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THE TWINS: Began their seven-game roadtrip with a win over the Cubs last night in Chicago... today, they will play the second of three on the North Side...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland for four games against the Guardians at Progressive Field from Monday-Thursday.

✦ Last night's win put the Twins back at .500 for the first time since they were 12-12 through their game on April 22 at New York-NL...last time they were over .500 was through their game on April 21 at New York-NL, when they were 12-11.

✦ Twins have won seven of their last nine overall and 10 of their last 14.

✦ Twins are looking to win their fourth-straight game today, which would match their season-long, done five times previously, last from July 4-8.

FRIDAY NIGHT WRIGLEY LIGHTS: The Twins beat the Cubs last night at Wrigley Field by a score of 5-2...Bailey Ober (7-3) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and seven strikeouts...Tommy Nance (1.1 IP), Taylor Rogers (0.1 IP), Andrew Morris (1.0 IP) and Yoendrys Gómez (1.0 IP) combined for 4.0 scoreless innings of relief, with one hit allowed and two walks...the offense recorded seven hits and went 3-for-6 with runners in scoring position...Luke Keaschall reached base safely three times, going 2-for-3 with a walk...Ryan Jeffers hit his eighth home run of the season, a three-run jimmey jack in the third inning.

✦ The Twins organization went a perfect 7-0 yesterday, with Minnesota and each of its six minor league affiliates winning...marked the org's first time doing so since June 22, 2024.

WINNESOTA: Since May 9, the Twins have gone 33-26, the second-most wins in the AL, trailing Chicago-AL (34-24)...since June 14, the Twins have gone 17-9, posting a winning percentage of .654, tied for second-best in MLB since that date...below are overall MLB rankings since June 14:

NORTHSIDE AND NORTH STARS: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 48th time in their history today...the Twins are 23-24 all-time against the Cubs, going 7-7 at Target Field, 10-14 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 8-4 in its last 12 against the Cubs (since '21).

✦ 47 games against the Cubs are second-most against any National League opponent (Pittsburgh - 51)...this excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.

✦ In nine career games against the Cubs, Kody Clemens is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with two doubles, three home runs, four RBI and a .958 OPS.

✦ In 12 career games against the Cubs, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .290 (9-for-31) with three doubles, two home runs, seven RBI, three walks and a .970 OPS.

✦ Victor Caratini made his debut with the Cubs on June 28, 2017 at Washington...he recorded his first career hit at Wrigley Field on July 9, 2017, doubling off Wade LeBlanc.

FLIGHTS AND FIST BUMPS: The Twins have gone 10-3 in their last 13 road games...in those 13, they have hit .285 (134-for-471) and averaged 7.0 runs-per-game...they have outscored opponents 91-51.

✦ Since June 15, Minnesota's 10 wins are tied for second-most in baseball with Chicago-NL (10-3), Milwaukee (10-7) and Philadelphia (10-6), trailing Boston (12-3).

✦ Twins entered this weekend having won four-straight road series (6/15-18 at TEX, 6/19-21 at ARI, 6/29-7/1 at HOU & 7/3-5 at NYY)...they are seeking their fifth-straight road series win today, which would mark the first time since September 1-October 1, 2023, when they won each of their final five road series at Texas, at Cleveland, at Chicago-AL, at Cincinnati and at Colorado.

E-LUKE-TRIC JULY: Over 11 games this month, Luke Keaschall is hitting .419 (13-for-31) with a 1.201 OPS...below is his June and July comparisons:

BEST OF: A win today or tomorrow and the Twins will earn their 17th series victory of the season...they have gone 16-14-1 in series play, 9-5-1 at home and 7-9-0 on the road.

✦ Twins have won eight of their last nine series, taking series from St. Louis (6/12-14), Texas (6/15-18), Arizona (6/19-21), Colorado (6/26-28), Houston (6/29-7/1), New York-AL (7/3-5), Cleveland (July 7-9) and Los Angeles-AL (July 10-12)...their only series loss in that span was a sweep by Los Angeles-NL (6/22-24).

✦ Twins are seeking their sixth-straight series win, which would mark their longest since winning six-straight from June 21-July 10, 2024 (at OAK, at ARI, at SEA, vs. DET, vs. HOU, at CWS).

✦ Twins are 8-8-0 all-time in series play against the Cubs...Twins last series win over the Cubs was at Target Field from July 8-10, 2025 at Target Field (2 of 3)...their last series win at Wrigley was September 21-22, 2021, sweeping in two.

SUMMER MOUNDNESS: Over their last 24 games, since June 16, Twins starting pitchers have combined to go 9-7, 3.17 ERA (133.1 IP, 47 ER) with 44 walks, 139 strikeouts and 10 quality starts...since that date, they rank fourth in baseball in ERA...they have not allowed more than four runs in any of those starts and have allowed two runs-or-fewer in 17 of those.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Minnesota is facing a left-handed starter for the 29th time...they have gone 13-15 against lefty starters this season...their last game vs. a left-handed starter was a 3-1 win on July 7 vs. Cleveland, against Joey Cantillo...they have won each of their last two vs. lefty starters (the other was July 5 at New York-AL against Ryan Weathers).

✦ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .319 (15-for-47) with a .938 OPS vs. lefties this season.

✦ Since June 9, Josh Bell is hitting .345 (10-for-29) with a .992 OPS vs. lefties.

JEFF YEAH: In three games since returning from the IL, Ryan Jeffers has gone 3-for-12 with two doubles, one home run, five RBI and one walk...over his last 22 games, dating back to April 23, he is hitting .312 (24-for-77) with seven doubles, six home runs, 19 RBI, 13 walks, a .407 on-base percentage, a .636 slugging percentage and a 1.043 OPS.

✦ Over his last nine road games, he has a 1.174 OPS with six walks, four doubles, three home runs and nine RBI.

HAPII BIRTHDAY: Happy birthday to Twins Hall of Famer Torii Hunter, who turns 51 today...Hunter played on his birthday 12 times over the course of his 19-year career, hitting .262 (11-for-42) with three doubles, two home runs, six RBI and five walks in those games.
