150th Anniversary History Facts	
May 17, 1927	The Cubs defeat the Boston Braves 4-3 at Braves Field in a 22-inning marathon that lasted 4 hours and 13 minutes ... the 22-inning game is the longest in franchise history.

WHERE THE RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD: The Cubs today wrap up their nine-game, 10-day road trip (3-5) returning back to Chicago and traveling south to take on the White Sox in a three game set (1-1) ... the Cubs will play the rubber match to see who takes the series at the Rate after they dropped game two last night 8-3 ... Jameson Taillon suffered the loss after surrendering right runs in 5.0 innings ... **Miguel Amaya** and **Pete Crow-Armstrong** recorded their third and fifth home run of the season, respectively and **Alex Bregman** finished the night 2-for-4.

- Following their three-game set against the White Sox, the Cubs will head back to Wrigley Field and host the Milwaukee Brewers (May 18-20) and the Houston Astros (May 22-24).
- The Cubs are in first place in the N.L. Central (29-17) ... Chicago's .630 winning percentage is the third-best in the majors.

SOUTHSIDE SNIPPETS: The Cubs and White Sox will meet for the first of two times this season, kicking it off at Rate Field this weekend ... the two clubs will then meet at Wrigley Field Aug. 17-19 ... the Cubs are 78-76 all-time against the White Sox, including a 40-38 record at Rate Field.

- The Cubs went 5-1 against the White Sox last year, sweeping them at Wrigley and going 2-1 at the Rate.
- The Cubs won the first-ever regular season game between the clubs on June 16, 1997 (8-3).
- The teams squared off once during Postseason play, matching up during the 1906 World Series with the White Sox claiming a 4-2 series victory.
- Across 26 career games against the Sox, **Nico Hoerner** is hitting .330 (29-for-88) 13 RBI and a .904 OPS.
- Infielder and Naperville, Illinois native **Nicky Lopez** spent the 2024 season with the Southsiders, appearing in 124 games for them, hitting .241 (96-for-398).

CROSSTOWN SQUARE OFF: Excluding the 2020 Covid season, this weekend marks the first time in 18 years (June 27-29, 2008) that the Cubs and White Sox will square off with both teams entering the series with a winning record.

SWIPING AWAY: Dating to May 5 across 11 games, the Cubs have recorded 11 stolen bases after stealing just two bases in their previous 10 games from April 24-May 4.

- Chicago this season has 31 stolen bases with just five caught stealing, good for a 86.1% stolen base rate ... their 86.1% stolen base rate is the third-highest in the majors, behind the Pirates (88.0%) and the Phillies (88.6%).
- Pete Crow-Armstrong** ranks fourth in stolen bases (11) in the National League this season ... what's more, since the beginning of last season, his 46 stolen bags are tied for the sixth-most in MLB.

GET ON!: The Cubs this season pace the majors in times on base (617) and rank second in on-base percentage (.341) ... additionally, their 633 total bases this year are the sixth-most.

- Michael Busch** is second in the majors in times on base (30) since May 1, while **Ian Happ** is tied for the seventh-most (27) in that same span.

BREGMAN'S STREAK: **Alex Bregman** is riding a seven-game hitting streak dating to May 8, batting .333 (10-for-30) with an .822 OPS ... he also has hits in 13 of his last 16 games since April 28 (.279/17-for-61).

AB-SUCCESS: Per Baseball Savant, Cubs fielders own a 71% success rate when challenging using the ABS system, the highest in the majors (min. 40 challenges) ... Chicago has challenged 51 times and have been successful on 36 of them ... their 36 successful challenges are tied for the fifth-most in the National League.

3-2, 3-2, 3-2: Since April 14 on 3-2 counts, Chicago is tied for the major league lead in home runs (7) and is tied for the fourth-most RBI (18) in the majors ... they also own the fifth slugging percentage (.395) ... on the season as a whole, the club's 108 walks lead the majors on that count.

- This season, **Ian Happ** has the fourth-most walks (19) on 3-2 counts in the majors.
- The Cubs have five players that have recorded 10+ walks on 3-2 counts this season: **Ian Happ** (19), **Michael Busch** (12), **Seiya Suzuki** (12), **Dansby Swanson** (11) and **Alex Bregman** (10).

FIVE STAR DEFENSE: **Pete Crow-Armstrong** (2nd, 10) and **Nico Hoerner** (4th, 8) both rank in the top-five in the majors in outs above average this season ... what's more, the Cubs have three players that rank in the top-25 in outs above average adding **Michael Busch** to the mix, who ranks 23rd with 4 OAA (per Baseball Savant).

- What's more, **PCA** leads the majors in fielding run value (11) and defensive runs saved (13).

THAT'S A GOOD EYE: Chicago hitters rank second in the majors with an 11.7% walk rate this season ... their 212 walks produced this year are the most in the majors.

- Three Cubs hitters rank in the top-20 of the N.L. in walk-rate this season: **Ian Happ** (2nd, 17.2%), **Michael Busch** (10th, 14.7%) and **Dansby Swanson** (19th, 13.1%) ... Happ's 34 walks this season are tied with Pittsburgh's **Bryan Reynolds** for the second-most in the N.L. this season.
- Furthermore, since April 25, Happ (19) and Busch (18) own the second and third-most walks in the National League, respectively.
- Alex Bregman** has posted the third-lowest chase rate in the N.L. (19.7%).

BUSHY!: **Michael Busch** is currently on a 17-game on-base streak since April 28 ... his 17-game streak ties his career-high streak from June 22-July 11, 2024 and is tied for the fifth-longest active on-base streak in the majors ... since May 1, he is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with a .462 on-base percentage, .520 slugging percentage, a .982 OPS and 13 RBI.

PETE VS. LEFTIES: In his previous 30 games dating to April 14, Pete Crow-Armstrong is batting .382 (13-for-34) against left-handed pitchers ... his .500 on-base percentage against lefties in that span is tied for the fifth-highest in the majors.

THAT'S A LOT OF PITCHES: Since April 14, **Ian Happ** has seen 590 pitches, the second-most in the majors ... as a team this season, the Cubs have seen the third-most pitches in the majors at 7,141.

Current Trends:

- Colin is scheduled to make his seventh start and ninth appearance of the season today against the White Sox at Rate Field.
- Has made one start and two appearances against the White Sox in his career ... owns a 2.45 ERA (2 ER/7.1 IP) with five strikeouts and two walks ... this will mark his first appearance at Rate Field.
- Has allowed two runs or fewer in six of his last eight starts dating to Sept. 18, 2025 and has surrendered three runs or fewer in 11 of his last 15 starts dating to Aug. 3, 2025, posting a 4.04 ERA (35 ER/78.0 IP) during the stretch.
- Has earned wins in four of his last seven starts since April 8 ... is 3-2 with a 4.80 ERA (16 ER/30.0 IP) as a starter this season.
- His .643 win percentage (27-15 record) since the start of the 2024 season is the fourth-highest clip in the N.L. (min. 50 GS), while his 27 wins during that same span are tied for eighth.
- Opposing hitters are batting .143 (5-for-35) against his splitter and .143 (4-for-28) against his slider.
- Is the only pitcher in Major League Baseball to have made 20-plus starts and four-plus relief appearances in each of the last three seasons dating to 2023.

2026 Notes:

- Began the 2026 season out of the bullpen, logging appearances of 3.0-plus frames on March 30 vs. Los Angeles (A.L.) (3.0 IP) and April 3 at Cleveland (3.1 IP).
- Pitched 6.0 innings in relief on April 14, in Philadelphia, becoming the fifth Cubs reliever since 2000 with an outing of at least 6.0 innings with no walks.
- Recorded a win in three-straight starts from April 8-20 for the third time in his career (last - 4 G, June 28-July 18, 2025).

2025 Notes:

- Colin appeared in 32 games (27 starts) for the Cubs in 2025, recording a 11-7 record with a 3.95 ERA (70 ER/159.1 IP) and 127 strikeouts.
- His 3.95 ERA marked a career-low while his 159.1 IP and 127 strikeouts were the second-highest and second-lowest, respectively, of his career.
- Owned a 4.33 ERA (69 ER/143.1 IP) as a starter, compared to a 0.56 ERA (1 ER/16.0 IP) as a reliever.
- Became the first Cubs pitcher to make 25-plus starts and five-plus relief appearances in a single season since Julián Tavárez in 2001.
- Appeared in his 100th career game April 25 in a start against the Phillies ... he picked up the win, his first of the season, throwing 5.0 scoreless innings and striking out a season-high seven batters.
- On June 5 in Washington, he became the first Cubs pitcher since Jamie Moyer on Aug. 22, 1986 vs. Cincinnati with an outing of at least 5.1 scoreless innings and no strikeouts ... completed his 500th career inning in the outing.
- From June 28-July 18, earned a win in a career-high four-straight starts, allowing two runs or fewer in all four of the outings, posting a 1.90 ERA (5 ER/23.2 IP) during the stretch.
- Recorded a career-high 11 strikeouts in his last outing Sept. 18 at Cincinnati, while tying a season-high 7.0 innings pitched.

Career Notes

- Signed a one-year contract with the Cubs on Nov. 6, 2025 after rejoining the Cubs for the 2025 season ... is in his second stint with the Cubs organization, also spending time with Chicago from 2019-20.
- Has spent time in the majors with San Diego (2015-16), Miami (2016), Cubs (2020, 2025-26) and Milwaukee (2021, 2023-24).
- Spent most of the 2021 and 2022 seasons with Fukuoka in the Japan League.
- Missed the 2017 season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on November 11, 2016.
- Was traded to Miami, July 29, 2016, and appeared in one game before being traded back to San Diego three days later, Aug. 1.
- Was selected by San Diego in the 12th round of the 2011 draft.
- Attended the University of Northern Iowa, St. Petersburg College (Fla.) and Indiana State University.
- Graduated from Cascade (Iowa) High School ... was First Team All-State as a senior.
