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PITTSBURGH PIRATES (57-59) vs. MILWAUKEE BREWERS (71-43)

August 6, 2026 - American Family Field - Milwaukee, WI - 1:10 CDT - Game #117/Road #60

RHP Braxton Ashcraft (11-4, 3.96 ERA) vs. RHP Dustin May (5-7, 4.38 ERA)

THE PIRATES: have won two of the first seven games on this eight-game road trip to Cincinnati (1-3, July 30-August 2) and Milwaukee (1-2, Monday-Thursday), including a 4-2 loss on Wednesday night at American Family Field...Will host New York (NL) for three games (Friday-Sunday) before embarking on a three-game road trip to Miami (August 11-13)...Are two games below .500 for the third time this season (they were 0-2 after a loss on March 28 at New York-NL and 1-3 after a loss on March 30 at Cincinnati)...Are in the 14th day of a stretch of 17 consecutive days with a game (their last off day was on July 23, while their next off day is scheduled for August 10)...Have hit 142 home runs (they hit 117 home runs all of last season)...Have the most hits (1030) in all of Major League Baseball...Have scored the third-most runs (586) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Washington (620) and Chicago-NL (592), after scoring 583 runs during all of last year...Have struck out the third-most batters (1077) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Philadelphia (1121) and Milwaukee (1119).

WHAT'S BREWING: Pittsburgh has won six of its first nine games against Milwaukee this season...The Pirates won two of three games from April 24-26 here at American Family Field, swept a three-game series from July 11-12 at PNC Park and won one of the first three games in this four-game series in Wisconsin...Pittsburgh can clinch its first season series win vs. Milwaukee since 2018 by taking one of the final four head-to-head meetings (the teams will meet for three games from September 15-17 at PNC Park).

MEET THE METS: The Pirates will head home for a three-game series (Friday-Sunday) against the Mets following today's series finale at Milwaukee...Pittsburgh dropped two of three games in its season-opening series against New York at Citi Field (March 26-29)...The Pirates have won or split each of their last three series against the Mets at PNC Park...They won two of three games from June 9-11, 2023, split a four-game series from July 5-8, 2024 and swept a three-game series from June 27-29, 2025...Pittsburgh has won or split at least four straight home series against the Mets only five times in series history (since 1962), coming from April 21, 1962-June 6 (G2), 1965 (10 straight), September 20, 1965-August 11, 1966 (four straight), September 19, 1980-August 16, 1983 (eight straight), April 15, 1991-June 20, 1993 (seven straight) & July 12, 2013-June 8, 2016 (four straight).

END(Y) IN SIGHT: Endy Rodríguez homered for a second straight game with his two-run blast (off DL Hall) in the seventh inning on Wednesday at Milwaukee...It marked his 10th Major League home run and his first off a left-handed pitcher...Rodríguez' only two career RBI against left-handed pitchers prior to Wednesday came on August 21, 2023 vs. St. Louis (single, off Drew Rom) and September 30, 2023 vs. Miami (single, off A.J. Puk)...He has homered in back-to-back games (also Tuesday at Milwaukee) for the first time in his career...The only Pirates switch hitters in the Modern Era (since 1901) to homer in three straight games were Jim Russell (July 4 [G2]-6 [G2], 1945), Orlando Merced (April 16-18, 1996), Ryan Doumit (June 10-12, 2008), Josh Bell (August 11-13, 2019) and Bryan Reynolds (April 2-4, 2023)...Rodríguez is batting .298 (25-for-84) with four doubles, six home runs, 15 RBI, 11 walks, four stolen bases, a .939 OPS and 13 runs in his last 25 games (since June 12 vs. Miami)...His batting average during that stretch ranks fourth among Major League switch hitters (minimum 80 at-bats), behind Chicago (NL)'s Pedro Ramírez (.317), Colorado's Cole Carrigg (.303) and teammate Jake Mangum (.301)...His OPS in that time ranks first among all MLB switch hitters.

MAYDAY: The Pirates have won two of their three head-to-head meetings against Brewers starting pitcher Dustin May, who is making his team debut in today's series finale at Milwaukee...Pittsburgh picked up a 10-3 win over May last year on August 30 at Boston...The Bucs also earned a 6-2 win over May this year on May 21 at St. Louis...Spencer Horwitz is 3-for-7 (.429) with two walks vs. May, while Jake Mangum is 3-for-5 (.600) with two RBI vs. him.

BEER BATTER: Bryan Reynolds singled and scored on Wednesday at Milwaukee...He has gone 62-for-191 (.325) with 13 doubles, two triples, eight home runs, 25 RBI, 21 walks, a .945 OPS and 28 runs in 54 career games at Miller Park/American Family Field...His batting average is the second-highest mark by any visiting player in stadium history (since 2001) with at least 175 at-bats here, behind only Albert Pujols (.326, 103-for-316)...His OPS is sixth among visiting players, behind Pujols (1.028), Nolan Arenado (1.020), Paul Goldschmidt (1.008), Joey Votto (.978) & Matt Holliday (.957).

HOW ACQUIRED: Selected in the second round of the 2018 Draft.

LAST TIME OUT: Ashcraft won a 4-1 decision after allowing one run over 5.0 innings on August 1 at Cincinnati...He did not return after the 1 hour and 46 minute rain delay.

AGAINST THE BREWERS: Ashcraft has posted a 5.63 ERA (8.0ip/5er) and eight strikeouts in his two career starts against Milwaukee...He had a no-decision after allowing one hit over 3.0 scoreless innings in Pittsburgh's 5-4 win on June 23, 2025 at American Family Field (his first Major League start)...Ashcraft also had a no-decision after allowing five runs in 5.0 innings in the Bucs' 7-6 win on July 11 (G1) at PNC Park.

CENTRAL INTELLIGENCE: Ashcraft is 4-0 with a 2.92 ERA (37.0ip/12er) in his last six starts against the National League Central, dating back to his scoreless outing of a career-high 7.2 innings on May 3 vs. Cincinnati (the Pirates are 6-0 in the games)...His 3.28 ERA (79.2ip/29er) in 16 appearances (15 starts) against the NL Central since making his first appearance vs. the division on June 14, 2025 at Wrigley Field (relief) is fourth in Major League Baseball (minimum 50.0 innings), behind San Francisco's Logan Webb (1.92), Chicago (NL)'s Colin Rea (2.26) and the Bucs' Carmen Mlodzinski (2.98).

LEADING THE WAY: Ashcraft has a team-high 11 wins this season...The last Pirate with more than 11 wins in a season was Mitch Keller (13 wins) in 2023...Pittsburgh has not had a starting pitcher with at least 12 wins and a sub-4.00 ERA in a season since Trevor Williams (14-10, 3.11) and Jameson Taillon (14-10, 3.20) did that in 2018.

HEY NOW: Ashcraft was named to his first career All-Star team this season, joining Paul Skenes as Pittsburgh's representatives (he replaced Skenes on the roster)...Skenes (130) and Ashcraft (128) became just the second pair of Pirates teammates to both have at least 115 strikeouts prior to the All-Star break in a single season (the first All-Star Game was held in 1933), joining Francisco Liriano (125) and Gerrit Cole (116) in 2015...They were also only the third pair of Pittsburgh starters to be named to the All-Star team in the same season, along with Bob Friend and Vernon Law (1960), as well as A.J. Burnett and Cole (2015)...Ashcraft's 128 strikeouts prior to the All-Star break were the sixth-most in Pirates history, behind Bob Veale (137) in 1965, Veale (134) in 1966, Skenes (131) in 2025, Skenes (130) this year and teammate Mitch Keller (129) in 2023.

TWICE AS NICE: Ashcraft has made multiple starts where he recorded at least 10 strikeouts and did not issue a walk...He struck out 11 batters on May 31 vs. Minnesota and 10 batters on June 24 vs. Seattle...Ashcraft became the only Pittsburgh pitcher during the Modern Era (since 1901) to post multiple such starts during a single season.

MR. CONSISTENT: Ashcraft pitched at least 6.0 innings, struck out at least five batters and walked two or fewer batters in six consecutive starts from May 3-May 31...He became one of five Pirates (six instances) during the Modern Era (since 1901) to do that, joining Rick Reuschel (six starts, September 4-October 1, 1985), Jon Lieber (six starts, June 15-July 13, 1998), Gerrit Cole (six starts, April 14-May 11, 2017 and six starts, July 30-August 26, 2017) and Paul Skenes (seven starts, June 11-July 23, 2024).

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Ashcraft did not allow a first-inning run in any of his first 20 Major League starts (from last year on June 23 at Milwaukee to May 31 vs. Minnesota)...The streak was snapped on June 6 at Atlanta (allowed two runs in the first inning)...Per the Elias Sports Bureau, he was one of three Major League pitchers in the Expansion Era (since 1961) to allow zero first-inning runs in at least each of his first 20 career starts, along with Rollie Sheldon (20, 1961) & Dennis Rasmussen (22, 1983-84).

TOMORROW'S STARTER

Pittsburgh has not named a starter for Friday night's series opener against New York (NL) at PNC Park.
