TODAY'S GAME: Is game 6 (3-2) of a 6-game homestand against Miami (1-2) and Chicago-NL (2-0).....following an off day tomorrow, the team takes a 6-game road trip to Washington (3g) and Atlanta (3g).....the next homestand covers 6 games against New York-NL (3g) and Pittsburgh (3g) from August 8-13.

IT WON'T BE THE SAME: This season marks just the second without **Bob Uecker** on the radio for the Milwaukee Brewers (also 1970).....the 2003 Hall of Famer passed away at the age of 90 on January 16.

IN THE STANDINGS (134 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 20*, **SECOND:** 57, **THIRD:** 43, **FOURTH:** 11, **FIFTH:** 3.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the Cubs by 2.0 games (*9 days tied for first from 3/18-3/26 before playing a game).

AT HOME: The team is 36-19 at home, going 13-5-0 in series play, including this series.....are 24-10 in the last 34 home games and 13-3 in the last 16.....are on a 3-game home winning streak.....had a season-high 6-game home winning streak from 7/7-7/13.

ON THE ROAD: The team is 28-24 on the road, going 8-7-2 in series play.....are 18-6 in the last 24 road games.....have had three season-high 5-game road winning streaks, coming from 5/25-6/2, 6/19-7/2 and 7/6-7/21.

MANAGER: **Pat Murphy** is in his second season as Brewers manager.....he was voted 2024 NL Manager of the Year after going 93-69 and winning the NL Central division championship.....he is the first manager in franchise history (in either league) to earn the honor.....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.

COACHES: Associate manager **Rickie Weeks** (2nd season), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (3rd season/2nd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (7th season), assistant pitching & strategy coach **Jim Henderson** (4th season/2nd in current role), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (2nd season), lead hitting coach **Al LeBoeuf** (1st season), hitting coach **Connor Dawson** (4th season), hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (1st season), assistant coach **Daniel de Mondesert** (2nd season), infield coach **Matt Erickson** (2nd season), first base coach **Julio Borbón** (1st season), third base coach **Jason Lane** (10th season/5th in current role).

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The team has made 18 replay challenges this season, going 12-6.....their last challenge (won) came on 7/29 vs. Chicago-NL as a hit by pitch involving Ian Happ was overturned.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have made the postseason six times in the last seven seasons (2018-24) and won the NL Central in four of the last seven, three of four, and two in a row.....Milwaukee is one of five teams to make the postseason in at least six of the last seven seasons, joined by the Astros (7), Braves (7), Dodgers (7) and Yankees (6).....the team was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in eight straight seasons (2017-24), missing by a single game in both 2017 and 2022.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only teams with 86+ wins in each of the last seven full seasons (2017-24).....this does not include 2020.....the Brewers have 730 wins since 2017 (4th in MLB/2nd in National League).

PERALTA AT A GLANCE: All-Star Freddy Peralta, 29, will make his 23rd start of the season and third against the Cubs.....Peralta last started last Friday vs. Miami and had no decision in a 5-1 loss (5ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 9k, 1hr, 1hbp, 98 pitches).....the team is 14-8 in his starts.....he has 9 quality starts.....opponents are batting .204 (91-for-446, 14hr).....he is 7-0 with a 2.66 ERA in his last 9 starts (50.2ip, 34h, 15r, 15er, 13bb, 56k, 5hr).....Peralta was acquired from Seattle with RHP Carlos Herrera and RHP Daniel Missaki for 1B Adam Lind on 12/9/15.....on 2/28/20, he signed a 5-year contract through the 2024 season with club options for 2025 and 2026.

RIGHT SAID FRED: Peralta is tied with **Garrett Crochet** (BOS) and **Max Fried** (NYY) for the Major League lead with his career-high-tying 12 wins (also 2023).....he is also among National League leaders in opponent AVG (6th, .204), H/9IP (6th, 6.73), ERA (T6th, 2.81) and WHIP (9th, 1.09).

FREDDY K-RUEGER: Peralta has 1,080 career strikeouts, trailing only **Yovani Gallardo** (1,226), **Ben Sheets** (1,206) and **Teddy Higuera** (1,081) on the all-time franchise list.

CAREER: Is 65-40 with a 3.66 ERA and 1 save in 200 games/151 starts (876ip, 356er).....is in his eighth Major League season, all with the Brewers (2018-25).....is 57-38 with a 3.64 ERA as a starter (792ip, 320er) and 8-2 with a 3.86 ERA in relief (84ip, 36er).....was an All-Star in 2021 and 2025.....was the Opening Day starter in 2024 and 2025.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 38-19 with a 3.25 ERA in 106 games/78 starts (470.2ip, 170er).....is 7-0 with a 1.55 ERA in 11 starts this season (63.2ip, 11er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 27-21 with a 4.13 ERA in 94 games/73 starts (405.1ip, 186er).....is 5-4 with a 4.19 ERA in 11 starts this season (58ip, 27er).

CAREER vs. CUBS: Has gone 8-2 with a 3.07 ERA in 20 games/15 starts against the Cubs (88ip, 51h, 30r, 30er, 44bb, 122k, 10hr), including 2-0 with a 2.45 ERA in 2 starts this season (11ip, 6h, 3r, 3er, 3bb, 13k, 2hr).
