YESTERDAY'S NEWS: The Orioles fell to the Red Sox, 12-3...The 12 runs are tied for the second most allowed by the O's after the All-Star break, joining August 16 vs. Boston (12-10), the 15 hits surrendered also tied for the most after the break, along with September 4 vs. Chicago-AL, while the nine-run losing margin is the largest following the break...**Anthony Santander** became the ninth Oriole to hit 40 home runs in a season and the first MLB switch-hitter since 2006 to do so with a solo blast in the seventh inning...Santander drove in all three runs for the Birds.

WHAT'S TRENDING: The O's have lost four of the last five games while scoring an MLB-low seven runs since September 4...The Orioles trail the Yankees (.576, 83-61) by 1.5 games in the AL East...Baltimore is 24-25 (.490) since the All-Star break and 29-32 (.475) since July 1...Since the start of 2023, Baltimore is 183-124 (.596), the second-best winning percentage in MLB behind the Dodgers (.608, 186-120) during that time.

☞ An AL East winner has not finished the season with a record under .600 since Boston in 2017 (.574, 93-69); the Red Sox also won the division in 2016 with that same record, as did Toronto in 2015.

HOMER HAPPY: The Orioles are second in MLB with 212 home runs behind the Yankees (215)...The Dodgers rank third with 196...The O's have hit 200 home runs in a season for the 13th time in team history and for the first time since 2019 (213)...Baltimore is averaging 1.46 homers per game this season, which would be the third-best mark in team history behind 1996 (1.58) and 2016 (1.56).

☞ Baltimore has an MLB-best nine players with at least 10 home runs: **Anthony Santander** (40), **Gunnar Henderson** (36), **Colton Cowser** (20), **Adley Rutschman** and **Jordan Westburg** (18), **Cedric Mullins** (15), **Ryan Mountcastle** and **Ryan O'Hearn** (13), and **Ramón Urias** (10); the team record is 10 players, done in 2019, 2000, and 1998.

☞ Henderson and Santander are one of three duos with at least 30 home runs, along with New York-AL's Aaron Judge (51) and Juan Soto (38) and New York-NL's Pete Alonso (31) and Francisco Lindor (30); Baltimore did not have a player reach 30 homers last season, and this year marks the first time since 2021 that the team has had multiple players with 30+ home runs (Mountcastle, 33 & Mullins, 30).

☞ The Birds have hit 13 leadoff homers, the most by the club in a single season and tied with the Phillies for the most in MLB; Henderson has 10 of those, second most in one year by an Oriole behind **Brady Anderson**, who hit all 12 in 1996; Cowser (2) and Westburg (1) have the other three for the O's in 2024.

TOP GUNN: **Gunnar Henderson** was named the AL Player of the Week yesterday...The award marked the second of his career, joining June 11, 2023...He slashed .417/.464/.833(10-for-24) with one double, three homers, six runs scored, five RBI, three walks, and two stolen bases in six games while ranking among AL leaders during the period in slugging percentage (1st), home runs (T-1st), total bases (T-1st, 20), OPS (2nd, 1.297), batting average (T-2nd), and hits (T-2nd).

☞ His 36 home runs are the most by an Oriole shortstop in team history, surpassing the record of 34 held by **Cal Ripken, Jr.** (1991) and **Miguel Tejada** (2004).

☞ Henderson's 109 runs scored are the most by an Oriole since **Jonathan Villar** (111) in 2019 and rank fourth in the AL and fifth in MLB this season; he's the sixth player in O's history (since 1954) to score 100 runs in back-to-back seasons after scoring exactly 100 times last year, joining with **Manny Machado** (2, 2015-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Brian Roberts** (3, 2007-09), **Anderson** (2, 1995-96), and **Ripken, Jr.** (3, 1983-85).

☞ He ranks fourth in the AL and MLB with 7.4 fWAR; that is the best mark by an Oriole since **Ripken, Jr.** in 1991 (10.6); eight Orioles (13 occurrences) have finished a season with at least 7.0 fWAR in a season; he's also among AL leaders in walks (3rd, 71), home runs (4th, 36), total bases (3rd, 306), hits (6th, 160), extra-base hits (6th, 68), on-base percentage (7th, .367), OPS (7th, .907), and slugging percentage (8th, .540).

☞ He's on pace to score 122 times; **Roberto Alomar** (132 in 1996), **Frank Robinson** (122 in 1966), and **Ripken, Jr.** (121 in 1983) are the only players in Orioles history (since 1954) to score at least 120 runs in a season.

☞ Henderson has hit 30 of his home runs as the leadoff hitter, the second player in Orioles history to do so, along with **Brady Anderson** (35) in 1996; he's batting .326/.385/.716 (31-for-95) with seven doubles and 10 home runs when leading off the game...His 1,100 OPS to begin a game is the best such mark in MLB this year and the second-best such OPS by an Oriole in team history, behind **Anderson** (1,256) in 1996 (min. 55 GS).

MASHED TATERS: **Anthony Santander** launched his 40th home run of the year last night, becoming the eighth Oriole (ninth occurrence) to do so and the first since **Mark Trumbo** in 2016 (see chart at right)...He's the eighth switch-hitter (12th occurrence) in MLB history to hit at least 40 homers in a season, along with New York-NL's Carlos Beltrán (2006), Houston's Lance Berkman (2: 2002, 06), Texas' Mark Teixeira (2005), Atlanta's Chipper Jones (1999), New York-NL's Todd Hundley (1996), San Diego's Ken Caminiti (1996), and New York-AL's Mickey Mantle (4: 1956, 58, 60-61)...Mantle is the only switch-hitter in MLB history to hit 50 homers, when he did so in 1956 (52) and 1961 (54).

☞ He's six RBI shy of 100 for the season; no Oriole has reached that mark since **Jonathan Schoop** (105) in 2017; the last Baltimore switch-hitter to do so is **Bobby Bonilla** (116) in 1996.

☞ Santander has hit 31 home runs since the start of June, tied with New York-AL's Aaron Judge and trailing Los Angeles-NL's Shohei Ohtani (32) for the most in MLB during that time; his 40 home runs rank third in MLB behind Judge (51) and Ohtani (46).

☞ His 101 home runs since the start of 2022 rank sixth most in MLB during that time and second in the AL, behind only Judge (150).

☞ He's the ninth player in O's history with multiple 30-homer seasons, joining **Manny Machado** (3, 2015-17), **Chris Davis** (4, 2012-13, 15-16), **Adam Jones** (2, 2012-13), **Rafael Palmeiro** (4, 1995-98), **Eddie Murray** (5, 1980, 82-83, 85, 87), **Boog Powell** (4, 1964, 66, 69-70), **Frank Robinson** (3, 1966-67, 69), and **Jim Gentile** (2, 1961-62).

☞ Santander is tied for 13th in team history with 151 home runs with **Chris Hoiles**, seven behind **Melvin Mora** for 12th.

HOLY COWSER: **Colton Cowser** leads AL rookies and is second among MLB rookies with 20 home runs, trailing San Diego's Jackson Merrill (23)...He's the 10th rookie in team history (since 1954) to hit at least 20 homers and the first since **Gunnar Henderson** (28) last year...He also has 21 doubles, the ninth rookie in O's history to record 20 doubles and 20 home runs in a season and the first since Henderson (29-28, 28 HR) in 2023...Cowser is second among AL rookies and ranks third among MLB rookies with 3.4 fWAR, trailing New York-AL's Austin Wells (3.7) and San Diego's Merrill (4.5)...He's among AL rookies in runs scored (1st, 70), extra-base hits (2nd, 43), total bases (2nd, 191), doubles (T-2nd, 21), RBI (3rd, 62), slugging percentage (4th, .434), OPS (4th, .759), and hits (T-4th, 106).

☞ His 10 Outs Above Average are more than all other O's defenders combined, per Statcast; eight of those have come in left field, two behind Toronto's Daulton Varsho for the most among MLB left fielders; the next closest left fielders have four OAA.

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Baltimore's penultimate road trip is a six-gamer that began last night with the first of three games in Boston...Following an off day on Thursday, the Orioles face Detroit for three games beginning Friday...Despite losing 14 of the last 24 road games, the Orioles are 40-30 (.571) away from Oriole Park, the third-best road record in MLB this season behind the Padres (.586, 41-29) and Yankees (.600, 45-30)...The Birds are 92-59 (.609) on the road since the start of 2023, the only MLB club with a road winning percentage above .600 during that time.

HIGH SOX: The Orioles and Red Sox complete their season series with two more games at Fenway Park through Wednesday...At 7-4, Baltimore has clinched the season series for a second straight year after going 7-6 against Boston in 2023...This marks the first time the O's have won the season series with the Sox in back-to-back years since doing so in four straight from 2012-15...One more win would guarantee a winning percentage of at least .600 against the Red Sox for the 15th time in team history (since 1954) and the first since 2012 (.722, 13-5).

☞ The Birds swept a three-game series in Boston from April 9-11, the 14th road series sweep of at least three games against the Red Sox by the Orioles team history (since 1954) and the first since April 2-4, 2021 (3 G).

THE SKIPPER: Manager **Brandon Hyde** is three wins away from 400 for his career, all with Baltimore...Four previous managers have won 400 games at the helm of the Orioles: **Earl Weaver** (1,480), **Buck Showalter** (689), **Paul Richards** (517), and **Hank Bauer** (407).

QUICK HITS: Scheduled to make his 21st start (29th appearance) of the season tonight against the Red Sox...Eight of his 20 starts this season have been scoreless, tied for the most such starts in MLB (min. 2.0 IP/GS) with Seattle's Bryce Miller...Owns a 2-1 record with a 2.60 ERA (10 ER/34.2 IP) since returning to the Orioles rotation on August 6...Went 4-7 with a 3.92 ERA (47 ER/108.0 IP) for the Samsung Lions last year...Allowed 129 hits (3 HR) and 88 strikeouts in 19 Korean Baseball Organization appearances...Became a free agent following his release from the Lions due to a calf injury...Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract on October 12, 2023...Made 11 starts with the Venezuelan Winter League after signing with the O's; went 4-2 with a 3.79 ERA (23 ER/54.2 IP) with 62 hits (3 HR) and 24 strikeouts across his 11 outings...Began the season with Triple-A Norfolk...Originally signed by Tampa Bay as an international free agent on July 2, 2006.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered his fifth loss of the season on September 4 vs. Chicago-AL after allowing a career-high-tying six runs on eight hits (3 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts in 4.1 innings; exited with two runners on, one of which scored...Marked his shortest start since July 23 at Miami (2.0 IP)...Surrendered his third leadoff home run of the season to Nicky Lopez, tied for the most in MLB and has done so twice in his last three starts, joining Houston's Jose Altuve on August 24...Threw 66 pitches, 43 strikes.

AGAINST THE RED SOX: Slated to make his fourth career appearance (3rd start) against Boston...Owns a lifetime 1-0 record with a 4.11 ERA (7 ER/15.1 IP) against the club...Last faced the Red Sox earlier this season on August 18 in Baltimore; earned the win after tossing 6.0 shutout innings on seven hits with four strikeouts...Allowed five runs on eight hits (1 HR) and one hit batter with one strikeout in 3.0 innings of relief on July 20, 2016, his lone appearance at Fenway Park.

AGAINST THE AL EAST: Facing an AL East opponent for the seventh time this season, all of which have come in starts...Owns a lifetime 2-1 record with a 2.98 ERA (16 ER/48.1 IP) across his 11 career appearances (8 GS) against the division...Holds a 1-1 record with a 1.72 ERA (6 ER/31.1 IP) across his six outings against AL East foes this year; has not given up a run across his last 18.1 innings against AL East opponents dating back to his start on June 18 at New York-AL.

NIGHT OWL: Is 5-4 with a 3.90 ERA (26 ER/60.0 IP) and 48 strikeouts to 21 walks across 12 night starts this season; opponents are slashing .268/.332/.411 (62-for-231) off him in his night starts.

LACK OF SUPPORT: Has received three runs or fewer of support in 17 of his 20 starts this season and one or fewer in four of his last six starts; his 3.54 RSA/9 is the lowest by an O's starter this year (min. 10 GS)...His 3.54 RSA/9 on the year ranks 101st out of 107 total MLB pitchers (min. 20 GS).

SIGN OF RELIEF: Has registered a 1-0 record with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP) in eight relief outings this season compared to a 6-5 record with a 3.54 ERA (40 ER/101.2 IP) in 20 starts...Three of his four earned runs surrendered as a reliever came in his last appearance out of the bullpen on August 1 at Cleveland.

MR. WORLDWIDE: Pitched three seasons with the Yakult Swallows in Nippon Professional Baseball from 2019-2021...Owns a lifetime 10-8 record with a 3.00 ERA (54 ER/162. IP) and 134 strikeouts in 40 appearances with the Swallows...Also played for Samsung in the Korean Baseball Organization for the 2022 and 2023 campaigns; posted a 3.04 ERA (95 ER/281.2 IP) across 49 appearances (48 GS) with the Lions.

2023 HIGHLIGHTS: Spent the season with Samsung...Did not allow a run in three straight starts (19.0 IP) from July 4-25...Tossed 8.0 scoreless innings on four hits and four walks with four strikeouts on July 25 vs. Kia.
