THE TWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip by going 1-2 against the Guardians in Cleveland over the weekend, avoiding the sweep with a victory on Sunday...tonight, they will continue the trip with the first of three at Comerica Park against the Tigers...they will complete the series on Wednesday afternoon then travel home for an off-day on Thursday, followed by a short three-game homestand/series vs. Kansas City next weekend.

A. ONE. RUN. WIN. IN. CLEVELAND.: The Twins beat the Guardians yesterday afternoon at Progressive Field by a score of 5-4...José Ureña made his Twins debut, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...Kody Funderburk got the win and Justin Topa, Cole Sands and Michael Tonkin each earned a hold, with Erasmo Ramírez earning his sixth major league save in his Twins debut...the offense scored four of their five runs in the first inning and put up an insurance run with a Kody Clemens safety squeeze bunt in the eighth...Matt Wallner had two hits, including a triple, and walked.

4 Yesterday's win was the Twins' first on the road since July 22 at Los Angeles-NL...also their first overall win since last Monday over Boston at Target Field.

SWR TO IL: The Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson on the 15-day Injured List with an illness...Woods Richardson has made 17 appearances (16 starts) for the Twins this season, going 5-4, 4.24 ERA (80.2 IP, 38 ER), 35 walks, 69 strikeouts, a 1.40 WHIP and a .252 opponent batting average...to replace Woods Richardson on the 26-man roster, the Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Darren McCaughan from Triple-A St. Paul...McCaughan has pitched in 17 games (10 starts) for St. Paul this season, going 5-5, 5.35 ERA (72.1 IP, 43 ER), 25 walks and 66 strikeouts...this will mark his second stint with Minnesota this season after appearing in three games for the Twins from March 31-April 6, allowing one run on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts.

I SAW A TIGER: The Twins and Tigers are playing the seventh of 13 games this season...these two last met for three games at Comerica Park from June 27-29 as the Twins won game one and lost games two and three...game three was a Sunday night game, where Skubal beat Paddack.

♣ The Iwins last win against the Tigers, on June 27, was their 500th over Detroit (since 1961)...

marks their second-most over any opponent, trailing their 544 wins over the White Sox...of the 500 wins, 110 have come at Comerica Park, 127 at Tiger Stadium, 81 at Metropolitan Stadium, 114 at the Metrodome and 68 at Target Field.

♣ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 138, 27 ahead of Cleveland (111)...62 of those have come at Comerica Park...they have homered 22 times in their last 17 games at Comerica and 13 times in their last nine here.

♣ Christian Vázquez is hitting .302 (42-for-139) with nine doubles, six home runs and 21 RB in 42 career games vs. the Tigers...

♣ Royce Lewis is hitting .366 (15-for-41) with three doubles, two home runs, six walks, nine RBI and a 1.032 OPS in 13 career games vs. the Tigers...he has reached base safely in all 13 career games vs. the Tigers...at Comerica Park, he is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with two home runs and a 1.149 OPS in six career games.

♣ Brooks Lee is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with two doubles and seven RBI in nine career games vs. the Tigers...

YES JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in six-straight, two short of his season-high of eight (done twice)...over his last 18 games, Jeffers is hitting .349 (22-for-63) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, a .388 on-base percentage, a .460 slugging percentage and an .848 OPS...in those 18, he has reached safely in 14.

THE MOOSE IS ON THE LOOSE: Over his last 14 games, Wallner has reached base safely in 12 games, posting a .396 on-base percentage (11 hits, 10 walks) and a 1.015 OPS in that span.
◆ He enters tonight with 14 home runs on the season, matching his single-season career-high, also done in 2023.

STONE COLD AUSTIN: Dating back to August 19, 2024, Austin Martin is hitting .304 (21-for-69) with seven doubles, five RBI, four walks, a .351 on-base percentage and a .757 OPS in 24 games for the Twins.

KEASCHALL UPDATE: Twins infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) played in his 14th game on rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo yesterday, going 1-for-4 with a single and a run scored...Keaschall was placed on the 10-day IL with a right forearm fracture after being hit by a Kyle Hendricks pitch on April 25 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

MORE THAN ABEL: Newly acquired right-handed pitcher Mick Abel made his Twins organization debut yesterday in a start for Triple-A St. Paul at Toledo...Abel pitched 5.0 shutout innings, with one hit allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts...Abel hit 96+ mph eight times with his fastball and averaged 95.3 mph on the day with the pitch...he was acquired on July 30 from Philadelphia, along with catcher Eduardo Tait, in exchange for Jhoan Duran.

TWINS Milb MONTHLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita infielder Kaelen Culpepper and left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for July.

◆ Culpepper, 22, played in 19 games for the Wind Surge during the month, hitting .395 (30-for-76) with four doubles, four home runs, 14 RBI, 11 runs scored, eight walks, four stolen bases, a .459 on-base percentage, a .605 slugging percentage and a 1.064 OPS...the club's fifth-best prospect was selected by the Twins in the first round (21st overall) in the 2024 MLB Draft out of Kansas State University

State University.

Prielipp, 24, made four starts in July for the Wind Surge, going 0-1, 1.20 ERA (15.0 IP, 2 ER), with five walks, 17 strikeouts and just 12 hits allowed...the club's 10th-best prospect (4th pitcher) was selected by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) in the 2022 MLB Draft out of the University of Alabama.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1985, Rod Carew became the 16th player ever to collect 3,000 career hits as he recorded it off Minnesota's Frank Viola, singling in the third inning at Anaheim Stadium.

NATIONALS GUARD: Last appeared as the bulk pitcher vs. Washington on July 27 and was dealt his first major league loss in Minnesota's 2-7 defeat...allowed five runs on five hits, with two walks and three strikeouts in 3.1 innings of work...entered in the fourth inning, allowing a sac fly to Paul DeJong...then allowed a RBI single to Josh Bell, a two-run single to Alex Call and a sac fly to Daylen Lile all in the fifth...plunked CJ Abrams twice; once in the fifth and once in the sixth...also recorded a wild pitch in the sixth, followed by a flyball and a walk before being replaced by Brock Stewart

TWO APPEARANCES AGO: Made his third career MLB appearance on July 18 at Colorado, throwing the eighth inning in relief...made Ryan Ritter fly out, fanned Brenton Doyle, allowed a double to Mickey Moniak, and struck out Jordan Beck.

MLB DEBUT: Pitched in his MLB debut on July 5 vs. Tampa Bay as the bulk pitcher, opposite Rays starter Taj Bradley...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 walkoff victory over the Rays; allowed five runs on nine hits, with no walks and one strikeout in 4.0 innings of relief...entered the game in the third inning, allowing an RBI double to Danny Jansen, followed by an RBI double in the fourth to Josh Lowe, two sacrifice flies to Yandy Díaz and Junior Caminero in the fifth, fanned Josh Lowe in the sixth for his first career MLB strikeout and finally allowed a sacrifice fly to Chandler Simpson also in the sixth

ripson, also in the SACL.

**Became the fourth Twin and first pitcher, to make his major league debut this season, joining Luke Keaschall (April 18), Ryan Fitzgerald (May 16) and Carson McCusker (May 18).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In nine games (2 starts) at home in Triple-A this season, Adams is 2-2 with a 4.05 ERA (33.1 IP, 15 ER), two home runs, 16 walks and 34 strikeouts, compared to 1-0 with a 3.26 ERA (30.1 IP, 11 ER), one home run, four walks and 24 strikeouts in 10 road appearances (3 starts).

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through four major league appearances, left-handed hitters have slashed

LETTINION STATES: INFOURT TOUR MAJOR league appearances, lett-named nitters have stashed .150/.200/.200 in 20 at-bats vs. Adams, while righties have stashed .150/.200/.200 in 20 at-bats... lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 90.6 mph, a hard-hit percentage of 50.0 and a whiff rate of 17.2; compared to righties' 88.2 mph, 42.1 hard-hit percentage and 19.6 whiff rate.

◆ In 19 Triple-A appearances (5 starts) this season, left-handed batters have hit .290 (29-for-100) with a .357 on-base percentage, .410 slugging percentage and .767 OPS.right-handed batters have hit .209 (29-for-139), with a .268 on-base percentage, a .295 slugging percentage and a .620 OPS and a .620 OPS
