BIRDLAND BITES: Tonight, the Orioles open a six-game homestand against the Red Sox and Astros...Baltimore will have an off day on Monday before welcoming Houston to Camden Yards on Tuesday...The Birds are coming off a 3-4 road trip, having dropped three of four to the Guardians before taking two of three from the Royals.

Chris Bassitt earned the victory in Wednesday's rubber match...He tossed 5.1 innings, putting him at exactly 1,300 career innings, one of 22 active pitchers in MLB to have reached the milestone.

Coby Mayo has hit a three-run homer in each of his last two games, marking the second time in his career homering in consecutive games (also 9/13-14/25)...He is the first Oriole with 3+ RBI in consecutive games since Colton Cowser (2 G) from June 18-19, 2025...The last Bird to have 3+ RBI in at least three straight was Jonathan Schoop (3 G) from July 19-21, 2017.

The Birds plated 20 runs during their three-game set against the Royals after scoring 14 runs across four games against the Guardians.

Tonight, the O's look to snap a six-game losing skid to the Red Sox at Camden Yards dating to April 2, 2025...Baltimore has not dropped seven straight home games to Boston since a nine-game losing skid from June 3, 2017-July 23, 2018.

GAME TIME CHANGE: After consultation with Major League Baseball, Saturday's originally scheduled 4:05 p.m. ET game between the Orioles and Boston Red Sox has been moved to 12:05 p.m. due to forecasted inclement weather. Gates will open at 10:30 a.m.

ROSTER MOVES: The Orioles have made several roster moves over the last two days...Today, they reinstated outfielder Tyler O'Neill from the 7-day Concussion Injured List and right-handed pitcher Andrew Kittredge (right shoulder inflammation) while optioning outfielder Johnathan Rodriguez to Triple-A Norfolk and right-hander Jose Espada to Double-A Chesapeake...Yesterday, the Orioles recalled right-handed pitcher Brandon Young from Triple-A Norfolk and placed right-hander Dean Kremer (right quad strain) on the 15-day Injured List, retroactive to April 20.

Young's lone MLB outing came on April 6 at Chicago-AL and he earned the victory after throwing 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits, two walks, and one wild pitch with two strikeouts.

O'Neill was placed on the IL on April 12, retroactive to April 9.

Kittredge made one appearance in Spring Training and began the year on the IL...He started a rehab assignment with Triple-A Norfolk on April 1 and was 0-1 with a 15.19 ERA (9 ER/5.1 IP) in six outings.

SEEING RED: In 41 career games against the Red Sox, Gunnar Henderson is slashing .247/.369/.540 (37-for-150) with 11 doubles, three triples, nine home runs, 29 runs, 24 RBI, 27 walks and four steals.

Among all active players, his .909 career OPS against Boston is seventh highest in the majors (min. 175 PA) behind CHC's Alex Bregman (1.013), PIT's Brandon Lowe (.998), LAD's Teoscar Hernandez (.985), STL's Ramon Urias (.935), LAA's Mike Trout (.930), and TB's Yandy Diaz (.918).

Henderson has 19 at-bats against Brayan Bello (5-for-19, 3 2B, 1 HR, 3 BB, 4 K)...The three doubles are tied for his most against a single pitcher with COL's Michael Lorenzen, while the 19 at-bats are tied for fifth most behind TOR's Jose Berrios (25), WSH's Zack Littell (23), MIN's Taj Bradley (22), and KC's Michael Wacha (20).

ACTION JACKSON: Jeremiah Jackson has hit safely in 11 of his last 13 games since April 10, slashing .340/.365/.680 (17-for-50) with two doubles, five homers, nine runs scored, 13 RBI, and two walks...During that time, he ranks among MLB leaders in RBI (T-2nd), total bases (T-6th, 34), hits (T-7th).

He recorded one hit and scored one run in each of his three games in Kansas City while striking out only once...He went 2-for-13 (.154) with one homer, three RBI, one walk, one steal, and six strikeouts during the four-game set in Cleveland.

CAN'T WARD HIM OFF: Taylor Ward has reached safely in 23 of the last 24 games since March 28 while slashing .295/.409/.463 (28-for-95) with 13 doubles, one homer, 12 runs scored, 11 RBI, 18 walks, one hit by pitch, and one steal during that time...He had his 16-game on-base streak, tied for the third longest of his career, snapped on April 15.

His 13 doubles lead the majors ahead of ATL's Matt Olson (11)...Ward's 13 two-baggers are the most by an Oriole in the first 25 team games of a season in team history (since 1954).

Ward has faced 510 total pitches this season, tied with teammate Gunnar Henderson for fourth most in the majors behind WSH's James Wood (516), ATH's Nick Kurtz (514), and SEA's Cal Raleigh (511).

LEAVE IT TO LEODY: Leody Taveras is batting .348/.455/.543 (16-for-46) with three doubles, two home runs, nine runs scored, 13 RBI, nine walks, and one stolen base as a starter this season...He's 1-for-6 with one RBI off the bench this year.

Taveras has hit safely in 11 of 13 starts overall this season.

He's recorded 14 RBI in 21 games (62 PA) this season after tallying 17 RBI in 58 games (180 PA) last year between Texas and Seattle.

TIGHT SQUEEZE: Of Baltimore's 25 games, an MLB-high 20 of them have been decided by three runs or fewer, outpacing Seattle (19)...The O's have also played 15 games decided by two or fewer runs, tied with the Yankees for the most in the majors, going 9-6 (.600) in those affairs.

'PEN PALS: The Orioles bullpen ranks third in the AL with a 3.48 ERA behind the Rangers (2.98) and Mariners (3.44).

Rico Garica has posted a 0.75 ERA (1 ER/12.0 IP) with 13 strikeouts across 12 appearances...His lone hit allowed is a home run by KC's Michael Massey on April 21.

The O's had stranded the first 21 inherited runners to begin the season until the seventh inning on April 17 in Cleveland...It was the most inherited runners stranded to start a season in Orioles history (since 1954) and the most to begin a season by an MLB team since the 2016 Oakland Athletics (26), per the Elias Sports Bureau

Overall, the team's 14.3 percent inherited runners scored rate (4 IRS/28 IR) is tied for the MLB lead with the Rockies (7 IRS/42 IR).

SHIPPING DOWN TO BALTIMORE: The Orioles and Red Sox are meeting for the first of two series at Camden Yards this season...Boston returns to Baltimore for a four-game set from September 3-6, while the Birds have two series at Fenway Park from June 2-4 and July 20-22.

The largest crowd at Oriole Park occurred on July 10, 2005, when 49,828 fans watched the O's face the Red Sox.

HERE'S TO YOU, MR. ROBINSON: Earlier today, Towson University unveiled Brooks Robinson Field at John B. Schuerholz Park before the team's game against Stony Brook...Brooks' son, Brooks David Robinson, who is a class of 1983 graduate of Towson University, spoke at the ceremony...The Robinson Family Foundation recently donated \$1 million, one of the largest single contributions in Towson athletics history, which will support Tigers baseball and permanently names the field in honor of Orioles legend and Hall of Famer Brooks Robinson, recognizing the Robinson family's enduring commitment to education, leadership, and teamwork.

QUICK HITS: Young is set to make his 14th career start and second this season after being recalled from Triple-A Norfolk yesterday...Was recalled from the Tides on April 6 and made his first start at Chicago-AL that day before being optioned back the following day...Was optioned to minor league camp on March 7 after making two Grapefruit League appearances...Signed with the Orioles as a non-drafted free agent on June 14, 2020.

LAST TIME OUT (MiLB): Earned the victory with Norfolk on April 18 at Durham after throwing 5.2 hitless innings, allowing one run and two walks with 10 strikeouts... Threw 88 pitches, 59 strikes.

📌 In three starts with the Tides in 2026, Young is 1-0 with a 1.08 ERA (2 ER/16.2 IP) and 19 strikeouts against three walks.

LAST TIME OUT (MLB): Made his first MLB start of 2026 on April 6 at Chicago-AL and earned the victory after tossing 5.0 scoreless innings, scattering two hits, two walks, and one wild pitch with two strikeouts...Threw 66 pitches, 39 strikes.

📌 Is one of three Orioles to have thrown 5.0+ scoreless innings in a game this season, joining **Chris Bassitt** (4/17 at CLE, 5.0 IP) and **Trevor Rogers** (3/26 vs. MIN, 7.0 IP).

UNFAMILIAR FOR: Set to make his first career start against the Red Sox...His lone career start opposite an AL East opponent came on July 29 (G2) vs. Toronto (ND, 6.0 IP, 6 H, 2 ER, 2 BB, 6 K).

INSIDE THE NUMBERS: Last season, Young limited right-handed hitters to a .150 (6-for-40) clip with zero extra-base hits against his four-seam fastball, while holding them to a .176 (3-for-17) mark with two home runs off his slider.

📌 In his first start of the season against the White Sox, righties went 0-for-2 off the heater and 1-for-4 off the slider.

📌 In 2025, lefties went 22-for-61 (.361) with six doubles and two home runs off the four-seamer, but Young held White Sox left-handers to an 0-for-7 clip in his first outing and 0-for-10 overall.

WELCOME TO THE SHOW: On April 19, 2025, he was recalled from High-A Aberdeen and made his MLB debut vs. Cincinnati that day (4.0 IP, 7 H, 3 ER, 3 BB, 3 K, 1 HR).

A NIGHT TO REMEMBER: On August 15, 2025 at Houston, the Lumberton, Texas native earned his first career win, tossing a career-high 8.0 scoreless innings, allowing one hit with zero walks and six strikeouts.

📌 He was perfect through 7.2 frames before Ramón Urías tallied an infield single...It marked the longest perfect-game bid by an Oriole since **Mike Mussina** threw 7.2 perfect innings on August 4, 1998 vs. Detroit.

📌 Young became the first Orioles rookie to throw 8.0 scoreless innings and allow one or zero hits since **Chris Waters** on August 5, 2008 at Los Angeles-AL (8.0 IP, 1 H, 0 R, 3 BB, 3 K).

📌 The victory snapped a streak of 10 starts without a win to begin his career, marking the second-longest winless streak to begin a career in franchise history (since 1954), trailing **Jimmy Yacabonis** (11 GS, 6/28/18-8/4/19).

CLEAN SHEET: On July 8, 2025 vs. New York-NL, Young threw an immaculate inning in the fifth frame, becoming the fifth pitcher in Orioles history (since 1954) to accomplish the feat, joining Kevin Gausman (4/23/18 vs. CLE, 7th inn.), B.J. Ryan (9/5/99 vs. CLE, 6th inn.), Mike Mussina (5/9/98 vs. TB, 9th inn.), and Jimmy Key (4/14/98 vs. CWS, 2nd inn.).

TOP DOG: He was named the 2024 Orioles Jim Palmer Minor League Pitcher of the Year, going 5-6 with a 3.57 ERA (44 ER/111.0 IP) and 132 strikeouts over 27 appearances (24 GS) between Double-A Bowie and Norfolk.
