**RECENT REDBIRDS:** The St. Louis Cardinals continue a nine-game homestand over 10 days with the second opponent of three, the Baltimore Orioles. Sunday afternoon, the Cardinals fell to the Boston Red Sox 11-3 but won the series, 2-1. The Orioles will be in town for three games through Wednesday. Following an open date on Thursday, a three-game series against the Chicago Cubs (May 24-26) will conclude the homestand.

**FLIGHT PATTERN:** The Cardinals enter today in 4th place in the National League Central, one game behind 3rd place Pittsburgh and 7.0 games behind first place Milwaukee (26-18). St. Louis has won five of their last seven games and have won each of their last two series.

**LOUTOS SELECTED, ROYCROFT OPTIONED, RIVAS DFA'd:** Prior to today's game, the Cardinals optioned RHP **Chris Roycroft** to Memphis (AAA) and selected the contract of RHP **Ryan Loutos** from Memphis. INF **Alfonso Rivas III** was designated for assignment.

**"LOU" TO "THE LOU":** RHP **Ryan Loutos**, 25, played college baseball at nearby Washington University of St. Louis. Loutos would become the most recent player from WashU to appear in a Major League game since former Cardinals general manager and infielder **Dal Maxvill**, who finished his playing career with the Oakland Athletics in 1975. Maxvill was also the last WashU baseball alum to play for the Cardinals (1962-72).

**REHAB IS "KEY":** Cardinals reliever **Keynan Middleton** (right forearm flexor or strain) continued his injury rehabilitation assignment in Springfield (AA) yesterday with his third appearance. Middleton threw a scoreless inning against Midland (Athletics) despite two walks while inducing a double play over 17 pitches. He is schedule to make back-to-back appearances on Wednesday and Thursday of this week in Springfield.

**A BEAST VS. THE (A.L.) EAST:** The Cardinals have posted the best winning percentage against American League East Division opponents since the start of 2023 with an 13-5 mark (.722). They are 2-1 against the Baltimore Orioles, winning a series 2-1 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards last September 11-13. The Cardinals are 5-1 against Boston and 2-1 against the Blue Jays, Rays and Yankees. Under third-year manager **Oliver Marmol**, the Cardinals are 20-14 (.588) against A.L. East opponents, his best record against any division with the N.L. Central (70-65, .519) ranking second.

**HOMER HAPPY:** The Cardinals extended their 2024 season high by homering in their seventh straight game yesterday as **Lars Nootbaar** broke up a streak of 10 straight retired by **Nick Pivetta** with a solo home run to right field. It marks their longest streak since homering in eight straight games from Aug. 28-Sept. 6, 2023. St. Louis is tied with the Orioles, Red Sox and Yankees for the longest active home run streak in MLB.

**WINN, WINN, WINN, WINN:** Cardinals rookie shortstop **Masyn Winn** has hit safely in a career-best 10 straight games (11-34, .324). Winn leads all Cardinals qualifying batters with a .281 average (15th in the N.L.), has the 4th-longest active hit streak in Major League Baseball and the 2nd-longest by a Cardinal behind **Willson Contreras** (14) this season. Cardinals rookies have posted four 10-game hitting streaks over the past two seasons with **Jordan Walker** running off streaks of 17, 12 & 12 in 2023.

**ALL EYES ON US:** The Cardinals will be televised nationally three times on this homestand. Yesterday afternoon, the Cardinals were televised on the Roku Channel for the first time this season against Boston. On Saturday, the Cardinals and Cubs will play on FOX with a homecoming from former Cardinals pitcher **Adam Wainwright** joining **Adam Amin** on the call. Sunday Night, the Cardinals and Cubs will continue their rivalry on ESPN.

#### BALTIMORE CONNECTIONS

**Lars Nootbaar's** older brother, **Nigel Nootbaar**, was a 12th round selection of the Orioles in 2014...pitched two professional seasons in the minors with Aberdeen and Delmarva (2014-15).

**Kyle Gibson** made 33 regular season starts for the Orioles last season...pitched in one postseason game for Baltimore.

**Ramón Urias** played two minor league seasons in the Cardinals organization (2018-19) ... claimed off waivers by Baltimore (Feb. 11, 2020).

**Drew Rom** was originally selected by Baltimore in the 4th round of the 2018 MLB Draft...pitched parts of five minor league seasons in the Orioles organization... traded to St. Louis with **César Prieto** and **Zack Showalter** from Baltimore in exchange for **Jack Flaherty**.

**Danny Coulombe** was born in in St. Louis.

Orioles EVP & GM **Mike Elias** spent five seasons as a scout with St. Louis, including over a year as the club's Manager of Amateur Scouting.

Orioles Co-Hitting Coach **Matt Borgschulte** was born in St. Louis...graduated from Parkway Central High School in Chesterfield in 2009...Played collegiately at Western Kentucky & Drury University in Springfield, MO...began pro coaching career with Palm Beach in the Cardinals organization in 2017...Prior to joining the Cardinals, coached at Southeast Missouri State Univ. in 2015-16 and spent 2014 as a volunteer coach at Drury Univ.

Cardinals Principal Owner and Chief Executive Officer **Bill DeWitt, Jr.** has been a prior owner of the Baltimore Orioles...his father, **William O. DeWitt**, began his baseball career in 1916 as a 14-year-old office boy with the St. Louis Browns, and later rejoined the organization as an executive and team owner, in the early 1940s...was majority owner of the Browns (1949-51) when Bill, Jr. served as the team's bat boy...DeWitt Jr.'s uniform (#1/8) was worn by **Eddie Gaedel** during his famous pinch hitting appearance on August 19, 1951.

Orioles Assistant Pitching Coach **Mitch Plasmeyer** was born in St. Louis...graduated from nearby DeSmet Jesuit High School in 2014...worked as MIZZOU Pitching Coach (2022) and Director of Baseball Player Development (2021-22).

**The St. Louis Browns** played 52 seasons in the American League (1902-53), playing at Sportsman's Park and sharing the same ballpark with the Cardinals from 1920-53...Coinciding with the sale of the Cardinals and Sportsman's Park to Anheuser-Busch, the Browns relocated to Baltimore and were rebranded as the Orioles in 1954.

The Baltimore Orioles of the National League went 72-30 against the St. Louis Browns/Perfectos from 1892-99 before being eliminated by the NL... Upon the foundation of the American League in 1901, a reorganized Baltimore Orioles franchise competed as a charter member, before relocating to New York City after two seasons, where they ultimately became known as the New York Yankees.

Late Hall of Fame Manager **Whitey Herzog** played 212 games as an outfielder for the Orioles over the 1961-62 seasons.

Orioles VP & AGM, Analytics **Sig Mejdal** worked for St. Louis for seven seasons (2005-11), spending his final year as the team's Director, Amateur Draft Analysis...began pro baseball career as a Quantitative Analyst for the Cardinals in 2005.

**Matt Slater**, Cardinals Special Assistant to the GM, Player Procurement, was a member of the Orioles front office from 1995-99.

Bally Sports reporter **Alexa Datt** was born in Derwood, Md...graduated from Col. Zadok Magruder High School and the University of Maryland.

In the only all-St. Louis World Series, Sportman's Park hosted the 1944 Fall Classic as the Cardinals defeated the Browns, 4-2, for their 5th World Series title...dubbed the "St. Louis Showdown," "Trolley Series," and "Streetcar Series" as many fans used that mode of travel to and from the ballpark...third World Series in which both teams had the same home field (1921 & 1922 at New York City's Polo Grounds)...remains one of four World Series to feature teams from the same city (1906 Chicago & 1921-22 in New York).

The Cardinals defeated the Orioles, 4-1, in the 40th Hall of Fame Game at Cooperstown (Aug. 1, 1983)...St. Louis minor leaguer **Danny Cox**, who started and earned the win, would make his big league debut five days later against the Phillies.

### TONIGHT'S GAME

- Makes his 8th start of the season tonight and his 15th career start against the Orioles.
- Is a perfect 3-0 in Interleague starts this season, beating the Athletics, White Sox and Angels.
- Tops the Cardinals with his 5 wins this season, ranking T-5th in the N.L. Has recorded decisions in all seven starts, with both of his losses coming against Milwaukee.
- Has MLB leading K% on Sweeper pitch, fanning 30 in 46 plate appearances (65.2).
- Allowed a career-high 3 HR's and a season-high 6 runs on 7 hits in 7-1 loss at Milwaukee on 5/9.
- Rookie Pedro Pagés has caught his last two starts after teaming with Willson Contreras for four and Iván Herrera for one (season debut on 4/9).
- Surpassed 1,600 career innings in his 5/3 start vs. the White Sox, firing 7.0 scoreless innings of three -hit ball in a 3-0 win, his 7th career win vs. the Pale Hose, the opponent he has his 3rd-most wins against.
- Opened the season with 17.0 scoreless innings, longest by a Cardinals starting pitcher this season and 4th-longest in MLB. The last time a Cardinals starting pitcher opened the season with 17.0+ scoreless innings was **Woody Williams** (24.2 IP) in 2003, who set the franchise record in the Divisional Era (1969-present). - *Elias*
- Had an 0.89 ERA through his first five starts with St. Louis, lowest by a Cardinal in his first five appearances as a starter with the organization since 1910.
- Struck out 12 batters vs. Milwaukee (April 21), his most since a career-high 13 vs. Houston (April 7, 2023); the 15th double-digit strikeout game of his career.
- Ranks T-13th among active pitchers with 103 career wins. Is joined by teammates **Lance Lynn** (137, 6th) and **Kyle Gibson** (106, T-11th) in the top-20.
- Gray is one of three free-agent starters (**Lance Lynn & Kyle Gibson**) that the Cardinals signed this past off-season.
- Has joined his fifth Major League team: Athletics (2013-17), Yankees (2017-18), Reds (2019-21), Twins (2022-23) and Cardinals (2024).

### CAREER

- Selected by the Oakland Athletics in the 1st round (18th overall) of the 2011 Major League Draft out of Vanderbilt University.
- His 3.46 career ERA ranks 6th among active pitchers & 1,574 strikeouts rank 16th.
- Has made seven career starts at Busch Stadium, with four of those being Quality Starts. He is 2-3, 2.90 ERA career at Busch (40.1 IP/13 ER). Five of his seven starts at Busch Stadium were with the Cincinnati Reds.

### 2024

- Has struck out 53 batters over his first seven starts for the Cardinals, 2nd most in franchise history behind **Fred Beebe's** 54 K's in his 1st seven starts as a Cardinal (1906).
- Struck out a season-high 12 batters over 6.2 innings in a 2-0 loss to MIL (4/21). Marked his 15th career double-digit strikeout game and first since a career-high 13 vs. HOU (4/7/23).
- Threw a season-high 7.0 scoreless innings in a 3-0 win over the White Sox on 5/3, lowering his ERA to 0.89, the lowest by a Cardinals pitcher in his first five starts with the club since 1910.
- Made his Cardinals regular season debut on April 9 vs. Philadelphia. Joined **John Smoltz** (Aug. 23, 2009 at San Diego - 5 IP, 3 H, 0 R, 0 BB, 9 K) as the 2nd Cardinal since 1901 (37th MLB pitcher overall) to pitch 5.0+ scoreless innings with 5 hits or fewer, zero walks, and 5+ strikeouts in his first game with the franchise.
- Struck out **Bryce Harper** (swinging) on April 9 for his first strikeout in a Cardinals uniform.
- Began the season on the 15-day I.L. with right hamstring injury, suffered on March 4.
