TODAY'S GAME: The Giants have lost the first two games of this four-game series with the Dodgers, being outscored by an 8-4 margin...SF is 1-4 on this final road trip of 2025 and are 38-41 (.481) on the road this year...it marks the fourth consecutive season in which the Giants have fallen below .500 on the road.

- ▶ SF enters today having lost nine of its last 13 games, with a -14 run differential in that span...the team has won one of its last four series (2-1 vs. AZ from September 8-10).
- ▶ The Giants entered last Saturday's contest in a tie with the Mets for the final Wild Card spot in the NL...however, losses in six of their last seven games have dropped the Giants 4.0 games back in the last week...SF is also 2.0 games behind the Reds and 1.0 game behind the Diamondbacks with just eight games remaining on the schedule.

AND WE'RE TIED!: With last night's loss, the Dodgers/Giants head-to-head all-time in the regular season is now 1,287 wins each with 19 ties...according to Sarah Langs, this is the first time the Dodgers/Giants head-to-head record has been tied since after a game on August 10, 1896.

GIANTS VS. NL WEST: SF is 20-27 (.426) vs. the NL West this season...when removing the Rockies from the equation (8-2, .800), SF is 12-25 (.324) vs. the NL West (6-7 vs. AZ, 3-8 vs. LAD, 3-10 vs. SD).

- ▶ The Giants have just three wins vs. the Dodgers this season...their fewest in a single season is four, done so five times (2024, 2022, 2020, 1979 and 1977).

WALK THIS WAY: The Giants enter tonight's game with the fourth-highest walk rate (9.1%) in MLB behind the Yankees (10.1%), Dodgers (9.5%) and the Mets (9.2%)...the Giants have drawn at least five walks in each of their last two games and have totaled 15 free passes in this series so far.

- ▶ According to *Sports Info Solutions*, in the last two days, Giants hitters have seen 117 more pitches than Dodgers hitters.

THAT'S A FIRST!: Last night, **OF Heliot Ramos** became the first Giants player to hit a leadoff home run against future Hall of Famer Clayton Kershaw...in fact, last night was just the ninth time in Kershaw's 18-year big league career, that he's allowed a leadoff home run...prior to Ramos, Arizona's Ketel Marte was the last to do it on Sept. 25, 2021.

ON THE HILL: **RHP Kai-Wei Teng** will face the Dodgers for the first time in his career tonight in what will be his 12th career big league appearance and his seventh start...

- ▶ Teng held the Diamondbacks to just one unearned run on two hits in his last outing on Monday.
- ▶ The right-hander is holding opponents to a .167/.286/.278 slash line the first time through the lineup, however opponents have a slash line of .349/.463/.372 the second time through.

JUST TWO MORE FOR THE 30-HR PLATEAU: **IF Willy Adames** needs just two home runs in San Francisco's final eight games to give the Giants their first 30 homer season since **Barry Bonds** in 2004...Adames, however has not homered in his last nine games and 34 at-bats.

- ▶ Adames' 28 homers are already he most by a Giants right-handed hitter since **Jeff Kent** clubbed 37 homers in 2002.

THE SCHMITTY OF ANGELS: **IF Casey Schmitt** has nine RBI vs. the Dodgers this season (including eight the last time the Giants played here in LA from June 13-15)...the nine RBI are the most by a Giant vs. LAD in a single season since **Darin Ruf** had nine RBI in 2022.

- ▶ The last Giants with 10+ RBI vs. LAD in a single season were **Brandon Belt** (13), **Joe Panik** (10) and **Buster Posey** (10) in 2016, yet they all played 18+ games...the last Giant with 10+ RBI vs. LAD in no more than 13 games (Schmitt currently has played nine games with four possible games remaining), was **J.T. Snow** with 11 RBI in 13 games in 1999.

WITH THE BATS: The Giants are hitting just .182 with a .272 OBP and .306 SLG pct. in their past 13 games, in which they've gone just 4-9.

- ▶ The Giants are just 2x19 with runners in scoring position in the first two games of this series.

ON DECK: Following these final two games against the Dodgers, the Giants will wrap up their regular season schedule with a six-game homestand against the Cardinals (Monday-Wednesday) and Rockies (Friday-Sunday).

IT TAKES TWO TO TENG-0: Teng is set to make his seventh Major League start and eighth appearance of the season after being recalled from Triple-A Sacramento on August 31 with **LHP Carson Whisenhunt** landing on the IL...Teng appeared in four games for SF last season, all in relief.

LAST TIME OUT: Got a no-decision on September 15 at Arizona after allowing one unearned run on two hits and a walk while striking out five over 4.0 innings.

IN THE BOOKS: With his win on August 8 vs. Washington, Teng became the ninth Taiwanese-born pitcher in MLB history to earn a win...he also became the first Giants pitcher to throw at least 5.0 innings or more in relief without a run allowed since **Keaton Winn** did so on September 3, 2023 at San Diego.

SWEEPIN': Has relied most heavily on his sweeper this year, throwing it 37.5% of the time...opponents are 9-for-42 (.214) with 17 strikeouts in at-bats ending in a sweeper...over his last two starts, opponents hit just .077 (1x13) vs. his sweeper with eight strikeouts.

STAY STRONG: Teng has done well in the earlier innings of his last four starts starts...in innings 1-3, Teng has 20 strikeouts, a 0.83 WHIP and zero earned runs allowed...from the 4th inning on in that span, he has five strikeouts, a 3.00 WHIP and has allowed eight earned runs.

WITH THE RIVER CATS: Teng posted a 3.63 ERA (23er, 57.0ip) in 26 games (four starts) with Sacramento this season...more specifically, in his last seven games (four starts) dating to June 22, he posted a 0.99 ERA (3er, 27.1ip) with 45 strikeouts to just 12 walks...hitters went 12-for-94 (.128) off him in that stretch.

POTW: Was named a Minor League Pitcher of the Week for the third time in his career this season, earning the honor for the week of July 6 for Triple-A Sacramento...he struck out 11 while allowing one walk and one hit across 5.0 shutout innings on July 2 vs. Reno.

2024: Made his MLB debut on March 31 at San Diego...he posted a 9.82 ERA (12er, 11.0ip) in four MLB games...he entered the season rated as #25 prospect in Giants farm system per *MLB.com*.

POUNDING THE ZONE: Has 764 strikeouts in 616.2 career Minor League innings...he has an 11.46 K/9 since 2021, which is the seventh-best K/9 in the Giants organization (both MLB and MiLB) over that span (min. 100 pitching appearances).

MAKE 'EM MISS: At the time of his recall, Teng's 14.05 K/9 this season was the best among all Triple-A pitchers (min. 50.0ip)...the next closest was Dodgers Minor Leaguer Paul Gervase (12.89 K/9)...his 37.1% strikeout rate was also best in Triple-A (min. 50.0ip) with Gervase ranking second (36.3%).

PEDIGREE: The native of Taiwan was acquired by San Francisco from Minnesota on July 31, 2019 in exchange for RHP Sam Dyson...also accompanying Teng to the Giants organization were OF Jaylin Davis and RHP Prelander Berroa...he was in big league camp each of the last two seasons, entering 2024 as the #25 prospect in the Giants' farm system according to *MLB.com*.

▶ Posted a 6.48 ERA (12er, 16.2ip) with 16 strikeouts and a .258 opponent average across nine appearances in August.
▶ Batters are 9-for-58 (.155) with 15 strikeouts off his sweeper.
▶ Has recorded at least four outs in 17 of 27 MLB games this season...pitched 2.0 innings in 11 of 19 games at Triple-A.
