YESTERDAY'S GAME: The Brewers lost to the Rangers, 7-5, in Surprise for their fifth straight defeat.....SS Joey Ortiz belted a 2-run HR.....2B Brice Turang went 2-for-3 with 2 runs and a triple.....3B Oliver Dunn went 2-for-3 with 1 RBI.....C Eric Haase went 2-for-2 with a run, RBI-double and walk.....DH Brock Wilken went 2-for-3 with an RBI-double.

THE ROSTER: The team opened Cactus League play with 58 players in Major League camp: 31 pitchers, 6 catchers, 13 infielders and 8 outfielders.....there are 18 non-roster invitees: 11 pitchers, 2 catchers, 4 infielders and 1 outfielder.

2023 IN REVIEW: The Brewers went 92-70 and qualified for the postseason for the fifth time in the last six seasons..... the team won the NL Central for the third time in the last six seasons, taking the division by 9.0 games over the Cubs the Brewers were defeated by Arizona, two games to none, in the NL Wild Card Series in Milwaukee.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last six full seasons (does not include 2020).....the Brewers have 573 wins since 2017, which ranks sixth in the majors and third in the National League.....the teams was just 2 games away from qualifying for the postseason in seven consecutive seasons, missing out by just a game in both 2017 and 2022.

MANAGER: Pat Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell....he is signed to a 3-year contract through 2026.....Murphy spent the previous eight seasons (2016-23) as bench coach.. his only other Major League managerial experience came in 2015 as interim manager of the San Diego Padres (42-54), rep

replacing Bud Black in June of that season.

TODAY'S STARTER: #46 - RHP BRYSE WILSON

RHP Bryse Wilson, 26, went 6-0 with a 2.58 ERA and 3 saves in 53 relief appearances during his first season with Milwaukee.....he held opponents to a .211 batting average.....he pitched as a full-time reliever for the first time in his professional career.....he was named Brewers Unsung Hero as voted on by members of the Milwaukee Chapter of the BBWAA....Wilson was acquired from Pittsburgh in exchange for cash on 1/4/23.

ALSO SCHEDULED TO PITCH...

LHP Hoby Milner, 33, went 2-1 with a 1.82 ERA in 73 relief appearances last season.....his 73 outings led the team and marked a career high.....he ranked among NL relief leaders in appearances (4th), ERA (5th) and WHIP (6th, 0.96)..... he held opponents to a .209 batting average, marking a career best.

LHP Robert Gasser, 24, enters the 2024 season as the sixth-best prospect in the Brewers organization according to *Baseball America*.....he was 2023 International League Pitcher of the Year and Brewers Co-Pitcher of the Year as he went 9-1 with a 3.79 ERA in 26 games (25 starts) at Triple-A Nashville.....Gasser was acquired from San Diego on 8/1/22 as part of the trade for LHP Josh Hader.....he is a non-roster invitee.

RHP Evan McKendry, 26, is a non-roster invitee.....McKendry was acquired from Tampa Bay last Aug. 1 in exchange for C Alex Jackson.....he went 12-6 with a 4.30 ERA in 28 games (23 starts) between Triple-A Durham (Rays) and Triple-A Nashville (Brewers) last season.....his 12 wins led the International League.

RHP Tobias Myers, 25, is a non-roster invitee.....Myers went 10-5 with a 5.03 ERA in 27 games (26 starts) last season at Double-A Biloxi.....he led the Southern League in strikeouts (168) and innings pitched (137.2).
