BIRDLAND BITES: The Orioles fell to the Diamondbacks last evening, 4-3, setting up this afternoon's rubber match...Following tomorrow's off day, the Birds begin a nine-game, 10-day homestand featuring matchups with the Blue Jays, Guardians, and Reds.

⚾ Last night, the O's played in their first game of the season decided by one run...Entering play today, only Baltimore and Minnesota have played in one contest decided by a single run in 2025...Baltimore's 32 one-run contests in 2024 were second fewest in MLB behind Boston (31), going 14-18 (.438) in those games.

⚾ The Birds have registered one home run or fewer in nine straight games (2 HR overall), marking their longest run since September 20 to October 1, 2023 (11 G)...It is tied for the second-longest active run in the majors behind Toronto (12 G).

⚾ The Orioles have not recorded a save through the first 12 games of the season for the first time since 2002 (also 12 G)...The last Baltimore club open the season without a save through 13 games was the 1988 Orioles (21 G).

⚾ Baltimore has stolen multiple bases in back-to-back games for the first time since April 27-28, 2024...The O's last did so in three straight games from April 22-24, 2022 (3 G).

⚾ With a win today, the Orioles would avoid going winless in their first four series of a season for the first time since 2010.

RECENT TRANSACTIONS: Prior to today's game, the Orioles placed right-handed pitcher **Zach Eflin** (right lat strain) on the 15-day Injured List (retroactive 4/8) and recalled right-handed pitcher **Colin Selby** from Triple-A Norfolk...Selby, 27, tossed 3.1 scoreless innings over three appearances with the Tides to open the season, scattering one hit and one walk while striking out five.

ALL ABOUT ADLEY: **Adley Rutschman** has reached base safely in each of his first 11 games, the longest season-opening streak by an Oriole since **Anthony Santander** (18 G) from April 8-27, 2022...**Aaron Hicks** reached base safely in each of his first 12 games from May 31 to June 14, 2023, but did not sign with the club until May 30 that season.

⚾ His 11-game on-base streak is tied with BOS' Kristian Campbell for the third-longest active run in the AL behind TOR's Vladimir Guerrero Jr. and ATH's Jacob Wilson (both 12 G).

⚾ Rutschman has gone a career-high-tying 18 straight games with one strikeout or fewer since September 21, 2024, matching his previous mark from July 23 to August 12, 2022...It is tied for the second-longest active streak by an Oriole, trailing **Ramón Urías** (31 G, 8/16/24-4/7/25).

'PEN PALS: Baltimore relievers have tossed 11.2 scoreless innings across the last four games, limiting opponents to a .061 average (2-for-33).

⚾ **Bryan Baker** has tossed 6.0 scoreless innings to open the season, scattering three hits with no walks and seven strikeouts across six appearances.

⚾ **Gregory Soto** has thrown 5.0 scoreless innings over his first five appearances, allowing three hits, two walks, and one hit batter while fanning eight...In 25 appearances since August 8, 2024, Soto is 1-0 with a 0.84 ERA (2 ER/21.1 IP), 0.94 WHIP, and 28 strikeouts.

⚾ **Seranthony Domínguez** is 1-0 with two holds, tossing 5.2 scoreless innings across six appearances while allowing one hit and six walks against seven strikeouts.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore is an MLB-best 103-68 (.602) on the road since 2023, ahead of Houston (96-70, .578) and Los Angeles-NL (96-73, .568).

⚾ **Dean Kremer** has allowed only seven home runs in 99.2 innings across his last 19 road starts since July 24, 2023...His 0.63 HR/9.0 IP during that stretch is sixth lowest among all MLB starters on the road during that period (min. 90.0 IP).

⚾ **Cedric Mullins** has reached base safely in a career-high-tying 12 straight road games (also 9/24/20-4/17/21) since September 25, 2024, going 16-for-43 (.372) with three doubles, two home runs, and nine RBI in that time.

⚾ **Ryan O'Hearn** has reached base safely in 10 straight road games since September 27, 2024, batting .400 (14-for-35) with three doubles, three homers, and five RBI in this span.

ALL RISP, NO REWARD: In five wins, Baltimore hitters are 19-for-55 (.345) with two doubles, one triple, and two home runs with runners in scoring position, compared to 4-for-30 (.133) with zero extra-base hits in seven losses.

⚾ O's pitching has limited the opposition to a .192 (20-for-104) RISP average, the fifth-lowest mark in the majors behind the Mets (.171), Phillies (.176), Dodgers (.185) and Astros (.188)...This includes a .125 (4-for-32) clip over the last four contests.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: The O's have grounded into an MLB-leading 14 doubles plays, ahead of the Athletics (13) and Mets (10)...The 14 double plays are the most through 12 games by a Baltimore club since the 2015 Orioles (16 GIDP).

⚾ The Birds have grounded into at least one double play in nine straight games, their longest streak since August 27 to September 6, 2019 (10 G).

⚾ In 2024, Baltimore's 71 double plays set a record for the fewest in a full season (min. 154 G) in MLB history.

POWER OUTAGE: After hitting 10 home runs in the first three games of the season, Baltimore has registered two long balls over its last nine contests since March 30, the fewest in the majors during that stretch with the next closest clubs being the Blue Jays, Braves, Royals (all 4 HR).

⚾ The Birds have 21 extra-base hits (9-2B, 2-3B, 10 HR) and a .974 OPS in five wins, compared to 10 extra-base hits (7-2B, 1-3B, 2 HR) and a .498 OPS in seven losses.

HOT AND COLD: The Orioles are batting .302 (55-for-182) from innings 1-4, the second-best mark in the majors behind only the Cardinals (.324)...From the fifth inning on, however, the Birds are hitting .206 (44-for-214), the sixth-lowest clip in the majors.

THE VALLEY: The Orioles and D-Backs complete their three-game season series this afternoon at Chase Field...The O's won the 2024 season set, 2-1, taking the first two games before dropping the series finale in Baltimore...Since 2016, the Birds have gone 3-1 in their last four series against Arizona, including a three-game sweep at Oriole Park in 2016...The O's have compiled a 9-5 record against the D-Backs during this stretch.

⚾ **Ryan O'Hearn** has hit safely in nine of 10 career games opposite Arizona, including an active eight-game hitting streak, batting .355 (11-for-31) with three doubles, one home run, and 7 RBI during that run.

QUICK HITS: Set to make his third start of the 2025 campaign...Was dealt the loss in his last outing on April 4 against Kansas City...Was his first loss on the road since August 8, 2024 at Toronto...Made five Grapefruit League appearances (3 GS), going 0-2 with a 7.27 ERA (14 ER/17.1 IP) on 21 hits (6 HR) and nine while striking out nine batters...In his final appearance on 3/23 at Atlanta, tossed 5.1 relief innings, allowing two runs on four hits and one walk with 10 strikeouts...Made 24 starts in 2024, going 8-10 with a 4.10 ERA (59 ER/129.2IP) on 110 hits (18 HR), 72 total runs, 51 walks, and three hit batters while striking out 123 hitters...Was on the 15-day Injured List (right triceps strain) from 5/24 (retroactive 5/21)-7/3.

MAKING HISS-TORY: Kremer has made one career start against the Diamondbacks... Was handed the loss after allowing six total runs (three earned runs) on four hits (1 HR)with four walks and a career-high 10 strikeouts across 5.2 innings...Became the second pitcher in franchise history to strike out 10 or more batters against Arizona, joining Wade Miley, who struck out 11 Diamondbacks hitters on September 24, 2016. In seven career starts against NL West foes, owns a 1-4 record with a 5.26 ERA (22 ER/37.2 IP), a 1.38 WHIP along with 38 strikeouts against 14 walks...Was originally drafted by the Los Angeles Dodgers in the 14th round (431st overall) of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft.

QUALITY AND QUANTITY: Kremer has recorded 31 quality starts since the beginning of the 2022 season, leading all Orioles starters during that time frame...Last season, Orioles starters recorded 68 quality starts, tied with the Blue Jays for the sixth most in MLB.

STRONG FINISH: In his final eight starts of the 2024 season dating to August 14, Kremer went 4-1 with a 2.98 ERA (15 ER/45.1 IP) on 37 hits (3 HR), 17 total runs, 15 walks, and one hit batter with 42 strikeouts. During that stretch, he limited left-handed batters to a .205/.283/.313 (17-for-83) line with 23 strikeouts.

FOUR IS NOT MORE: Last season, Kremer posted a 2.75 ERA (22 ER/72.0 IP) on 52 hits (6 HR), 29 total runs, 25 walks, and two hit batters with 65 strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP from innings one through three...In the fourth inning, however, he owned an 8.87 ERA (23 ER/23.1 IP) on 31 hits (6 HR), 26 total runs, nine walks, and one hit batter with 24 strikeouts and a 1.71 WHIP. Opponents slashed .170/.245/.258 (33-for-194) with four home runs against him the first time through the lineup, compared to .271/.336/.432 (52-for-192) with seven home runs the second time around.

THE RUN AROUND: His 13 unearned runs allowed in 2024 were tied with teammate Corbin Burnes and Boston's Tanner Houck for the AL lead and tied four fourth most in the majors behind Washington's MacKenzie Gore (21) and San Diego's Michael King/ St. Louis' Lance Lynn (both 14).

BANANA SPLIT: He utilized his splitter 18.5 percent of the time last season, holding opponents to a .139 (14-for-101) average...his 36.0 percent whiff rate on the offering was the highest of any of his pitches, while his 34 strikeouts were his second most behind his four-seam fastball (45 K).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Kremer went 5-5 with a 3.78 ERA (29 ER/69.0 IP) on 50 hits (6 HR), 31 total runs, and 28 walks with 65 strikeouts across 13 road starts in 2024. His .196 (50-for-255) opponent batting average on the road was fifth lowest in the AL and seventh lowest in MLB (min. 65.0 IP). Did not walk a batter on April 4 at Arizona, snapping a streak of walking at least one batter in a career-high 13 straight road starts since April 19, 2024
