TODAY'S GAME: SF hosts the Mets for the second game of this three-game series after taking the opener last night, 5-2...a victory today would give the Giants a series win.

- ▶ The win moved the Giants to 3-2 on their current 10-game homestand after going 2-2 vs. Arizona over the weekend.
- ▶ San Francisco is 6-5 through its first 11 home games this year, averaging 3.5 runs/game (38 runs in those 11 games) in the early going...last season, SF averaged 3.8 runs/game and went 45-36 by the bay.

ROSTER MOVES: The Giants made the following roster moves prior to tonight's game:

- ▶ **RHP Mitch White** (#54) was added to the active roster today after being acquired from Toronto for cash considerations on Saturday night.
- ▶ **RHP Landen Roupp** was optioned to Triple-A Sacramento postgame yesterday.

CAKE POP?: Giants Director of Video Coaching **Fernando Pérez** celebrates a birthday today.

EVEN STEVENS: The Giants last hosted the Mets exactly a year ago, splitting a four-game series on April 20-23...in fact, SF has won or tied its last four home series against the Mets dating to 2019...the stretch is SF's longest such streak in the matchup since they won or tied their first five series here at Oracle Park between 2000 and 2005 (*Stats, LLC*).

- ▶ Since Oracle Park opened in 2000, SF is 43-35 vs. New York-NL on the shores of McCovey Cove.
- ▶ The Giants have gone 77-76 overall against the Mets since 2000 with a -4 run differential.

JHL DELIVERS: OF Jung Hoo Lee has reached base in each of his last 13 games and hit safely in 12 of those after going 1x3 with a walk last night...he's slashing .340/.397/.453 with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, four walks, two steals and 11 runs in that stretch (since April 7).

- ▶ Lee leads all Giants with 25 hits this season...the last Giants rookie to lead the team in hits in a season was **Robby Thompson** in 1986 (149).
- ▶ His 25 hits are second-most among MLB rookies behind SD's Jackson Merrill (26).

WADE'S WORLD: IF/OF LaMonte Wade Jr. remains one of MLB's best on-base machines in 2024.

- ▶ Wade has reached base in 18 of 22 games where he's had an at-bat this season, and is slashing .358/.453/.472 with 10 runs, three doubles, a home run and six RBI.
- ▶ His .358 batting average is fourth in MLB and his .453 OBP is third-best in the Majors (min. 60 PA).

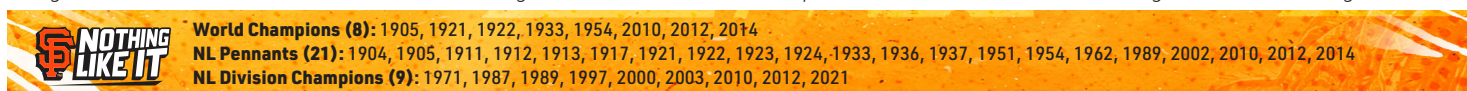
DOWN THE ROAD...: So far this season, the Mets and Giants have been two different offensive clubs when playing at home vs. on the road, as demonstrated in the chart below.

ON THE WEBB: RHP Logan Webb takes the bump tonight for San Francisco making his sixth start of the campaign...Webb has gone 7.0 innings in each of his last three starts while giving up a combined three runs in that time (1.29 ERA)...SF has won each of those three games.

- ▶ Since 2022, Webb has worked 439.0 innings (most in the Majors) over 70 starts (which are tied for second-most in the Majors in that span behind STL's Miles Mikolas' 72 starts).
- ▶ Additionally, Webb owns a 2.15 ERA (30er, 125.2ip) in his 18 starts here at home since the start of last year...the 2.15 home ERA is lowest in the Majors among starters with 80.0 innings pitched at home in that time.
- ▶ In three career starts against the Amazins here at Oracle Park, Webb is 2-0 with a 2.79 ERA (6er, 19.1ip) with 22 strikeouts to just three walks...SF has gone 3-0 in Webb's three career starts versus New York-NL at Oracle Park.

GROUND CHUCK: Entering play today, Giants pitching has a 49.4% groundball rate, second-best in the Majors behind the Philadelphia Phillies at 51.3%.

- ▶ SF's groundball rate is quite consistent with last year's 49.6% rate that led the Majors in 2023.
- ▶ After last night's outing, **RHP Keaton Winn** boasts a 59.5% groundball rate good for second-best in the Majors behind Philly's Ranger Suárez (61.3%)...if you look at the top-5, you'll see a lot of Orange & Black.

JOLLY OL' SAINT NICK: IF Nick Ahmed is slashing .357/.386/.452 with two doubles, one triple, five RBI and four runs scored in his last 13 games dating to April 8.

- ▶ Defensively he's been worth +4 DRS so far in '24...as a team in 2023 the Giants were -21 DRS at the shortstop position.

NOT A LOT OF CLIFFS NOTES: Not many Giants have faced tonight's opposing starter Luis Severino since he broke into the league back in 2015.

- ▶ **IF Matt Chapman** has the most experience against him from his time in the American League but he's 1-for-13 with four strikeouts against him in 15 PAs.
- ▶ Other than that only **OF Michael Conforto** (0x8, 4k), **IF Wilmer Flores** (0x4, 3k) and **DH/OF Jorge Soler** (1x3) have faced the 30-year old righty.

WEBB GEMS: SF's Opening Day starter is in his sixth season with the Giants and made his fifth Opening Day roster here in 2024...SF's ace signed a contract extension last April that keeps him in a Giants uniform through the 2028 season.

LAST TIME OUT: Continued his recent run of success last time out with 7.0 shutout innings against the D-Backs on Thursday night in the Giants' 5-0 win...allowed two hits, walked one and struck out five in his 102-pitch effort...according to *Sports Info Solutions* Webb got 10 outs and allowed no hits on his fastball and slider...he got another 10 outs with the changeup even though both of the hits he allowed came off the pitch.

LAST THREE: Has worked 7.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his last three starts entering today's outing...he owns a 1.29 ERA (3er, 21.0ip) in that time with 18 hits allowed, two walks and 12 strikeouts...SF has won each of those three starts...entering today's outing with the Mets, Webb has not allowed a run in his last 11.0 innings pitched dating to his April 13 start at Tampa Bay.

EL CAMBIO: Webb dominated hitters last year with his changeup, using the pitch 41.6% of the time with opponents hitting .225 with a .309 SLG% off the pitch...according to *Statcast*, Webb's changeup was the second-most valuable pitch in the Majors in terms of run value at +28...only the Yankees Gerrit Cole had a more valuable pitch (+29 with his four-seam fastball) (*run value is defined as the run impact on an event based on the runners on base, outs ball & strike count*)...in the early going in 2024, it has not been as dominant a pitch as it was a season ago but it is improving...through four starts, opposing hitters are batting .306 with a .371 SLG% off his changeup...as mentioned above it was much improved last time out vs. Arizona with the D-Backs going 2-for-12 off the pitch.

VS. NEW YORK-NL: Is facing the Mets for the fifth time in his career and fourth time here at Oracle Park...in his three previous starts vs. the Mets here at Oracle Webb has a 2.79 ERA (6er, 19.1ip) and the Giants have won each of his three career starts against the Mets here.

SUP, HOMIE?: Webb is 25-16 with a 2.70 ERA (101er, 337.0ip) in 55 career starts at home here at Oracle Park...SF has won six of his last eight starts here dating back to August 2 of last year with Webb logging a 2.09 ERA (13er, 56.0ip) in that span...Webb has a long way to go to catch some recent Giants legends in terms of starts here at Oracle but his 2.70 ERA so far stacks up with some of the best hurlers to pitch in this ballpark..

BAND TOGETHER: The Giants as a team are 58-39 (.600) in Webb's 96 regular season starts since 2021...SF went 15-18 in his 33 starts in 2023 and gave him two or fewer runs of support in 22 of those 33 starts (66.7%)...Webb had the lowest run support average of any qualified starter in baseball last year (3.21)...Webb went 9-1 in 2023 when receiving at least three runs of support...SF is 3-2 in his five starts so far this year and Webb has received two or fewer runs of support in three of his five outings.

0-1 IS MUCH BETTER THAN 1-0: Webb's first pitch strike percentage is 69.9% through five starts in 2024...last time out vs. Arizona, Webb's first pitch strike percentage was 60.9%, his second-lowest in an outing this season (was 60.0% in his April 2 outing at the Dodgers).

BOOTS ON THE GROUND: Webb's 62.7% ground-ball rate led the Majors in 2023, and was up from 2022's 57.8% mark...his 62.7% mark last season also established a career-best, slightly upping his 62.2% total from his breakout 2021 campaign...through four starts this year he owns a 56.4% ground ball rate...below is a chart of Webb's groundball breakdown by start so far in 2024, with his last start being his most groundball heavy - 14-of-17 (82.4%) balls in play were on the ground.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 4/22 vs. NYM; 1.0ip, h, r, er, 2bb (27 pitches)

- ▶ Since allowing two runs in 0.2 innings in his first appearance of the year on March 30 at SD in a non-save situation (SF won 9-6), Doval has made six appearances and gone 1-0-3 with three hits allowed, one run allowed, three walks, and 11 strikeouts (6.1ip).
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season after posting a 2.63 ERA and converting 26 of his 28 save chances in 41 first half games...was the winning pitcher for the NL team after working a scoreless 7th inning.
- ▶ Wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).
- ▶ The 39 SVs were also most by a Giant since **Brian Wilson** (48 in '10).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/21 vs. ARI; 2.0ip, h (21 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment with Triple-A Sacramento and reinstated from the 15-day IL on Friday...made season debut Sunday, tossing 2.0 shutout innings...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Made five rehab appearances between San Jose (A) and Sacramento (AAA)...threw 5.1 innings and allowed two runs on five hits with seven strikeouts...threw 4.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts while on his rehab stint with Sacramento (three games).
- ▶ Made 15 appearances for SF at the Major League level last year, posting a 6.52 ERA...had a really nice end to the '23 season with SF, working 7.0 scoreless innings with six strikeouts over the season's final 10 days.
- ▶ 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP John Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 4/20 vs. MOD (w/A San Jose); 1.0ip (8 pitches)

- ▶ Returned from his rehab assignment and reinstated from the 15-day IL yesterday...veteran reliever suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Was placed on the IL the next day...made two rehab appearances for Single-A San Jose totalling 2.0 innings last Thurs. and Sat.
- ▶ Made his fourth Opening Day roster, first with SF...the previous three came with Atlanta (2019-2021).
- ▶ Appeared in 33 games for SF in 2023 and posted a 2.97 ERA with 43 strikeouts over 33.1 innings of work (11.61 SO/9).
- ▶ Made his Giants debut on May 31 after he missed the entire 2022 season recovering from TJ surgery.
- ▶ Held right-handed hitters to a .182 average in 2023, compared to a .263 average against lefties.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 4/21 vs. ARI; L, 1.0ip, 2h, 2r, er, k (22 pitches)

- ▶ Over his last eight outings dating to April 3, Miller has allowed three runs (two earned) over 8.1 innings (2.16 ERA) with 13 strikeouts, one walk, a 0.48 WHIP and a .107 opposing batting average (3x28).
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-15 off him early on...RHBs are 3-for-23.
- ▶ Has appeared in 11 games for SF, allowing eight runs (seven earned) in 11.0ip.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
