Offense

Atlanta plated 12 more runs in a win, 12-1, over Miami yesterday afternoon, and the club's 206 runs dating to the All-Star break are third most in all of baseball.

Only the Brewers (227) and Blue Jays (224) have scored more runs since the break.

Atlanta plated double-digit runs in each of its final two games in Miami, and its seven total 10-run games since the break are the most in baseball. The club scored at least 10 runs just four times in 95 games before the break.

The Braves are scoring over a full run more per game after the All-Star break (5.42) than it did before (4.08).

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Braves and Phillies tonight open a four-game weekend series with what is the 10th of 13 scheduled meetings between the clubs this season...This weekend marks the final scheduled series between the two clubs this season.

A The Braves and Phillies last met for three games at Truist Park, June 27-29, and Philadelphia took two-of-three that weekend...Atlanta is 4-5 over the first nine games between the teams this year, and needs to win three-of-four this weekend to take the season series.

A Atlanta went 7-6 against Philadelphia last season to win the season set, and has won the season series with the Phillies in four straight years...The Braves have won the season set with the Phillies in four consecutive years for the first time since a five-year run, 2012-2016.

A Atlanta dropped two-of-three games here at Citizens Bank Park earlier this season, and is just 2-6 over its last eight games here dating to last season...Dating to the opening of Citizens Bank Park in 2004, the Braves' 100 total defeats here are their most in any visiting stadium.

A RH Cal Quantrill is set tonight to make his second start with Atlanta and the sixth of his career versus Philadelphia...The 6-foot-3, 195-pound Ontario native is 1-1 with a 5.55 ERA (15 ER/24.1 IP) all-time against the Phillies, including 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA (10 ER/7.1 IP) in two turns this season while with the Marlins...Atlanta claimed him off waivers from Miami on August 21, and he allowed five hits and three runs over 4.2 innings in his only start with the Braves, August 23 vs. the Mets.

A RH Aaron Nola has pitched against the Braves more than any other team in his career, compiling a 16-11 record with a 3.59 ERA (91 ER/228.1 IP) over 37 total starts...The 6-foot-2, 200-pound native of Baton Rouge, LA, has not faced Atlanta this season, but over four turns against the Braves last year he went 1-1 with a 5.40 ERA (13 ER/21.2 IP)...The right-hander has made two starts since returning from the injured list, and has combined to allow 12 hits and eight earned runs over 8.1 innings across the two games.

OLSON IN PHILLY: Matt Olson enters play tonight with 15 career homers in 33 games in this building, including 14 across 28 regular season starts...He is a career .252/.312/.677 batter at Citizens Bank Park.

A Only three visiting players have more in this building between the regular and postseasons - Freddie Freeman and Juan Soto with 17 (in 113 & 44 games, respectively), and Michael Conforto with 16 (in 62 games).

A Olson's .998 OPS here at Citizens Bank Park is fourth highest by any player, home or road, with at least 100 at-bats in this building...Only Soto (1.133), Starling Marte (1.009) and Bryce Harper (1.002) have higher marks.

JURICKSON PROFAR: Reached base five total times and scored four runs yesterday afternoon, going 2-for-3 with a pair of homers and three walks...Over 25 games in August, he has batted .309/.454/.660 with a 1.113 OPS.

A Profar's 205 wRC+ in August are the most by a qualified batter in baseball, and his 1.6 fWAR ranks sixth.

A No player in baseball has drawn more than Profar's 23 walks this month, and his .454 on-base percentage trails just Geraldo Perdomo (.474) and Nick Kurtz (.471).

A Of the 28 players with at least 50 plate appearances out of the leadoff spot this month, Profar leads in homers (tied, 8), runs (24), RBI (24) and total bases (58).

A Dating to his reinstatement from the restricted list on July 2, Profar's 1.6 fWAR are the most by a primary left fielder in the National League...In the 80 games in which he was restricted, Atlanta's primary left fielders compiled -1.0 fWAR, third lowest at the position across baseball.

OZZIE ALBIES: Homered for the second consecutive game yesterday afternoon, going 2-for-5 with a pair of runs and five total RBI...He hit a pair of homers on Tuesday night, and drove in nine total runs over the final two games of Atlanta's series in Miami.

A Since 2021, there are three occurrences of a Brave having nine RBI in a two-game span, and Albies owns all three - June 29-30, 2021 (10 RBI), August 18-19, 2025 (9 RBI) and August 26-27, 2025 (9 RBI).

A All three homers over his last two games were hit on the barrel...He had just 14 barrels over his first 131 games this season...Four of his 12 hardest-hit balls of the season have come over his last four games.

A In 38 games since the All-Star break, Albies has batted .265/.327/.435 across 162 plate appearances...He leads all second basemen in baseball in RBI (30) in that span, ranks second in extra-base hits (13) and total bases (64), and third in homers (6), doubles (7) and runs scored (22).

RONALD ON BASE: Ronald Acuña Jr. registered just one at-bat but reached base five total times yesterday afternoon...He worked a career high-tying four walks and was hit by a pitch in the third inning.

A He became one of just two players in the majors this season to go hitless but still reach base at least five times, joining Pittsburgh's Joey Bart (4 BB, HBP)...Only four major leaguers have done it since the 2020 season.

A The last Brave to reach five times in a hitless performance was Dale Murphy, who drew five walks on April 22, 1983, versus the New York Mets.

A Acuña Jr has batted just .279 (12-for-43) and hit one homer since returning from the injured list on August 15, but owns a .426 on-base in that span.

- A* Making his 26th start of the season, second with Atlanta and sixth of his career against Philadelphia.
- A* Made two starts against the Phillies earlier in the season while with Miami, going 0-1 with a 12.27 ERA between both outings.
- A* Is 1-1 with 5.55 ERA in five starts against Philadelphia.
- A* In 19 starts against NL East Opponents, Quantrill has gone 2-6 with a 4.89 ERA.
- A* Making his third career start at Citizens Bank Park...Owns a 0-1 record with a 7.71 ERA in his previous two outings in Philadelphia while pitching with Miami and Colorado.
- A* Was claimed off waivers by Atlanta on August 22.
- A* Went 4-10 with a 5.50 ERA in 24 starts with Miami this season.
- A* Suffered the loss in his Braves debut, allowing five hits, three runs and three walks over 4.2 innings pitched.

2025

- A* Made his sixth career Opening Day Roster, first with Miami.
- A* Recorded an immaculate inning, the first of his career, on May 18 against Tampa Bay in the fourth inning...Punched out Jonathan Aranda, Christopher Morel and Kameron Misner on nine pitches.
- A* It was the first immaculate inning in the majors for the 2025 season and the second in Marlins in franchise history.
- A* Eclipsed 600 strikeouts and 800.0 innings pitched at Cincinnati on July 10, becoming the 15th Canadian-born player to reach the milestones.
- A* Made two starts against Atlanta, going 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA with five strikeouts between both outings.
- A* Atlanta claimed Quantrill off waivers from Miami on August 22, 2025.
- A* Went 4-10 with a 5.50 ERA in 24 starts with the Marlins.
- A* Went 1-2 with a 2.92 ERA in five outings in the month of July.

Career

- A* Went 27-15 with a 3.58 ERA over parts of four seasons with Cleveland between 2020-23.
- A* The 99 appearances for the Guardians are easily the most for a single club in his career.
- A* Was traded from Cleveland to Colorado on November 17, 2023 in exchange for catcher Kody Huff.
- A* Went 8-11 with a 4.98 ERA in 29 starts with Colorado during the 2024 season.
- A* Among pitchers with as many starts as Quantrill since the beginning of the 2021 season, his 144 outings are the 12th most in baseball and easily the most among any primary starter on the Braves staff.
- A* San Diego traded Quantrill to Cleveland along with Catcher Austin Hedges, Josh Naylor, Gabriel Arias, Joey Cantillo and Owen Miller in exchange for RHP Mike Clevinger, OF Greg Allen and Player To Be Named Later.

- A* Quantrill's father, Paul, spent 14 years in the majors between Boston, Toronto, Los Angeles (NL), New York (AL), San Diego, and Miami.
- A* Selected by the San Diego Padres in the First Round, eighth overall, of the 2016 June Amateur Draft from Stanford University.
