SATURDAY'S 25TH ANNIVERSARY OF 2001 WORLD SERIES CHAMPIONSHIP WITH THROWBACK JERSEY GIVEAWAY: Saturday will celebrate the 25th anniversary of the D-backs’ World Series title born from one of the most unforgettable moments in franchise history....over 30 former players and coaches will be honored at the pregame celebration to honor the historic championship team and its enduring legacy...as part of the festivities, the first 25,000 fans will receive a 2001 Throwback Jersey courtesy of Chase.

HERE’S THE STORY: The D-backs look for their sixth series win or split in their last 8 series (4 wins, 1 split).

- Michael Soroka** is making his first start since Aug. 22 vs. Reds.
 - Vs. Marlins, is 3-0 with a 1.59 ERA (7 ER in 39.2 IP) in 6 career starts (5 quality).
- Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 10 straight games, batting .324 (11-for-34)/1.188 OPS with 2 doubles, 4 homers, 8 RBI, 7 walks and 1 HBP.
- With runners in scoring position over their last 4 games, the D-backs are hitting .433 (13-for-30)/1.367 OPS with 4 doubles, 3 homers and 17 RBI.

LAST GAME: The D-backs walked-off the Marlins 8-7 thanks to **Corbin Carroll’s** 2-run homer.

- The D-backs overcame multiple 3-run deficits, trailing 3-0 in the second inning before tying at 3-3 in the third inning, and 7-4 in the seventh inning.
- Kevin Ginkel** reached 347 career strikeouts in the seventh inning, the most all-time by a D-back reliever.
- Corbin Carroll** tallied 2+ hits with 3+ RBI in a game for the first time since Aug. 1.
- Lars Nootbaar** had his second consecutive multi-hit game and second 3-hit performance.
- Corbin Burnes** went decisionless in his second start off the Injured List (5 ER in 4.2 IP, 5 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

ROSTER MOVES: OF **Jesús Sánchez** (No. 18) reported to the Major League roster today...the D-backs optioned OF **Tommy Troy** following last night’s game.

WILD CARD RACE: The D-backs are fourth in the NL Wild Card race, 2.5 games behind the Padres (WC3, Season tied 5-5), 3.5 games behind the Phillies (WC2, tied 3-3) and 4.0 behind the Cubs (WC1, trail 2-4).

ANSWERBACKS: The D-backs’ 45 comeback wins lead the Majors, ahead of the Cubs (42) and Dodgers (42).

- Their 23 comeback home wins are tied for fourth most in the NL with the Brewers, behind the Padres (27), Dodgers (26) and Cubs (24).

HOMERING INTO HISTORY: The D-backs’ 4 walk-off homers in games when trailing are tied for the most in a season in MLB history with the 2006 Reds and 2014 White Sox (source: OptaSTATS).

ARENADO NEARING ANOTHER 25/75 SEASON: **Nolan Arenado (25 HR/72 RBI)** is 3 RBI shy of becoming the fifth third baseman since 1969 [min. 100 GS per year] with 9+ seasons of 25+ homers and 75+ RBI, to join Mike Schmidt/PHI (12 from 1974-87), Aramis Ramirez/PIT-CHC-MIL (10 from 2001-12), Manny Machado/BAL-LAD-SD (10 from 2015-2026) and Adrián Beltré/LAD-SEA-BOS-TEX (9 from 2004-16).

1-RUN WINS: 28 of the D-backs’ 80 wins (35 pct.) have been decided by 1 run...their 28 1-run victories are their most in a season since 2017 (29), and are second most in the Majors this season, behind the Dodgers (30) and ahead of the Braves (26).

- Since the All-Star break, the D-backs’ 12 1-run wins are tied for fourth most in the Majors with the Padres, behind the Braves (15), Dodgers (13) and Reds (13).

NOOT THERE IT IS: Lars Nootbaar has reached base safely in 14 of his last 17 games, batting .372 (16-for-43)/1.113 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI, 8 walks and 1 sac fly.

- Nootbaar** with runners in scoring position as a D-back, is carrying a 1.128 OPS with 1 double, 3 homers, 13 RBI, 6 walks and 1 sac fly.

KING OF CATCHERS: Gabriel Moreno’s 5.2 bWAR leads all catchers (ahead of Dillon Dingler/DET, 4.0) and has the 11th-highest mark among position players.

- His .301 AVG, .379 OBP, .846 OPS, 31 doubles, 9 sac flies, and 5 stolen bases (T-1st) lead catchers [min. 90 G].
- His 9 DRS rank tied for second among NL catchers (also: Freddy Fermin/SD), behind Luis Torrens/NYM (12).

LATE MAGIC: Jordan Lawlar, from the eighth inning on, is hitting .375 (9-for-24)/.986 OPS with 1 double, 1 homer, 6 RBI and 2 walks.

- Ketel Marte**, from the eighth inning on, is carrying a .909 OPS with 3 doubles, 7 homers, 20 RBI, 18 walks, 1 stolen base and 2 sac flies.
- Ryan Waldschmidt**, from the eighth inning on, is hitting .409 (18-for-44)/1.127 OPS with 4 doubles, 2 homers (both walk-offs), 7 RBI, 7 walks and 1 sac fly.
- Lars Nootbaar**, from the ninth inning on, is hitting .381 (8-for-21)/1.071 OPS with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 RBI, 6 walks and 1 sac fly.
- James McCann**, from the seventh inning on, is hitting .365 (41-for-146)/1.007 OPS with 3 doubles, 3 homers, 10 RBI and 4 walks.

STRONG ARMS: The D-backs bullpen’s 2.59 ERA (18 R-16 ER in 55.2 IP) in September ranks best in the NL and third in MLB, behind the Blue Jays (2.31) and Guardians (2.39).

VS. MARLINS: The D-backs are 7-6 in their last 13 games.
