Today's Headlines

Heston Kjerstad (BAL) went 3-for-5 on Friday with a double and two RBI, helping lead his Scottsdale Scorpions to a 10-3 victory over the Salt River Rafters. Kjerstad now holds an AFL batting slash of .373/.403/.661 (22-for-59) through 13 games.

Nick Yorke (BOS) had a 3-for-5 showing with the Scottsdale Scorpions on Friday, hitting a double and driving in two runs. Yorke now holds a .911 OPS in the Fall League (18-for-53) and is one of 22 qualified hitters with a figure above .900.

Mike Vasil (NYM) pitched four scoreless innings with the Peoria Javelinas on Friday, leading his team to a 4-0 victory over the Mesa Solar Sox. Vasil allowed three hits and struck out five while lowering his Fall League ERA to 4.82 over three appearances (9 1/3 IP).

Justin Fall (MIA), an Arizona State alumnus, returns to the mound at Phoenix Municipal Stadium tonight for the first time since his final season with the Sun Devils (2021). Fall was a 17th-round pick in the 2021 MLB Draft and made 18 career starts at Arizona State.

Today's schedule features the first AFL games at Phoenix Municipal Stadium in 10 years. The 17-year home of the AFL's Phoenix Desert Dogs (1995-2002; 2004-2012), Phoenix Municipal Stadium also hosted the Mesa Saguaros and Phoenix Saguaros for parts of the 1990's. The ballpark opened in 1964 and has been the Spring Training home of the San Francisco Giants and Oakland Athletics, as well as the home ballpark of the Triple-A Phoenix Giants/Firebirds. Since 2015, the venue has been the home ballpark of Arizona State University baseball.

Arizona Fall League Alumni Spotlight

Dustin Pedroia (Scottsdale Scorpions, 2004) was an Arizona State Sun Devil from 2002-2004, returning to the Valley of the Sun for the Fall League just months after his second-round selection in the 2004 MLB Draft. The right-handed-hitting infielder made his MLB debut in 2006. He played all 14 seasons of his MLB career with the Boston Red Sox, earning four All-Star selections, two World Series championships (2007 and 2013), four Gold Glove Awards and the American League MVP Award in 2008.
