RAY REPORT—The Rays continue a six-game homestand against the Marlins (1-0, two to play) and the Orioles (three to play) today at Tropicana Field...have won 11 of 13, 17 of 20, and 24 of their last 31 games...since April 4, have the majors' best record (27-9) and ERA (3.04)...own MLB's second-best record overall behind the Braves (31-14)...are off to the third-best start in club history (see table on the right) in spite of having the fifth-toughest strength of schedule thus far (.506)...have led the AL East for seven straight days...have spent 13 days atop the division, 25 in second, six in third, four in fourth, and three in fifth.

- ★ The Rays won their seventh straight series opener with a 7-2 victory over the Marlins last night...it marks their longest streak since a span of 10 straight from May 23-June 24, 2025—that stretch was the second longest in team history and one shy of the franchise record (11G) established from April 21-May 26, 2023...they have won 10 of their last 12 series openers.
- ★ **Cedric Mullins** produced his ninth career game with four hits or more last night and first since May 21, 2023 at TOR (5H)...his performance included a pair of bunt singles, an additional infield hit, and his third home run of the campaign...per Baseball Savant, he became the third player in the majors to record three infield hits or more in a single game this season, joining teammate **Chandler Simpson** (May 11 at TOR - 3H) and **ATH Darell Hernaiz** (April 30 vs. KC - 3H)...he is the eighth Ray in the Statcast era (since 2015) to record three infield hits or more in a game.
- ★ **Yandy Diaz**'s home run in the 1st inning marked his 105th as a Ray, surpassing **Carl Crawford** for seventh most in franchise history...it also marked his 374th hit at Tropicana Field, breaking a tie with **Kevin Kiermaier** for sixth most in stadium history (see "The Great Yandino" note below).
- ★ In the 6th inning, **Hunter Feduccia** reached on a double off the B-ring catwalk...it is the first fair ball hit off a catwalk this season and the first since **Brandon Lowe** doubled off the B-ring on Aug. 17, 2024 vs. AZ.
- ★ Rays starting pitchers have allowed three runs or fewer in 20 straight starts (April 22-pres.), tied for the second-longest streak in franchise history (also: May 14-June 3, 2018), trailing only a 23-game streak from Sept. 11, 2024-April 2, 2025.
- ★ The Rays have won 11 straight at Tropicana Field, tied for their third-longest streak in franchise history (see table on the right and "Tip Trop Shape" note below).
- ★ The club is 17-3 in its last 20 games, tied for their second-best stretch in franchise history behind an 18-2 run between June 29-July 22, 2013...with a win today, they would tie the best 21-game span in franchise history (18-3, 13x, last: April 2-24, 2023)...the surge has boosted their postseason odds from 28.5 pct. (April 21) to 85.2 pct. entering play today, a 56.8 pct. increase (FanGraphs)...the Cubs (+20.6%) have the second-largest odds increase over that timeframe.
- ★ The Rays will look to secure their seventh straight series win today, which would mark their third-longest single-season streak in franchise history behind a pair of 10-set streaks from June 24-July 29, 2013 and July 28-Aug. 31, 2008.

RICHIE RICH—Today is **Richie Palacios'** 29th birthday...he last appeared in a game on his birthday in 2024 at BOS...he is batting .462 (6-for-13) with 4 RBI over his last four games (May 11-pres.).

TIP TROP SHAPE—The Rays have won 11 straight games at Tropicana Field, their longest home winning streak since a franchise-record 14-game run to open the 2023 season (March 30-April 24)...it ties the third-longest streak in club history (see table on the right)...the Rays have held opponents to three runs or fewer in all 11 games of the winning streak, the second-longest stretch at home in franchise history behind a 14-game streak from Aug. 13-Sept. 5, 2022...they have outscored opponents, 51-14, during the streak and out-homered them, 12-6...they have trailed in only two of the 10 contests, falling behind the Blue Jays 2-0 and 3-2 on May 5 and facing a 1-0 deficit against the Giants on May 3...the Rays staff has pitched to a 1.26 ERA (100.0IP, 14ER) at home since the streak began.

★ The Rays 15-4 home record is the best in the majors and their second-best start at home in franchise history behind only 2023 (17-2)...only the 2023 team (18-2) has won 16 or more of their first 20.

MAY FLOWERS—In May, **Jonathan Aranda** paces the majors in average (.439/18-for-41) and OBP (.528) and ranks highly in hits (T6th) and OPS (8th, 1.065)...has reached base safely 28 times this month, tied for second most in the majors with **CIN JJ Bleday** and **NY Yankees Aaron Judge**, trailing only **CHC Michael Busch** (29)...he has reached base safely in six straight, tied for his longest stretch of 2026 (also: March 26-April 1 & April 4-10).

★ His 33 RBI lead the AL, marking the fourth-latest into a season a Rays hitter has led the Junior Circuit in RBI, earlier than only **Evan Longoria** in 2010 (May 22) and 2009 (June 9) and **Austin Meadows** in 2021 (June 10), per Stats Perform...it is tied for the seventh-most RBI by a Ray through the club's first 43 games (also: **Fred McGriff**, 1999) and marks the most since **Randy Arozarena** (35) in 2023.

★ In his last 24 games (April 18-pres.), he is batting .338 (27-for-80) with 12B, 5 HR, 18 RBI, a .444 OBP, and a .982 OPS...his .338 average is the fourth best in the AL and eighth best in the majors during that timeframe.

THE RAY WAY—The Rays staff ranks highly in the majors in saves (1st, 19), opp. average (3rd, .218), opp. OPS (4th, .648), WHIP (4th, 1.16), and ERA (5th, 3.48)...they have posted a top-six WHIP in the majors in each of the last nine seasons (2017-25), MLB's longest active streak...the Rays have permitted three runs or fewer 22 times (T4th in AL), going 20-2 in those games compared to a 9-12 mark when allowing four runs or more...they have held opponents to two runs or fewer 17 times (T3rd) and one or zero runs 11 times (T1st).

★ The rotation paces the majors in WHIP (1.07) and opp. on-base pct. (.271) while ranking second in ERA (3.01) behind the Braves (2.93)...this includes an MLB-best 2.93 ERA (178.0IP, 58ER) in their last 36 starts dating back to April 4.

★ Despite allowing at least one run in four straight games, the Rays bullpen's 2.12 ERA (76.1IP, 18ER) over the last 20 games (April 22-pres.), still leads the majors...the Rays are the only team in MLB that has not lost when leading after five innings (22-0)...their seven blown lead losses are tied for the third-fewest in baseball (also: **BAL, CHI, CIN, LAD, STL**), behind only the Padres and Rangers (6 each)...they had five blown lead losses in their first seven games compared to two in their last 36 games (April 19 at PIT - led 2-1, lost 6-3 & May 13 at TOR - led 3-1, lost 5-3).

THE GREAT YANDINO—**Yandy Diaz** has achieved multiple milestones and climbed several of the Rays all-time lists this season:

- ★ Surpassed **Carl Crawford** (104) for the seventh-most home runs in team history last night...also marked his 374th hit at Tropicana Field, passing **Kevin Kiermaier** for sixth most in stadium history.
- ★ Recorded his 1,000th career hit via a ground-rule double on May 7 at BOS...became the 20th Cuban-born player to reach the mark in MLB history...the base knock was his 284th extra-base hit as a Ray, seventh most in franchise history...also marked 273rd multi-hit game as a Ray, surpassing **Ben Zobrist** (272) for third most in team history.
- ★ Passed **B.J. Upton** (910) for the fourth-most hits in franchise history on April 21 vs. CIN.
- ★ Became the first player to record multiple five-hit games in a Rays uniform on March 29 at STL...marked the 12th five-hit game in team history and the first since he did so on Sept. 3, 2025 vs. SEA.

NATIONAL PASTIME—The Rays have won each of their last five games against the NL (April 22-pres.), on the heels of a 4-10 start in interleague games...MLB began scheduling teams to play each of the 15 teams in the opposite league in 2023...since 2023, the Rays have a 90-69 record (.566) in interleague games, the best mark in the AL over that span.

★ **Chandler Simpson** is batting .337 (60-for-178) in 47 career interleague games with 4 2B, 3 3B, 13 RBI, and 14 SB...he posted a 13-game hitting streak between March 26-April 20, tied for the fifth-longest streak in team history against the NL...he has hit safely in 17 of 19 interleague contests this season and reached base in 18 of 19.

★ In 19 games against the NL this season, **Jonathan Aranda** is batting .344 (22-for-64) with 2 2B, 4 HR, 16 RBI, and a team-best 1.019 OPS.

SHARKBAIT OOH HA HA—Today, the Rays and Marlins continue the Citrus Series as part of MLB's second annual Rivalry Weekend...the Rays lead the all-time series, 85-63, after the clubs split the 2025 season series, 3-3...the Rays have won nine of 13, 17 of 22, and 29 of their last 36 against the Marlins...Tampa Bay has won 11 of its last 14 series against Miami, including eight straight from May 14, 2019-Aug. 31, 2022...since 2019, the Rays 28-7 (.800) record is the best by any team against a single opponent (min. 20G).

★ Five active players today (**Nick Fortes**, **Cole Sulser**, **MIA Pete Fairbanks**, **MIA Calvin Faucher**, and **MIA Christopher Morel**) have played for both clubs in their careers.

★ The Rays held an all-time record of 46-47 against Miami prior to **Kevin Cash** becoming manager in 2015...under Cash, the club is 39-16 and won a franchise-best nine straight games against the Marlins between July 22, 2018-Sept. 4, 2020.

★ Since the start of 2025, **Yandy Diaz** has gone 8-for-24 (.333) with 1 2B, 2 HR, 7 RBI, a .625 slugging pct., and a 1.010 OPS in six games against the Marlins.

SCORING CHANGE—On May 12, in the 7th inning, **Vladimir Guerrero Jr.** reached on what was originally ruled an error by **Junior Caminerro**, this has been changed to an RBI-single and affected the statistics for the following players: **Guerrero (+H, +RBI)**, **Kevin Kelly (+H)**, **Caminero (-E)**, **Cole Sulser (+ER)**.

TODAY'S START—Nick Martinez will make his ninth start with the Rays and fourth at home...marks his 289th career appearance (138th start) and 13th opposite the Marlins (sixth start)...is seeking a team-high fifth quality start of the campaign...enters his ninth major league season and first with the Rays...signed as a free agent on Feb. 10, 2026.

✦ Has earned the win in four consecutive starts, matching the longest streak of his career (4x, last: July 13-Aug. 9, 2025)...a victory today would make him the first Rays pitcher to record a win in five straight starts since **Shane McClanahan** (5) from May 17-June 9, 2022...it would also tie the sixth-longest streak in franchise history.

✦ A victory today would also make Martinez one of only two AL pitchers with three wins or more in May, joining **ATH Aaron Civale** (3-0).

✦ Ranks fourth among MLB qualifiers with a 1.70 ERA, behind **NY Yankees Cam Schlichter** (1.35), **CWS Davis Martin** (1.62), and **LAA José Soriano** (1.66).

LAST TIME OUT—Earned his fourth straight win after allowing one earned run over 5.2 innings on May 10 at BOS (W, 5.2IP, 7H, ER, OBB, 3SO)...has allowed two runs or fewer in each of his first eight starts this season, becoming the third MLB pitcher age 35 or older in the live-ball era (since 1920) to open a season with eight consecutive such starts, joining **PIT A.J. Burnett** (9G in 2015) and **BOS Rolando Arrojo** (8G in 2001)...his eight-start streak is the longest active run in the majors and the longest such streak by a pitcher age 35 or older at any point in a season since **TEX Jacob deGrom** posted 14 straight from April 18-July 1, 2025...the last time a pitcher turned the trick in nine straight contests was **ATL Chris Sale** between June 7-July 31, 2024.

✦ Has tossed 5.0 innings or more without issuing a walk twice in his career, both coming this season (also: 6.0IP, March 30 at MIL).

✦ Martinez (35.278) became the oldest pitcher in franchise history to win four straight starts, just ahead of **Charlie Morton**, who turned the trick at 35 and 210 days old (May 25-June 10, 2019).

GONE FISHIN'—The Miami native is 4-1 with a 3.58 ERA (37.2IP, 15ER) and 27 strikeouts in 12 career appearances (five starts) opposite the Marlins...in his last start against Miami on July 8, 2025, he went 5.0 innings, allowing a career-high 10 earned runs on seven hits and three walks with two strikeouts in the loss.

✦ Martinez is 7-3 with a 3.37 ERA (115.0IP, 43ER) and 91 strikeouts in 40 career appearances (14 starts) vs. NL East opponents...he has pitched to a 4.42 ERA (79.1IP, 39ER) with 63 strikeouts across those 14 starts...last faced an NL East club (NYM) on Sept. 7, 2025 where he tossed 1.0 inning of relief in seven pitches, recording his fourth hold of the year.

✦ In Interleague games this year, he is 1-1 with a 2.23 ERA (19.1IP, 5ER) and 12 strikeouts...over the span of his career, he is 12-11 with a 3.90 ERA (187.0IP, 81ER) and 153 strikeouts.

✦ The Marlins are one of four clubs he has recorded four wins or more against, joining **ATH** (4-5), **HOU** (4-5), and **LAD** (4-2).

NO PLACE LIKE HOME—At Tropicana Field this season, Martinez is 2-0 with a 1.53 ERA (17.2IP, 3ER) and 14 strikeouts...his home ERA ranks fourth in the AL and ninth in the majors, just ahead of teammate **Drew Rasmussen**, who owns a 2.00 ERA (18.0IP, 4ER) that ranks sixth in the AL.

✦ Is one of four Rays starters with two wins or more at home this year, alongside **Shane McClanahan** (3-0), **Rasmussen** (2-0), and **Jesse Scholtens** (3-1).

CHANGE UP THE PACE—Martinez has posted a .137 (7-for-51) opp. average on his changeup this season with an opp. slugging pct. of .190...min. 30 AB, his opp. SLG is the fifth lowest in the AL behind **CLE Tanner Bibee** (.034/1-for-29), **KC Kris Bubic** (.125/4-for-32), **CWS Davis Martin** (.167/3-for-30), and **CLE Joey Cantillo** (.175/5-for-40)...of those seven hits on Martinez's changeups, none of them have been barreled...his 32.4 whiff rate on the pitch is the eighth best in the AL under the same criteria.

RAISING THE BAR—Martinez ranks highly in multiple MLB pitching rankings, according to Baseball Savant...his Pitching Run Value (12), Fastball Run Value (10), and Offspeed Run Value (5) are all in the 96th percentile or higher, an improvement from his -2 Pitching Run Value, 0 Fastball Run Value, and -2 Offspeed Run Value in 2025.
