FLIGHT PATTERN: The St. Louis Cardinals open their 1st road trip (at BOS-3, at PIT-3) of the season this weekend, taking on the Boston Red Sox in the opening game of a three-game weekend series at Fenway Park. The Cardinals, who were off vesterday, concluded their season-opening six-game homestand on Wednesday afternoon with a 12-5 win over the LA Angels to improve to 4-2...St. Louis began their 134th season of play in the National League by handing the Minnesota Twins a three-game series sweep over the weekend ... St. Louis enters today in first place in the National League Central Division, 1/2-game in front of the Chicago Cubs.

GORMAN ON INJURED LIST/SAGGESE RECALLED: The Cardinals placed infielder Nolan Gorman (right hamstring strain) on the 10-day I.L. today, retroactive to April 2, and recalled infielder Thomas Saggese from Memphis (AAA). Saggese wears uniform no. 25.

MEETING THE MONSTER: The Cardinals have won their last three games at Fenway Park, sweeping the Red Sox here in 2023 to match their longest regular season win-streak at the ballpark. They also won three-straight here between 2003 & 2008.

IT FEELS LIKE FALL: The Cardinals have faced the Red Sox in four World Series (1946, 1967, 2004, 2013), winning in seven games in both 1946 and 1967 before losing all four in 2004 and in six games in 2013. The Cardinals 12 World Series games at Fenway Park are their 2nd-most at any road stadium (15 at Original Yankee Stadium) and most by any opponent in Fenway Park history. BOSTON BRAVES: The Cardinals also played 11 games against the Boston Braves at Fenway Park during the 1914-15 seasons to accommodate larger crowds before Braves Field was constructed.

FANTASTIC FINISHES: The Cardinals have posted six wins in the final at-bat during their regular season series with the Red Sox, four of them occurring at Fenway Park.

- June 10, 2003 at Boston (Game 1 in Series): Tied 7-7 in the 9th Jim Edmonds and Scott Rolen hit one-out doubles before Eduardo Perez singled in Rolen with an insurance run for a 9-7 as Cal Eldred closed out the game.
- June 12, 2003 at Boston (Game 3 in Series): Tied 5-5 in the 13th inning The Red Sox intentionally walked Albert Pujols with two outs and Kerry Robinson on 3rd base. Jim Edmonds hit a three-run home run for an 8-5 lead. Esteban Yan held the Red Sox to two runs in the bottom half for an 8-7 win.
- August 5, 2014 at St. Louis (Game 10 in Series): Tied 2-2 in the 8th inning A.J. Pierzynski, Oscar Taveras and Jon Jay hit three consecutive two out singles to give St. Louis a 3-2 lead. Trevor Rosenthal closed out the 9th inning for his 35th save.
- May 12, 2023 at Boston (Game 20 in Series): Trailing 6-5 in the 9th, Lars Nootbaar singled in Paul DeJong, then Nolan Gorman blasted a go-ahead two-run home run for an 8-6 victory as Ryan Helsley got the win in an appearance where 19-of-28 pitches registered 100+ MPH.
- May 13, 2023 at Boston (Game 21 in Series): Trailing 3-1 in the 9th, after back-to-back walks to lead off the inning, Nolan Gorman smacked a pinch-hit RBI double. Alec Burleson's pinch-hit fielder's choice resulted in an erratic throw allowing the go-ahead run to score.
- May 18, 2024 at St. Louis (Game 24 in Series): Tied 2-2 in the bottom of the 8th inning the Cardinals opened their half of 8th with four consecutive singles from Nolan Arenado, Alec Burleson, Ivan Herrera and Nolan Gorman to put up a 5-run inning in their final at-bat for 7-2 win.

CAPE COD CARDINALS: Cardinals to have played in the Cape Cod Baseball League include pitchers Erick Fedde (Yarmouth-Dennis 2013) and Andre Pallante (Chatham 2017), infielders Brendan Donovan (Hyannis 2017) and Alec Burleson (Bethesda 2018 & Bourne 2019), outfielders Lars Nootbaar (Orleans 2017), Victor Scott II (Cotuit 2022), coach Jon Jay (Brewster 2005), and broadcaster Ricky Horton (Chatham 1978).

Cardinals Hall of Famer John Tudor pitched his first five MLB seasons in Boston (1979-83)...was selected by the Red Sox in the 3rd round of the 1976 MLB January Draft-Secondary Phase.

Red Sox principal owner John Henry was born in Quincy, III...spent most of his childhood on the family farm in Forrest City, Ark. where he was a Cardinals fan who grew up listening to Harry Caray, Jack Buck, and Joe Garagiola on the radio...was age nine when he saw his first MLB game at Sportsman's Park in St. Louis.

Cardinals Hall of Famer **Chris Carpenter** was born in Exeter, NH...graduated from Trinity High School in Manchester, NH.

Red Sox Assistant Hitting Coach Dillon Lawson Served as an assistant coach with Lindenwood University (2007-09) and Southeast Missouri and as the hitting State University (2012-15), coach with the University of Missouri (2017).

Red Sox Catching Instructor/Bullpen Catcher Parker Guinn previously coached at Southern Illinois Edwardsville University (2015-16).

TODAY'S GAME:

- Has entered his 8th season in Major League Baseball and his 1st to begin a season with the Cardinals. Has previously pitched for the Nationals (2017-22) and White Sox (2024).
- Started the Cardinals 2nd game of season (3/29 vs. MIN) and allowed just one run on two hits in his 6.0 IP (73 pitches), earning the 5-1 win.
- Is facing the Red Sox for the 3rd time in his career and for the 1st time at Fenway Park; It's his 1st appearance against the BoSox since 10/3/21 while pitching for the Nationals.
- Improved to 2-2 with 2.97 ERA in 7 career starts at Busch Stadium, including a 2-2 mark with 1.98 ERA (27.1 IP/6 ER) in his 5 starts as a Cardinal at Busch Std. with no HR's allowed.
- Was acquired by the St. Louis Cardinals with OF Tommy Pham in a three-team/nine-player trade from the Chicago White Sox which
 included the Los Angeles Dodgers on July 29, 2024.
- Went 2-5 with a 3.72 ERA in his 10 starts with the Cardinals last season and had a 7-4 mark with 3.11 ERA in 21 starts for the White Sox.
- The White Sox were 27-81 at the time he was traded; 7 of those 27 wins (26 pct.) belonged to Fedde.
- Posted a 1.94 ERA in 13 home starts in 2024 between Guaranteed Rate Field (CWS) and Busch Stadium (STL). Ranked 2nd in MLB behind only Reynaldo Lopez (1.78) of Atlanta.
- Had four scoreless starts of 5.0 for the White Sox at home. Posted an 0.95 ERA over his first six starts at Guaranteed Rate Field, lowest by a White Sox pitcher in his first six home starts since Tommy John recorded a 0.76 ERA in 1967.
- Ran off a career-high four straight wins last season from 4/28-5/14.

FEDDE vs. BOSTON:

- Making just his 3rd career appearance (2nd start) vs. the Red Sox and his 1st career appearance at Fenway Park.
- His two previous outings came while pitching for the Washington Nationals, the last on 10/3/21 in a relief appearance.
- Owns a career mark of 0-0 with 16.20 ERA vs. Boston covering just 1.2 IP
- Is 8-7 with 3.94 ERA in 29 career Interleague games (26 starts);
- Is 6-3 in 17 games (15 starts) vs. AL East teams with wins against Baltimore (2), Tampa Bay (2) & Toronto (2).

CAREER NOTES:

- Played one season for NC Dinos of the KBO League in 2023 where he led the league in wins (20), ERA (2.00), strikeouts (209) and WHIP (0.95) over 30 starts covering 180.1 innings pitched.
- Earned the 2023 Choi Dong-won Award, annually awarded to the best pitcher in the KBO League.
- Was a member of the 2019 Washington Nationals World Championship squad, making 12 starts and 21 appearances during the
- regular season. Did not make the postseason roster but traveled with the team on the Taxi Squad. Played high school baseball at Las Vegas High School where he was teammates with Bryce Harper. Compiled a 14-8 record over his
- three-year varsity career.
 Was a two-sport athlete, starring as an All-State honoree in soccer. Helped LVHS to the 2009 Nevada High School State
- Championship, defeating Bishop Gorman 4-3 in a shootout.
- Played college baseball at the University of Nevada-Las Vegas. Was 8-2 with a 1.76 ERA (76.2 IP) over 11 starts with 82 strikeouts during his junior season in 2014.
- Drafted by the Washington Nationals in the first round (18th overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft out of UNLV.

- Made six Grapefruit League starts, the last on March 23 vs. WSH when he worked a 4.1 IP and threw 76 pitches
- Was 1-2, 3.72 ERA in his six spring starts, allowing a 1.24 WHIP in 19.1 IP with 12 strikeouts.
- Worked a spring high 5.0 IP and threw 83 pitches in March 17 win at WSH, allowing just one unearned run on three hits.
