THE TWINS: Have gone 1-4 through five games on their six-game, seven-day homestand, going 0-3 vs. the Dodgers and 1-1 vs. the Rockies...following today's series finale with Colorado, the Twins will travel to Houston to begin a six-game, seven-day roadtrip with three against the Astros (Monday-Wednesday) and three against the Yankees (Friday-Sunday).
 ☞ The Twins have won seven of their last 12 and nine of their last 16.
 ☞ Twins are playing their 38th day game today...37 day games, entering today, are tied with Baltimore, Chicago-AL and Miami for second-most in baseball, trailing Washington (39)...Minnesota is 16-21 during the day.
 ☞ Twins have gone 6-6 in rubber games this season...their six wins were April 12 at Toronto, May 10 at Cleveland, May 14 vs. Miami, May 20 vs. Houston, June 14 vs. St. Louis and June 21 at Arizona.

NOT ALL GOOD, MAN: The Twins lost to the Rockies last night at Target Field by a score of 8-5...Mike Paredes (0-1) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing three runs on eight hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and two strikeouts...Marco Raya made his major league debut, allowing two runs on two hits in 2.0 innings of relief...the offense recorded 10 hits and struck out just four times...Trevor Larnach went 3-for-5 with a double (14) and three RBI, while Brooks Lee went 2-for-4 with a double (12).

I EXPECTED THE ROCKY MOUNTAINS TO BE A LITTLE ROCKIER THAN THIS: The Twins and Rockies are facing off for the 30th time in their history today...the Twins have gone 16-13 all-time against Colorado, going 2-1 at the Metrodome (2003), 6-6 at Coors Field (2008, '14, '23 & '25) and 8-6 at Target Field (2010, '17, '22, '24 & '26).
 ☞ In 12 career games against the Rockies, Byron Buxton is hitting .333 (15-for-45) with two doubles, two triples, three home runs, nine RBI, four walks and a 1.067 OPS...in his last seven games against the Rox, he is hitting .400 (12-for-30) with five extra-base hits.
 ☞ In 10 career games against the Rockies, Kody Clemens is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two doubles, two triples, two home runs, nine RBI and a 1.229 OPS.
 ☞ In seven career games vs. Colorado, Royce Lewis is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBI and a 1.172 OPS.

NATIONAL NEWS: Twins have gone just 10-19 against National League opponents this season...they have gone 0-3 vs. Cincinnati (April 17-19), 1-2 at New York-NL (April 21-23), 1-2 at Washington (May 5-7), 2-1 vs. Miami (May 12-14), 1-2 vs. Milwaukee (May 15-17), 0-3 vs. Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. St. Louis, 2-1 at Arizona (June 19-21), 0-3 vs. Los Angeles (June 22-24) and 1-1 vs. Colorado...their next NL opponent will be the Cubs for three games at Wrigley Field, coming out of the All-Star break, from July 17-19.

BUX THE BEST: Updated voting for the MLB All-Stars were released on Thursday and Byron Buxton moved on to phase two of the voting...Buck received 1,789,018 votes in the phase one process, joining him is Aaron Judge (2,567,404), Mike Trout (2,511,587), Cody Bellinger (1,614,585), Daulton Varsho (1,336,544) and Jesus Sánchez (1,260,762)...phase two voting will start tomorrow at 11 am (CT) and will conclude on Thursday, July 2 at 11 am (CT)...below are Byron Buxton's rankings among AL outfielders in a few offensive categories on the season:

ADDITIONALLY...Buxton ranks third among that same group in RBI (43), trailing Bellinger (49) and Adell (45).

WELL CONNECTED: Twins hitters struck out just four times last night, marking the sixth time in their last seven games in which they have struck out five times-or-fewer...Minnesota has struck out just 158 times this month, the second-fewest in baseball, trailing Arizona (152)...by comparison, in May, they were tied for fourth-most strikeouts in baseball (252) and in March/April they ranked tied for ninth-most in MLB (279).
 ☞ Brooks Lee leads the AL this month in lowest strikeout percentage at 8.0%.

MAJORITY RULES: The Twins are looking to win their 12th series of the season today...they have gone 11-14-1 in series play, 6-5-1 at home and 5-9-0 on the road...they enter today having won three of their last four series...Twins are also 6-6 in rubber games this season.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first series win over Colorado since taking two of three at Target Field from June 10-12, 2024...Twins are 6-3-0 all-time in series play vs. the Rockies.
 ☞ Twins are 3-6-0 vs. NL opponents in series play this season, their three wins being May 12-14 vs. Miami, June 12-14 vs. St. Louis and June 19-21 at Arizona.

POWER PLAY: Through 24 games this month, the Twins are slugging .474, which ranks second-best in baseball, trailing only Colorado (.501).
 ☞ This month, Minnesota ranks third in baseball in OPS (.811), trailing Colorado (.855) and Milwaukee (.824).
 ☞ Twins have homered in all but four of their last 21 games since June 4, hitting 37 in that span...since that date, they rank second in baseball in homers, trailing the Athletics (42).

I AM THE ONE WHO 'NACHS: Over his last 10 games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .462 (18-for-39) with four doubles, two home runs, 10 RBI, a .488 on-base percentage, a .718 slugging percentage and 1.206 OPS.
 ☞ In 20 games this month, he is hitting .364 (24-for-66) with six doubles, two home runs, 11 RBI, six walks and a .970 OPS...his batting average is tied for third-best in baseball among players with at least 70 plate appearances this month.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Low-A Fort Myers outfielder Luis Fragoza and FCL Twins right-handed pitcher Frederick Hiciano as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.
 ☞ Fragoza, 19, played in four games for the Mighty Mussels, hitting .467 (7-for-15) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks and a 1.356 OPS...the Valencia, Venezuela native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2024.
 ☞ Hiciano, 18, made one start for the FCL Twins on Thursday at the FCL Braves, allowing one run on two hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the Moca, Dominican Republic native was signed by the Twins as an international free agent in January of 2026.

- Connor Prielipp is slated to make his 12th career MLB start this afternoon and first against the Colorado Rockies.
- In his last outing on June 19 at Arizona, Prielipp took the loss after allowing six runs (three earned) on nine hits (1 HR), with three walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched in a 9-5 Twins defeat.
- Today will be Prielipp's seventh home start of the season; he owns a 4.18 ERA (32.1 IP, 15 ER) in six starts at Target Field this season, compared to a 6.56 ERA (23.1 IP, 17 ER) in five road starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Prielipp made his 11th start of the season on June 19 at Arizona opposite right-hander Michael Soroka...took his fifth loss of the season, allowing a career-high-tying six runs (three earned) on a career-high nine hits – one being a Ketel Marte solo homer in the sixth inning – with three walks and four strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched in a 9-5 Twins loss...the 6.0 innings of work matched a career high (done three times: May 16 vs. Milwaukee, June 2 vs. Chicago-AL and June 13 vs. St. Louis), and is the first time Prielipp has reached the 6.0 inning mark on the road.

- A TALE OF TWO HALVES:** In his last six games dating back to May 22 at Boston, Prielipp has given up an average of 6.8 hits/game and allowed opponents to hit .328 (41-for-125) against him; through his first five starts of the season, he held opponents to an average of 5.0 hits/game and a batting average of .169 (15-for-89).
- BUILDING HIM UP:** Prielipp has thrown more than 95 pitches in each of his last two starts, marking the first time in his career that he has thrown 95-or-more pitches in back-to-back starts...additionally, he has now thrown 90-or-more pitches in four of his last five starts and in six of 11 starts this season; heading into this season, he had never thrown more than 90 pitches in a start during his professional or collegiate career (see Innings and Pitches note below).

TWO STARTS AGO: Prielipp made his 10th start of the season on June 13 vs. St. Louis opposite Cardinals left-hander Matthew Liberatore...did not factor into the decision, a 9-6 Minnesota defeat, after allowing four runs on seven hits (1 HR), with two walks and two strikeouts in 6.0 innings pitched...all four of Prielipp's runs came in the first two frames via an Iván Herrera two-run homer in the first and three Cardinals hits in the second (Blaze Jordan - triple, Pedro Pagés - double and Nathan Church - single)...from the third-sixth inning pitched 4.0 scoreless, allowing only three hits.

INCHING UP THERE IN INNINGS AND PITCHES: Prielipp has made 15 combined appearances (14 starts) so far this season for Triple-A St. Paul (four games/three starts) and Minnesota (11 starts); in those appearances he has thrown a total of 71.1 innings...here are some numbers showing Prielipp's workload by season since his freshman year at the University of Alabama.

MAKE THE CLIMB: Today will be Prielipp's first career start against the Rockies, fifth career start against a National League opponent and third in a row since June 13; is 0-2 with a 4.09 ERA (22.0 IP, 10 ER), seven walks, 20 strikeouts, a .264 (23-for-87) BAA and a 1.36 WHIP through his first four career starts against the NL (MLB debut on April 22 at New York-NL, May 16 vs. Milwaukee, June 13 vs. St. Louis and June 19 at Arizona)...has tossed 6.0 innings in each of his last three starts against the NL, but is still searching for his first Interleague win.

- In his two starts against National League opponents at home (May 16 vs. Milwaukee and June 13 vs. St. Louis), Prielipp owns a 3.65 ERA (12.0 IP, 5 ER) with four walks, 10 strikeouts and a 1.17 WHIP.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Through 11 games, Prielipp has started six times at home and five times on the road...at Target Field he is 2-2 with a 4.18 ERA (32.1 IP, 15 ER), 12 walks, 33 strikeouts and a 1.11 WHIP; compared to 0-3 with a 6.56 ERA (23.1 IP, 17 ER), 11 walks, 22 strikeouts and a 1.84 WHIP in his four starts on the road.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Through 11 MLB starts, lefties are slashing .278/.328/.426 (15-for-54) with five doubles, one home run, five walks and 13 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .256/.339/.413 (41-for-160) with six doubles, two triples, five home runs, 18 walks and 42 strikeouts against Prielipp.

THE ARSENAL: In his 11 starts, Prielipp has used a five-pitch mix...here are his numbers and results, per Baseball Savant:

- CHANGING IT UP?:** Prielipp threw his changeup an MLB career-high 25 times on June 19 at Arizona; the most he had thrown in a game previously was 18 times on May 27 at Chicago-AL...Diamondbacks hitters batted .167 (1-for-6) with one single and one strikeout against the pitch; coming into the game opposing hitters were hitting .286 (8-for-28) against the change.
- THE CURVEBALL:** On June 19, Diamondbacks hitters went 3-for-5 against Prielipp's curveball with two singles and a homer; prior to the start, Prielipp held opposing hitters to a .194 (6-for-31) average against the curve with only one extra-base hit (2B).
