ABBOTT AN ALL-STAR: On Tue, LHP Andrew Abbott was named to the National League All-Star team as a replacement for LAD's Yoshinobu Yamamoto. • It's his first career All-Star selection.

ELLY DE LA ALL-STAR: SS EIIy De La Cruz has been named to the National League All-Star team for the second consecutive season.

- He's the first Reds player to be selected as an All-Star in back-to-back years since **Joey Votto** (2017-18).
- Is the <u>sixth</u> primary shortstop in Reds history to make consecutive All-Star teams, joining Barry Larkin (1988-91, '93-'97, '99-2000), David Concepcion (1975-82), Leo Cardenas (1964-66), Roy McMillan (1955-57), and Eddie Miller (1943-44, '46-'47).
- Is the seventh Red to earn multiple All-Star selections within his first 3 career seasons, the first since **Chris Sabo** (1988, '90).
- Joins Johnny Bench (4, 1968-71), Frank Robinson (3, 1956-59), and Vada Pinson (2, 1959-60) as the only Reds players named to multiple All-Star teams before turning 24.

FRANCONA CLOSING IN ON 2000 WINS: Terry Francona enters tonight's game 3 wins away from reaching 2.000 as a Major League manager.

- He'd become the 13th manager to reach the 2,000-win milestone.
- Would be the second active manager in the majors with 2,000 wins (Tex' Bruce Bochy 2,216).
- Each big league skipper with 2,000 career wins, except for **Bochy** and **Dusty Baker**, are in the Hall of Fame.
- Baker (2,183) and Sparky Anderson (2,194 wins) are the only 2,000win skippers to manage the Reds.
- Leo Durocher is the only 2,000-win manager to play for Cin (1930-33).
- Would be the fourth manager to earn his 2,000th win for a team he once played for (1987), joining Bochy (SF), Bucky Harris (Det), and John McGraw (NYG).

SERIES NOTES: The Reds are 136-106 all-time vs the **Marlins**, including 43-29 here at **Great American Ball Park**.

- The Marlins have clinched the 2025 season series vs Cin...it's Mia's first season series victory over the Reds since 2018 (5-2).
- Cin went 1-2 at Mia from 4/21-4/23 when the roof was open for all 3 games at loanDepot park...it marked the Reds' first series loss to the Marlins since 8/7-8/9, 2023 at GABP (1-2).
- The Reds have gone 25-15 over the last 7 seasons (6-1 in 2019, 0-0 in 2020, 5-2 in 2021, 4-3 in 2022, 3-3 in 2023, 5-2 in 2024, <u>2-4 in 2025</u>) following 4 straight season series losses to the **Marlins**.

NO ROOM FOR THE BROOM: The Reds have not been swept in any of their first 30 series this season, including this 4-game set vs **Mia** (1-2).

- Marks their longest streak of consecutive series without being swept to open a season since 1989, when that team also went 30 straight series before getting broomed in a 3-game set from 7/17-7/19 vs **Phi**.
- Only the 1970 Reds team, which won the NL Pennant, opened a season with a longer streak, going 32 straight series before getting swept in a 2-game set at Chc from 7/22-23.
- <u>The Reds are the only Major League team that have yet to be swept this</u>
 <u>season.</u>

WREAKING HAVOC IN THE FIRST: The Reds have scored at least 1 run in the 1st inning 29 times this season, including last night vs **Mia** (3r).

- Cin has plated 67 runs in the 1st inning this season, tied with LAD for second-most in the majors, behind only **Bos** (70)...this includes the 10 runs plated in the 1st inning on 5/10 at **Hou**.
- Cin has outscored opponents 67-41 in the first inning and are slashing .261/.343/.411 with 11 home runs.
- Twice didn't score a first-inning run in a season-high 8 straight games (6/29-7/7 & 6/8-6/17).
- Have plated multiple runs in the opening frame of a game 19 times this season (last: last night vs Mia), tied with the Red Sox for the most-such instances in MLB.

THE FUTURE IS HERE: C Alfredo Duno and **INF Sal Stewart** will represent the Reds organization in the 26th edition of the **All-Star Futures Game** on 7/12 at **Truist Park** in Atlanta, GA.

LAST TIME OUT: Suffered the 5-1 loss on Sat (7/5) at Phi (6.0ip, 4h, 3r/3er, 2bb, 8k, 2hr, 85TP).

- Held Phi scoreless through 4.1 innings (2h, 55TP) until Edmundo Sosa's solo homer in the 5th.
- After Alec Bohm's 1-out, 2-run homer in the 6th, induced a Nick Casatellanos ground out and a J.T. Realmuto strikeout to conclude his outing
- Was his 10th quality start...is the first time in his career he's reached 10 quality starts in a season...is the first Reds' LHP to reach 10 QS in a season since Wade Miley in 2021.

JUNE 29 vs SD: Did not factor in the decision in the 3-2 win vs SD on 6/29 (5.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er, 2bb, 5k, 1hr, 1hb, 95TP).

- The only run he allowed came off Xander Bogaerts 4th inning solo homer.
- Threw 49 pitches combined in innings 3 & 4.
- Was ahead in the count to just 38% of his 26 batters (10-of-26)...his average going into the game was 48.8%.
 Threw first pitch-strikes to 57.7% of his 26 batters (15-of-
- 26)...his average going into the game was 66.5%.
 It marked just the second time in his career in which he
- allowed at least 7 hits and fewer than 2 runs in a game... he also did it on 4/19/24 vs LAA (7-1 win, 6.1ip, 7h, 1r/1er).

JUNE 23 vs NYY: Did not factor in the decision in the 6-1 win vs NYY on Mon, 6/23 (4.1ip, 6h, 1r/1er, 0bb, 6k, 1hr, 94TP).

- Gave up Aaron Judge's 343rd career home run (1st inn.).
- Threw 53 pitches through the first 2 innings.

Was his fifth start this season in which he didn't walk anyone.

JUNE 18 CG vs MIN: Earned the rain-shortened 4-2 CG win vs Min on 6/18 at Great American Ball Park (6.0ip, 3h, 2r/2er, 2bb, 4k, 1hr, 1hb, 87TP)....the game ended in the bottom of the 6th inning with 2 outs...the 6-inning complete game marked his first CG at any professional level.

- Was his ninth quality start of the season.
- Retired 19 of the final 23 batters he faced.
- With Andrew Abbott's 9-inning complete game at Det on 6/10, the Reds turned in CGs over a 7-game for the first time since 2017 (Scott Feldman 5/7 vs SF & Lisalverto Bonilla 5/13 at SF).
- Lodolo's was the first Reds' CG at GABP since Hunter Greene's on 6/6/22 vs AZ (7ip).

JUNE 11 at CLE: Suffered the 11-2 loss on 6/11 at Cle (3.1ip, 5h, 6r/6er, 2bb, 6k, 1hr, 1hb, 76TP).

- Was his shortest start since 8/17/24 vs KC (2.1ip).
- Gave up a 3rd-inning grand slam to Carlos Santana...was the second grand slam he's allowed in his career (also: SF's Matt Chapman, 5/11/24, 1st innning).
