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BIRDLAND BITES: Baltimore continues its final homestand of the year tonight vs. Toronto (3 to play) having been swept by Milwaukee this past weekend...Following an off day on Thursday, the Orioles wrap up the regular season with three games at Yankee Stadium...The O's are 5.0 games behind the White Sox for the final Wild Card spot with the Astros (3.0 GB) and Blue Jays (3.0 GB) also in the mix.

- Yesterday, the Orioles were shut out for the eighth time this season and for the second consecutive game...The Birds have now been shut out in consecutive games at least three separate times in the same season for the second time in Orioles history (since 1954) joining the 1955 Orioles (also three).
- The O's have not scored in 19 straight innings, marking the first time in which they have not scored in 19+ innings since a 25-inning scoreless drought from July 9-12, 2024.
- The O's have played in an AL-high 34 games decided by two runs or fewer since the All-Star break, trailing the Cardinals (37 G) and Dodgers (35 G) for the most such contests in MLB during that period.

BATTLING THE BLUE BIRDS: The Orioles have won or split each of the last seven home series with the Blue Jays dating back to 2023, including a 2-2 split in May this year...According to *STATS Perform*, it's the second-longest streak of home series without a series loss against Toronto in team history (since 1954), trailing a 10-series run between 1977-1981.

POLAR PLUNGE: **Pete Alonso** leads the AL and is fourth in MLB with 105 RBI this season while also ranking among AL leaders in total bases (3rd, 292), home runs (4th, 38), OPS (5th, .858), slugging percentage (5th, .500), extra-base hits (6th, 62), hits (T-7th, 154), and runs (8th, 92)... Since the All-Star break, his 17 home runs lead the AL ahead of SEA's Randy Arozarena (15 HR).

- He leads the AL in RBI ahead of HOU's Yordan Alvarez (99 RBI)...Alonso led the NL with 131 RBI in 2022 with the Mets and looks to become the first player to lead the AL and the NL in RBI in a season, per the *Elias Sports Bureau*...Seven Orioles have led the AL in RBI: Chris Davis (138 RBI, 2013), Miguel Tejada (150 RBI, 2004), Eddie Murray (78 RBI, 1981), Lee May (109 RBI, 1976), Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), Brooks Robinson (118 RBI, 1964), and Jim Gentile (141 RBI, 1961).
- According to *STATS Perform*, since RBI became official in 1920, the only players to lead the AL in RBI in their first year playing in the Junior Circuit (including ties) are TEX's Josh Hamilton (130 RBI, 2008), CWS' Dick Allen (113 RBI, 1972), BAL's Frank Robinson (122 RBI, 1966), BOS' Dick Stuart (118 RBI, 1963), and BOS' Ted Williams (145 RBI, 1939).
- Alonso hit his 300th career home run on September 15 at New York-NL, a game-tying solo homer in the ninth inning...According to *STATS Perform*, Alonso became the 10th-fastest player to reach 300 career home runs at 1,160 games, trailing Aaron Judge (955 G), Ralph Kiner (1,087 G), Ryan Howard (1,093 G), Juan Gonzalez (1,096), Shohei Ohtani/Alex Rodriguez (both 1,117 G), Giancarlo Stanton (1,119 G), Harmon Killebrew (1,137 G), and Mark McGwire (1,148 G)...He's hit 302 career home runs, the third most in a player's first eight seasons in MLB history behind Ralph Kiner (329) and Albert Pujols (319).
- Alonso's 38 home runs this year are the fourth most by an Oriole in their first season with the club behind Frank Robinson (49, 1966), Mark Trumbo (47, 2016), and Nelson Cruz (40, 2014)...He's the sixth Oriole with 100+ RBI in his first year with the team, along with Miguel Tejada (150, 2004), Frank Robinson (122, 1966), Albert Belle (117, 1999), Nelson Cruz (108, 2014), and Mark Trumbo (108, 2016).
- He has started all 156 O's games this year, tied for the most starts in MLB along with ATL's Matt Olson and PHI's Bryce Harper...The last Oriole to start every team game in a season was Jonathan Schoop in 2016.
- Alonso has played in 572 consecutive games, the second-longest active streak in the majors behind ATL's Matt Olson (938 G).

COBY BEEF: **Coby Mayo** has reached base safely in a career-best 23 straight games since August 25, slashing .293/.376/.598 (24-for-82) with four doubles, seven home runs, 16 runs, 16 RBI, and 10 walks.

- His on-base streak is the longest by an Oriole since **Gunnar Henderson's** 36-game stretch from May 22-June 29, 2024.
- Mayo's .571 slugging percentage since the All-Star break is the highest in the AL (min. 150 AB), outpacing teammate **Pete Alonso** (.543)
- Since August 31, he is 12-for-39 (.308) with three doubles and four home runs against right-handed pitching after going 0-for-29 off righties from August 11-30.
- Mayo is batting .315/.384/.713 (45-for-143) with nine doubles, 16 home runs, and 33 RBI this year against left-handed pitching...He leads the majors in home runs, slugging percentage, and OPS (1.097) against lefties...The 16 homers are the second most in a season off lefties by an Oriole behind Gary Roenicke's 18 in 1983.

'PEN PALS: **Josh Walker** hasn't allowed a run in 20 games (17.2 IP) since August 6, the longest streak by an Oriole since Zack Britton had a franchise-record-tying 25-game stretch from June 22-August 22, 2016.

- Eleven Baltimore pitchers have recorded at least one save this season, breaking the franchise record since saves became an official statistic in 1969...The Birds are one of seven teams in MLB to have at least 11 players tally at least one save this year, led by the Cubs, Twins, and Nationals (all 14).

PATIENCE IS A VIRTUE: The O's rank second in the AL and fifth in the majors with 569 walks this season behind the Cubs (654 BB), Brewers (648 BB), Dodgers (607 BB), and White Sox (571).

- According to the *Elias Sports Bureau*, the Birds look to lead the AL in walks for the seventh time in franchise history (since 1954) and for the first time since 1990 (660 BB).
- Baltimore has had 10 different players this season record at least 30 walks, tied for most in MLB with Milwaukee and Minnesota...It is tied for the most by the Orioles in a single season in franchise history (since 1954), along with 1999, 1982, 1973, and 1970.

NIP AND TUCK: The Orioles are 50-54 in games decided by three runs or fewer, tied for the most such games in the majors with the Guardians (56-48) and Royals (44-60)...Their .481 winning percentage in those games ranks 19th in the majors.

- Baltimore is 17-24 in one-run games this year...The team's .415 winning percentage in those situations is 26th in the majors ahead of the Rockies (.405, 17-25), Angels (.396, 19-29), Giants (.372, 16-27), and Tigers (.357, 15-27).

QUICK HITS: Baz is scheduled to make his 31st start as an Oriole after being acquired from the Tampa Bay Rays in exchange for four minor leaguers and a 2026 Competitive Balance Round A pick on December 19, 2025...The O's and Baz agreed to terms on a five-year contract extension on March 27 that covers the 2026-30 seasons.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision on September 15 at New York-NL after throwing 4.0 innings, allowing three runs on seven hits (1 HR) and two walks with two strikeouts...Threw 68 pitches, 43 strikes.

- Bo Bichette led off the fifth inning and hit a 105.1 mph liner, striking Baz on the right elbow...Baz was removed from the outing following the play.
- He has allowed four home runs over his last three starts (16.0 IP) after permitting three long balls over his previous 14 starts (80.0 IP) from June 12-August 29.

CLIPPED WINGS: Baz has made seven career starts opposite Toronto, going 4-1 with a 2.13 ERA (9 ER/38.0 IP)...Suffered the loss in his lone start this season on June 7 at Rogers Centre, allowing five runs (1 ER) on seven hits (1 HR) and one walk with three strikeouts over 5.2 innings.

- The four unearned runs allowed in his start earlier this season at Toronto were a career high.
- Among all active MLB starters who have throw at least 35.0 innings against Toronto, Baz's 2.13 ERA is second lowest behind TB's Shane McClellanahan (1.96 ERA, 12 ER/55.0 IP).
- He owns a 2.91 ERA (18 ER/55.2 IP) across nine starts against the AL East this season.

RUNS, YOU SAY?: He has received 10 runs of support over his last two starts...However, eight of the 10 came in the third inning on September 9 vs. Cleveland...In his previous eight starts from July 26-Septmeber 4, he received a total of 10 runs of support.

- Overall, his 3.49 run support average is third lowest in MLB ahead of KC's Michael Wacha (3.33) and NYY's Cam Schlitler (3.45).
- Baz is 6-2 with a 3.55 ERA (20 ER/50.2 IP) in nine starts this season when receiving four or more runs of support...In 21 starts when receiving three runs or fewer, he is 0-13 with a 4.34 ERA (59 ER/122.1 IP).

DUE FOR A DUB: Despite posting a 4.15 ERA (42 ER/91.0 IP) over his last 16 starts since June 18, he is 2-9 in those outings, with the Orioles going 4-12 in his starts.

- The Birds are 9-21 in his 30 starts.
- His 15 losses are tied for the most in MLB along with CLE's Tanner Bibee and CIN's Brady Singer...The 15 losses are the most by an Oriole since Dylan Bundy (16) in 2018.

CONTROLLING THE LONG BALL: In 36 starts since August 26, 2025, Baz has permitted 15 home runs over 201.1 innings (0.67 HR/9.0 IP)...Over his first 26 starts of the 2025 campaign, he allowed 26 homers over 138.0 innings (1.70 HR/9.0 IP).

DOUBLE TROUBLE: Baz has allowed 42 doubles, second most in MLB behind KC's Seth Lugo (44)...On April 21 at Kansas City, Baz permitted a career-high five doubles.

- The 42 doubles are the most allowed by a Baltimore hurler since Kyle Gibson (43) in 2023.
- His 35 doubles were the most allowed by an Oriole pitcher in the first half of the season in club history (since 1954), ahead of Rodrigo López (34, 2006).

SECONDARY STUFF: Over his last nine starts, opponents are slashing .400/.464/.560 (10-for-25) with a double and a home run off Baz's changeup...He opened the season holding opponents to a .250 (7-for-28) clip on the offering.

- During the same time period, he has held the opposition to a .211 (4-for-19) mark with one home run off his cutter...Opponents opened the year hitting .261 (24-for-92) with seven doubles and three homers off the pitch.

TEEEING OFF EARLY: Opponents are slashing .330/.340/.628 (31-for-94) with 13 doubles and five home runs off Baz on the first pitch of an at-bat.
