YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles lost to the Yankees, 10-1...The loss clinched the AL East for New York... **Ramón Urias** recorded Baltimore's first hit in the fifth inning...**Corbin Burnes** made his last start of the regular season and allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) and one walk with nine strikeouts in 5.0 innings and finished the year with a 2.92 ERA, becoming the second qualified Oriole since 1993 to have a sub-3.00 ERA along with **Kyle Bradish** (2.83) in 2023.

✪ **Jackson Holliday**, **Ryan Mountcastle**, and **Austin Slater** all recorded pinch-hit knocks, the first time the O's have had three pinch hitters tally hits since May 6, 2015 at New York-NL (Snider, Navarro, and Young); it marked the first time by the Orioles in a game that began with a designated hitter since September 18, 2012 at Seattle (Flaherty, Teagarden, and Tolleson).

BE THE NOISE: Fans can now purchase Postseason tickets for potential games at Oriole Park at Camden Yards by visiting orioles.com/Postseason...It's time for Birdland to set the tone, pack the Yard, and Be The Noise.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's clinched a Postseason berth on Tuesday, their second straight year in the playoffs after winning the AL East with an AL-best 101-61 record in 2023...This marks the fourth time in team history that the club has made the playoffs in at least two straight seasons, joining 1996-97, 1973-74, and 1969-71 (3)...The team's magic number to clinch the top Wild Card spot is one as they lead the Tigers and Royals both by 3.0 games; any Baltimore win or Detroit loss in the final three games would give the Orioles a home playoff game on Tuesday at Camden Yards...If the Postseason started today, the Birds would host Kansas City...The O's have lost eight of their last 13 and 11 of 17...The team is 35-40 (.467) since July 1, 30-33 (.476) since the All-Star break, and 23-27 (.460) since August 1.

✪ Baltimore is 189-132 (.589) since the start of 2023, the best record in the AL and the third-best winning percentage in MLB during that time, behind the Dodgers (.607, 195-126) and Braves (.596, 190-129); the 189 wins in back-to-back years are the most by the O's since 1979 (102-57) and 1980 (100-62).

✪ New York will win the division with a winning percentage under .600; marks the first time an AL East winner has not finished the season with a record above .600 since Boston won the division in 2017 and 2018 at 93-69 (.574).

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles rank second in MLB with 228 home runs, ahead of the Dodgers (227) while trailing the Yankees (235)...Baltimore led MLB in homers through June with 139, 16 more than New York-AL, but have hit 89 home runs since, tied for 13th in MLB...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and this year marks the most by the club since 2017 (232).

✪ Baltimore has nine players with at least 10 home runs, tied with the Dodgers and Red Sox for the most in MLB this season: **Anthony Santander** (44), **Gunnar Henderson** (37), **Colton Cowser** (23), **Adeley Rutschman** (19), **Cedric Mullins** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (11); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

✪ Henderson and Santander are one of two duos with at least 35 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (58) and Juan Soto (41); the O's did not have a player reach 35 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2016 that the team has had multiple players with 35+ home runs (Trumbo, 47; Davis, 38; Machado, 37).

✪ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and second in MLB this year behind the Phillies (15); Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one season by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 for the club in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** is three homers shy of becoming the fourth shortstop (11th occurrence) in MLB history to hit 40 home runs, joining Alex Rodriguez (6x, 1998-2003), Rico Petrocelli (1969), and Ernie Banks (4x, 1957-60)...He passed **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004), who led the O's record by a shortstop with 34 entering this season...He would also be the second player in Orioles history to hit 40 homers and steal 20 bases, along with **Brady Anderson** (50 HR, 21 SB) in 1996.

✪ He was voted the 2024 Most Valuable Oriole by members of the local media; he's the eighth player to earn MVP in back-to-back seasons and the first since **Adam Jones** in 2011-12.

✪ Henderson earned AL Player of the Week on September 9, the second such award of his career; he slashed .417/.464/.833 (10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games.

✪ His 118 runs scored are fourth in the AL and sixth in MLB, and are the most by an Oriole since **Roberto Alomar** set the club record with 132 in 1996; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), Jones (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), Anderson (2, 1995-96), and Ripken, Jr. (3, 1983-85).

✪ He's on pace to score 120 times; Alomar, **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and Ripken, Jr. (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

✪ Henderson ranks third in the AL and fourth in MLB with 8.2 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since Ripken, Jr. set the club record with 10.6 in 1991; four O's (six occurrences) have finished a season with an 8.0 fWAR, along with Ripken, Jr. (3x; 10.6, 1991; 9.8, 1984, & 8.5, 1983), **Brooks Robinson** (8.1, 1964), F. Robinson (8.2, 1966), and **Jim Gentile** (8.0, 1961).

✪ He has hit 31 of his home runs when batting leadoff, the second most in Orioles history, behind **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996.

MASHED TATERS: **Anthony Santander** ranks third in MLB with 44 home runs, trailing New York-AL's Aaron Judge (58) and Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (53)...He's the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season and one of four (five occurrences) at least 44 (see chart at right).

✪ His solo home run on Tuesday at New York-AL gave him 100 RBI for the season, the first Oriole to reach that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; he's the fourth Oriole switch-hitter to do so, joining **Eddie Murray** (5x, 1980, 82-85), **Ken Singleton** (2x, 1979-80), and **Bobby Bonilla** (1996).

✪ Santander has hit 35 home runs since the start of June, behind Ohtani (39) and Judge (38) for the most in MLB; no other player has more than 27 during that time.

✪ His 105 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth in MLB during that time and are second in the AL, behind only Judge (157).

✪ He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

HOLY COWSER: **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 23 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (24)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-2B, 28 HR) in 2023...Among rookies, Cowser leads the AL and ranks third in MLB with 4.0 fWAR, behind San Diego's Jackson Merrill (5.0) and Pittsburgh's Paul Skenes (4.2)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 76), total bases (1st, 219), extra-base hits (T-1st, 50), walks (2nd, 52), slugging percentage (2nd, .447), RBI (3rd, 68), OPS (3rd, .771), doubles (3rd, 24), and on-base percentage (5th, .324).

✪ His 11 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders.

✪ He's two home runs shy of becoming the fifth Oriole rookie to hit at least 25 homers in a season, along with Henderson, **Ryan Mountcastle** (33, 2021), **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (28, 1982), and **Eddie Murray** (27, 1977); Mountcastle is the only one of that group who did not win Rookie of the Year.

AGAINST THE TWINS: The Orioles and Twins wrap up the regular season this weekend at Target Field...This marks their first meeting since the O's swept a three-game set at Oriole Park from April 15-17...Baltimore hit nine home runs in the three games, including a walk-off two-run blast by Cedric Mullins to complete the sweep...Since the start of 2022, the Birds are 10-6 (.625) against Minnesota and have won seven in a row dating back to July 2, 2023, the longest winning streak against the Twins since another seven-gamer from August 22, 2011 to April 8, 2012; the last eight-gamer vs. Minnesota was from July 30, 1996 to May 1, 1997.

DOCUMENT IT: A documentary focused on the city of Baltimore and the Orioles to air on a streaming network or digital carrier in Spring of 2025...The story of the city coming back from an economic and human catastrophe (the Key Bridge collapse), while a new ownership group and President usher in the next chapter of Oriole excellence...A team that has long been part of the city's DNA and mirrors its resilience...Interwoven are stories from our neighborhoods, our fans, and our schools (starting with Harlem Park Elementary, which the Orioles have adopted)...All combining to tell the riveting story of a City, State, and Major League team making a run for a Championship.

✪ The project is being filmed and produced by Mike Tollin Productions; creator of projects such as "The Last Dance," "The Captain," and "Justice USA," Mike Tollin Productions is the nation's premier production house for sports documentaries and storytelling.

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 16th career start tonight against the Twins... Recalled from Triple-A Norfolk on August 20 before appearing in a game after Zach Eflin landed on the 15-day IL; marks his third stint with the Orioles this season; also served as the 27th man for the doubleheader against Toronto on July 29...Became the first Oriole pitcher to make his Major League debut this season and fourth Oriole overall, joining INF Jackson Holliday, C David Bañuelos, and INF/OF Connor Norby...Became the first Oriole to throw at least 100 pitches in his MLB debut since Wei-Yin Chen on April 10, 2012 vs. New York-AL; is the third MLB player to do so since the start of 2019, joining Chicago-AL's Dylan Cease on July 3, 2019 (G1) vs. Detroit (101) and Cincinnati's Andrew Abbott on June 5, 2023 vs. Milwaukee (105)...On June 12 vs. Atlanta, he became the 11th Oriole in team history to throw at least 6.0 scoreless innings in his first career MLB home start and first since Mike Wright Jr. on May 17, 2015 vs. Los Angeles-AL (7.1IP); at 24 years, 61 days old, became the youngest O's left-hander to toss 6.0+ shutout frames since Zack Britton (23y, 249d) on August 28, 2011(G1) vs. New York-AL (7.0 IP)...On September 3 vs. Chicago-AL, he became the second-youngest Oriole (24y, 144d) with 10 strikeouts and no walks in a game behind Dennis Martínez (24y, 81d) on August 3, 1978 vs. Milwaukee and the youngest to do so in a nine-inning game... Acquired by the Orioles along with RHP Yennier Cano, LHP Juan Rojas, and RHP Juan Núñez from the Minnesota Twins in exchange for RHP Jorge López and cash considerations on August 2, 2022...Originally selected by the Minnesota Twins in the third round (No. 98 overall) of the 2021 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Nebraska.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor in the decision on September 21 vs. Detroit... Allowed two runs on two hits and three walks with seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings; has struck out 30 batters across his last four starts (22.0 IP)...Threw 89 pitches, 62 strikes.

AGAINST THE TWINS AND THE AL CENTRAL: Slated to make his first career start against Minnesota and third straight against an AL Central opponent...Has gone 1-2 with a 2.74 ERA (7 ER/23.0 IP) in his four starts against the division... Notched career highs in innings (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in his September 3 start vs. Chicago-AL.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: 0-5 with a 9.75 ERA (26 ER/24.0 IP) with six homers in six road starts compared to 2-4 with a 3.60 ERA (20 ER/50.0 IP) and six home runs allowed at Oriole Park...Opponents are slashing .283/.385/.535 (28-for-99) off Povich on the road.

NIGHT OWL: Has gone 2-5 with a 4.22 ERA (25 ER/53.1 IP) in his 10 night outings compared to 0-4 with a 9.15 ERA (21 ER/20.2 IP) in five afternoon starts...Holds a 5.28 ERA (9 ER/18.1 IP) with 18 strikeouts to three walks across his last three night starts.

HIGH TIDE: Went 6-1 with a 3.48 ERA (30 ER/77.2 IP), a 1.11 WHIP, and 89 strikeouts against 27 walks across 15 outings (14 GS) for the Tides this year...When Povich was first promoted, he ranked among International League leaders in strikeouts (2nd), opponent average (3rd, .203), ERA (4th), WHIP (4th, 1.11), and wins (T-4th); only trailed teammate RHP Chayce McDermott (82) in strikeouts...At the time, his 75 strikeouts were tied for fifth among all minor league pitchers.

FOREVER YOUNG: At 24 years, 168 days old, he is currently the youngest pitcher on the O's and the third-youngest player overall behind Gunnar Henderson (23y, 90d) and Jackson Holliday (20y, 298d).

FLOWERS, NOT SHOWERS: Named the International League Pitcher of the Month for April after going 2-1 with a 1.03 ERA (3 ER/26.1 IP) and a league-best 40 strikeouts in five starts...Also named the Orioles Minor League Pitcher of the Month after leading O's minor leaguers (min. 20 IP) in ERA, WHIP, and strikeouts... Named International League Pitcher of the Week for April 1-7 after going 1-0 with a 0.82 ERA (1 ER/11.0 IP), three hits, three walks, and 14 strikeouts in two starts at Charlotte during the week.
