COLORADO ROCKIES (7-24) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (14-18)

May 3, 2024 at PNC Park, Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - GAME #33/HOME #13 RHP CAL QUANTRILL (0-3, 5.34 ERA) vs. LHP MARTÍN PÉREZ (1-1, 2.86 ERA)

THE PIRATES:...were off yesterday...Went 1-5 on their road trip to San Francisco (1-2) and Oakland (0-3)...Have lost four straight and seven of their last nine games...Have been charged with two errors in their last seven games...Have gone 4-0 in extra innings this season, which is tied for the most second-wins in extra frames in MLB (Cleveland leads

with five)...It is Pittsburgh's longest win streak in extra-innings games to begin a season since 2012 (also 4-0)...The last start to a season with a longer streak was 1960 (7-0).

ABOUT TONIGHT'S STARTER: Martín Pérez gets the start tonight in the opener of this weekend series against the Rockies...Pérez comes into today with the fifth-lowest ERA (2.86) among qualified left-handed pitchers in MLB...The only four southpaws with a lower ERA coming into today are Shota Imanaga (0.78), Ranger Suarez (1.32), Tarik Skubal (1.72) and Tyler Anderson (2.23).

MORE ABOUT MARTÍN: Martín Pérez has a 2.86 earned run average and allowed only one home run through his first six career starts with the Pirates...The last player to have a sub-3.00 ERA and allow one or zero home runs through six career starts with Pittsburgh was J.A. Happ in 2015 (1.57 ERA, one home run allowed)...Special thanks to StatsPerform.

TAKING A STAND: Tonight the Pirates a open a 10-day, nine-game homestand that begins with the Rockies...The Angels will visit PNC Park for the first time since 2016 with the beginning of a three-game series Monday night...Following an off day on Thursday, the homestand will wrap up with three games against the Cubs from May 10-12...The Pirates are tied for the fewest home games (12) in MLB coming into today.

NOW BATTING SECOND: Bryan Reynolds has started in the second spot of the lineup in all 32 Pirates games this season...The last player to start a season with a longer streak of starts in the second lineup spot for the Pirates

was Andrew McCutchen in 2016 (first 41 team games).

THERE'S NO PLACE LIKE HOME: The next outing by David Bednar will make him one of 15 pitchers to appear in 100 career games at PNC Park (Tony Watson has the most with 242)... Bednar is 4-4 with 35 saves and a 2.55 ERA (98.2ip/28er) in his career at PNC Park.

THE RENEGADE: David Bednar has converted each of his last four save opportunities and comes into today with 66 as a member of the Pirates...Bednar's next save will tie him with Matt Capps for the eighth-most in team history.

CLOSING IN ON OROSCO: Aroldis Chapman comes into today with 1166 career strikeouts, which are just three shy of tying Jesse Orosco for the second-most all-time among left-handed relievers (Billy Wagner leads with 1196)...Chapman's 1166 career punchouts are also the 10th-most overall among relief pitchers (Hoyt Wilhelm has the most with 1363).

TAKING A WALK: Pittsburgh is one of five MLB teams to record at least one batting walk in every single game this season, along with the Brewers, Cardinals, Diamondbacks and Yankees...The Pirates rank third in all of MLB with 130 walks, trailing only the Dodger (143) and Yankees (139)...Special thanks to StatsPerform.

KEEPING UP WITH CONNOR: Connor Joe is one of eight National League players with more runs than strikeouts this season (minimum 15 runs)...According to StatsPerform, Joe is the only player in MLB to appear at both first base and the outfield at least 14 times each in 2024.

START ME UP: Pittsburgh's starting rotation has recorded a 3.21 ERA (53.1ip/19er) in the team's last 10 games...Pittsburgh's starting rotation ranks fifth in the National League in ERA (3.67) and batting average against (.238) and third in innings pitched (176.1).

CALL TO THE PEN: Pittsburgh's bullpen has recorded a 2.43 ERA (40.2ip/11er) and 47 strikeouts in the team's last 12 games...Since April 20 the bullpen's 2.43 ERA is the seventh-lowest in all of MLB and second-lowest among National League clubs...The only National League team to record a lower bullpen ERA in that time is Los Angeles (1.62).

JARED JONES: The 22-year-old righthander will make his seventh start tomorrow afternoon...Allowed three runs in 5.0 innings while losing a 3-2 decision to San Francisco's Keaton Winn in his last start Sunday at Oracle Park...Enters today tied with Yoshinobu Yamamoto of the Dodgers for the most strikeouts (42) among all rookies in MLB...Threw 50 of his 59 pitches for strikes but had a no-decision (5.0ip/0r) in his start on 4/16 in the team's 3-1 loss against the Mets at Citi Field...Had seven or more strikeouts in each of his five career games (Jose DeLeon was the only other Pirate to debut since 1893 to begin his career with five straight appearances with seven-plus strikeouts after also doing so in 1983)...Has allowed three runs or fewer in each of his first six starts...Entered the 2024 campaign rated 72nd among Baseball America's top 100 prospects (No. 3 among Pirates prospects).
