NATIONALS AFTER DARK

The Nationals will take on the Giants in game two of three at Oracle Park on Tuesday night...Washington came back from two runs down in the ninth inning to defeat San Francisco, 4-3, as the clock struck midnight in Washington D.C.... The win was the Nationals first of the season when trailing after eight innings.

- CJ Abrams** (2-for-4, 2 RBI, R) tied the game in the ninth inning with a two-run single...He would then steal second and come around to score on **Daylen Lile's** game-winning base hit.
- Miles Mikolas** worked 4.2 scoreless innings with a pair of strikeouts and allowed just three hits.
- Following this series, the Nationals will head back to Washington to enjoy an off day on Thursday before they begin a six-game homestand with the Mariners (Fri-Sun) and Royals (June 15-17).

YOU PLAY TO WIN THE GAME

Washington has won four consecutive road series, the longest streak by the Nationals since May 2018, per *Elias Sports Bureau*...With a win tonight, the Nationals would win five straight road series for the first time since Aug.-Sept. 2014.

- The Nationals are 22-13 (.629) on the road this season...Washington's 22 wins on the road are second-most in Major League Baseball behind only the Braves (23)...The .629 winning percentage ranks third-best.
- Overall, the Nationals are 23-17 (.575) since April 25...Washington has won nine of its 14 series over this stretch and has lost just two series since May 2.

VOTE FOR OUR ALL-STARS

All-Star voting is now open and **CJ Abrams** and **James Wood** have placed themselves among the best players in Major League Baseball and the National League...See charts to the right for position specific rankings.

- Abrams has reached base safely in 12 of the last 14 games...He has two doubles, three home runs, six RBI, two hit by pitches, six walks, three stolen bases and nine runs scored during that span.
- Wood has reached base safely in 21 of his last 23 games, hitting .326/.448/.547 with four doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, 18 walks, one hit by pitch and 22 runs scored during that stretch.

MAKING THEIR PITCH

Simon Mathews' pitching staff ranks fourth in Major League Baseball (second in the National League) with a 3.32 ERA in 19 games since May 19...They are 11-8 during that stretch and have secured nine saves, tied for second-most in MLB.

- Zach Littell** has won his last five games pitching to a 1.93 ERA (6 ER/28.0 IP)...He had held opponents to a .188 average over that span...His five-game winning streak is the first by a Nationals pitcher since **Stephen Strasburg** earned the win in a Nationals record (2005-pres.) seven straight games from June 21-July 28, 2019.
- Brad Lord** (5 games, 1 ER, 11.1 IP, 0.79 ERA), **Orlando Ribalta** (8 games, 1 ER, 8.1 IP, 1.08 ERA) and **Paxton Schultz** (5 games, 1 ER, 6.1 IP, 1.42 ERA) have all yielded just one earned run in relief since May 19.

BACKSTOP BATS

Drew Millas and **Keibert Ruiz** have been the most productive offense catching tandem in Major League Baseball since May 6...Combined, they rank among all MLB catching groups in slugging percentage (1st, .579), OPS (1st, .952), batting average (1st, .318), RBI (1st, 24) and hits (1st, 34), home runs (14th, 6).

- Ruiz has hit safely in 15 of his last 19 games, going 24-for-65 (.369) with nine doubles, four homers, 18 RBI, three walks, one stolen base and 13 runs scored.
- On the season, Ruiz is tied for first among Major League catchers with 14 doubles and fourth among all catchers (min. 100 PA) in slugging percentage (6th, .496).

VERY OFFENSIVE AS OF LATE

Since May 6, Washington's offense ranks first in runs scored (173), RBI (168) and in home runs (49) and second in slugging percentage (.458) and doubles (58) and OPS (.785).

- Washington has scored 51 runs in the first inning this season, the most in Major League Baseball.
- The Nationals have also scored 130 runs in the seventh inning or later this year, also the most in MLB.
- The Nationals recorded at least one extra-base hit in 32 straight games from April 29-June 2, the fourth-longest active streak in baseball behind San Francisco (36), Pittsburgh (34) and Chicago White Sox (33) at that time.

THIS AND THAT

Some notable notes about other Nationals players:

- Daylen Lile** is tied for second among National League outfielders with 15 doubles.
- Nasim Nuñez** is tied for the lead in Major League Baseball in stolen bases (23).
- Dylan Crews** reached safely in 14 straight games after he was recalled on May 19.

FARM REPORT

A PLAYER AND A PITCHER OF THE WEEK

Harrisburg right-handed pitcher **Josh Randall** threw 7.0 scoreless innings striking out nine batters while only allowing three hits and a walk on June 5 against Somerset to earn Eastern League Pitcher of the Week...In his last three starts, he's gone 2-0 and has allowed just one earned run with 18 strikeouts and a .185 opponent's average in 18.0 innings pitched.

Fredericksburg outfielder **Gavin Fien** earned Carolina League Player of the Week by hitting .500 (9-for-18) with a double, two home runs, 15 RBI, four walks and a stolen base over his last five games...He has at least two RBI in each of those five games, including a five-RBI game on June 6.
