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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues a six-game road trip tonight through Toronto (1-2) and New York-NL (1-0, 2 to play)...The Birds are coming off a 2-5 homestand, having been swept in a four-game set by the Red Sox before taking two of three from the Guardians...Baltimore is 3.0 games behind Cleveland for the final Wild Card spot with Toronto (1.0 GB) and Texas (1.5 GB) also in the mix.

- 👉 **Gunnar Henderson** gave the Birds a 2-1 lead with a solo homer in the eighth frame...It marked his eighth career go-ahead home run in the eighth inning or later, including his second this season...On April 7 at Chicago-AL, Henderson broke a 2-2 tie in the eighth frame with a two-run shot off Chris Murphy.
- 👉 **Brandon Young** did not factor into the decision after working 5.0 innings, allowing one run on five hits (1 HR) and five walks with six strikeouts...He became the second Oriole starter this season to allow one or zero runs while issuing five walks, joining **Trevor Rogers** on July 3 at Cincinnati (W, 5.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 5 BB, 4 K).
- 👉 The Birds struck out 12 times in yesterday's win...Baltimore has double-digit strikeouts in each of its last five games and in nine of its last 11 contests...The O's have 10+ strikeouts in a franchise-record 68 games, surpassing the team record set by the 2021 club (67 G)...The 68 such games are fifth most in the majors ahead of the Angels (73 G), Reds (72 G), White Sox (71 G), and Pirates (69 G).
- 👉 After going 1-for-9 with runners in scoring position last night, the Birds have exactly one hit with RISP in each of their last three games (3-for-27, .111) after going 13-for-28 (.464) over their previous three games.
- 👉 Oriole pitching has permitted at least one home run in eight straight games, their second-longest streak of the season behind a 15-game run from April 12-28.

QUEENS GAMBIT: **Pete Alonso** hit his 299th career home run Saturday...He looks to become one of 19 active players in the majors to reach 300 career home runs, led by NYY's Giancarlo Stanton (456) and LAA's Mike Trout (425).

- 👉 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, Alonso can become the 20th player in MLB history to hit his 300th career home run against his former club...Andrew McCutchen was the last to accomplish the feat, homering at Philadelphia during his second stint with Pittsburgh on April 14, 2024.
- 👉 Alonso's 35 home runs this year are the sixth most by an Oriole in their first season with the club, trailing Frank Robinson (49, 1966), Mark Trumbo (47, 2016), Nelson Cruz (40, 2014), Mark Reynolds (37, 2011), and Albert Belle (37, 1999).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 18 straight games, slashing .281/.352/.578 (18-for-64) with one double, six home runs, 13 runs, 13 RBI, and six walks.

- 👉 It is the second-longest on-base streak by an Oriole this season, trailing Taylor Ward's 20-game run from July 1-27.
- 👉 Mayo's .559 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is second highest in the AL (min. 100 AB) behind TB's Victor Mesa Jr. (.609).
- 👉 Since August 31, he is 7-for-27 (.259) with three home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.
- 👉 Mayo is batting .321/.384/.737 (44-for-137) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.121) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole trailing Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

MORE ON THE POLAR BEAR: **Pete Alonso** ranks among AL leaders in RBI (1st, 100), home runs (4th, 35), total bases (4th, 280), OPS (5th, .859), slugging percentage (5th, .496), extra-base hits (7th, 59), hits (7th, 151), and runs (8th, 89).

- 👉 Alonso has started all 151 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with ATL's Matt Olson...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- 👉 He's played in 567 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (933 G).
- 👉 Alonso leads HOU's Yordan Alvarez (96) for the most RBI in the AL...He looks to become the eighth player in franchise history (since 1954) to lead the AL in RBI, joining Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- 👉 According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 17 games (15.2 IP) since August 6...It's the longest scoreless streak, by games, by an Oriole since **Yennier Cano** (17 G) from April 14-May 17, 2023...The last to do so in 18 straight games in a single season was Donnie Hart's 18-game stretch from July 17-September 20, 2016.

- 👉 Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs (14).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's lead the AL and rank fourth in the majors with 557 walks this season behind the Cubs (636 BB), Brewers (620 BB), and Dodgers (578 BB)...The White Sox are second in the AL with 545 free passes.

- 👉 According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954), including for the first time since 1990.
- 👉 Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 49-51 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors with the Cardinals and Guardians...Their .490 winning percentage in those games ranks 18th in the majors.

- 👉 Baltimore is 17-22 in one-run games this year, but the O's are 7-4 in their last 11 such contests since August 14.

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 30th start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the win on September 9 vs. Cleveland after working 5.2 innings, allowing five runs on six hits (2 HR), one walk, and two hit batters with five strikeouts...Threw 100 pitches, 61 strikes.

⚡ Improved to 2-13 in his career when allowing at least five earned runs, joining his victory on June 20, 2025 vs. Detroit (5.1 IP, 4 H, 5 ER, 1 HR, 4 BB, 6 K).

⚡ Permitted two home runs for the first time since allowing a career-high five long balls on August 19, 2025 vs. New York-AL...Prior to the outing, Baz was the only Oriole in franchise history (since 1954) to pitch at least 4.0 innings without allowing more than one home run in each of their first 28 starts with the team, surpassing the previous record held by Jim Hardin (19 GS, 1967-68).

⚡ The two hit batters tied a career high, joining September 28, 2024 at Boston.

CONCRETE JUNGLE: Baz earned the win in his lone career start opposite the Mets on June 15, 2025 at Citi Field...He threw 6.2 scoreless innings, scattering three hits, four walks, and one hit batter with six strikeouts.

⚡ He has allowed three runs or fewer in each of his seven Interleague starts this season, posting a 3.20 ERA (14 ER/39.1 IP), but is 1-4 in those outings, with the Birds going 1-6 in the contests.

RUNS, YOU SAY?: In his last outing, Baz received eight runs of support, all coming in the third inning, after receiving a total of 10 runs of support across his previous eight outings from July 26-September 4.

⚡ Overall, his 3.46 run support average is fourth lowest in MLB ahead of KC's Michael Wacha (3.40), NYY's Cam Schlitler (3.41),and CLE's Tanner Bibee (3.45).

⚡ Baz is 6-2 with a 3.55 ERA (20 ER/50.2 IP) in nine starts this season when receiving four or more runs of support...In 20 starts when receiving three runs or fewer, he is 0-13 with a 4.26 ERA (56 ER/118.1 IP).

NOW WE TURN THE TIDE: Despite posting a 4.03 ERA (39 ER/87.0 IP) over his last 15 starts since June 18, he is 2-9 in those outings, with the Orioles going 3-12 in his starts.

⚡ The Birds have lost 21 of his 29 starts this season.

⚡ His 15 losses are tied for the most in MLB along with CLE's Tanner Bibee (15)...The 15 losses are the most by an Oriole since Dylan Bundy (16) in 2018.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 35 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted 14 home runs over 197.1 innings (0.64 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

⚡ His 0.75 home runs per nine innings this season signal the lowest mark by an Orioles starter (min. 25 GS) since Zach Britton (0.70 HR/9.0 IP) in 2011.

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Baz has allowed 42 doubles, second most in MLB behind KC's Seth Lugo (44)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

⚡ His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

SECONDARY STUFF: Over his last eight starts, opponents are slashing .429/.500/.619 (9-for-21) with a double and a home run off Baz's changeup...He opened the season holding opponents to a .250 (7-for-28) clip on the offering.

⚡ During the same time period, he has held the opposition to a .133 (2-for-15) mark with one home run off his cutter...Opponents opened the year hitting .261 (24-for-92) with seven doubles and three homers off the pitch.

TEERING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .330/.344/.604 (30-for-91) with 13 doubles and four home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat.

Per *STATS Perform*, he is the third player in team history (since 1954) with 100+ RBI and 75+ walks in his first season with the Orioles, joining Albert Belle in 1999 (117 RBI, 101 BB) and Frank Robinson in 1966 (122 RBI, 87 BB)
