The Brewers are looking for their 60th win of the season today in their 94th game....the franchise record for the fewest number of games needed to reach 60 wins is 99 in 1979 (60-39).

Double Burgher

The Brewers are playing the Pirates in a doubleheader for the ninth time in franchise history....the team has never taken a doubleheader against Pittsburgh, going 0-2 with six splits (0-0-2 in MIL and 0-2-4 in PIT)....the teams last faced off in a doubleheader on 8/14/21 at PNC Park (split)....the last six doubleheaders between the teams have come in Pittsburgh.

In his last 46 games, Garrett Mitchell is batting .327 (48-for-147) with 7 HR and 21 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .385 OBP/.578 SLG/.963 OPS.

In his last 12 games, Brice Turang is batting .345 (19-for-55) with 2 HR and 9 RBI....during this stretch, he has a .368 OBP/.564 SLG/.932 OPS.

Trevor Megill is unscored upon in his last 13 games (13ip, 6h, 3bb, 17k) and has a 1.16 ERA over his last 31 outings (31ip, 17h, 5r, 4er, 6bb, 41k).

IN THE TRAINER'S ROOM: RHP Coleman Crow (right forearm), LHP Brian Fitzpatrick (left elbow), LHP DL Hall (left pectoral), INF David Hamilton (left hamstring), LHP Kyle Harrison (left forearm), RHP Joel Kuhnel (right shoulder), OF Brandon Lockridge (right knee), RHP Quinn Priester (right thoracic outlet), RHP Carlos Rodriguez (right shoulder), RHP Brandon Woodruff (right shoulder), LHP Rob Zastryzny (left trapezius) and LHP Angel Zerpa (left forearm) are on the injured list....Fitzpatrick, Lockridge, Priester and Zerpa are on the 60-day IL.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy (417g, 249-168, .597) is in his third season as Brewers manager....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25)....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Returning from the 2025 staff is offense & strategy coordinator Jason Lane (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator Jim Henderson (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator Néstor Corredor (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach Chris Hook (8th season), bullpen coach Charlie Greene (3rd season), lead hitting coach Eric Theisen (2nd season/1st in current role) and third base coach Matt Erickson (3rd season/1st in current role)....assistant pitching coach Juan Sandoval, hitting coach Guillermo Martinez, hitting coach Daniel Vogelbach and first base coach Spencer Allen are all in their first seasons on the coaching staff.

IN THE STANDINGS (107 days): The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 69, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 7.5 games....the team has held first place for the last 53 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 29-18 at home, going 10-4-1 in series play....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are a Major League-best 30-18 on the road, going 10-4-1 in series play....the team is 22-8 in its last 30 road games, including 10-2 in the last 12 contests....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 24 replay challenges this season, going 16-8....their last challenge (lost) came on 7/1 vs. Cincinnati as a no blocking of the plate call was confirmed and an out call involving Garrett Mitchell stood.

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25)....this does not include the shortened 2020 season....the Brewers have 822 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (914), Astros (852) and Yankees (840).

SPROAT AT A GLANCE: Brandon Sproat, 25, will make his 18th appearance and 16th start of the season.....Sproat last pitched last Sunday in a start at Arizona and had no decision in the Brewers' 3-2 win (4ip, 5h, 1r, 1er, 3bb, 4k, 92 pitches).....the team is 10-5 in his starts.....he has 3 quality starts.....opponents are batting .244 (71-for-291, 14hr)..... he was acquired from the Mets with INF/OF Jett Williams on January 21 in exchange for RHP Freddy Peralta and RHP Tobias Myers.....he entered 2026 as the fifth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....Sproat was selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Florida.

LAST SEASON: Sproat entered the 2025 season as the second-best prospect in the Mets organization according to *Baseball America* with his changeup rated best in the system.....he went 8-6 with a 4.24 ERA in 26 games/25 starts at Triple-A Syracuse.....he was named International League Pitcher of the Month for July (5gs, 2-0, 0.67era)..... Sproat was selected by the Mets on September 7 and went 0-2 with a 4.79 ERA in 4 starts.....he made his Major League debut on 9/7 at Cincinnati and carried a no-hitter into the sixth inning but took a 3-2 loss (6ip, 3h, 3r, 3er, 4bb, 7k).

CAREER: Is 3-6 with a 5.06 ERA in 21 games/19 starts (99.2ip, 89h, 56r, 56er, 44bb, 101k, 14hr).....has pitched for New York-NL (2025) and Milwaukee (2026).

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 2-2 with a 6.25 ERA in 8 games/7 starts, all coming this season (36ip, 25er).

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 1-4 with a 4.53 ERA in 11 games/10 starts (53.2ip, 27er).....is 1-2 with a 4.19 ERA in 9 games/8 starts this season (43ip, 20er).

CAREER vs. PIRATES: Sproat has not faced the Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania Pirates.

DROHAN AT A GLANCE: Shane Drohan, 27, will make his 19th appearance and ninth start of the season.....Drohan last pitched last Monday in a start at St. Louis and earned a 4-3 win (6ip, 6h, 3r, 1er, 2bb, 2k, 85 pitches).....he is 2-2 with a 3.69 ERA as a starter (39ip, 16er) and 2-0 with a 1.82 ERA as a reliever (24.2ip, 5er).....the team is 5-3 in his starts.....he has 2 quality starts.....opponents are batting .243 (59-for-243, 5hr).....he made his Major League debut in a start on 4/8 at Boston.....he is also 1-1 with a 3.29 ERA in 3 games/ 2 starts this season at Triple-A Nashville (13.2ip, 14h, 6r, 5er, 7bb, 17k, 2hr).....Drohan was acquired from Boston with LHP Kyle Harrison and INF David Hamilton on February 9 for INF Caleb Durbin, INF Andruw Monasterio, INF/C Anthony Seigler and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round B selection.....name is pronounced "DROH-ehn."

LAST SEASON: Drohan went 5-1 with a 2.27 ERA in 12 games/11 starts at Triple-A Worcester.....he held International League opponents to a .185 AVG with 67 strikeouts in 47.2 innings while posting a 1.01 WHIP.....he was on Worcester's injured list from 5/13-8/25 with left forearm inflammation.

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER: Is 32-22 with a 4.25 ERA in 107 games/91 starts (425.1ip, 387h, 226r, 201er, 212bb, 489k, 51hr) while pitching in the Boston (2021-25), Chicago-AL (2024) and Milwaukee (2026) organizations.....he was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 23rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft but did not sign.....he was then selected by Boston in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft.....Drohan went from Boston to Chicago-AL in the 2023 Rule 5 Draft and returned to the Red Sox in June 2024.....he underwent left shoulder surgery 2/22/24, performed by Dr. Nikhil Verma, and missed most of the 2024 season.

AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-1 with a 3.03 ERA in 12 games/4 starts (38.2ip, 13er).....**ON THE ROAD:** Is 3-1 with a 2.88 ERA in 6 games/4 starts (25ip, 8er).

vs. PIRATES: His only outing against Pittsburgh came in relief on 4/24 at American Family Field (4ip, 4h, 3r, 1er, 1bb, 2k).

ODDS & ENDS: Drohan graduated from Cardinal Newman (FL) High School, where he played three years of football (quarterback) in addition to baseball.....he went on to attend Florida State University.....his father, Bill, pitched in the Royals organization from 1987-90 at the Rookie and Class-A levels.....Drohan enjoys watching football and basketball and playing video games.....he is a fan of the Miami Dolphins and Miami Heat.
