THE TWINS: Completed their final roadtrip of the 2024 season with a record of 2-5, going 1-3 in Cleveland and 1-2 in Boston...

At 81-75, the Twins need one win in their final six games to secure a winning record for the second-straight season (87-75 in 2023) and fourth time in six seasons under Rocco Baldelli.

BAD NEWS DAY IN BOSTON: The Twins were swept on the day Sunday in their doubleheader at Fenway Park, losing game one by a score of 8-1 and losing game two by a score of 9-3...

YOU'LL HAVE TO DO IT YOURSELF: Minnesota enters tonight at 81-75 and 1.0 game back of the second and third Wild Card spots...

Table with columns: W-L, GB, LAST 10, SINGE ASB, YESTERDAY, TONIGHT. Rows for Baltimore, Detroit, Kansas City, Minnesota, Seattle.

NOTE: Twins own the tiebreaker over Kansas City (7-6), Detroit (7-6) and Seattle (5-2).

GONE FISHIN': Twins and Marlins are playing each other for the 20th, 21st and 22nd times in their history this week...

The last time the Twins hosted the Marlins came in a three-game series from June 7-9, 2016 as the Twins won two games...

19 games against the Marlins is the fewest for Minnesota against any opponent in their history (Colorado, San Francisco and Washington all next fewest with 24 each).

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 17-26 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego, 1-2 vs. St. Louis, 0-3 vs. Atlanta and 1-2 vs. Cincinnati...

By comparison, the Twins have gone 64-49 against American League opponents.

Byron Buxton is hitting .317 (32-for-101) with three doubles, nine home runs, 19 RBI, a .614 slugging percentage and a .983 OPS in 28 games against the NL this season...

Buxton has 28 career home runs in Interleague Play, second most in Twins history, trailing only Torii Hunter (33).

C4, EXP-LOS-IVE: Carlos Correa went 0-for-4 in game two of the doubleheader in Boston on Sunday night, snapping his on-base streak at 20...

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins are slashing .255/.312/.427 (.738 OPS) against left-handed pitching, compared to .245/.318/.409 (.727 OPS) against right-handers.

The Twins are 21-23 when facing a left-handed starter...they went 16-9 when facing a left-handed starter prior to the All-Star break, but have since gone 5-14.

Minnesota's .256 average against lefties ranks second the AL and ranks seventh-best in baseball...the Twins' .427 slugging percentage vs. lefties leads the AL and ranks sixth in baseball.

In his last 42 games against lefties (since June 5) Carlos Santana is slashing .299/.384/.667 (1.051 OPS).

In his last 15 games against left-handed pitching, Manny Margot is slashing .324/.378/.441 (.820 OPS)...Margot, who typically leads off against left-handed starters, is hitting .357 (.35-for-98) from the leadoff spot against left-handed pitching, the fourth-best in baseball, trailing Yandy Diaz (.367), Jose Altuve (.364) and Ketel Marte (.361).

FARMER'S ONLY: Kyle Farmer has hit safely in a career-high 13-straight games with an at-bat, hitting .405 (15-for-37) with three doubles, three home runs, five RBI and a 1.180 OPS in that span...

In 19 games this month, he is hitting .395 with a .711 slugging percentage and a 1.150 OPS...among all MLB players with a minimum of 40 September plate appearances, he ranks third in batting average, trailing Victor Robles (.444) and Randal Grichuk (.400)...

his slugging percentage ranks third, trailing Grichuk (.950) and Shohei Ohtani (.756)...his OPS also ranks third, behind Grichuk (1.392) and Ohtani (1.180).

TEXAS LEAGUE ALL-STARS: Right-handed pitchers Zebby Matthews and Andrew Morris, and outfielder Carson McCusker have been named Texas League Postseason All-Stars, representing the Twins' Double-A affiliate, the Wichita Wind Surge.

Matthews, 24, made 10 appearances (9 starts) for the Wind Surge from May 9-July 9, going 2-1, 1.95 ERA (55.1 IP, 12 ER) with six walks, 63 strikeouts (10.3 K/9.0 IP) and a .180 opponent batting average...

Morris, 23, made 12 appearances (10 starts) for the Wind Surge from May 21-August 7, going 6-3, 1.90 ERA (61.2 IP, 13 ER) with 14 walks, 63 strikeouts (9.2 K/9.0 IP) and a .210 opponent batting average...

McCusker, 26, played in 98 games for the Wind Surge, hitting .281 (104-for-370) with 26 doubles, 15 home runs, 64 RBI, 56 runs scored, a .357 on-base percentage and an .846 OPS...

ON THIS DAY IN DAZZLE HISTORY: In 1984, the original Ironman, Dan Gladden, played both games of a doubleheader while playing for San Francisco, hosting San Diego, leading off and playing centerfield...

Gladden had four hits in eight at-bats on the day, with one RBI, two runs scored, two walks, one strikeout and one stolen base...

Gladden played 349 career games in centerfield, 284th most all-time among right-handed-throwing players born in the U.S., trailing Tony Gwynn, Jr. (350) and ahead of Hersh Martin (346); 38 more games and he would have tied Peanuts Lowrey (387) for 268th...

17 more games and he would have tied good ol' Wally Westlake (366) for 275th.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Last pitched on September 18 at Cleveland and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-inning, 5-4 loss...allowed two runs on four hits (2 HR) in 7.0 innings, with no walks and a career-high 12 strikeouts; previous high was 11 on July 28, 2024 at Detroit...both runs came on Josh Naylor solo home runs.

- ☞ Induced 17 whiffs on 54 swings (31.5%).
- ☞ Tied with Pablo López for the team lead with his 18th quality start...also ranks T-10th in the American League and T-14th in MLB in quality starts.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on September 13 vs. Cincinnati...took the loss, allowing five runs on six hits (1 HR) in 6.2 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed second-inning solo home run to TJ Friedl, then five runs on three hits in the seventh...was pulled with two on and two outs in the seventh; Jorge Alcalá entered, allowing a walk and a grand slam.

**VS. MIAMI:** Making first career start and appearance vs. Miami.  
 ☞ In six Interleague starts this season, is 1-2, 6.89 ERA (31.1 IP, 24 ER), nine walks, 29 strikeouts, a 1.28 WHIP and a .263 (31-for-118) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ In 17 career Interleague starts he is 4-3, 4.70 ERA (90.0 IP, 47 ER), 26 walks, 80 strikeouts, a 1.16 WHIP and a .233 (78-for-335) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ After tonight, will have faced 27 of 29 opponents in his career – all but New York-NL and Chicago-NL.

**BACK AT HOME:** Making his 14th home start of the season...in the previous 13, he's gone 7-3 with a 4.07 ERA (73.0 IP, 33 ER), 21 walks, 81 strikeouts, a 1.05 WHIP and a .207 (56-for-270) opponent batting average...in 16 road starts, he is 5-4, 3.67 ERA (95.2 IP, 39 ER), 20 walks, 99 strikeouts, a 0.91 WHIP and a .195 (67-for-343) opponent batting average.  
 ☞ Has gone 14-7 with a 3.74 ERA (221.1 IP, 92 ER) in 42 career home starts, compared to 11-12 with a 3.68 ERA (240.0 IP, 98 ER) in 44 road starts.  
 ☞ The Twins are 8-5 in Ober's 13 home starts this season.  
 ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second on the Twins in home wins with 14, trailing Joe Ryan (19).

**REVERSE SPLITS:** Through 29 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .182 (52-for-286) with a .589 OPS and 26.8 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .217 (71-for-327) with a .684 OPS and 27.4 percent strikeout rate.  
 ☞ On September 13, Cleveland left-handed hitters went 4-for-16 with two home runs and seven strikeouts against Ober...right-handed hitters went 0-for-9 with five strikeouts.  
 ☞ Lefties have a 27.7 percent whiff rate and 86.2 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, righties a 30.1 percent whiff rate and 89.0 mph average exit velocity.  
 ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .227 (183-for-807) with 41 doubles, three triples, 27 home runs and a .665 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .225 (205-for-912) with 37 doubles, eight triples, 44 home runs and a .694 OPS.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP SIMEON WOODS RICHARDSON (2024: 5-5, 4.00 ERA // CAREER: 5-6, 4.17 ERA)

Right-hander Simeon Woods Richardson is scheduled to start tomorrow night vs. Miami...last pitched on September 19 at Cleveland, allowing one run on five hits, one walk and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings; didn't factor into the decision of Cleveland's 3-2 win...is facing Miami for the first time in his career...is making his 10th Interleague start of the season; in the previous nine, he is 2-3, 4.22 ERA (42.2 IP, 20 ER), 16 walks, 38 strikeouts, a 1.36 WHIP and a .259 (42-for-162) opponent batting average.

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
- Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
