## AROUND THE HORN

**CARROLL'S 50 TRIPLES SPARKS 50% OFF TICKETS:** In celebration of Corbin Carroll's 50th career triple on May 24 vs. Rockies, fans can receive 50% off tickets to the D-backs' June 15-17 series vs. Angels by using the code CORBIN50 at dbacks.com/tickets...the offer ends tomorrow, May 26 at 11:59 p.m. AZT...to redeem the offer, fans should select the game they wish to attend, click "Unlock" and enter the code.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** The D-backs are 8-2 in their last 10 games and 11-4 since May 9, the NL's most wins in the span (ahead of 10 by the Brewers and Braves).

- The D-backs begin a 6-game, 7-day trip @ Giants (May 25-27) and Mariners (May 29-31) after going 6-1 in their 7-game homestand vs. Giants (3-0) and Rockies (3-1)...was their first 6-win, 7-game homestand since Aug. 8-14, 2024 (6-1 vs. Phillies and Rockies).
- **Corbin Carroll's** season-high 12-game hitting streak is the Majors' longest active streak...is batting .432 (19-for-44)/1.378 OPS with 4 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers, 8 RBI and 10 walks (9 K).
- **Ketel Marte's** season-high 8-game hitting streak is the Majors' second longest active streak...is batting .531 (17-for-32)/1.537 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 12 RBI and 4 walks (1 K).
- **Ryan Waldschmidt** has 3 straight multi-hit games and reached base safely in 11 of his last 12 games, batting .375 (15-for-40)/.944 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 4 RBI and 5 walks.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs won 9-1 vs. Rockies.

- **Ryne Nelson** tossed a career-high 8.0 innings in his fourth straight quality start (1 R, 6 H, 3 BB, 3 K).
- **Corbin Carroll** recorded his third career 4-hit game and fifth career multi-triple game.
- **Ketel Marte** posted his second straight 3-hit game with 2 doubles and 3 RBI.
- **Tommy Troy** doubled twice to become the fourth D-back rookie all-time with 2 extra-base hits in their debut.

**CARROLL TRIPLE WATCH:** **Corbin Carroll** is 2 triples shy from setting the club record (current: Stephen Drew, 52 in 773 G).

- Is 1 of 9 players in the last 50 years with 5+ multi-triple games (also: George Brett-KC/5 from 1979-90, Brett Butler-ATL-CLE-LAD-NYM/5 from 1983-95, Lance Johnson-CWS-NYM/8 from 1991-97, Omar Vizquel-CLE-SF/5 from 1998-2006, Jimmy Rollins-PHI/5 from 2001-08, Carl Crawford-TB-BOS/8 from 2004-11, Curtis Granderson-DET-NYY/5 from 2007-10, and José Reyes-NYM/9 from 2005-17).

**CARROLL MEETS GEHRIG:** **Corbin Carroll** is the 1 of 2 MLB players all-time to reach 50+ triples and 80+ homers in 537 career games or less (also: Lou Gehrig, 461 G).

**CORBIN BARRELS:** **Corbin Carroll** is the second D-back all-time to have 4 triples and 2 homers in a 7-game span (May 17-24) with David Peralta from July 7-18, 2015 (4 3B, 2 HR).

- Fifth MLB player within the last 20 seasons with 4 triples and 2 homers in a 7-game span (also: Jimmy Rollins/PHI from July 22-29, 2007, Starling Marte/PIT from June 18-25, 2013, David Peralta/AZ from July 7-18, 2015 and Daylen Lile/WSH from Sept. 5-11, 2025).
- Only 1 MLB player since 1998 has had 5 triples and 2 homers in an 8-game span: Cristian Guzmán/MIN from April 5-13, 2001.
- 2 MLB players since 1998 have had 4 triples and 3 homers in an 8-game span: Cristian Guzmán/MIN from April 6-14, 2001 and Kyle Tucker/HOU from Aug. 19-25 (2), 2020.

**FOR 5 ABOVE .500:** The D-backs reached a season-high 5 games above .500 on April 18 (13-8).

**OPPOSING STARTER RISP:** Since May 4 against opposing starters with runners in scoring position, the D-backs boast an MLB-best .342 AVG (27-for-79) with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 38 RBI and 10 walks (10 K).

**OFFENSE OUT OF THE GATES:** In their last 10 games since May 15 from innings 1-3, the D-backs' 31 runs are the most in MLB, ahead of the Brewers (19) and Nationals (19)...are batting .352 (44-for-125)/.966 OPS with 12 doubles, 4 triples, 2 homers and 12 walks.

**BULLPEN IN MAY:** In May, the D-backs' bullpen ranks among the Majors in hits (1st, 37), walks (1st, 18), extra-base hits (2nd, 11), OPS (2nd, .529), WHIP (2nd, 0.99), opponent AVG (2nd, .189) and ERA (4th, 2.28).

**STARTING STRONG:** Since May 5, D-backs' starters have recorded an MLB-leading 14 quality starts in their last 19 outings, allowing 2 or fewer runs in 12 games.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' rotation ranks among MLB leaders in innings (1st, 124.2), IP/G (1st, 6.2), WHIP (1st, 0.99), OBP (1st, .259), wins (T-2nd, 12) and ERA (3rd, 2.45).

**DIVISION SHOWDOWNS:** The D-backs are 8-2 in this stretch of 13 straight NL West matchups (2-1 @ Rockies, 3-0 vs. Giants, 3-1 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

**SERIES WINS:** The D-backs have won 4 of their last 5 series (won 2-1 vs. Mets, lost 1-2 @ Rangers, won 2-1 @ Rockies, won 3-0 vs. Giants, won 3-1 vs. Rockies).

**VS. GIANTS:** The D-backs are 6-1 in their last 7 games.

- Swept their last series 3-0 from May 18-20.
- Have won 4 consecutive season series by a single game since 2022 (7-6 from 2023-25 and 10-9 in 2022).

- **Geraldo Perdomo** has reached base safely in 8 straight games, batting .370 (10-for-27)/1.180 OPS with 3 doubles, 1 triple, 1 homer, 7 RBI and 8 walks.
- **Gabriel Moreno** has reached base safely in 7 straight games, carrying a .998 OPS with 1 double, 2 homers, 3 RBI and 7 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado's** 35 homers, 85 extra-base hits and 119 RBI vs. Giants lead all active MLB players...since 1985, only 4 other players have hit 30+ homers vs. Giants: Gary Sheffield (34), Paul Goldschmidt (32), Jeff Bagwell (32) and Larry Walker (32).
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 5-game hit streak, batting .421 (8-for-19)/1.244 OPS with 1 double, 3 triples, 2 RBI, 2 walks and 1 stolen base...has reached 2+ times in 4 straight games.

- Tossed 7.0 scoreless innings with a no-decision in the 2-1 win on May 21 vs. Rockies (4 H, 1 BB, 4 K).

- Is tied for the second-longest tenured active D-back with Zac Gallen and Kevin Ginkel, behind Ketel Marte (10th season), and is 1 of 12 D-backs all-time to play 8+ seasons: Ketel Marte (10), Nick Ahmed (10), Miguel Montero (9), David Peralta (9), Zac Gallen (8), **Merrill Kelly (8)**, Kevin Ginkel (8), Randy Johnson (8), Luis Gonzalez (8), Andrew Chafin (8), Christian Walker (8) and Paul Goldschmidt (8).
- Has 12+ wins and 175.0+ innings in 3 of his last 4 seasons.
- Re-signed with the D-backs on Dec. 19, 2025 (2-year contract through 2027 with a vesting option for 2028).
- Was traded to the Rangers on July 31, 2025 for top prospects RHP David Hagan (No. 8), LHP Kohl Drake (No. 12) and LHP Mitch Bratt (No. 14).

**LAST START:** Recorded the win in his third consecutive quality start on May 20 vs. Giants (3 ER in 6.0 IP, 8 H, 0 BB, 4 K).

**WINNING WAYS:** Is seeking his fourth straight win to set his second longest career single-season win streak, behind his 5 straight from May 15-June 9, 2023.

**VS. GIANTS:** 23rd start, 11th on the road.

- In his last 5 starts, is 3-0 (team is 3-2) with a 2.76 ERA (10 ER in 32.2 IP), opponent .238 AVG (30-for-126), 6 walks and 28 strikeouts.
- In his last 2 road starts, is 1-0 with a 1.93 ERA (3 ER in 14.0 IP), 0 walks and 16 strikeouts.
- Ranks among active starters vs. Giants [min. 50.0 IP] in wins (T-1, 9), quality starts (3rd, 14), innings (3rd, 133.2) and strikeouts (5th, 110).
- In his last 8 starts vs. NL West with the D-backs, is 5-2 with a 2.55 ERA (16 R-15 ER in 53.0 IP), opponent .221 AVG (43-for-195), 10 walks and 47 strikeouts.

**ON A ROLL:** In his last 3 starts (vs. NYM, @ COL, vs. SF), is 3-0 with a 2.05 ERA (5 ER in 22.0 IP), an opponent .188 AVG (15-for-80), a 0.82 WHIP, 3 walks and 13 strikeouts.

- Ranks among NL relievers [min. 20.0 IP] in walk rate (2nd, 3.5 pct).
- Recorded his 100th appearance as a D-back on May 20.
- Is scoreless in 11 straight road games, going 1-0 with a 0.56 WHIP, opponent .147 AVG (5-for-34)/.314 OPS, 1 walk and 3 strikeouts.
- Has allowed 2 runs (1 ER) in his last 23 games, going 1-1 with a 0.40 ERA (2 R-1 ER in 22.1 IP), opponent .139 AVG (10-for-72), 0.58 WHIP, 3 walks and 10 strikeouts.

- Is scoreless in 10 of his last 11 games, with a 0.96 ERA (1 ER in 9.1 IP), opponent .156 AVG (5-for-32), 0.75 WHIP, 2 walks and 4 strikeouts.
- Is scoreless in 8 straight home games, going 0-0 with an opponent .120 AVG, 0.55 WHIP, 1 walk, 3 strikeouts and no extra-base hits.
- Is holding righties to a .135 AVG (5-for-37)/.395 OPS (BB, 6 K).
- With RISP, hitters are 4-for-22(.182) with 2 walks and 6 strikeouts.

- Since March 30, has allowed 1 of his 9 inherited runners to score.
- Has not allowed a homer in his last 21 games (19.0 IP, 76 BF).
- Limiting righties to a .143 AVG (4-for-28)/.515 OPS (3 BB, 7 K) and lefties to a .191 AVG (9-for-47)/.510 OPS (4 BB, 16 K).

  - His 9 saves of exactly 1.0 inning, with no batters reaching safely are most in the Majors, 2 ahead of Mason Miller/SD (7).
  - His win on Thursday vs. Rockies was his first since April 9, 2025 vs. White Sox while with the Guardians.
  - Has not allowed an earned run in 16 of his last 18 appearances (10 SV/1 BS, opponent .127 AVG, 0.80 WHIP, 6 BB, 17 K).
  - Has not allowed a run in 7 of his last 8 road games, going 0-1 with 5 saves...owns an opponent .154 AVG, 0.82 WHIP with 2 walks and 8 strikeouts.
  - Vs. righties, has allowed just 3 hits (.103, 3-for-27) and yielded 1 walk in his 22 appearances (30 BF) with 10 strikeouts.
