TODAY'S GAME: The Giants enter today having lost the series to the Phillies after last night's 5-4 defeat on Sunday Night Baseball and seek a victory in today's finale with the Phils to avoid a four-game sweep.

- ▶ SF is 1-5 through the first six games of its longest road trip of the season after going 1-2 in Boston and 0-3 so far here in South Philly.
- ▶ With yesterday's defeat the Giants are a season-worst five games under the .500 mark at 15-20 as they enter play today.
- ▶ SF is trying to avoid being swept in a four-game set here at Citizens Bank park for the first time May 7-10, 2018.
- ▶ The Giants are 9-5 in the day games while they are 6-15 in night games..SF has a .748 OPS and are averaging 4.7 runs/game during the day...at night they own a .628 OPS and are averaging 3.1 runs/game.

ROSTER MOVES: RHP Mason Black (#47) had his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento.

- ▶ RHP Daulton Jefferies was designated for assignment to make room on the roster for Black.

SAY HEY...HAPPY BIRTHDAY!: Hall of Famer Willie Mays celebrates his 93rd birthday today...Mays homered three times on his birthday during his playing career (his 23rd, 29th and 31st birthdays).

LUMBERJAK: C Jakson Reetz made quite the first impression yesterday, hitting his first career Major League homer in the ninth inning to make it a one-run game.

- ▶ It was Reetz's first plate appearance as a Giant after entering the game as a defensive replacement...the last player prior to Reetz to homer in his first Giants plate appearance was IF Alen Hanson on April 28, 2018 in the first game of a doubleheader against the Dodgers.

BEARS, BEETS, BATTLESTAR GALACTICA: Scranton, PA area native RHP Mason Black will make his Major League debut today in the ballpark he grew up going to as a child.

- ▶ The 24-year-old was the Giants third-round pick in the 2021 draft out of Lehigh University, which is roughly 60 miles north of Citizens Bank Park in Bethlehem, PA...Black attended Valley View High School in Archibald, PA, 20 minutes northeast of Scranton and roughly 140 miles from CBP.
- ▶ He enters today's outing as SF's seventh-best prospect according to MLB.com...in six starts for Triple-A Sacramento this year Black was 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA (3er, 26.2ip) with 29 strikeouts.
- ▶ Black will be the second Giants prospect in as many years to make his MLB debut here at CBP against the Phils...LHP Kyle Harrison made his debut here last year on August 22 (3.1ip, 5h, 2r, 2er, bb, 5k).

MIKEY'S PIGGY BANK: OF Michael Conforto owns a career .892 OPS with 21 doubles, one triple, 23 homers and 74 RBI against the Phillies (103 games), most of that coming in his time with the New York Mets.

- ▶ Conforto's 74 career RBI vs. the Phillies are third-most among active players behind Freddie Freeman (130) and Marcell Ozuna (77).
- ▶ In this ballpark, Conforto has a .285/.356/.565 slash line (.921 OPS) with 13 doubles and 15 homers...his 15 homers here are the most he's hit at any stadium outside of Citi Field (66), his home ballpark with the Mets from 2015-2021.

THAIRO TIME: IF Thairo Estrada launched his fifth homer of the year yesterday and is now tied for the team lead with OF Michael Conforto and DH/OF Jorge Soler...he's 6-for-12 in this series with a double, homer, five RBI and two runs scored.

- ▶ Estrada has hit safely in each of his last 11 games against the Phillies dating to September 2, 2022...in that time he's slashed .413/.462/.565 with two doubles, one triple, one homer, nine RBI, seven runs scored and three walks.
- ▶ All told, Estrada has hit safely in 13 of his 14 career games against the Phillies overall, batting .407 (22x54).
- ▶ In eight games at CBP, Estrada is 14-for-30 (.467) with a homer and seven RBI.

LOOKING FOR LENGTH: Giants starters logged at least 6.0 innings in five of six games from April 22-28 with the lone exception being an opener going 1.0 inning...in six games on this trip, no Giants starter has finished 6.0 innings.

- ▶ When the Giants get at least 6.0 innings from their starter this year they are 12-4.
- ▶ The only starter on this trip to complete even 5.0 innings was LHP Kyle Harrison, who did so in last Thursday's finale in Boston.
- ▶ SF's rotation has a 7.85 ERA (16er, 18.1ip) on this six-game trips o far.

YEAH HAR, WE'RE (ALMOST) IN THE ROCKIES: Following today's game SF will reach the final stop on this 10-game roadie as they'll play three games in Denver starting tomorrow.

- ▶ Since 2021 the Giants are 18-8 vs. the Rockies at Coors Field with a +51 run differential...however, SF went 4-3 against the Rockies in Denver in 2023, losing three of four games in their last series there in mid September.
- ▶ In 51 games against the Rockies overall since 2021 the Giants are 38-13 with a +113 run differential.

WITH THE GIANTS: Black will be making his MLB debut after having his contract selected from Triple-A Sacramento today...has spent parts of four seasons in the system after being taken in the third round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of Lehigh University (Bethlehem, PA)...Black will be the seventh Giant, and sixth Giants pitcher, to make his Major League debut this season.

OPPORTUNITY CALLS: Black looked to be a favorite to win a rotation spot out of Spring Training prior to the signing of **LHP Blake Snell**...Black forced his way into the big leagues with a strong start in Triple-A, going 2-1 with a 1.01 ERA (3er, 26.2ip), 29 strikeouts, a 0.90 WHIP and a .178 opposing batting average (16x90) over six starts...he is 12-14 with a 3.22 ERA in the Minors with 320 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .219 opposing batting average over 262.1 career innings (59 starts).

THE FUTURE IS NOW: With the prospect graduation of both **LHP Kyle Harrison** and **RHP Keaton Winn**, Black is currently the Giants' third-ranked pitching prospect, No. 7 overall, according to *MLB.com*.

VS. PHILADELPHIA: This is Black's first career game vs. his childhood favorite team...Black grew up a Phillies fan with his favorite player being Hall of Fame RHP Roy Halladay...he is from Scranton, Pennsylvania and attended Lehigh University.

LAST SEASON: He ascended to Triple-A for the first time in his three-year professional career...put forth a strong 3.86 ERA (26er, 60.2ip) in 13 starts in the hitter-friendly Pacific Coast League...posted a 1.19 ERA (4er, 30.1ip) with 42 strikeouts and seven walks over his final seven starts with Richmond...overall, he averaged 11.3 strikeouts per 9.0 innings for the season, striking out 155 batters in 123.2 innings.

REVERSE SPLITS: In 2024, lefties have a .152/.300/.303 slash line against Black, while righties have a .193/.220/.246 mark...historically, however, lefties have a .183/.297/.312 slash line against Black with 156 strikeouts and 27 extra-base hits while righties have slashed .245/.304/.386 with 164 strikeouts and 41 extra-base hits.

Pitch Arsenal: Slider, Cutter, Sinker

Last Game: 5/2 at BOS; S, 1.0ip, k (14 pitches)

- ▶ Has pitched once in the last seven days after throwing in three straight from April 26-28.
- ▶ Is 2-0 with a 1.64 ERA and 6-for-6 in save opportunities over his last 11 outings.
- ▶ Has struck out 15 batters over 11.2 innings of work (11.6 SO/9.0).
- ▶ 12 of his 15 strikeouts this year have come with his slider.
- ▶ Righties are just 2-for-19 (.105) off him, while lefties are 7-for-25.
- ▶ Earned his first career All-Star selection last season and wrapped up the 2023 season with 39 saves, tied for the most in the NL and second-most in MLB behind CLE's Emmanuel Clase (44).

#64 SEAN HJELLE ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/5 at PHI; 2.0ip, 2h, 6k (30 pitches)

- ▶ Has worked 4.0 scoreless innings in this series and struck out 10... the last time a Giants reliever had 10+ strikeouts in any series (since 1969) was **RHP Tom Griffin** from Aug. 14-17, 1980 vs. ATL.
- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 19...missed SF's first 21 games with a right elbow strain he suffered early in spring.
- ▶ Four of his five outings with SF have been scoreless.
- ▶ The 6'11" right-hander is tied for the tallest pitcher in MLB history with RHP Jon Rauch.

#77 LUKE JACKSON ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Curveball

Last Game: 5/4 at PHI; 0.2ip, h, k (13 pitches)

- ▶ Reinstated from the 15-day IL on April 22...he suffered a low back strain on Opening Day against the Padres back on March 28.
- ▶ Has made four appearances since being reinstated (5.0ip, 6h, 0r, bb, 3k).
- ▶ Batters are 8-for-21 (.381) with two walks and three strikeouts vs. Jackson in his six appearances at the MLB level this year.
- ▶ Allowed all four of his inherited runners to score so far in 2024.

#68 ERIK MILLER ▶ LHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Changeup, Slider

Last Game: 5/4 at PHI; 1.0ip, h, r, er, 2bb, k, hr (19 pitches)

- ▶ Has held opponents scoreless in nine of his last 11 outings, while striking out 15 batters and posting a 0.82 WHIP.
- ▶ LHBs are 2-for-19 off him and RHBs are 5-for-34 with 2 HRs.
- ▶ The southpaw made his debut on Opening Day.
- ▶ Is ranked the Giants No. 27 prospect according to *MLB.com*.
- ▶ Made 48 appearances in Triple-A last year and converted 14-of-17 save opportunities while striking out 73 batters (12.63 K/9ip).

#73 RANDY RODRÍGUEZ ▶ RHP

Pitch Arsenal: Four-Seam FB, Slider, Changeup

Last Game: 5/4 at PHI; 2.1ip, 2h, 4r, 1er, 2bb, 2k (48 pitches)

- ▶ Recalled from Triple-A Sacramento Thursday and made his MLB debut on Saturday...struck out Bryce Harper for his first career strikeout.
- ▶ Is SF's 28th-best prospect according to *MLB.com*.
