## AROUND THE HORN

**MEXICAN BASEBALL HALL OF FAME:** On Tuesday, the Mexican Baseball Hall of Fame (Salon de Fama del Beisbol Mexicano) announced its Mexican Baseball Immortals of Class 2026, featuring the D-backs' own **Erubiel Durazo** and **Rodrigo Lopez** in the "Mexicans in Major Leagues" category.

**Durazo**, who was a member of the D-backs' 2001 World Championship team, played 4 seasons (1999-2002) with Arizona and has served as D-backs Special Advisor on Mexico to the President, CEO & General Partner since 2016...**Lopez** pitched for the D-backs in 2010, where he led the team in innings (200.0) and starts (33), and has served as an analyst for D-backs Spanish Radio broadcasts since 2014 as well as general manager of Mexico's 2023 and 2026 World Baseball Classic teams.

**HERE'S THE STORY:** D-backs' starters have recorded 7 quality starts in their last 9 outings and allowed 1 or fewer runs in 6 of those.

- Since May 5, the D-backs' 2.73 ERA ranks fourth in the NL, behind the Brewers (7 G, 1.73), Braves (8 G, 1.81) and Pirates (9 G, 2.61).
- In the span, the D-backs rank among MLB leaders in quality starts (1st, 7), innings (1st, 59.1), innings/G (1st, 6.2), opponent AVG (2nd, .178), WHIP (3rd, 0.93), OBP (3rd, .249), OPS (4th, .573) and strikeouts (4th, 52).
- D-backs pitchers have starts of 6.0+ innings in 8 of their last 9 games.
- The D-backs are 15-5 (.750) when leading after 5.0 innings, including 6-4 (.600) on the road.

**LAST GAME:** The D-backs lost 6-5 @ Rangers on Wednesday after overcoming a 3-run deficit with 5 runs (1 in sixth, 1 in seventh, 3 in ninth) to give them a 2-run lead heading into the bottom of the ninth.

- **Ryne Nelson** recorded a season-high 7.0 innings and 8 strikeouts (ND, 3 R, 4 H, 0 BB)...marked the first time in his career recording 7.0+ innings, 8+ strikeouts and 0 walks.
- **Nolan Arenado** had a game-tying RBI-double in the ninth inning to go along with his RBI sac fly in the seventh inning.
- **Ildemaro Vargas** hit a go-ahead 2-run single in the ninth inning.
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** had a RBI double in the sixth inning to open up the scoring for the D-backs.
- **Corbin Carroll** reached base a career-high-tying 4 times ( 1-for-2, 2B, 3 BB, SB).

**DIVISION SHOWDOWNS:** Beginning tonight, the D-backs will face 13 straight NL West matchups (May 15-17 @ Rockies, May 18-20 vs. Giants, May 21-24 vs. Rockies, May 25-27 @ Giants) and 17 of their next 20 (also: June 1-4 vs. Dodgers).

**A ROX LEGEND:** **Nolan Arenado**, who was drafted by Colorado in the second round of the 2009 Draft, played 12 professional seasons with the organization, including 5 in the Minors (2009-2013) and 8 in the Majors (2013-20), where he was a 5-time NL All-Star, 4-time Silver Slugger, 8-time Gold Glove and 4-time Platinum Glove.

**ROLLIN' NOLAN:** **Nolan Arenado** has reached base safely in 18 of his last 19 starts, hitting .361 (22-for-61)/1.042 OPS with 5 doubles, 3 homers, 9 RBI and 10 walks, including 9 games reaching 2+ times.

- Since April 21, ranks among MLB third basemen [min. 70 PA] in OPS (2nd, 1.027), OBP (1st, .446), SLG (1st, .581), AVG (2nd, .355), runs (T-2nd, 15), times on base (T-4th, 33) and hits (T-4th, 22).
- Among active players in MLB, his 392 go-ahead or game-tying RBI are fourth most, behind Andrew McCutchen (398), Paul Goldschmidt (401) and Freddie Freeman (422).

**BULLPEN SPOTLIGHT:** In their last 12 games since May 1, the D-backs lead MLB in ERA (1.99, 7 R-6 ER in 31.2 IP), opponent AVG (.173; 19-for-110), OPS (.489), OBP (.244), SLG (.245), runs (8), hits (19), walks (9) and WHIP (0.88), and are tied for the fewest homers (0).

**GARCIA'S GAMES:** **Brandyn Garcia** has allowed only 1 single and 0 walks with 6 strikeouts in 5 games (5.2 IP) since being recalled from Triple-A Reno on May 1.

- Since May 1, ranks among MLB relievers in ERA (T-1st, 0.00), OBP (T-3rd, .059), OPS (3rd, .118) and WHIP (3rd, 0.18) [min. 5.0 IP].
- Has held opponents scoreless in 11 of his last 13 games, since Sept. 12, 2025, with a 2.08 ERA (4 R-3 ER), opponent .178 AVG (8-for-45)/.391 OPS, 2 walks and 15 strikeouts.

**¡BRAVO MORILLO!** **Juan Morillo** has allowed 1 run over his last 11 games, going 1-0 with 1 save, a 0.84 ERA (1 ER in 10.2 IP), opponent .135 AVG, 0.56 WHIP, 1 walk and 14 strikeouts.

**VS. ROCKIES:** The D-backs face the Rockies for the Rocky Mountain Showdown as part of MLB's second annual "Rivalry Weekend" presented by Booking.com.

- The D-backs have won 10 of their last 12 series vs. Rockies since 2023, going 27-12.
- The D-backs taken 4 of their last 6 road series @ Rockies since 2023, going 10-9.

- **Ketel Marte** has reached base 2+ times in 10 straight starts, hitting .488 (20-for-41)/1.416 OPS with 9 doubles, 2 homers, 14 RBI and 6 walks.
- **Corbin Carroll** has a 7-game hitting streak (.321, 9-for-28/1.139 OPS, 2 2B, 3 HR, 6 RBI, 5 BB) and hit safely in 18 of his last 19 games (.299, 23-for-77/1.036 OPS, 4 2B, 2 3B, 6 HR, 11 RBI, 12 BB).
- **Lourdes Gurriel Jr.** has a 7-game hitting streak, batting .310 (9-for-29)/.930 OPS with 2 doubles, 2 homers, 10 RBI and 1 walk...reached base in 11 straight games (.311/.930 OPS, 14-for-45, 2 2B, 3B, 2 HR, 13 RBI, 6 BB).
- **Gabriel Moreno** has 2+ hits in 5 straight games, batting .619 (13-for-21)/1.494 OPS with 5 doubles, 2 RBI and 1 walk.

## NEXT STARTER: LHP EDUARDO RODRIGUEZ (4-0, 2.25)

- Tossed a career-high 8.1 innings with 1 run in his last start on May 10 vs. Mets (W, 4 H, 3 BB, 4 K).
- In his last 3 starts (2 quality), is 2-0 with a 1.35 ERA (3 ER in 20.0 IP), opponent .157 AVG, 10 walks and 15 strikeouts.
- In his 4 road bids, is 1-0 with a 3.05 ERA (7 ER in 20.2 IP), 12 walks and 12 strikeouts.
- Won his last start road start @ Rockies, tossing 7.0 innings with 1 run (6 H, BB, 6 K) on Aug. 14, 2025.

- Is tied for the second-longest tenured active D-back with Zac Gallen and Kevin Ginkel, behind Ketel Marte (10th season), and is 1 of 12 D-backs all-time to play 8+ seasons: Ketel Marte (10), Nick Ahmed (10), Miguel Montero (9), David Peralta (9), Zac Gallen (8), **Merrill Kelly (8)**, Kevin Ginkel (8), Randy Johnson (8), Luis Gonzalez (8), Andrew Chafin (8), Christian Walker (8) and Paul Goldschmidt (8).
- Has 12+ wins and 175.0+ innings in 3 of his last 4 seasons.
- Re-signed with the D-backs on Dec. 19, 2025 (2-year contract through 2027 with a vesting option for 2028).
- Was traded to the Rangers on July 31, 2025 for top prospects RHP David Hagan (No. 8), LHP Kohl Drake (No. 12) and LHP Mitch Bratt (No. 14).

**LAST START:** Earned the win in a quality start on May 9 vs. Mets (1 ER in 7.0 IP, 3 H, 3 BB, 6 K).  
 • Recorded his eighth career win with 7.0+ innings, 3 hits or fewer and 6+ strikeouts (prev.: June 4, 2025 @ Braves).

**QUALITY CONTROL:** Looks to be the only visitor in Coors Field history with 7 straight quality starts (h/t: MLB Research)...his 6 straight are tied for the longest streak with Cole Hamels/PHI-TEX-CHC (2011-19) and Dan Haren/ATH-AZ (2006-10).  
 • His 84 quality starts are 1 shy of fourth most in franchise history with Patrick Corbin (85).

**VS. ROCKIES:** 18th start, 10th on the road.  
 • In his last 13 starts since May 2, 2021, is 8-0 (team is 10-3) with a 1.92 ERA (20 R-18 ER in 84.1 IP), opponent .215 AVG (65-for-302), 21 walks and 86 strikeouts.  
 • Ranks among starters vs. Rockies since 2022 [min. 5 GS] in ERA (1st, 1.72), wins (1st, 8) quality starts (1st, 11), WHIP (1st, 0.95), innings (2nd, 73.1) and strikeouts (2nd, 79).  
 • In his last 6 road starts, is 4-0 with a 2.19 ERA (11 R-9 ER in 37.0 IP), an opponent .224 AVG (30-for-134), 11 walks and 35 strikeouts.
