TODAY'S GAME: The Giants will try to avoid the sweep and salvage the final game of this homestand this afternoon with the D-Backs...they are 1-4 on the homestand having gone 1-2 vs. Miami and 0-2 thus far versus Arizona.

- ▶ The Giants have lost 14 of their last 21 games dating to August 11 to fall to four games below .500...with yesterday's loss, SF has also lost each of its last four series.
- ▶ SF is 4-9 (.308) in its last 13 home games dating to August 11...it's the first time the Giants have had a .308 win % over a 13-game stretch at home since 2022 when they also went 4-9 from June 15-July 14, 2022... SF is 39-32 overall this year at Oracle Park.

STAY AWHILE, CHAP: The Giants signed **IF Matt Chapman** to a six-year, \$151 million extension that keeps the Gold Glove third baseman in a Giants uniform through the 2030 season...as part of the deal, Chapman will also make an annual contribution of \$125,000 to the Giants Community Fund during each year of the six-year pact.

- ▶ He owns a 6.0 bWAR in 136 games in 2024, tied for third-best in the National League with ARI's Ketel Marte behind LAD's Shohei Ohtani (7.0), NYM's Francisco Lindor (6.3)... it's Chapman's highest bWAR total since putting up a career-best 7.8 bWAR in the aforementioned 2019 season.
- ▶ Chapman's 22 homers are the most by a Giants third baseman since **Pablo Sandoval** hit 23 in 2011...the last Giants third baseman to hit more than 23 in a single season was also Sandoval when he hit 25 in 2009.
- ▶ The third baseman leads this year's Giants in hits (126), doubles (33), home runs (22), RBI (69), runs scored (90), walks (61) and total bases (227).

WE'RE WITH YA INDIANA JONES...: SF had its 11-series unbeaten streak versus the D-Backs at home snapped with the D-Backs clinching this series last night...it was the Giants' first series loss at home to Arizona since losing a two-game set to Arizona August 26-27, 2019.

- ▶ The Giants are trying to avoid the sweep this afternoon...the last time the Giants were swept in any three-game series by the D-Backs was July 25-27, 2022...the last time it happened here at home was May 24-26, 2019.

BUILDING BLOCKS: Giants rookies have played big roles on both sides of the ball for the Giants in 2024.

- ▶ SF's rookie pitchers have thrown 449.1 innings so far in 2024, most in the Majors just ahead of the cross-bay A's and their 442.1 innings from rookies.
- ▶ It's the most innings thrown by a group of Giants rookies in a single season since 1975 when that club's rookies combined to throw 541.1 innings.
- ▶ On the other side, SF's rookie position players have appeared in 167 games this year, 14th most in the Majors, but have combined for a .760 OPS...the .760 OPS from rookies is second-best in MLB behind San Diego's rookies with a .792 OPS (*Philadelphia's rookies have an .877 OPS but have only amassed 33 games played entering play today*).

HEAR ME ROAR: The reigning NL Pitcher of the Month **LHP Blake Snell** starts the finale this afternoon, his 17th start this year with SF.

- ▶ Snell led the Majors with 53 strikeouts in August while posting a 1.64 ERA (7er, 38.1ip) in six starts that included his first career no-hitter (also his first career shutout)...he gave up just 16 hits to the 144 batters he faced last month.
- ▶ Since returning from his second IL stint on July 9, Snell has a 1.30 ERA (9er, 62.1ip) with 83 strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .117 batting average allowed in 10 starts...the 1.30 ERA, 83 strikeouts, 0.75 WHIP and .117 average against are all best in the Majors in that time among qualified starters.
- ▶ His 1.30 ERA over his last 10 games is the lowest ERA by a Giant in a 10-game span since **RHP Kevin Gausman** had a 1.14 ERA from May 2-June 23, 2021 (min. 60.0ip).

THROWING TOO MANY PUNCHES...: The Giants struck out 14 more times last night, the 13th time in their last 20 games registering at least 10 strikeouts...not so coincidentally they have won just two of those 13 games with 10+ strikeouts.

- ▶ SF's 217 strikeouts since August 12 are tied for third-most in the Majors with Tampa Bay behind Milwaukee (223) and Boston (219).
- ▶ However, the club's 29.9% strikeout rate in that time is highest in the Majors.
- ▶ Three of last night's 14 strikeouts were called third strikes, giving SF 317 looking strikeouts for the year...the 317 strikeouts looking are fourth-most in the Majors and third-most in the NL behind the Pirates (325) and Brewers (322).

ANOTHER ONE: Giants top prospect **IF Bryce Eldridge** was named the Northwest League Player of the Month for August after his torrid month at High-A Eugene.

- ▶ He batted .376/.469/.763 and led the league in homers (nine), RBI (24), total bases (71) and SLG (.763) and was second in AVG (.376), runs (21), hits (35) and OPS (1.232)...he finished third in OBP (.469) and fifth in doubles (seven)...the 19-year-old recorded 11 multi-hit games.

This Date in Giants History

SEPTEMBER 5, 1998 - Giants outfielder **Barry Bonds** set a new NL mark reaching base in 15 consecutive plate appearances. His five singles, two doubles, two homers and six walks during the streak broke Dodger Pedro Guerrero's mark of 14 established in 1983.

CITY BY THE BLAKE: The reigning NL Cy Young winner makes his 17th start for SF...Snell joined SF late in the spring on a two-year, \$62 million contract (includes an opt out after the 2024 season).

LAST TIME OUT: Returned to form after a rough start at Seattle on August 24...struck out eight Marlins on August 30 with just one run allowed on four hits and one walk in 7.0 innings...the earned run came in the 7th inning and snapped his of 30.1 consecutive scoreless innings at home, which is the longest such streak in Oracle Park history (since 2000) according to *Elias*.

VS. ARIZONA: Will make his 10th career start vs. Arizona, and second this season.

- 👉 Faced Arizona on April 19 of this season when he was still getting stretched out after a delayed Spring Training...struck out three while allowing five runs on nine hits and a walk over 4.2 innings en route to a loss.
- 👉 Is 5-2 in his career vs. the Diamondbacks with a 1.86 ERA (11er, 53.1ip), 73 strikeouts and a 0.88 WHIP...Snell's 0.88 WHIP is his best against all teams he has at least five starts.
- 👉 His 1.86 ERA in nine starts vs. Arizona ranks third-best all-time among pitchers with at least eight starts against the Diamondbacks.

A NEW MAN: Snell has a sub-1.50 ERA in his last 10 starts...since returning from the IL on July 9, Snell is 2-0 with a 1.30 ERA (9er, 62.1ip), 83 strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .117 opposing batting average over that span...prior to this stretch, Snell was 0-3 with a 9.51 ERA (25er, 23.2ip), 31 strikeouts and a 1.94 WHIP in six starts.

- 👉 His 1.30 ERA over his last 10 games is the lowest ERA by a Giant in a 10-game span since **RHP Kevin Gausman** had a 1.14 ERA from May 2-June 23, 2021 (min. 60.0ip).
- 👉 Snell has 68 strikeouts over his last seven starts, which is the most by a Giant since **LHP Madison Bumgarner** struck out 69 from July 31-September 1, 2015.
- 👉 Below is a chart of where Snell ranks in MLB since July 1.

DEEP CUTS: With his last outing, Snell has now worked at least 7.0 innings in four starts this year, more than he did all of last season with SD (three times)...he's had more 7.0+ inning outings in a single season only three other times in his career (a career-best seven times in 2018 and five times apiece in 2017 and 2021)...overall, Snell has worked at least 6.0 innings in half of his 16 starts so far this year.

HOME IS WHERE THE HEAT IS: Although winless at Oracle Park, Snell has performed well with a 2.83 ERA (15er, 47.2ip), 67 strikeouts and a 1.03 WHIP in nine starts.

- 👉 Over the nine starts, Snell has received just 12 runs of support from the Giants offense.
- 👉 In five home starts since returning from the IL, Snell has a 0.29 ERA (1er, 31.1ip), 45 strikeouts and a 0.61 WHIP...the 0.29 ERA is the lowest by a Giant over a five start span at home (min. 30ip) since **RHP Juan Marichal** has a 0.20 ERA (1er, 45.0ip) from August 15-September 16, 1969.

GOTTA GET AHEAD: Getting ahead has been vital to Snell's success this season...opponents are slashing .122/.205/.180 with a .386 OPS in at-bats in which he gets ahead 0-1 in the count...when Snell falls behind 1-0, opponents are slashing .280/.400/.470 with an .870 OPS.

CURVE IT: Opponents are hitting .100 (11x110) against Snell's curveball with 61 strikeouts this season...Snell has thrown 301 curveballs since returning from the IL on July 9, holding opponents 8-for-86 (.093) with 48 strikeouts and 80 swing and misses.

WALK IT BACK: This season, Snell has walked 37 batters in 86.0 innings with an 10.7% walk rate...the Diamondbacks have a 29.8% O-Swing rate (percent of swings at pitches outside the strike zone), which is the fifth-lowest in MLB, and a 9.0% walk rate, which is fifth-highest in MLB.
