JUMPIN' JUPITER: The St. Louis Cardinals continue their 29th Spring Training at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium (1998-2026) today when they welcome the New York Mets to Jupiter, the 19th of 28 scheduled Spring Training games for the Redbirds.

• Beginning today, the Cardinals play in Jupiter for seven of the final 10 Grapefruit League games.

• On Monday, March 23, the Cardinals break camp in Florida and fly to Springfield, Mo. to play an exhibition with the Double-A Cardinals at Hammons Field at 6:05 p.m. CT.

PLAYING FOR KEEPS: Two weeks from today on March 26, the Cardinals will host the Tampa Bay Rays on Opening Day, the earliest game in franchise history.

• St. Louis played on March 27 last season vs. Minnesota, a 5-3 Redbirds winner at Busch Stadium.

CARDS SPRING ROSTER STANDS AT 43: The Cardinals recently reduced their Spring Training roster to 43 players after re-assigning RHP **Max Rajcic**, LHP **Bruce Zimmermann**, and OF **Chase Davis** to Minor League camp.

IN FULL BLOOM: The Cardinals introduced **Chaim Bloom** on Sept. 30 as the team's new President of Baseball Operations taking the post that had been held by **John Mozeliak** who headed the team's baseball operations since Oct. of 2007 ... Bloom, who worked previously with the Boston Red Sox (2020-23) and Tampa Bay Rays (2005-19) had served as an advisor for the Cardinals the past two seasons.

RED JACKETS: 12 Cardinals Hall of Famers scheduled to be present on 2026 Opening Day at Busch Stadium include **Ozzie Smith**, **Édgar Rentería**, **Tony La Russa**, **Ray Lankford**, **Ted Simmons**, **Vince Coleman**, **John Tudor**, **Jason Isringhausen**, **Willie McGee**, **Mark McGwire**, **Al Hrabosky**, and **Scott Rolan**.

SPRING BREAKOUT: As part of MLB's third annual Spring Breakout showcase, the top Cardinals prospects will host by the Nationals top young talent on March 19 at Roger Dean Chevrolet Stadium, following the Cardinals Nationals game at 1:05 p.m.

• The exhibition will be streamed live and for free on MLB.TV, MLB.com, and on the MLB App.

• St. Louis will have 25 of its top 30 prospects participating, including eight of the top 10.

FRIDAY NIGHT LIGHTS: Tomorrow night is the second of two Spring night games for the Cardinals in 2026.

• Since 2006, St. Louis is 19-16-5 overall in Spring Training night games, including a 7-4-0 mark in Jupiter.

• Since 2006, the Cardinals 49 night Grapefruit League games are the fewest in Major League Baseball (thanks to **C.J. Cherre** & **Ernie Moore**) ... The White Sox (45 games) rank 29th, while the Dodgers (152 games) lead MLB.

WHITE NAMED BUCK O'NEIL AWARD WINNER: The National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum's Board of Directors selected **Bill White** as the 2026 recipient of the John Jordan "Buck" O'Neil Lifetime Achievement Award, presented to an individual for extraordinary efforts to enhance baseball's positive impact on society ... The 92-year-old White will be honored at the Awards Presentation on July 25, as part of 2026 Hall of Fame Weekend ... White played eight seasons in St. Louis (1959-65, '69) and was inducted into the Cardinals Hall of Fame in 2020.

FEELING A DRAFT: The Cardinals own six of the top 86 picks (13, 32, 50, 68, 72, 86) in the upcoming 2026 MLB Draft, the most of any Major League team ... Since the DeWitt ownership group (1996-present), 2026 will be only the third time St. Louis has possessed as many as six of the top 86 selections, following 2005 (6 of top 78) and 2012 (6 of top 86).

TODAY'S PITCHERS

#36 MICHAEL McGREEVY · RHP · 6-4 · 230 LBS · AGE 25

- Makes his fourth Grapefruit League start today.
- Cardinals 1st round pick in 2021 made his Major League debut vs. Texas on July 31, 2024, throwing 7.0 innings and allowing one run in a 10-1 victory.
- Has 11 wins in his first 21 Major League games, 6th Cardinals pitcher to achieve that mark and first since Luis Arroyo in 1955. Jack Harper set the franchise record with 14 wins in 1901. Bobby Miller of the Dodgers was the last in MLB with 11 (2023).
- His .769 win percentage Post All-Star Break over the past two seasons (2024-25) is the best among starting pitchers. His 7 wins post All-Star Break ranked T-5th among Major League pitchers. Most by a Cardinals pitcher since Adam Wainwright went 10-2 post All-Star Break in 2021.
- Ranked among N.L. rookies in 2025 Wins (8, T-2nd), Innings Pitched (95.2, 6th) and Games Started (16, 6th)
- Combined to make 31 starts over 32 appearances between St. Louis and Memphis (AAA) in 2025. Hurlled a career-high 170.2 innings and won 16 games.

#67 MATT PUSHARD · RHP · 6-3 · 250 LBS · AGE 28

- Selected from the Miami Marlins in the 2025 Major League Baseball Rule 5 Draft. Became the first Major League Rule 5 Draft Pick the Cardinals have selected from the Marlins.
- Member of the 2025 International League Champion Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp (AAA).
- Was originally signed by the Miami Marlins as a non-drafted free agent out of the University of Maine in 2022.
- Made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League at 24-years old making five appearances.
- Has held his opposition to a .197 BA over 722 total batters faced over his minor league career.
- Developed a sweeper during the 2025 season, an east-to-west pitch from his over-the-top pitching slot.
- Appeared in 134 minor league games as a member of the Marlins organization. Made only one start, coming during the 2025 season in Jacksonville (AAA). A spot start at Syracuse (6/17) pitching 2.0 innings.

#58 CHRIS ROYCROFT · RHP · 6-7 · 245 LBS · AGE 28

- Signed by the Cardinals as a minor league free agent, two days after his 25th birthday, following pitching two seasons with the independent Joliet Slammers of the Frontier League, the local team near his hometown and college.
- Struck out Francisco Lindor (swinging) for his first Major League strikeout. Surrendered a home run to two-time All-Star Game Home Run Derby Winner, Pete Alonso, as the next batter, challenging him on a 1-2 pitch.
- At 6-foot-7, is the tallest to appear for St. Louis since pitchers Adam Wainwright (6-7) and Andrew Miller (6-7). Only minor league pitchers D.J. Carpenter (6-8) and Reiner López (6-8) are taller in the organization.
- Climbed three levels during the 2023 season from Peoria (High-A) to Memphis (AAA) before making his Major League debut in 2024.
- In 2024, profiled the lowest hard-hit percentage (exit velocity of 95 MPH or more) on four-seam fastballs (13.0%) of pitchers facing 40 or more batters.
- Was selected to his first Opening Day roster in 2025 and retired the side (9-1-2) in order with a strikeout for a Hold vs. Minnesota (March 27)

#65 GEORGE SORIANO · RHP · 6-1 · 230 LBS · AGE 27

- Acquired by the Cardinals on February 10, 2026 from the Nationals in a trade that sent RHP Andre Granillo to Washington.
- Was claimed off waivers three times in 2025-26 off season by the Orioles (11/5/25), Braves (1/9/26) and Nationals (1/30/26).
- Has been on the Marlins Opening Day roster each of the last two seasons (2024 & 2025).
- Pitched in 72 Major League games, making one start, as a member of the Miami Marlins (2023-25).
- Made one postseason appearance completing a scoreless inning with the Marlins in Game 1 of the 2023 Wild Card round against the Philadelphia Phillies at Citizens Bank Park.
- Made his Major League debut vs. Arizona (April 16, 2023) tossing 3.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with a pair of strikeouts. Fanned All-Star outfielder Corbin Carroll for his first Major League strikeout.
