METSCELLANEOUS: The Mets fell to the Phillies, 5-4, in extra-innings last night...New York has lost back-to-back games and three of their last four...The Mets have outscored their opponents 98-73 in 20 games this month...New York is in a stretch of 17 straight games without an off-day (7-8)...The Mets head out on their final road trip of the year, a seven-game trip (2-3) to Miami (2-1) and Philadelphia (0-2)...New York is off on Monday before they conclude the 2023 schedule with a six-game home stand against the Marlins (three games) and Phillies (three games).

BRETT THE MET: Over the last four games, Brett Baty is batting .333 (5-15) with four runs, two home runs, three RBI with a .733 SLG and a 1.067 OPS...Againt right-handed pitchers, Baty has posted a .304 OBP this season.

EL JEFF-E: Jeff McNeil has safely reached base in 15 straight games, posting a .375 OBP in that span...In 49 games since the start of August, Jeff McNeil is batting .306 (60-196) with 31 runs, nine doubles, two triple, seven home runs, nine walks with five steals, a .348 OBP and a .480 SLG...McNeil has an .910 OPS in 20 games this month, recording 10-extra base hits.

SENGA GENESIS: Kodai Senga's 12 wins are tied for the most in franchise history by a Japanese born player...Masato Yoshii also had 12 in 1999...He is 12-7 with a 2.96 ERA (53 ER/161.1 IP) with 74 walks and 194 strikeouts in 28 starts this season...His 2.96 ERA ranks fourth in the majors and second in the National League...His 2.96 ERA is the seventh-lowest by a Japanese-born pitcher in MLB history (min. 100 innings).

DOING THE SPLITS: Brandon Nimmo is batting .295 with 46 runs, 15 doubles, three triples, 11 home runs, 36 RBI, 39 walks with a .378 OBP and a .477 SLG in 76 games on the road this season...This compares to a .247/.346/.452 slashline in 72 games at Citi Field...Francisco Lindor has posted a .283/.343/.500 slashline with 56 runs, 23 doubles, two triples, 16 home runs and 26 walks in 79 games on the road in 2023...He has posted a .213/.311/.375 slashline in 73 games at Citi Field...Pete Alonso is slashing .237/.340/.552 with 24 home runs and 54 RBI in 75 road games...He is batting .202/.302/.473 at Citi Field.

TAKE IT TO THE BANK: In 17 career games at Citizens Bank Park, Luis Guillorme is a .423 (11-26) hitter with three runs, one double, one triple, three RBI and four walks...Jeff McNeil has hit .321 (50-156) with 17 runs, 12 doubles, two triples, one homer, 13 RBI and 13 walks in 43 games at the yard...Brandon Nimmo has slashed .280/.426/.484 with 27 runs, seven doubles, two triples, seven home runs and 18 RBI in 49 games in Philly...Pete Alonso has hit .237/.316/.455 with nine doubles and eight home runs in 39 contests at Citizens Bank Park

30-FOR-30: Francisco Lindor has recorded 30 stolen bases and 27 home runs this season...He is looking to become the fourth player in franchise history to record 30 home runs and 30 steals in a single-season...He would join David Wright (2007), Howard Johnson (1991, 1989, 1987) and Darryl Strawberry (1987).

DINGERS!: The Mets feature eight players who have recorded at least 10 home runs this year...The team record is 10 players with 10 or more home runs, done in 2017...The 2019 team featured nine players, while the 2007 and 2005 teams feature eight players as well...The Mets have socked 204 home runs this season...That is the fifth-most in the National League...The 2022 Mets hit 171 home runs...The 2023 team became the fifth team in franchise history record 200 or more homers in a year...The team's 204 home runs are the fourth-most in a single season in franchise history...They previous four years with 200 or more homers are: 2019 (242), 2017 (224), 2016 (218) and 2006 (200).

GOT TO GO TO MO'S: Ronny Mauricio has safely hit in 13 of his first 18 career games...He is batting .261 (18-69) with five runs, three doubles, one home run, seven RBI, five walks and six steals in his first 18 career games...He is one of five players in franchise history to record a hit in each of his first five career major league games.

FOR PETE'S SAKE: Pete Alonso has recorded his second season with 45 or more home runs, becoming the only player in franchise history to do so...He recorded his third season with 40 or more home runs...He became the fifth player in major league history with three or more seasons of 40 or more homers in their first five years, joining Ralph Kiner (four), Ryan Howard (three), Albert Pujols (three) and Eddie Mathews (three)...He is the only player in franchise history with multiple seasons of 40 or more home runs...He is tied for second in the majors and is tied for second in the National League with 45 home runs... Alonso's 191 home runs since he entered the league in 2019 are the most in the major leagues.

PHILLIES-METS NOTES: The Mets are 95-85 all-time at Citizens Bank Park...The Mets are 18-9 vs. Philly over the last two years.

QUINTANA NEWS & NOTES

RECENTLY: Quintana made his first start with the Mets on July 20 against his former team, the Chicago White Sox....Quintana signed a two-year contract with New York on December 9, 2022...The southpaw began the season on the IL due to a stress fracture in his rib cage...Underwent surgery on March 17.

LAST TIME OUT: Quintana made his 11th start of the season on September 17 against the Reds at Citi Field...He threw 6.2 innings and allowed two runs and one walk while striking out two batters.

300 CLUB: Today, Quintana will make his 301st career major league start...In his last start, Quintana became the 11th active pitcher to reach 300 career starts and joined Clayton Kershaw, Madison Bumgarner and Wade Miley as the only active left-handed ptichers with 300 or more career starts.

REHAB ASSIGNMENT RECAP: Made five appearances across St. Lucie (A), Binghamton (AA) and Syracuse (AAA) as part of his rehab assignment after being placed on the 60-day IL with a left rib fracture...Threw 15.2 innings in five games, four of which were starts, pitching to a 4.60 ERA (8 ER/15.2 IP) while tallying 16 strikeouts compared to eight walks

PHILADELPHIA FREEDOM: Tonight, Quintana will make his eighth start against the Phillies...Quintana last faced Philadelphia on July 29, 2022 at PNC Park with the Pirates...Threw 5.2 shutout innings allowing four hits and struck out four batters...Holds a career 1.04 ERA (2 ER/17.1 IP) against the club at home compared to a 4.30 ERA (11 ER/23.0 IP).

HOT STREAK: Quintana's homerless inning streak came to an end at 97.1 innings in his start on August 12 at St. Louis after allowing a solo homer to Tyler O'Neill to lead off the bottom of the seventh inning...The last pitcher before Quintana to reach 90.0+ homerless innings was Tyson Ross (100.0 IP) in 2015...Courtesy of Elias...Last season Quintana owned the lowest ERA (0.89) in Major League Baseball during the month of September last year and is the lowest ERA in any month in his career.

LEFT 'EM SPEECHLESS: Reached 1,500 career strikeouts in his start vs. Colorado on August 16, 2022...Quintana currently ranks fifth among active MLB lefties in strikeouts (1,577) behind Clayton Kershaw (2,934), Chris Sale (2,187), Madison Bumgarner (2,070) and Patrick Corbin (1,588).

2022 SEASON: Quintana allowed two earned runs or fewer in 26 starts in the regular season...Posted a season-high 19.1-inning scoreless streak from September 11-28, the longest scoreless streak in by a Cardinals pitcher in 2022...
