**TODAY'S TILT**...the Mariners finish the 7-game homestand with the last of 3 games against the Texas Rangers (1-1)...Seattle also hosted the Athletics (1-3) on the homestand...following today's game, the Mariners will embark on their final road trip of the season against the Athletics (3 G, 9/11-9/13), Los Angeles Angels (3 G, 9/14-9/16) and Colorado Rockies (3 G, 9/18-9/20)...today's game against the Rangers will be televised and streamed on **Mariners TV** with **Aaron Goldsmith** and **Ryon Healy** on the call and **Ryan Rowland-Smith** serving as field analyst...the game will also be broadcast live on **Seattle Sports (710 AM)** with **Rick Rizzs** and **Gary Hill Jr.** on the call.

**ODDS AND ENDS**...the Mariners won yesterday's matinee by a 3-2 final score...Seattle is 49-22 (.690) when they score 4+ runs and 18-56 (.243) when they score 3-or-fewer runs.

- **In The Mix With Six** - The Mariners are 44-28 (.611) in 72 games when their starting pitchers go 6.0+ innings and 24-50 (.324) in 73 games when starters fail to record 18+ outs in a game.
- **Hold Me Close** - The Mariners have played 44 one-run games in 2026, tied for the most in the American League...the Mariners are 22-22 (.500) in one-run games.
- **J.P. Sizzle - J.P. Crawford** is batting .385 (10x26) with 3 runs, 1 double, 3 RBI and 10 walks over his last 9 games (8/31-c), reaching base at a .553 clip with a .976 OPS in 38 plate appearances.

**RALEIGH KEEPS ROLLING**...**Cal Raleigh's** career-high tying 9-game hitting streak (8/29-9/9), was snapped yesterday...Raleigh has still been red-hot at the plate for the last few weeks (8/16-c), batting .313 (21x67) with 16 runs, 5 doubles, 9 home runs, 16 RBI and 15 walks, getting on base at a robust .439 clip, slugging .791 with a 1.230 OPS across 82 plate appearances...during that span (8/16-c), among players with at least 70 PA, Raleigh's 1.277 OPS ranks 2nd in the big leagues behind only Mickey Gasper-BOS (1.290)...Raleigh's .791 slugging percentage ranks 3rd, trailing Gasper (.865) and Rafael Devers-SF (.793).

**ACT IV OF THE STETSON SHOWDOWN**...Stetson University alums RHP **Logan Gilbert** and RHP Jacob deGrom are set to face off for the fourth time this season after toeing the rubber against each other on April 6 in Arlington (Rangers win) April 17 in Seattle (Rangers win) and July 26 in Arlington (Mariners win)...Gilbert and deGrom are the only active MLB players who attended Stetson...prior to this season, the fellow Stetson Hatters had never faced off in a regular season game.

**MARINERS CELEBRATE HISPANIC HERITAGE**...the Mariners today are celebrating Hispanic Heritage at the ballpark...the Mariners are currently represented by players and coaches from the Dominican Republic, Venezuela, Mexico, Puerto Rico, Cuba and Colombia.

**LEGENDARY LOGAN**...Mariners starter **Logan Gilbert** is having another stellar season, going 11-9 with a 3.71 ERA (68 ER, 165.0 IP), 42 walks, 176 strikeouts and a 1.07 WHIP...Gilbert has reached both 1,000 career strikeouts and 1,000 career innings this season...he ranks among the all-time Mariners leaders (min. 500.0 IP) in WHIP (2nd, 1.06), SO/9 (3rd, 9.54), SO/BB (3rd, 4.75), strikeouts (5th, 1,060), innings pitched (7th, 1,000.1), ERA (6th, 3.60), wins (T-9th, 58) and starts (5th, 174)...Gilbert was named among the top 50 greatest Mariners that was unveiled on Aug. 8 as part of 50 Seasons Celebration Weekend.

**THE LAZER SHOW**...**Lazaro Montes** is batting .263 (5x19) with 1 double, 2 home runs, 6 RBI and an .932 OPS over his first 7 MLB games...Laz yesterday recorded a pinch-hit double, his first pinch hit and double in MLB...on Tuesday, he hit his first home run at T-Mobile Park, a blast that went a projected 474 feet, the farthest homer at T-Mobile Park in the Statcast Era (2015-c) and tied for the farthest HR in MLB this season with Fernando Tatis Jr.-SD...the homer was hit at 116.1 MPH off the bat, the 3rd-hardest hit HR by a Mariners player since 2015, behind only **Julio Rodríguez** (117.2 MPH, 9/11/22 vs. ATL) and Nelson Cruz (116.8 MPH, 9/27/17 at OAK)...Mike Zunino is the only other Mariners player to hit a ball at least 116.0 MPH off the bat since Statcast began tracking exit velocity.

**20/20 VISIONARIES**...**Randy Arozarena** and **Julio Rodríguez** have both recorded 20/20 seasons in back-to-back years (2025-26), joining Alex Rodriguez and Ken Griffey Jr. (1998-99) as the only other pair of Mariners teammates with a 20/20 season in the same year, also doing so in consecutive seasons...Arozarena and Rodríguez are the only teammates in AL this season to each reach 20+ HR and 20+ SB, joined in MLB by only Jackson Merrill and Fernando Tatis Jr of the Padres...Julio became the first player in MLB history to begin their career with 5-straight 20/20 seasons, while Randy became just the 5th in MLB history with at least 6 consecutive 20/20 seasons.

**RANDY AROZARENA, SILVER SLUGGER?**...**Randy Arozarena** has been among the best left fielders in the AL, batting .273 (140x512) with 93 runs, 29 doubles, 1 triple, 22 home runs, 67 RBI, 21 stolen bases, a .371 OBP and slugging .463 for an .834 OPS...Randy ranks among the AL qualified left field leaders in fWAR (1st, 4.2), bWAR (1st, 4.6), OPS+ (1st, 140), wRC+ (1st, 144), home runs (1st), runs (1st), doubles (T-1st), OBP (T-1st), slugging percentage (2nd) and OPS (2nd).

**COLE YOUNG, AMERICAN LEAGUE GOLD GLOVER?**...second baseman **Cole Young** has been the best defensive second baseman in the American League this season according to Defensive Runs Saved (*Sports Info Solutions*)...Young's 15 DRS trails only Brice Turang-MIL (21 DRS) in MLB...Young also leads AL second basemen in fielding percentage (.991), assists (368) and innings (1,236.1).

**AS YOU MAY KNOW**...**Andrés Muñoz** secured his 26th save of the season in yesterday's game, striking out 2 batters in a scoreless 9th inning, and...**AS YOU MAY ALSO KNOW**...Muñoz is currently sporting a career-high 14.34 SO/9 but ranks 2nd in MLB behind only Mason Miller-SD (16.58) among pitchers with at least 50.0 innings, but...**DID YOU KNOW?**...Muñoz is the only reliever in Mariners history to record 4 seasons of at least 75 strikeouts?...Muñoz, who has posted at least 75 strikeouts in 2022, 2024, 2025 and 2026, ranks ahead of Edwin Díaz (2016-18), Arthur Rhodes (2000-02) and Bobby Ayala (1994-95, '97) who each have 3 seasons a piece.

## ON THIS DATE IN MARINERS HISTORY - SEPTEMBER 10

- **1984** - Alvin Davis hit his club rookie record 25th home run to pace the Mariners to a 7-3 win over Texas in the Kingdome.
- **1995** - Joey Cora's RBI double in the eighth inning is the game winner in a 5-4 win that completes a three game sweep vs. Kansas City.
- **1997** - Alex Rodriguez hits 23rd HR into left field 2nd deck off Thompson.
- **2008** - J.J. Putz records his 99th career save, passing Mike Schooler for 2nd on the Mariners all-time list.
- **2015** - Nelson Cruz connected on his 40th home run of the season in the Mariners 5-0 win over Texas...Félix Hernández tied the AL lead for wins with 17, the most he has recorded since a career-high 19 in 2009...Cruz becomes 4th player in club history with a 40-HR season and has hit 40 home runs in consecutive seasons.
- **2019** - Kyle Lewis records his first Major League hit, a home run, vs. Cincinnati.
- **2025** - The Mariners extend their winning streak to 5-games with their third consecutive comeback win in a 4-2 win over the Cardinals in 13 innings thanks to **Leo Rivas'** second career home run in a 2-run, walk-off homer in the bottom of the 13th, for his second career walk-off hit...It also marked the Mariners' first 13+ inning regular season game since Aug. 9, 2022 vs. Yankees (1-0 Mariners win).

ABOUT LOGAN GILBERT...

- Gilbert, 29, is making his 29th start of the season and the 175th start of his career...also marks his 4th start against the Rangers this season and the 20th of his career.
- Selected by Seattle in the 1st round (14th overall) of the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft; signed by Mariners scout Rob Mummau on June 16, 2018.
- Spent 3 seasons at Stetson (FL) University, 2016-18...in 2017, was ASUN Pitcher of the Year and ASUN 1st-Team All-Conference.
- Named the 2022 and the 2024 Mariners Most Valuable Pitcher by the Seattle Chapter of the BBWAA.
- Named to his 1st All-Star team in 2024.
- Was named AL Player of the Week for June 15-21, marking the 2nd time he has won the award (also: July 3-9, 2023).

**LAST TIME OUT**...L#9 on Sept. 4 vs ATH, tossed 4.2 innings, allowing 7 runs (7 ER) on 8 hits and 2 walks while striking out 10 batters... is only the 2nd time this season he has recorded fewer than 5.0 innings...tied his career high in home runs allowed in a single-game (also: 5/4/26 vs. ATL)...his 10 strikeouts tie his season-high and are tied for the 4th-most he has thrown in a single start (8x).

**1000-AND COUNTING**...recorded his 1000th career inning pitched in his last start on Sept. 4 vs. ATH...is the 7th Mariners pitcher to record 1000+ innings pitched with the team...joins Aaron Nola-PHI, Logan Webb-SF, and Kyle Freeland-COL as 1-of-4 active pitchers to have recorded 1000+ career innings with a single franchise...he is the first pitcher that made their MLB debut in 2021-or-later to record 1000+ innings of work.

**THE HOME STRETCH**...across his last 8 home starts (6/16-c), he is 5-2 with a 3.42 ERA (19 ER, 50.0 IP) and 13 walks to 62 strikeouts (4.77 K/BB)...he also owns a 0.90 WHIP over the 8 game home stretch...his 62 strikeouts recorded during the span is tied for the 4th most he has recorded over an 8-game home span in a season and is the most since he tossed 66 K's from June 16 to Sept. 27 of last season...has allowed 3-or-fewer runs over 5.0+ IP in 8 of his last 9 starts, including 6 quality starts.

**FOR THE HOME CROWD**...his 9 home games with 7+ strikeouts and 2-or-fewer walks this season are tied for the lead in MLB, matching Jacob Misiorowski-MIL and Jesús Luzardo-PHI...has recorded 3 starts of 1-or-fewer earned run allowed over 7.0+ IP, ranking T-10th most in MLB this season...is 1-of-7 AL pitchers with 3+ such games in 2026...has thrown 42 career quality starts at home, 13th most in MLB since 2021, including 7 this season... his 1.063 WHIP at home this season ranks 11th-lowest in MLB (min. 75.0 IP) while his 4.36 K/BB at home ranks 13th-best and his 10.33 K/9 is 11th-highest.

**DEEP IN THE HEART OF TEXAS**...has faced Texas more than any other opponent across his career (19 GS), with his next closest being 17 GS against ATH...has thrown 6.0+ innings in 11 of his 18 career starts against Texas, including 10 quality starts...in each of his 3 starts this season against the Rangers has allowed 3-or-fewer runs over 5.1+ IP, including 2 quality starts with 5+ strikeouts...among all-time MLB pitchers with at least 100.0 IP against the Rangers, ranks 2nd in K/BB (4.91), T-11th in opponent batting average (.209), T-8th in WHIP (0.98), and 8th in K/9 (8.97).

**TAKING IT DEEP**...over his career has recorded 30 games of 7.0+ IP, including 7 games of 8.0+ IP...of those 7 such games, has allowed no runs in 4, including an 8.0-inning, 2-hit outing against the Rangers at T-Mobile Park...allowed only 2 batters to reach base and struck out 9 in the start on June 16, 2024 to join Félix Hernández as 1 of only 2 Mariners pitchers to allow 2-or-fewer base runners and record 9+ strikeouts over 8.0 innings in a start...his 29 outings of 3-or-fewer runs allowed over 7.0+ IP are 7th most in the AL since 2021.

**CHECK OUT THE WHIP**...owns a 1.07 WHIP this season, ranking 10th among qualified pitchers in 2026...his 0.98 WHIP since 2024 ranks T-4th in MLB among qualified pitchers.

**THE WILD WEST**.....across 62 career starts against AL West opponents, he is 21-14 with a 3.29 ERA (133 ER, 363.2 IP), 370 strikeouts, 76 walks allowed and a 1.00 WHIP...among all-time MLB pitchers (min. 200 IP) against AL West teams, he ranks 6th in WHIP (1.00), 8th in SO/BB (4.87), and T-17th in opp. BA (.213)...among Mariners pitchers ranks 5th in strikeouts (370) against the AL West.

**GIVE ME FIVE**...in his last start on Sept. 4 vs. ATH, recorded his first start of the season where he did not complete 5.0 innings after recording 5.0+ IP in each of his prior 21 starts...his 21-game streak marks the 2nd longest of his career and is tied for the 4th-longest such streak recorded by a pitcher this season...his 26 games with 5.0+ IP this season is T-5th most in MLB...the Mariners went 15-6 over his streak.

**EXCLUSIVE COMPANY**...on Aug. 13 at NYY, he eclipsed 150 strikeouts this season becoming just the 2nd pitcher with 5-consecutive seasons of 150+ strikeouts since 2022 (also: Dylan Cease-3Tms)...his 5 such seasons rank 3rd-most in franchise history, trailing Félix Hernández (10 seasons) and Randy Johnson (8 seasons), while ranking ahead of Mark Langston (4 seasons).
