**THIS DATE IN ASTROS HISTORY
MAY 30**

1976 - In the second game of a doubleheader at Fulton County Stadium vs. the Braves, the Astros set a franchise record with 23 singles and set the then-club record with 25 hits in a 16-5 win...**Cliff Johnson** leads the attack with four hits and five RBI...**Enos Cabell** adds three hits and three runs scored...the win completes a doubleheader sweep for Houston...since this date, the Astros have reached 25 hits on four other occasions, but have not posted 23 singles in a game.

TODAY'S GAME: The Astros, who are 7-3 in their last 10 games, will play the second game of their 10-day, nine-game homestand today against the NL Central division leading Brewers...**RHP Peter Lambert** (3-4), a free agent signing this offseason, will start for the Astros opposite the Brewers and **RHP Brandon Sproat** (1-3).

DRIVING THE LAMBO: Today's Astros starter **RHP Peter Lambert** has been solid in his seven starts for the Astros, going 3-4 with a 3.79 ERA (17ER/40.1IP) with 40 strikeouts and a .200 opponent average...Lambert pitched last year for the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the NPB, posting a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts in 23 appearances in Japan...he began this season at Triple A Sugar Land (1.84 ERA in three appearances) before being called up to join the rotation on April 17.

STAR WARS NIGHT: The Astro are celebrating **Star Wars Night** today at the ballpark, which features themed characters, special activities and an exclusive Star Wars-themed **Carlos Correa Mandalorian & Grogu Bobblehead Add-On Package** for \$49.50...additionally, fans can meet iconic Star Wars™ characters and enjoy great photo opportunities before the game.

FOR STARTERS: Astros starters have a combined ERA of 3.33 (30ER/81IP) over the last 14 games (since May 15) with a 1.04 WHIP...in that span, they have allowed just 47 hits in 81.0 innings for a Major League-best .168 opponent average, while also ranking second in the AL in WHIP and fourth in ERA...additionally, Astros starters have allowed one-or-fewer runs seven times in the last 14 games.

HOMER HAPPY: The Astros have slugged 17 homers in their last eight games...Houston now ranks second in the AL in homers with 77, trailing only the Yankees (86) in that category.

THE LINEUP: The Astros have yet to repeat a lineup this season, using 59 different lineups in their first 59 games...**DH Yordan Alvarez** has the most starts at any spot in the lineup among Astros, as he's hit second 47 times this season.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Astros dropped an extra-inning affair to the Brewers last night by a score of 5-4 in 10 innings...**RHP Kai-Wei Teng** (3ER/5IP) started for Houston, recording seven strikeouts and allowing just three hits, but was haunted by a Brewers two-run homer in the 5th...**RF Cam Smith** was the Astros offensive player of the game, as he went 2x4 with a double, homer, walk and two RBI.

EVERYDAY OKERT: **LHP Steven Okert** worked 2.0 scoreless innings last night and has now pitched in each of the last two games, giving him 28 appearances this season, which ranks tied for fourth in the Majors...the lefty has had a strong month of May, posting a 2.25 ERA (3ER/12IP) in 12 games.

ON THE MEND: **RHP Hunter Brown**, who's recovering from a right shoulder sprain, made his second rehab start last night, working 3.0 innings of one-run ball for Triple A Sugar Land...Brown tossed 44 pitches in the outing (33 strikes), recording five strikeouts, while allowing just one hit, a solo homer, among the 10 batters he faced.

PITCHER OF THE MONTH?: **RHP Spencer Arrighetti** has made a strong case for the AL Pitcher of the Month award, going 4-1 with a 0.93 ERA (3ER/29IP) and a .165 opponent average (16x97) in five starts in May...during the month, he has the lowest ERA among AL starters, while ranking tied for first in wins and second in opponent average.

ON THE LEADER BOARD: **DH Yordan Alvarez** currently leads the Majors in OPS (1.056) and total bases (134)...in the AL, he ranks tied for first in extra-base hits (31), tied for first in HR (20), second in SLG (.641), second in OBP (.415), tied for fourth in hits (63), tied for fourth in RBI (39), fifth in batting avg. (.301), tied for sixth in walks (38), and tied for seventh in runs (38).

HISTORIC HOMERS: **DH Yordan Alvarez** is off to one of the most prolific starts in franchise history...his 20 homers through the club's first 59 games of the season match the franchise record, also reached by **1B Jeff Bagwell** in the 1999 season.

YOR-GONE!: **DH Yordan Alvarez** has blasted 190 career regular season home runs, which ranks seventh in Astros history...he's now one home run shy of matching **3B Alex Bregman** for sixth all-time.

AIR YORDAN: **DH Yordan Alvarez** had a three-game span from Monday thru Wednesday in Arlington in which he went 6x12 with five homers and eight RBI...some notes on his sizzling run:

- he became the first Astros player with multiple homers in back-back games since **Jose Altuve** turned the trick, Sept. 4 (2 HR) and Sept. 5 (3 HR) at TEX.
- he matched the club record for HR in a three-game span...that record is shared by **Jose Altuve** (2023), **Richard Hidalgo** (2000) and **Glenn Davis** (1990).
- he became the fifth Astros player with multiple homers in consecutive games...the others: **Jose Altuve**, 9/4-5, 2023 at TEX; **Richard Hidalgo**, 9/9-10, 2000 at CHC; **Moises Alou**, 8/13/2000 at PHI, 8/14/2000 vs. PIT; **Doug Rader**, 7/20-21/1973 vs. NYM.

WALKER, TEXAS HAMMER: **1B Christian Walker** has four homers and nine RBI in his last six games...for the season, he ranks third in the AL in RBI (40), tied for fifth in extra-base hits (25), sixth in HR (15), seventh in total bases (109), and ninth in SLG (.512)...Walker also has not committed an error in his 58 games played.

HIT PAREDES: **3B Isaac Paredes** has 498 career hits and is looking to become just the 10th Mexican-born player in MLB history to reach 500 career hits...two of those eight played portions of their careers with the Astros in **3B Vinny Castilla** (1,884 hits) and **C Alex Treviño** (604 hits).

HEATING UP: **RF Cam Smith** has recorded a hit in eight of his last nine games, batting .333 (11x33) with two doubles, two HR, four RBI, three walks and a 1.010 OPS in that span...**OF Taylor Trammell** is riding a career-high, eight-game hitting streak, batting .407 (11x27) with two doubles, one triple, two RBI and a .984 OPS within the streak.

LAST START - MAY 24 at CHC: Last pitched last Sunday vs. the Cubs at Wrigley Field...snapped a 2-game losing streak after pitching 5.0 innings of 3-run ball, allowing 5 hits and 4 walks with 5 strikeouts...surrendered 3 runs in the 2nd inning, but escaped a bases-loaded jam to limit the damage and end the frame...retired 9 of the next 10 batters he faced to finish his day after 103 pitches (57 strikes).

THE LAMBO: A minor league free-agent signing this offseason, Lambert has been a stabilizer in the Astros rotation amid a flux of injuries...has recorded a quality start in 3 of his 7 outings, including 2 scoreless outings...has also pitched 6.0+ innings in 4 of his 7 starts...among AL pitchers with 40.0+ innings pitched this season, Lambert ranks T-8th in opponent batting average (.200)...began the year at Triple A Sugar Land before being added to the Major League roster on April 17.

VS. MIL: Has 2 career appearances (1 start) against the Brewers, in which he's gone 0-1 with a 5.63 ERA (5ER/8IP)...last faced them in relief on July 3, 2024 in Colorado, shutting them down across 4.1 innings...allowed just 2 hits and no walks with 2 strikeouts in that outing...has faced 10 players of the current Brewers offense, including **Sal Frelick** (0x2, BB), **Gary Sánchez** (0x3, 2K), **Jake Bauers** (0x2), and **Christian Yelich** (1x3, BB, K).

TOE-TO-TOE WITH 'SHO': Notched the best the best start of his career on May 5 vs. LAD, outdueling **Shohei Ohtani** by allowing just 3 hits over 7.0 innings with 4 walks and 4 strikeouts...received the winning decision in the Astros 2-1 victory...matched his career high with 7.0 innings, which he's now accomplished 4 times.

SWING & A MISS: Made his Astros debut on April 17 vs. STL...opened eyes by inducing 23 whiffs by Cardinals hitters...that total ties as the 4th-highest by an AL pitcher in 2026.

WITH THE SPACE COWBOYS: Did not make the Major League team out of Spring Training and was granted his release on March 24...re-signed to a minor league deal on March 27 and began the year at Triple A Sugar Land...made 3 appearances, including 2 starts for Sugar Land to begin the 2026 season...in those 3 appearances, he recorded a 1.84 ERA (3ER/14.2IP) with 12 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .208 opponent batting average...added to the Major League roster on April 17.

2025 SEASON: Spent the 2025 season with the Tokyo Yakult Swallows in the Nippon Professional Baseball League...made 23 appearances for the Swallows, recording a 3.98 ERA (55ER/124.1IP) with 111 strikeouts, 54 walks and a 1.44 WHIP.

ABOUT LAMBERT: Right-handed pitcher joined the Astros on a minor league deal this offseason...prior to this year, had appeared at the Major League level in 4 seasons with the Colorado Rockies (2019, 2021, 2023-24)...in 74 Major League appearances with the Rockies, including 35 starts, he recorded a 6.28 ERA (170ER/243.2IP) with 181 strikeouts...was selected by the Rockies in the 2nd round of the 2015 MLB Draft out of San Dimas High School.

FAMILY TIES: Has an older brother, **RHP Jimmy Lambert**, who pitched in parts of four seasons (2020-23) in the Majors with the Chicago White Sox...in 83 career appearances, he recorded a 4.33 ERA (48ER/99.2IP) with 98 strikeouts.

LAST APPEARANCE (5/29 vs. MIL): Allowed 1 run on 2 walks in 0.1 of an inning last night vs. MIL.

TIDES TURNING: In his last 10 appearances (since May 3), he's recorded a 1.00 ERA (1ER/9IP) with 7 strikeouts, a .143 opponent batting average and a 1.22 WHIP...prior to May 3, he posted a 12.54 ERA (13ER/9.1IP) in his first 11 games of the season.

ALL-TIME ASTRO RANKINGS: With his outing on April 24 vs. NYY, he reached 338.0 career innings, passing **RHP Octavio Dotel** for the 10th-most innings by a reliever in Astros history...ranks 7th all-time in appearances (338) among relievers in Astros history, and is closing in on **RHP Ryan Pressly** (342) for 6th on that all-time list...also among Astros relievers, he ranks 4th all-time in strikeouts (471).

DAIKIN PARK RANKINGS: His 244 career strikeouts at Daikin Park are 3 away from matching **RHP Octavio Dotel** (247) for the 2nd-most by a reliever in the venue's history...reached 179.2 career innings pitched at Daikin Park with his outing on May 16 vs. TEX, surpassing **RHP Ryan Pressly** (179.1) for 4th-most by a reliever in the venue's history.

VS. MIL: In 6 career appearances vs. MIL, he's recorded a 1.69 ERA (1ER/5.1IP) with 6 strikeouts and a .111 opponent batting average.

CAREER: In 338 career games with the Astros, he's recorded a 2.87 ERA (111ER/348IP) with 471 strikeouts, a 1.22 WHIP, a 12.18 K/9 and a 0.75 HR/9...since 2019, he ranks 1st in strikeouts and 2nd in appearances among active AL relievers.
