd** (8), NYY **Max Fried** (8) and SF **Robbie Ray** (5) have more...it marks the most pickoffs by a Rays pitcher since **Blake Snell** had five in 2019...Pepiot is one of five Rays right-handers (6x) to record four pickoffs (or more) in a season, joining **James Shields** in 2011 (13) and 2006 (4), **Alex Cobb** in 2017 (5), **Gerami Gonzalez** in 2003 (5) and **Tyler Glasnow** in 2018 (4).

BUILT DIFFERENT—Pepiot, who is making his team-leading 25th start, became the fourth Rays pitcher and third traditional starter to make 20 starts before the All-Star break, joining **Blake Snell** (2018, 20GS), **David Price** (2014, 20GS) and **Ryne Stanek** (2019), who started 25 games as an opener before the break...after tonight's outing, he will be on pace for 33 starts, which would mark the highest total by a Rays pitcher since **Charlie Morton** (33GS) in 2019 and fall one start shy of the single-season club record shared by **Chris Archer** (2017 & 2015), Price (2011) and **Scott Kazmir** (2007)...he has anchored a Rays rotation that ranks among MLB leaders in fewest pitches per inning (2nd, 15.7), innings pitched (4th, 647.2IP), quality starts (4th, 52) and WHIP (5th, 1.22).

- ✦ Pepiot was the first Rays pitcher to start on Opening Day and in the club's last game before the All-Star break since **Chris Archer** in 2017.

THINK FAST—Across his last 14 starts dating back to May 25 vs. TOR, opponents are batting .170 (26-for-153) in at-bats ending with Pepiot's fastballs (four-seamer, cutter, sinker), the lowest mark on any AL pitcher's fastballs in that span (min. 150AB)...over half (44) of his 86 strikeouts in that span have come on his four-seamer (34) and cutter (10).

REVERSE PSYCHOLOGY—Pepiot has limited left-handed hitters to a .190 (42-for-221) average, the fourth-lowest mark among AL right-handers (min. 240BF) behind CLE **Gavin Williams** (.130), TOR **Kevin Gausman** (.177) and HOU **Hunter Brown** (.185)...right-handed hitters are batting .258 (72-for-279) against Pepiot, but this includes a 34-for-157 (.217) clip across his last 14 starts (.321 in first 10GS).

TOP HEAVY—The first three spots in opposing lineups are batting .281/341/521 (54-for-192) against Pepiot, but 4-9 hitters have produced a .195/274/377 (60-for-308) line...this includes a .145 (8-for-55) average against cleanup hitters, second lowest among qualified major league pitchers behind NYM **David Peterson** (.125).

TOMORROW'S PROBABLE STARTER: RHP SHANE BAZ (8-8, 4.92)

LAST TIME OUT—Did not earn a decision after yielding four runs over 4.0 innings in a 5-4 win on Aug. 6 at LAA (ND, 4.0IP, 5H, 4ER, 2BB, 9SO, HR)...is 0-5 with a 6.27 ERA (37.1IP, 26ER), 47 SO and a .296 (45-for-152) opp. average in his last seven starts dating back to his last start vs. the Athletics on July 2 at Steinbrenner Field...the Rays are 1-6 in those starts.

vs. ATHLETICS—In two career starts against the A's, Baz has gone 1-0 with a 1.84 ERA (14.2IP, 3ER), 15SO, a 0.95 WHIP and a .196 (10-for-51) opp. average...his last outing opposite the Athletics came on July 2 at Steinbrenner Field, when he pitched 7.0 innings of three-run ball and struck out a season-high-tying 11 batters in a 4-3 defeat (ND, 7.0IP, 7H, 3ER, 2HR, 1BB, 11SO).
