CAREER

Tall, powerful right-hander was Washington's Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2021 and 2022...Made his Major League debut in 2022 and returned to the mound in 2025.

- 1,076 days passed between his debut on Aug. 26, 2022 vs. Cincinnati and his second career appearance on Aug. 6, 2025 vs. Athletics.
- Was ranked as high as the No. 53 prospect according to MLBPipeline.com and the No. 61 prospect per *Baseball America* entering the 2023 season.
- Had the “Best Curveball” in Washington’s system, per *Baseball America*, for two consecutive seasons (2024-25)...Had the “Best Slider” in the system in 2021 and 2022.
- Led all of Minor League Baseball with 175 strikeouts in 2021.

LAST START

Cavalli struck out nine across 6.0 innings of two-run ball, allowing just three hits and two walks against the Los Angeles Angels on September 11 at Nationals Park...He took the no-decision in the 4-3 win.

vs. ST. LOUIS

Cavalli is set to make his second career start against the St. Louis Cardinals...He tossed 4.2 innings of two-run ball with four walks and three stikeouts against the Cardinals on April 7 at Nationals Park.

EARNED NOT GIVEN

Cavalli ranks 8th in the National League with a 3.12 ERA...He looks to become the first Nationals pitcher since 2019 to finish in the top 10 in the National League in ERA...**Max Scherzer** (6th, 2.92), **Patrick Corbin** (8th, 3.25) and **Stephen Strasburg** (10th, 3.32) all finished in the top 10 that season.

THREE FOR ME

Cavalli has allowed three earned runs or fewer in 29 of his 31 starts this season, the best mark among Major League starters, ahead of the New York Yankees’ **Cam Schlitte**r (28), Milwaukee’s **Jacob Misiorowski** (27) and Cleveland’s **Parker Messick** (27)...He trails only **Max Scherzer** (30, 2018) for the most such outings in Nationals history (2005-pres.).
