HISTORIC DAY AT TARGET FIELD: The Twins beat the Astros yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 9-3. Joe Ryan (6-5) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 5.2 innings pitched...

KLING, HIGGINS, DROPO...AND MIRANDA: Yesterday, Jose Miranda reached safely in each of his first three plate appearances, extending his on base streak to 13 consecutive plate appearances...

MIRANDA 1B 2B 1B 2B 1B 2B 1B HR 2B 1B HBP 1B 1B FO. Counting the hit-by-pitch yesterday and going off strictly plate appearances (not at-bats), Miranda's reaching base streak (via hit, walk or hit-by-pitch) was the longest since Kevin Youkilis in 2009.

IT'S THAT DANG JOSE, HE'S SO HOT RIGHT NOW: Jose Miranda is hitting .376 (50-for-133) with 13 doubles, one triple, five home runs, 31 RBI, a .419 on-base percentage, a .602 slugging percentage and a 1.020 OPS in his last 38 games, since May 24...

24/7 - ALL DAY, EVERY DAY: The Twins have homered in a club record 24-straight games, since June 10...during the streak, 12 different Twins have homered...the streak is the longest of 2024...

C4-EVER MINNESOTA: Since joining the Twins from the Astros in 2022, Carlos Correa has played in 341 games for Minnesota, hitting .270 (350-for-1298) with 69 doubles, five triples, 51 home runs, 174 RBI, 178 runs scored, 149 walks and a .795 OPS...

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALLNER: The Twins have placed utility player Austin Martin on the 10-day Injured List with a right oblique strain...Martin has played in 47 games for Minnesota, hitting .265 (30-for-113) with nine doubles, one home run, nine RBI, 27 runs scored, 11 walks, six stolen bases (8 chances), a .331 on-base percentage and a .702 OPS...

SHOOTING STARS: The Twins have gone 3-2 against the Astros this season, going 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2 and 1-1 this weekend...a win today and the Twins will win the season series for the second-straight season (4-2 in 2023) and fourth time in their last five tries...

RECORD BOOKS: Twins No. 2 prospect Brooks Lee made his major league debut on Wednesday night and has gone 7-for-15 with one walk, one double, one home run and six RBI in four games to begin his major league career...the last Twin to begin their career by hitting in each of their first five was Miguel Sanó, who hit safely in his first seven from July 2-8, 2015...

HAPPY 28th, BOYS: Twins radio stallion Dan Gladden and Bally Sports North stud Cory Provus are both celebrating their birthday today...the Twins are 21-38 all-time on their birthday, tied for third-fewest wins of any day in July...

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

- LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched July 2 vs. Detroit, opposite Tarik Skubal, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-3 win...allowed three runs on four hits (2 HR) in 5.2 innings, with two walks and four strikeouts...allowed just two baserunners (1 H, 1 BB) through 4.0 innings...in the fifth, Justyn-Henry Malloy hit a solo home run and Ryan Kreidler added a two-run shot...was pulled after a sixth-inning two-out walk; Jorge Alcalá entered and stranded the runner.
- ⚔ Induced nine whiffs on 41 swings (22.0%)...ranks in MLB's 23rd percentile with a 21.7 percent whiff rate this season.
 - ⚔ Allowed five hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph); Detroit went 3-for-5 on those swings, including Malloy's (106.4 mph) and Kreidler's (103.4 mph) home runs...ranks in MLB's 57th percentile with a 37.7 percent hard-hit rate.
 - ⚔ Minnesota is 10-4 in Woods Richardson's 14 starts this season.

- TWO STARTS AGO:** Started June 26 at Arizona, opposite Ryne Nelson, and earned the win in Minnesota's 8-3 victory...allowed three runs on four hits in 5.1 innings with two walks and four strikeouts...stranded a runner on third in the first inning...allowed an RBI triple to Lourdes Gurriel Jr. in the fourth...was pulled in the sixth with one out and runners on second and third; Josh Staumont entered and allowed both inherited runners to score.
- ⚔ Induced nine whiffs on 38 swings (23.7%).
 - ⚔ Allowed six hard-hit balls; Arizona went 1-for-6 on those swings, the only hit being Christian Walker's 105.4 mph double.

- WOODS RICHARDSON VS. HOUSTON:** Making second career start vs. Houston...faced Astros on June 2 at Minute Maid Park and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 win, allowing three runs on three hits (2 HR) in 4.1 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts.
- ⚔ Grew up in Sugar Land, TX and attended Kempner High School, less than 30 miles from Minute Maid Park and was a big Astros fan growing up, even having one of his childhood birthday parties at Minute Maid Park.

- HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Making seventh home start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.69 ERA (31.2 IP, 13 ER), 9.09 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 3.41 walks-per-9.0 innings and 0.85 home-runs-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 2-1 with a 3.38 ERA (40.0 IP, 15 ER), 6.30 K/9, 2.03 BB/9 and 1.13 HR/9 in eight road starts...has allowed a .198 (23-for-116) batting average and .597 OPS at home, compared to .245 (37-for-151) BAA and .690 OPS on the road.

- REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 14 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .185 (20-for-108) with a .259 slugging percentage, .536 OPS and 20.3 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .252 (40-for-159) with a .434 SLG, .726 OPS and 20.2 percent strikeout rate...righties have hit 16 of the 20 extra-base hits vs. Woods Richardson.
- ⚔ Average exit velocity vs. Woods Richardson: 87.0 mph by lefties, 90.4 mph by righties.
 - ⚔ Hard-hit percentage vs. Woods Richardson: 35.7 percent by lefties, 39.7 percent by righties.
 - ⚔ Among right handed pitchers, Woods Richardson has allowed the fourth-lowest slugging percentage (.259) and fifth-lowest OPS (.536) to left-handed hitters (min. 100 LHB faced).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix this season...here's his 2024 repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚔ On July 2, Detroit went 1-for-6 with three strikeouts, an 82.8 mph average exit velocity and four whiffs on 13 swings vs. Woods Richardson's 4-seamer.
- ⚔ In his last seven starts since May 28, opponents have hit .191 (9-for-47) and slugged .255 vs. his 4-seamer... in his first seven starts, the pitch allowed a .296 (16-for-54) batting average and .333 slugging percentage.
- ⚔ Ranks in MLB's 89th percentile with a breaking ball run value of 5, 86th percentile with a fastball run value of 7.
- ⚔ Opponents have gone 3-for-5 with a triple and a home run vs. Woods Richardson's first-pitch curveballs, which he throws 14.8 percent of the time.

CAREER NOTES

- Entered 2024 ranked by *Baseball America* as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
- In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
- Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
- In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
- Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
- Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by *Baseball America*.
- Posted a 2.72 ERA with 38 walks, 118 strikeouts and a .199 opponents batting average across three levels in 2022.
- Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
- Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
- With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
- While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for José Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
- Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
- In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
- Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
- In 2019, posted 4.25 ERA in 20 starts for Low-A Columbia before being dealt to Toronto in trade that sent Marcus Stroman to the Mets.
- Finished 2018 season with Rookie-Kingsport, allowing three runs on six hits with 11 strikeouts in two appearances.
- Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
- Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
