BIRD WATCHING: The St. Louis Cardinals play the finale of a three-game series with the Colorado Rockies. The two teams split the first two games with St. Louis winning 7-6 on Friday and Colorado winning 10-7 last night. Following the game, the Cardinals will return to the Pacific Time Zone for a three-game series with the San Francisco Giants starting with a 5:10 p.m. local start on Labor Day televised nationally on NBC & Peacock. The Cardinals are 3-2 in the first five game of this three-city trip through the National League West Division.

FLIGHT PATTERN: St. Louis enters play today in 3rd place in the National League Central, 17.0 games behind first place Milwaukee and 10 games behind 2nd place Chicago. The Cardinals are 4.0 games out of the 3rd Wild Card position held by Arizona with Miami and San Diego in their path. St. Louis has 10 road games remaining and nine home games.

HJERPE RECALLED; RINCÓN OPTIONED: Prior to today's game, the Cardinals recalled LHP **Cooper Hjerpe** from Memphis (AAA) and optioned RHP **Hancel Rincón** to Memphis. Hjerpe, the Cardinals 1st Round selection in the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oregon State University, would become the 8th Cardinals pitcher and 13th overall to make his MLB debut.

HELLO, MY NAME IS...: When LHP **Cooper Hjerpe** takes the mound for the first time, he will become the 26th different Cardinal to debut this season and 13th Cardinal to make his Major League debut. Both marks are tied for the franchise high since the start of 1985 with the 26 Cardinals debut accomplished in 1985 and 1995, while the 13 MLB debuts matches 1997, 2020 and 2022.

GETTING SERIES-OUS: With a win today, the Cardinals would win 5 of their last 6 road series with only a sweep disrupting the streak at Citizens Bank Park (8/21-23). A Cardinals win would also mathematically eliminate the Rockies from the Wild Card race.

IVÁN THE CHEERABLE: Cardinals designated hitter/catcher **Iván Herrera** has homered in the first two games of this series with 3 RBI in consecutive games as well. He is looking to match his career-best with a home run in three straight games (Sept. 21-23, 2025). The last Cardinals player to homer in all three games of a series with the Rockies was Hall of Famer **Scott Rolen** (Sept. 17-19, 2002 at Coors Field. Herrera is on a nine-game hitting streak against the Rockies, longest by a Cardinals player since **Paul Goldschmidt** ran off a franchise best 16 games (2022-24). With 3 RBI today, Herrera would join six other MLB players with three consecutive 3+ RBI games against the Rockies (**Daulton Varsho, Daniel Murphy, Cody Ross, Brian Giles, Bret Boone & Sammy Sosa**).

BYE-BYE-BÁEZ: Cardinals rookie OF **Joshua Báez** slammed a home run of the season last night in his initial at-bat, giving him 7 HR in his first 21 games. He joins **Albert Pujols** as the only Cardinals with 7 HR in his first 21 games and also joins White Sox rookie **Munetaka Murakami** as the only two players in MLB this season. Báez homered in his first three plate appearances in his Major League debut at Wrigley Field on Aug. 15 to set a Major League record.

KYLE IN STYLE: Today's starting pitcher is Colorado-native **Kyle Leahy**, born in Longmont. The Cardinals 17th round selection in 2018 out of Colorado Mesa has limited his opponent to two runs or less in each of his last 12 starts, including five scoreless starts. Since the streak began on June 23, Leahy leads all MLB pitchers with a 1.37 ERA and a perfect 5-0 record, the only pitcher with an unblemished mark who has thrown 50.0 or more innings over that time.

SEPTEMBER SENSATIONS: Through the first five games of September, the Cardinals lead all of Major League Baseball with 37 runs and 36 RBI. The Redbirds lead the National League with a .304 batting average, 10 home runs, 20 extra base hits and a team OPS of .867. Five of their 36 RBI have come from sacrifice flies, which they also lead the MLB circuit.

Kyle Leahy was born in and resides in Boulder... graduated from Erie High School...selected to play at the Colorado High School Futures Game at Coors Field...played college baseball at Colorado Mesa University in Grand Junction (2016-18).
Daniel Descalso played two seasons with Colorado (2015-16).
2026 Cardinals Hall of Fame Inductee **Albert Pujols** made MLB debut at Coors Field (Apr. 2, 2001)... singled off Mike Hampton that night for his first hit.
Jose Quintana was traded from Pittsburgh to St. Louis at the 2022 MLB Trade Deadline and made 12 regular season and one postseason start.
Cardinals Hall of Famer **Matt Holliday** was originally selected by Colorado in the 7th round of the 1998 MLB Draft...played parts of six seasons for the Rockies (2004-08, '18) where he was a three-time All-Star and appeared in the 2007 World Series.
Jaden Hill was originally selected by St. Louis in the 38th round of the 2018 MLB draft, but did not sign Louisiana State University.

Bryan Torres played in 67 games for the 2019 Rocky Mountain Vibes (Rookie-Brewers).
Justin Bruhl pitched in seven games for the Rockies in 2023.
Cardinals Assistant General Manager **Randy Flores** pitched in 82 games in three seasons (2002, 2009-10) over two stints with Colorado.
National Baseball Hall of Fame outfielder **Larry Walker** played for Colorado (1995-04) and St. Louis (2004-05)...member of 2004 NL Champions.
Rockies Bullpen Coach **Matt Buschmann** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Lafayette High School in Wildwood, Mo.
TJ Rumfield's father, **Toby Rumfield**, played in 13 games for Memphis (AAA) in 2002 where he was teammates with **Stubby Clapp**.
Rockies MLB.com **Thomas Harding** covered the Memphis Redbirds (AAA) for two seasons for the Commercial Appeal (1998-99)...mentored recent Cardinals MLB.com writer **Anne Rogers**.

Rockies Special Assistant **Clint Hurdle** played in 78 games for St. Louis in 1986.
Ricky Horton pitched for the 1990 Denver Zephyrs (AAA-Brewers) and 1991 Colorado Springs Sky Sox (AAA-Indians).
St. Louis Post-Dispatch reporter **Derrick Goold** is Boulder native...graduated from Centaurus High School in Lafayette...worked as a staff writer for the Rocky Mountain News (2000-01).

TODAY'S START:

- The 29-year old Erie, Colorado native (makes his 27th start of the season (28th career) and 125th career appearance. Leahy's first 97 Major League career appearances all came in relief (2023-25).
- Will be making his 1st career start at Coors Field where he owns 0-0 mark with 4.50 ERA (4.0 IP) in two relief appearances.
- Has allowed 2-or-fewer runs in a career-high 12 straight starts (June 23-present), matching the longest streak by a Cardinals hurler since at least 1900, with Adam Wainwright (12 in 2009).**
- Surrendered 8 runs combined over his last 12 starts (1.37 ERA), the fewest by a Cardinal in any 12-start span since **Jack Flaherty** gave up 8 in a 12 start span from Aug 1-Sept. 29, 2019.
- Leahy's 1.80 second half ERA (40.0 IP) ranks 2nd in MLB since the All-Star Break to Braves **Chris Sale** (1.75); min. 40.0 IP
- Leahy (10) and **Andre Pallante** (12) are the two Cardinals with double-digit wins this season ... Enters today on a career-high 5-game winning streak (June 28-present), tying **Andre Pallante** (5/23[1]-6/22) for the longest on the team this year.
- Since June 23, leads MLB (min. 50.0 IP) with a 1.37 ERA (9 ER/59.1 IP) and his 12 starts yielding 2 runs or fewer in that span.**
- His 129.1 innings pitched are a single-season MLB career high, as are his 118 strikeouts. His career single-season high for IP as a professional is 144.2 in 2022 between Memphis (AAA) and Springfield (AA).
- Ranks in MLB's 97th percentile in arm extension (7.3 ft.), which is measured from how far off the mound he releases the ball on average.
- Led off his Aug. 12 start vs. PHI by striking out **Kyle Schwarber** (looking) for his 100th strikeout this season, marking his first MLB season with 100+ strikeouts.
- Kyle's 97 career relief appearances before his 1st career Major League start (Sept. 28, 2025 at CHI) were the most by a Cardinal since **Jordan Hicks** (April 21, 2022 at Miami) who made his 1st career start after having made 114 career relief appearances.

LAST TIME OUT (Saturday, August 29 vs. Pittsburgh): ND, L 6-2; 3.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 3 SO, 1 HR - 51 pitches.

- While on pitch count, worked 3.0 IP, allowing solo HR, and took ND in the Cardinals 6-2 loss to the Pirates at Busch Stadium.
- It was his 12th consecutive start allowing 2 runs or fewer, but his 2nd straight start while being held to season-ending usage watch.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS:

DON'T WALK: Became one of three Cardinals to strike out 8-or-more batters with 0 walks in his 8/7 start vs. COL, along with **Dustin May** (9 SO, 0 BB) on 5/27 at MIL and **Matthew Liberatore** (9 SO, 0 BB) on 8/19 at CIN.

BEND, DON'T BREAK: Ranks 1st among MLB starting pitchers in opponent batting average with 2 outs & RISP at .073 BA (4-53) ahead of Angels **Jack Kochanowicz** (.077, 2-26).

CENTRAL FOCUS: Earned four wins against NL Central opponents this season (April 28 at PIT, May 4 vs. MIL, July 4 at Chicago, Aug. 18 at Cincinnati) to improve to 6-1 in his career against divisional opponents.

EN GARDE: Ranks T-9th among NL pitchers with his 29 Opponent's Sword Swings (1st: Cade Cavalli, 36). A “sword” swing is an expression of the art of forcing a batter to take an uncomfortable, awkward swing.

AIR BENDER: Boasts average swing & miss distances of 5.5 inches on his sweeper, highest among St. Louis starters.

HELLO 4TH OF JULY: Hurlled 5.0 scoreless innings through the Wrigley Field fog as the Cardinals handed the Cubs a 3-0 shutout on Independence Day ... Leahy allowed three singles and struck out six on only 77 pitches ... Following a 49-minute pre-game rain delay, **JJ Wetherholt** homered on the first pitch of the game . The game was also halted for 15 minutes after the 6th inning due to heavy fog combined with smoke from nearby fireworks.

PARK PLACE: Has made 8 starts this year at a Park (Last: 8/23 at Citizen's Bank Park); each of his first six road games took place at Parks (Petco Park, Comerica Park, Daikin Park, loanDepot park, PNC Park, Great American Ball Park). His start at Target Field on June 12 ended the string.

NO DECISIONS: Has earned the decision in 14 of his 26 starts, but just 6 decisions in his last 17 starts, going 5-1 since 5/23(2) at CIN.

STRETCHING OUT: Worked at least 5.0 innings in 20 of his 26 starts on the year, including a career-high 6.1 innings on 6/23 vs. Arizona.

LEAHY VS. COLORADO:

- Makes his 2nd career start and 7th career appearance vs. the Rockies today.
- Gained a 3-2 win over the Rockies on 8/7/26 at Busch Stadium in his 1st start against Colorado; struck out 8, one shy of his career high.
- Is 2-0 with a 4.05 ERA (13.1 IP/6 ER) and 19 strikeouts and no HR's allowed in six career appearances vs. COL.
- He worked 3.2 relief IP allowing just one run on 7/22/25 at Coors Field, striking out 7.
- Today marks his 4th career start vs. the NL West (SD-2, ARI-1); His combined start/relief 0.99 career WHIP against the NL West is the 7th lowest in Cardinals franchise history (min. 40.0 IP).
