**THE WORD ON THE 'BIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a seven-game road trip over eight days in the Golden State with the second stop in West Sacramento to play a three-game series with the American League West division leading Athletics. The Cardinals split a four-game series with the Padres to conclude a 17-day stretch at MLB Ballparks (with one rainout called two hours before first pitch on May 5 vs. Milwaukee) at 9-7.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** St. Louis enters play today at 23-17 and in 3rd place in the National League Central, 3.5 games behind first place Chicago and percentage points behind 2nd place Milwaukee. The 3.5 games is the furthest the Cardinals have been out of first place this season, spending seven days at that deficit throughout the season. The high watermark of the season was eight games over .500 at 23-15 on May 8.

**HITLESS WONDERS:** The Cardinals pitching staff held the San Diego Padres to 14 hits over their four-game series at Petco Park. According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, this was the fewest hits allowed in a four-game series in Cardinals franchise history dating to 1900. The last team to accomplish this feat was the Chicago Cubs, holding the Milwaukee Brewers to 14 hits in a four-game superfecta from April 26-29, 2018.

**CARAY ON MY WAYWARD SONS:** This series will be an All-In-The-Family special as **Chip Caray** will be the television broadcast voice of the St. Louis Cardinals and his twin sons **Chris** and **Stefan** will call the action for the Athletics. This comes nearly 35 years to the date that **Chip** joined his father **Skip** and grandfather **Harry** on a broadcast at Wrigley Field between the Atlanta Braves and Chicago Cubs on May 13, 1991. This will be the first Major League Baseball game called by identical twins; and to the best of our research in conjunction with MLB, by a father and sons duo as the lead of baseball broadcast (**Archie Manning** joined **Peyton** and **Eli Manning** as a spin-off broadcast "Manning Cast" on Monday Night Football with former Cardinals broadcaster and Hall of Famer **Joe Buck** and **Troy Aikman** on the main call).

**ROAD KILL:** The Cardinals enter with the best road record in Major League Baseball at 13-7 (.650). The Cardinals have not lost three straight road games this season and the last time the Cardinals lost three or more were the final four games of the 2025 regular season (Sept. 24-28 at SF & CH).

**CALIFORNIA FIVE:** This season, along with all even years, the Cardinals will play road games at all five California locations. They played four games in San Diego (May 7-10), now West Sacramento with the Athletics (May 12-14), Anaheim for the Angels (July 20-22), Los Angeles for the Dodgers (Sept. 1-3) and San Francisco for the Giants (Sept. 7-9). The Cardinals are 2-2 to begin this season and were 9-7 in their "California Five" road matchups in 2024.

**IT'S ALL LOGISTICS:** St. Louis has played 11 one-run games this season and are 8-3 (.727) in those close contests, trailing only the Rays (8-1, .889) and Cubs (9-2, .818) in winning percentage. They have the most wins in extra inning games with a 5-1 record. When scoring first, the Cardinals are 16-4 (.800), tied with the Cubs (16-4, .800) for the best mark in the National League, trailing the Rays (18-3, .857) and Rangers (14-3, .824) in the junior circuit.

**BACK ON THE TRAIL:** The Cardinals just finished a stretch of 16 games over 17 days with one rain cancellation (May 5 vs. MIL) posting a 9-7 mark. This was the longest stretch without a scheduled off day of the 2026 season.

**CENTRAL CASTING:** Entering play today, all five teams in the National League Central are 22-19 or better. Among American League teams, only the Tampa Bay Rays (27-13) or New York Yankees (26-16) would not be in last place in the N.L. Central.

**PRIMETIME PLAYERS:** The Cardinals will be broadcast locally on Cardinals TV for all three games of this series. Through 40 games this season, 20% of the Cardinals games have been on National TV with St. Louis posting a 5-3 record. They have been televised four times by FOX, one by ESPN, one by Apple TV, one by Peacock and a co-exist with Fox Sports 1.

#### SACRAMENTO & ATHLETICS CONNECTIONS

**Jacob Wilson's** father, **Jack Wilson**, was selected by St. Louis in the 9th round of the 1998 MLB Draft and played parts of three minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization before being traded to the Pirates for LHP **Jason Christiansen** (July 29, 2000).

Cardinals broadcaster **Chip Caray's** son, **Chris Caray**, is an Athletics broadcaster.

**Justin Bruhl** was born in nearby Petaluma, Calif.

**Joel Kuhnel** made his MLB debut on Aug. 16, 2019 vs. St. Louis while pitching for Cincinnati.

**Daniel Descalso** was born in Redwood City, Calif...graduated from St. Francis High School in Mountain View in 2004...played college baseball at University of California, Davis (2005-07)...resides in Danville, Calif.

Cardinals Minor League Outfield Coordinator **Ryan Ludwick** was a 2nd round draft pick of the Athletics in 1999 and Cardinals Special Advisor & Pitching Instructor **Jason Isringhausen** pitched for the Athletics from 1999-2001 before he signed with St. Louis as a free agent in December 2001.

Cardinals Pitching Strategist **Dean Kiekhefer** pitched in four games for the Athletics during the 2018 season.

Athletics Hitting Coach **Mike Aldrete** was the Cardinals Asst. Hitting Coach (2008-11) and Bench Coach (2012-14)...member of the Cardinals 2011 World Championship team and 2013 NL pennant winner...his son, **Michael Aldrete**, was selected by St. Louis in the 39th round of the 2012 Draft.

Cardinals Video Coordinator **Chad Blair** previously served in a similar role with the Athletics from (1988-95)...is a native of nearby Santa Rosa, Calif.

Cardinals Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to Player Development **Mark McGwire** played parts of 12 seasons in Oakland (1986-97)...1987 AL Rookie of the Year...1989 World Series Champion & member of three AL pennant winners (1988-90)...eight-time AL All-Star (1987-92, '95-97)...won two Silver Sluggers (1992 & '96) and one Gold Glove (1990)...selected by Oakland in the 1st round (#10) in the 1984 MLB Draft...traded to St. Louis for **Eric Ludwick**, **T.J. Mathews** and **Blake Stein**.

Hall of Famer and A's Special Assistant to the President **Dennis Eckersley** pitched nine seasons with Oakland (1987-95) and two with St. Louis (1996-97)...converted 386 of his 390 career saves between the Athletics (320) and Cardinals (66).

Athletics Quality Control Coach **Marcus Jensen** played 16 games for St. Louis in 1999.

Athletics Roving Coach **Stephen Piscotty** was a Cardinals 2012 1st round draft pick and played in 323 games for St. Louis from 2015-17 before the A's acquired him on Dec. 14, 2017 in exchange for **Yairo Muñoz** and **Max Schrock**.

Cardinals Assistant Hitting Coach **Brandon Allen** played in 44 games for the A's from 2011-12 & was the A's Opening Day First Baseman in 2012.

Athletics Head Athletic Trainer **Jeff Collins** is a SIU Carbondale graduate.

Hall of Fame Manager **Tony La Russa** was a manager of the Athletics (1986-95) and Cardinals (1996-2011)...is only manager to win multiple pennants in both leagues and one of two (Sparky Anderson) to win a World Series in both...His 70 postseason victories (50 with St. Louis, 19 with Oakland, & 1 with Chicago) rank 2nd to Joe Torre (84)...La Russa piloted the A's to four division titles, three AL pennants, and the 1989 World Championship...is A's franchise wins leader (798)...also played parts of four seasons in Oakland (1968-71).

Mgr. of Baseball Info. & Media Services **Chris Tunno** was the clubhouse manager for the Athletics California League affiliate, Stockton Ports (A) at the beginning of the 2007 season under manager **Darren Bush**, current A's bench coach..

TONIGHT'S GAME:

- Making his 8th start of the 2026 season tonight as he completes the starting rotation's 8th time thru; it's his 69th career start (177th career appearance).
- Tonight's game continues a pattern of having alternated Home & Road starts to begin the season; Is trying to win a 3rd-straight Road start which would be a career high.
- His 177th career appearance tonight ranks 70th all-time among Cardinals pitchers; He joins **Adam Wainwright** (478), **Carlos Martinez** (274), **Lance Lynn** (206), **Miles Mikolas** (204) and **Chris Carpenter** (198) since 2000 to reach 177 career games pitched for St. Louis while also making 60 or more starts.
- Pitched 5.0 or more innings in each of his first seven starts, longest streak by a Cardinal since **Sonny Gray** ran off 12 straight last season from July-September.
- **Leads all current Cardinals pitchers in career starts (68), wins (27), innings pitched (497.1) and strikeouts (350).**
- **Is 2.2 innings shy of reaching 500 IP for career.**
- Made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for the 5th time (2022-26), tied with **Lars Nootbaar** for most among active Cardinals.

LAST TIME OUT (Wednesday, May 6 vs. Milwaukee): L, 6-2; 6.0 IP, 8 H, 5 R, 5 ER, 2 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR, 104 pitches.

- Was victimized by a 3-run HR by Andrew Vaughn in 4-run 1st inning and lost his 3rd-straight decision at Busch Stadium.
- Matched his single game career high (3rd time) with 104 pitches, doing so for the first time since 2024 season.

2026 NOTES:

**SLIDE ON IN:** Is holding opposing batters to a .143 BA (7-49) with his slider, and 17 of his 29 strikeouts this season have come via the slider.

**COUNT ON ME:** Has worked at least 5.0 IP in all seven arts this season, allowing 2 runs or fewer in three of those games; has throw 6.0 IP in his last two starts.

**IF AT FIRST:** Has had issues with 1st inning, allowing a 1.050 OPS, 9 runs and 3 HRs in 1st inning and batters are hitting .412 (7-17) when contacting the 1st pitch of an at-bat.

**BITTER BREW:** Allowed four 1st inning runs, including 3-run HR, in 6-2 loss to MIL on 5/6, losing his 3rd straight decision at Busch Stadium.

**AHOY MATEY:** Pitched a season-best 6.0 innings while allowing one run in the Cardinals 5-4 win at PNC Park (4/29) in game three of a four-game series sweep of Pittsburgh.

**TRI-DENT:** Fanned 8 Mariners on 4/24 in his season-high 5.1 IP, but took the 3-2 loss after Josh Naylor's solo HR in the 6th snapped a 2-2 tie.

**SPACE TRAVELER:** Earned his 1st road win since 5/16/25 at Kansas City in a 7-5 Space City win over the Astros on 4/18 in Houston.

**MARCH MADNESS:** Made his 2026 season debut on 3/31 vs. NYM and gained a 3-0 win as he worked 5.0 scoreless IP, allowing just 3 hits.

CAREER:

- Has made the Cardinals Opening Day Roster for five consecutive seasons (2022-26) after arriving at 2022 Spring Training as a non-roster invitee, his first official invite to Major League Spring Training.
- Is 12-15 in his 34 career games started at Busch Stadium while the Cardinals have gone 16-18 in those games.
- Since his 2022 Major League debut, boasts the highest ground ball percentage (63.0%) in Major League Baseball among pitchers with 400.0+ innings pitched.
- As a starting pitcher (365.2 IP), Pallante's 59.6 career groundball pct. currently is the 8th-best in MLB since the stat has been tracked since 1987 (min. 350.0 IP as starter).
- Started vs. San Francisco (June 20, 2024) at Rickwood Field in Birmingham, Ala., tossing 5.1 innings in the 6-5 Cardinals win. Was the first Cardinals starting pitcher to earn a win at a neutral site since Alan Benes vs. San Diego on April 19, 1997 at Aloha Stadium in Honolulu, Hawaii.

PALLANTE vs. ATHLETICS:

- Is making his 1st career start and appearance vs. the Athletics and at Sutter Health Park.
- The Athletics are one of three teams he has yet to face in his career along with the Angels and Cardinals.
- Looking to record his first win in his home state of California after 10 appearances and 21.1 innings without.
- His win at HOU (4/18) was his 1st win in an Interleague start since 5/16/25 at Kanas City; is 5-8, 4.94 ERA in 19 career Interleague starts.
- The Cardinals have won 4 of his last 5 career Interleague road starts after losing each of the first four.
