COLORADO ROCKIES (16-26) vs. PITTSBURGH PIRATES (23-19)

May 13, 2026 - PNC Park - Pittsburgh, PA - 6:40 EDT - Game #43/Home #22

LHP Jose Quintana (1-2, 3.90 ERA) vs. RHP Mitch Keller (4-1, 2.87 ERA)

THE PIRATES: began this six-game homestand vs. Colorado (Tuesday-Thursday) and Philadelphia (Friday-Sunday) with a 3-1 victory over the Rockies on Tuesday night... Went 3-3 on their recent seven-day road trip to Arizona (2-1, May 5-7) and San Francisco (1-2, Friday-Sunday)...Have recorded the best stolen base percentage (88.4, 38-for-43) in all of Major League Baseball...Have posted the sixth-best run differential (+33) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Atlanta (+90), New York-AL (+76), Los Angeles-NL (+59), Milwaukee (+56) and Chicago-NL (+44)...Have the fourth-best starting rotation ERA (3.30) in all of Major League Baseball, behind only Atlanta (3.06), New York-AL (3.07) & Tampa Bay (3.07).

ROCK YOUR WORLD: Pittsburgh won four of six games against Colorado last season (the Rockies won two of three games from August 1-3 at Coors Field, while the Pirates swept a three-game series from August 22-24 at PNC Park)...Pittsburgh is 44-26 (.629) against Colorado since the beginning of the 2014 campaign and has won or split 10 of 11 season series during that time.

GOING STREAKING: The Pirates have won five consecutive games vs. the Rockies, a streak that began last year on August 3 in Denver...It is Pittsburgh's sixth winning streak of at least five games vs. Colorado in series history (since 1993)...That also happened from September 4, 1996-July 31, 1997 (six), August 25, 1999-May 26, 2000 (six), Sept. 21, 2015-May 20, 2016 (eight), May 23, 2019-May 29 (G2), 2021 (seven) & July 17, 2022-May 8, 2023 (five).

INDISPENCEABLE: Spencer Horwitz went 2-for-3 with a walk on Tuesday vs. Colorado...He is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with four doubles, a triple, nine RBI, eight walks and a 1.007 OPS in nine games during the month of May...His .393 on-base percentage this year ranks fifth among National League hitters.

CRUZ CONTROL: Oneil Cruz was 3-for-4 with two doubles and two runs on Tuesday vs. Colorado...It was his fourth career multi-double game, along with May 21, 2024 vs. San Francisco, July 19, 2024 vs. Philadelphia and last year on July 22 vs. Detroit...Cruz' 64 total bases out of the leadoff spot are tied with Los Angeles (NL)'s Shohei Ohtani for the sixth-most in Major League Baseball, behind Washington's James Wood (86), Minnesota's Byron Buxton (83), Kansas City's Maikel Garcia (67), St. Louis' JJ Wetherholt (67) and Los Angeles (AL)'s Zach Neto (66)...He is batting .295 (13-for-44) with five stolen bases and 10 runs scored in his 10 games so far this month.

WHAT TO WATCH FOR: Marcell Ozuna is 12-for-29 (.414) with two doubles, a home run and seven RBI in his career against Jose Quintana...Ozuna is hitting at a .389 clip (7-for-18) with a double, two home runs and four RBI against left-handed pitchers since April 16 vs. Washington.

BEST OF THE BEST: Paul Skenes allowed just two hits and one hit by pitch while striking out 10 batters over 8.0 scoreless innings on Tuesday vs. Colorado, his second straight start of at least 8.0 scoreless innings with two or fewer hits allowed and zero walks issued (also May 6 at Arizona)...He joined Bob Veale (September 16-22, 1963) and Steve Blass (September 15-20, 1968) as the only Pirates pitchers in the Modern Era (since 1901) to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings and allow two or fewer hits in back-to-back starts...Skenes also became just the fourth Major League pitcher in the Modern Era to pitch 8.0 scoreless innings while allowing two or fewer hits and issuing zero walks in back-to-back starts, joining Boston (AL)'s Cy Young (September 19 [G1]-23 [G2], 1905), Chicago (AL)'s Billy Pierce (June 21-27, 1958) and San Diego's Mat Latos (May 7-13, 2010)...He has not allowed a walk in 35.0 straight innings, a streak that began in the fourth inning on April 13 vs. Washington.

ON THIS DATE IN PIRATES HISTORY

May 13, 2009: Jack Wilson collected three hits, including a go-ahead double in the fourth inning, to lead the Pirates to a 5-2 win over the Cardinals at PNC Park. Ross Ohlendorf started and improved to 4-3 after allowing one run on two hits and striking out five batters in 6.0 innings of work. Matt Capps then preserved the victory by recording the final two outs and securing his sixth save of the season.

LAST TIME OUT: Keller won a 4-2 decision after allowing two runs on four hits and two walks (he had four strikeouts) in 6.0 innings of work on May 7 at Chase Field in Arizona.

AGAINST THE ROCKIES: Keller is 3-1 with a 1.91 ERA (28.1ip/6er) in five career appearances (four starts) against Colorado...He won a 9-5 decision after allowing five runs (including a career-high-tying three home runs) over 5.0 innings last year on August 3 at Coors Field...Keller tossed his only career shutout against the Rockies on May 8, 2023 at PNC Park...He made one of two career relief appearances against Colorado on May 25, 2022 at PNC Park (he also did it on May 18, 2022 at Chicago-NL).

K IS FOR KELLER: Keller enters tonight's start vs. Colorado with the eighth-most strikeouts (872) in Pirates history...He surpassed Rick Rhoden (852) in his start on April 19 vs. Tampa Bay and Deacon Phillippe (861) during his start on April 25 at Milwaukee...He passed Dock Ellis (869) for eighth place in his start on May 7 at Arizona.

WINNING WAYS: Keller brings a three-game winning streak into tonight's start vs. Colorado (since April 19 vs. Tampa Bay)...He has posted a 2.88 ERA (25.0ip/8er), a .189 batting average against (17-for-90) and a 0.88 WHIP over four starts during the streak.

RIGHT PLACE, RIGHT TIME: Keller has limited right-handed hitters to a .123 batting average against (8-for-65) and a .320 OPS...The last extra-base hit he allowed to a righthander came last year on September 12 at Washington (a homer by Brady House).

SIX PACK: Keller pitched 6.0 innings and allowed two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts this season (March 28 at New York-NL, April 3 vs. Baltimore, April 8 vs. San Diego)...He was the first Pirate to toss at least 6.0 innings while allowing two or fewer runs in each of his first three starts of a season since Joe Musgrove (April 5-16, 2019).

CONSISTENT KELLER: Keller pitched 6.0 scoreless innings during his start on April 8 vs. San Diego, marking his second scoreless start of at least 6.0 innings through his first three starts of the 2026 campaign (also March 28 at New York-NL)...He joined Salomon Torres (2002), Zach Duke (2005), Jeff Karstens (2008), Wandy Rodriguez (2013) and Jameson Taillon (2018) as the only Pirates during the 21st century with two scoreless starts of at least 6.0 innings through their first three games of a season...Keller's 17 starts of at least 6.0 scoreless innings during his career (since 2019) are the 10th-most by a Pittsburgh pitcher in the Live Ball Era (since 1920)...Paul Skenes, who has done that in back-to-back starts, ranks tied for 12th (15 starts).

THE OPENING ACT: Keller started Pittsburgh's Home Opener for the second straight season after also doing so last season on April 4 vs. New York (AL)...Keller, who earned the win after allowing two runs in 6.0 innings on April 3 vs. Baltimore, was the first Pirates pitcher to start back-to-back Home Openers since Zach Duke in 2009 and 2010.

DAZZLING DEBUT: Keller scattered three hits without issuing a walk (had three strikeouts) over 6.0 scoreless innings, but had a no-decision in Pittsburgh's 4-2, 11-inning loss on March 28 at New York (NL)...Keller left with the game scoreless after six frames...The Pirates took a short-lived, 1-0 lead into the bottom of the 10th before the Mets tied it...Pittsburgh also added a run in the top of the 11th before New York's Luis Robert Jr. hit a walkoff, three-run home run off Hunter Barco in the bottom half...Keller joined Vance Worley (June 15, 2014 at Miami), Nick Kingham (April 29, 2018 vs. St. Louis) and Joe Musgrove (May 25, 2018 vs. St. Louis) as the only Pirates in the 21st century to toss at least 6.0 scoreless innings without allowing a walk in a season debut.
