MANAGER: Pat Murphy (450g, 268-182, .596) is in his third season as Brewers manager.....he was voted NL Manager of the Year in 2024 and 2025.....he is one of four managers ever to win Manager of the Year in consecutive seasons, joining the Braves' Bobby Cox (2004-05), Rays' Kevin Cash (2020-21) and Guardians' Stephen Vogt (2024-25).....Murphy was named the 20th manager in franchise history on 11/15/23, replacing Craig Counsell.....he signed a multi-year contract extension on 2/20/26.

COACHES: Offense & strategy coordinator **Jason Lane** (11th season/1st in current role), pitching coordinator **Jim Henderson** (5th season/1st in current role), field coordinator **Néstor Corredor** (4th season/3rd in current role), pitching coach **Chris Hook** (8th season), assistant pitching coach **Juan Sandoval** (1st season), bullpen coach **Charlie Greene** (3rd season), lead hitting coach **Eric Theisen** (2nd season/1st in current role), hitting coach **Guillermo Martinez** (1st season), hitting coach **Daniel Vogelbach** (1st season), first base coach **Spencer Allen** (1st season), third base coach **Matt Erickson** (3rd season/1st in current role).

IN THE STANDINGS [146 days]: The team has spent the following number of days alone or tied at each spot in the NL Central standings: **FIRST:** 108, **SECOND:** 10, **THIRD:** 8, **FOURTH:** 13, **FIFTH:** 7.....the Brewers are currently in first place, leading the second-place Cubs by 4.5 games.....the team has held first place for the last 92 days.

AT HOME: The Brewers are 42-22 at home, going 15-4-1 in series play.....after a 7-7 start, the team has gone 35-15 (.700) at home.....the team has a pair of season-high 5-game winning streaks coming from 4/30-5/12 and 5/25-6/2.

ON THE ROAD: The Brewers are 36-26 on the road, going 12-7-1 in series play.....had season-high 5-game winning streaks from 5/31-6/8 and 6/21-7/3.

LET'S GO TO THE VIDEO TAPE: The Brewers have made 33 replay challenges this season, going 24-9.....their last challenge (won) came on 8/18 vs. Seattle as a safe call at second base involving Brock Rodden was overturned (caught stealing).

BREWING SUCCESS: The Brewers have qualified for the postseason seven times in the last eight seasons and three seasons in a row.....the team was just two games away from making the postseason in nine straight seasons (2017-25), missing out in both 2017 and 2022 by a single game.....Milwaukee has won the NL Central in four of the last five seasons and three seasons in a row.

BREWING CONSISTENCY: The Brewers, Astros and Dodgers are the only Major League teams with 86+ wins in each of the last eight full seasons (2017-25).....this does not include the shortened 2020 season.....the Brewers have 841 wins since 2017, which ranks fourth in the majors behind the Dodgers (929), Astros (869) and Yankees (858).

MAY AT A GLANCE: Dustin May, 28, will be making his 24th start of the season and first against the Mariners.....it will be his third start for the Brewers.....May last started last Wednesday at San Diego and had no decision in a 4-3, 11-inning loss (7ip, 4h, 1r, 1er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 83 pitches).....he left with a 2-1 lead.....he was acquired from St. Louis on August 3 with LHP JoJo Romero for OF Alexander Frias and OF Josiah Ragsdale.....his teams are 11-12 in his starts (1-1 w/MIL).....he has 12 quality starts (2 w/MIL).....opponents are batting .247 (112-for-454, 9hr).....he is 1-0 with a 2.08 ERA in 2 starts with the Brewers (13ip, 7h, 3r, 3er, 5bb, 11k, 2hr).....May has a mutual option for 2027.

LAST SEASON: May went 7-11 with a 4.96 ERA in 25 games/23 starts between Los Angeles-NL (19g/18gs) and Boston (6g, 5gs).....his teams went 10-13 in his starts.....he had 10 quality starts.....opponents batted .259 (132-for-510, 21hr).....he was traded by the Dodgers to the Red Sox on July 31.

CAREER: Has gone 25-27 with a 3.93 ERA in 94 games/80 starts (446ip, 388h, 211r, 195er, 153bb, 414k, 49hr).....has pitched for Los Angeles-NL (2019-25), Boston (2025), St. Louis (2026) and Milwaukee (2026).....has three World Series rings with the Dodgers (2020, 2024 and 2025).....he missed the entire 2024 season while recovering from “Tommy John” surgery and an esophageal tear.....it was his second “Tommy John” surgery (also 5/11/21).....May was selected by the Dodgers in the third round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft from Northwest (TX) High School.

CAREER AT AMERICAN FAMILY FIELD: Is 1-1 with a 2.45 ERA in 3 starts (14.2ip, 4er).....is 1-1 with a 2.08 ERA in 2 starts this season (13ip, 3er).....he took a no-hitter into the eighth inning against the Brewers on May 27 but took a 2-1 loss.

CAREER ON THE ROAD: Is 12-15 with a 4.58 ERA in 46 games/38 starts (202.1ip, 103er).....is 2-4 with a 5.59 ERA in 10 starts this season (48.1ip, 30er).

CAREER vs. MARINERS: His only career outing against Seattle came with the Dodgers in a start and 4-3 loss on 4/19/21 at T-Mobile Park (5ip, 4h, 4r, 3er, 1bb, 8k, 2hr, 1hbp).

ODDS & ENDS: Prior to being drafted by the Dodgers was committed to Texas Tech University.....he resides in Justin, TX.....is married.....wife’s name is Millie.
