Second baseman **Jeff Kent** will be officially inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY today. The best years of his 17-year Major League career came with the Giants from 1997-2002, when he posted a 31.6 of his career 55.4 bWAR as one of the pillars of the Giants' offense. He was a three-time All-Star, the 2000 NL MVP and won three of his four Silver Slugger awards as a Giant.

**TODAY'S GAME:** With a series win secured, the Giants eye their first three-game sweep of the season in this afternoon's series finale with the Angels.

- Each of the other 29 teams in the Majors this season have completed at least one series sweep of three games or more...the Giants would be the last team to do so if they can finish the sweep.
- SF has won four straight home games, five of its last six and is 11-5 (.688) in its last 16 games here at Oracle Park dating to June 14...SF began the year 13-20 through its first 33 home games.
- The Giants' .688 home winning percentage since June 14 is best in the Majors.

**ROSTER MOVES:** LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (#88) was recalled from Triple-A Sacramento and will start this afternoon's finale for SF...RHP **Tristan Beck** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.

**LET'S GO TO THE HAALLLL:** 2B **Jeff Kent** will be inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame this afternoon in Cooperstown, NY...for more on Kent, see pages two and three.

**HALO TOP:** The Giants are 30-20 (.600) all-time vs. the Angels...the .600 winning percentage vs. LAA is SF's third-best against all active teams, behind only its marks vs. the Guardians (17-10, .630) and Rangers (29-18, .617).

- SF faces Interleague opponents in eight of its 11 series following the All-Star break, also visiting the Rangers, Guardians and Red Sox and hosting the Tigers and Astros within the next month...SF's 11-18 (.379) Interleague record is lowest in the NL this year and third-lowest in the Majors ahead of the Twins (12-21, .364) and Angels (11-21, .344).
- The Giants are trying to complete a three-game sweep of the Angels here at home for the first time since May 1-3, 2015.

**WE'RE OFF TO SEE THE WHIZ:** LHP **Carson Whisenhunt** (SF's #12 prospect according to MLB.com) will make his third start for SF this season this afternoon...he's been used as a spot starter twice thus far while spending a majority of this season with Triple-A Sacramento.

- His last outing with SF came on July 9 versus Colorado where he picked up his second win with 5.2 innings of two-run ball in SF's 8-2 victory.
- He was optioned back to Triple-A the following day and made one start with the River Cats last Sunday in Albuquerque, blanking the Isotopes over 5.0 innings while striking out eight.
- In 17 games (16 starts) at Triple-A this year, Whisenhunt is 6-4 with a 4.15 ERA and 90 strikeouts in 82.1 innings.

**BIZ DEV: IF Rafael Devers** homered for a second consecutive game to give him a team-best 22 homers...15 of those 22 homers have come in his last 40 games since June 6.

- His 15 homers since June 6 are tied for most in the Majors with TB's Junior Caminero and COL's Hunter Goodman...his .979 OPS since June 6 is sixth-best in MLB (min. 140 PA).
- Since the start of May, Devers leads the Majors with 44 extra-base hits (73 games played)...the next closest player is CHC's Pete Crow-Armstrong (40 XBH).
- Six of the Giants' nine runs came via the homer yesterday (Devers' three-run blast as well as a three-run homer by **OF Jung Hoo Lee**)...the Giants have scored 201 runs since June 1, with 105 coming via a home run (52.2%)...the 52.2% mark is fourth-highest in MLB over that span and second-highest in the NL behind only the Reds (59.1%).

**WHAT'S BREWING...:** The Giants welcome in the Milwaukee Brewers for a three-game set tomorrow night, ending a nearly three-week long stretch of opponents with records below .500 like themselves...so far, during this run that began on July 3, SF has gone 8-10 in the 18 games with a -1 run differential (85-84).

- SF split a series with the Brewers in Milwaukee from June 1-4, bouncing back to win the final two games of the series to earn the split.
- Here at home, the Giants have won three of their last four series against Milwaukee in San Francisco dating to 2022...SF took three-of-four from Milwaukee at Oracle last year.

JEFF KENT HEADS TO COOPERSTOWN



**HALL PASS!:** 2B Jeff Kent will be officially inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame in Cooperstown, NY on Sunday after receiving enough votes from the Contemporary Baseball Era Committee back in December...it was Kent's first time on the Contemporary Era ballot after falling off the writer's ballot in 2023...the ceremony will take place at 1:30 p.m. ET / 10:30 a.m. PT and be televised live on MLB Network.

- ▶ Kent becomes the sixth player to go in as a San Francisco Giant, joining **Orlando Cepeda, Juan Marichal, Willie Mays, Willie McCovey** and **Gaylord Perry**.
- ▶ Marichal is one of 61 scheduled Hall members to attend this year's induction ceremony.
- ▶ Overall, Kent becomes the 26th player or manager to be enshrined in Cooperstown with his primary team being designated as a Giant (*see full list to the right*).
- ▶ Kent is one of 16 players/managers in the hall to go in wearing a Giants cap...the 10 players/managers wearing a New York Giants cap are: **Christy Mathewson, John McGraw, Carl Hubbell, Bill Terry, Ross Youngs, Monte Irvin, George "High Pockets" Kelly, Freddie Lindstrom, Travis Jackson** and **Hoyt Wilhelm**.
- ▶ The 16 people donning Giants caps in the Hall are second only to the Yankees, who have 22 players, coaches or managers with their cap according to *MLB.com*.

**NUMBERS DON'T LIE:** One of the best offensive second basemen of his generation, Kent's 377 career homers are the most by a primary second baseman in AL/NL history.

- ▶ His 1,518 career RBI are third-most among primary second basemen behind only Nap Lajoie (1,599) and Rogers Hornsby (1,584), who are also both in the Hall of Fame.
- ▶ His career .500 slugging percentage is second-best in AL/NL history behind only Hornsby (.577) while his 2,298 career games are 11th-most.
- ▶ Overall, Kent had eight seasons as a second baseman where he hit at least 20 homers and drove in 100 runs...the eight such seasons are most among all second baseman in Major League history...Hornsby is second on that last with five such seasons.
- ▶ Kent's 560 career doubles are 30th on the all-time list.

**AWARDS & ACCOLADES:** During his 17-year Major League career Kent was named an All-Star five times (1999-2001, 2004-2005), was named the National League Most Valuable Player (2000) and won four Silver Sluggers (2000-2002, 2005).

- ▶ In addition to winning the MVP in 2000, Kent finished in the top-10 in MVP voting four times (1997, 1998, 2000 when he won it and 2002)...all four of those instances came while wearing a Giants uniform.

**BECOMING A GIANT:** Was acquired by San Francisco from Cleveland on November 13, 1996...Kent, along with **Julián Tavárez, José Vizcaíno** and a PTBNL (**Joe Roa**) joined the Giants while **Matt Williams** and PTBNL (**Trenidad Hubbard**) went to Cleveland in return.

KENT AS A SAN FRANCISCO GIANT

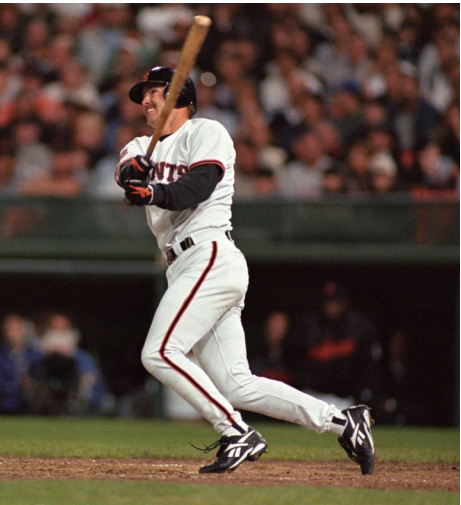


- ▶ The best years of his 17-year Major League career came with the Giants from 1997-2002, when he posted a 31.6 of his career 55.4 bWAR as one of the pillars of the Giants’ offense.
- ▶ During his six seasons in the orange and black, Kent slashed .297/.368/.535 (.903 OPS) with 247 doubles, 22 triples, 175 home runs, and 689 RBI in 900 career games...in those six seasons he averaged 41 doubles, 29 homers and 114 RBI.
- ▶ He was named the National League’s Most Valuable Player in 2000 after hitting .334 with 41 doubles, 33 homers, 125 RBI and a 1.021 OPS in 159 games...the only other Giants infielder to win an MVP award in the SF-era besides Kent was **Willie McCovey** in 1969.
- ▶ Kent earned three of his five All-Star selections as a Giant (1999-2001) also won three of his four Silver Slugger awards during his stint in SF (2000-2002).
- ▶ During his time in the postseason as a Giant, he batted .290 with five homers and 11 RBI in 24 games.
- ▶ His still ranks among the Giants all-time postseason leaders in homers (T-4th), batting average (5th) and slugging percentage (.495, 3rd)...he’s also the only Giant in team history to have a pair of multi homer games in the postseason (Game 3 of the 1997 NLDS vs. Florida and Game 5 of the 2002 World Series vs. Anaheim).
- ▶ All told, he helped the Giants reach postseason play in three of his six seasons by the Bay (1997, 2000, and 2002) and the Giants clubs he was a part of averaged 91 wins a season in that time.

KENT’S MEMORABLE MOMENTS AS A GIANT

**THE ORANGE & BLACK:** He made his Giants debut on Opening Day 1997 at Candlestick Park versus the Pittsburgh Pirates...Kent batted fifth and went 0-for-3 with an RBI thanks to a sac fly.

**IT’S BYE, BYE BABY:** He clubbed the first of his 175 career home runs as a Giant in Game 2 of the 1997 season, a two-run blast in his first at-bat of the day off Steve Cooke...he finished the game 2-for-4 with a double, the homer and five RBI in SF’s 7-5 win.



**GOIN’ FISHIN’:** In Game 3 of the 1997 NLDS vs. Florida, Kent blasted a pair of homers for SF’s only two runs of the game in their loss to the Marlins at Candlestick Park.

**WALK IT OUT:** The slugger had five career walk-off homers with three of the five coming as a Giant...his first career walk-off homer came off the Reds’ Stan Belinda in the bottom of the 10th inning on July 26, 1998 to give SF a 2-1 win.

**THE CYCLE:** Logged the 20th cycle in Giants history when he did so on May 3, 1999 at Three Rivers Stadium in Pittsburgh... Kent singled in the 1st inning, homered in the 3rd, tripled in the 5th and doubled in the 7th to accomplish the feat...he finished the day 5-for-5.

**PAC THE PARK:** Kent hit the first of his 33 career regular season home runs as a Giant at then Pacific Bell Park on May 1, 2000 versus the Mets...his 33 homers at Pac Bell as a Giant are tied for fifth-most by a Giants right-handed batter in the ballpark’s history behind **Buster Posey** (61), **Rich Aurilia** (46), **Pedro Feliz** (45) and **Wilmer Flores** (42).

**FIRST DIBS:** Two days later on May 3, 2000 (also against the Mets), Kent delivered a three-run walk-off homer off Turk Wendell to send the Giants to an 8-5 win in 11 innings...the win was the first walk-off victory in Pacific Bell Park history.



**M-V-P:** Named the National League’s MVP in 2000, receiving 22 first-place votes after slashing .334/.424/.596 (1.021 OPS) with 196 hits, 33 homers and 125 RBI...Kent was the first second baseman to win the award since Ryne Sandberg in 1984.



**HELLO WORLD:** Clubbed two homers in Game 5 of the 2002 World Series versus Anaheim to help the Giants rout the Angels 16-4 and take a 3-2 series lead going back to Anaheim...Kent finished the day 3-for-5 with four runs scored, two homers and four RBI...he is the only player in Giants postseason history with a pair of multi-homer games in the postseason.



**UP ON THE WALL:** Following his playing career, Kent was inducted on to the Giants Wall of Fame on August 29, 2009. Coincidentally it will be exactly 17 years to the day that the Giants retire Kent’s #21 later this season when they do so on August 29 versus the Diamondbacks.

**WIZ KID:** Whisenhunt is back on the Major League roster for a third time this season after making two spot starts for SF so far...with an injury to **RHP Trevor McDonald**, Whisenhunt could get an extended look in SF's rotation...the 25-year-old was selected in the second round of the 2022 MLB Draft out of East Carolina...he currently ranks as the Giants' No. 12 prospect (fourth pitcher) per *MLB.com*.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Blanked Triple-A Albuquerque last Sunday in Albuquerque, dealing 5.0 scoreless innings with three hits allowed, one walk permitted and eight strikeouts in the River Cats' 5-1 win...he was also very efficient, needing only 79 pitches to navigate the 5.0 innings...50 of the 79 pitches were strikes.

**LAST MAJOR LEAGUE OUTING:** Last pitched for the Giants in a spot start just before the All-Star break on July 9 vs. the Rockies...he picked up his second win in as many MLB starts this year with 5.2 innings of two-run ball while working around four walks.

**SMALL SAMPLE SIZE ALERT:** In his two outing with SF he's was thrown his changeup an average of 83.3 mph, about 2.2 mph faster than he threw it in his five MLB starts last year...he was also throwing all his pitches from a slightly higher arm angle than he did a year ago...this year's offerings have come at a 51 degree angle, three degrees higher than last year (48 degrees)...lastly, in the two starts he's used his slider 23.3% of the time in his two MLB starts, over 9% higher than its usage rate w/SF a season ago (14.0%).

**VS. LOS ANGELES-AL:** This will be his first career start vs. the Angels at the Major League level but he's worked against their affiliate in Triple-A Salt Lake...IF Denzer Guzman is 1-for-7 vs. Whisenhunt with the one hit being a homer, José Siri is 1-for-6 with a triple, Vaughn Grissom is 1-for-2 while Wade Meckler is 0-for-1 with a walk.

**WITH THE RIVER CATS:** Whisenhunt is 6-4 with a 4.15 ERA (38er, 82.1ip), 90 strikeouts and a 1.42 WHIP in 17 games (16 starts) for Triple-A Sacramento this season...he was the PCL Pitcher of the Month for May, going 2-0 with a 2.81 ERA (10er, 32.0ip), 32 strikeouts and a 1.22 WHIP in six starts.

**4S UP:** Whisenhunt threw his four-seam fastball the most of any of his four pitches last season (47.8%)...opponents hit .209 (9x43) with eight strikeouts against the pitch...in his two MLB starts this season he's used his four-seamer 40.1% of the time with opposing hitters going 5-for-12 in ABs that end with the pitch.

**CHANGING THINGS UP:** Whisenhunt's most-used offspeed pitch last season was his changeup (37.3%)...the pitch, which has long been rated as one of the better pitches in the minor leagues, had a .286 opposing batting average in the Majors in 2025 (10x35) with six strikeouts and a 37.8% whiff rate...in his two MLB starts this year batters have gone 3-for-19 with two singles and a homer in his two starts...three of the six strikeouts he's gotten w/SF have come on the change.

**LAST SEASON (AT TRIPLE-A):** Had a decorated season in the minors in 2025...in Triple-A, Whisenhunt finished inside the PCL's top-15 in wins (9, T-3rd), strikeouts (95, 11th), starts (21, 13th) and innings pitched (107.2, 13th)...he was named a Triple-A PCL All-Star as well as the league's Pitcher of the Year.

**LAST SEASON (IN THE MAJORS):** He made five starts for SF, going 2-1 with a 5.01 ERA (13er, 23.1ip), 16 strikeouts and a 1.46 WHIP...earned his first career MLB win on August 3 at the Mets...allowed two runs (one earned) while striking out four in 5.1 innings.
